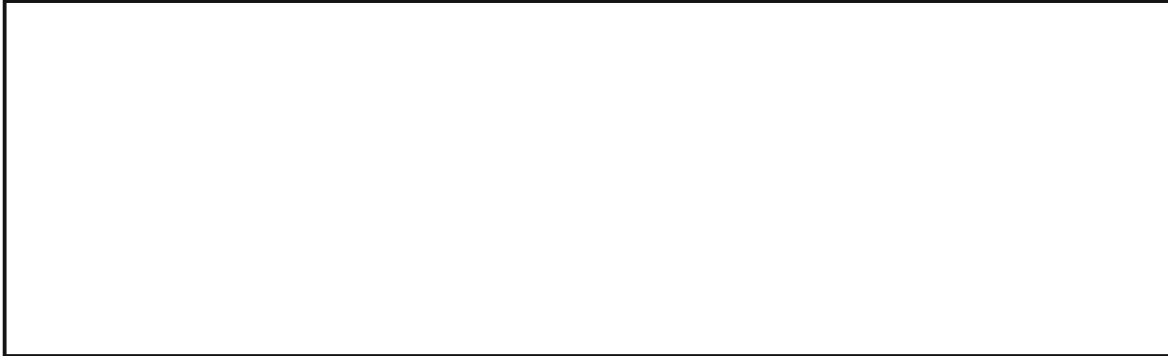

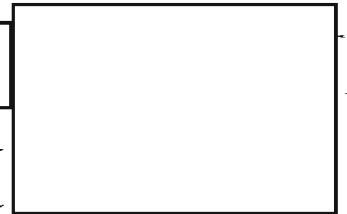

He is going to give me more wealth than I know what to do with. Now, my advice is to double or triple the security because he ain't worth very much in a lot of people's eyes."

(He tried to use a southern accent on the second message.)

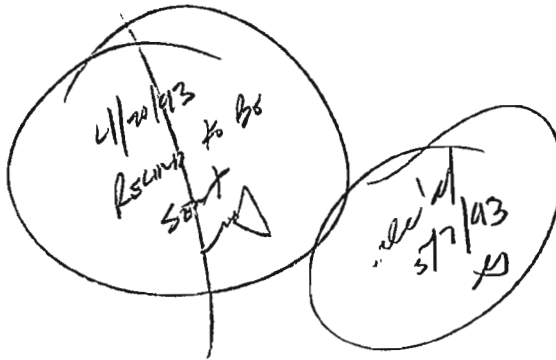

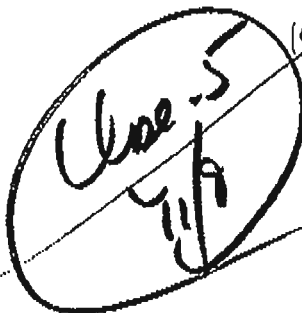

After being advised of the purpose of the interview and identity of the interviewing agent [redacted] provided the following:

[redacted] stated he was retired from the IBT where he had previously worked with the office of Joint Counsel in Los Angeles in public relations. Upon questioning, he admitted to making several telephone calls in September 1990 to the IBT at tele. (800) 828-6496. However, when confronted with the quotes in the complaint, such as "You're a dead duck bitch" and "You're going to be a victim", [redacted] denied making those statements, indicating that his threats were always "conditional." To illustrate, [redacted] said his threats were: "But for 30,000 miles between us I'd get you."

A review was attempted of [redacted] last telephone bill. However, [redacted] indicated he had thrown it away. He did provide one telephone bill. Examination of that bill revealed over 118 telephone calls to tele. [redacted] between March 28 and April 2, 1990. [redacted] said, referring to the IBT, they "won't give me a therapist or a dentist."

[redacted] claimed he was suffering from post traumatic stress syndrome because of the death of relatives in wars. He said he was also upset because the IBT wouldn't provide him with a psychotherapist.
