

Since the shooting, no additional incidents have been reported.

The local authorities were notified and the Subject was detained for a 72 hour psychiatric evaluation. Both threatened offices were contacted and they received identifying information on the Subject for future reference. An "Urgent Report" was generated on this threat situation and forwarded to FBIHQ on the same evening of the incident. A copy of the Campbell Police Department Police Report, case number 2004-4884, documenting the arrest of will be attached hereto for further reference. As this matter will not be prosecuted, the Subject identifying information will be entered into ACS and it is recommended that this matter be closed on this same
