Synopsis: To report a possible threat to United States Senator Robert C. Byrd.

Reference: Reference telcal from SSRA [redacted]
Charleston, West Virginia, RA, to SSA [redacted] VC/FU.

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Details: On 01/11/2000, Detective [redacted] Cabell County, West Virginia, Sheriff's Department (CCSD), advised that [redacted] West Virginia, [redacted] is well-known by members of the CCSD. He explained that [redacted] [redacted] has become infatuated with an aide in the Washington, D.C., office of United States Senator Robert C. Byrd.

Detective [redacted] explained that [redacted] has written several letters to the aide, as well as having placed numerous telephone calls to her. Detective [redacted] indicated, however, that [redacted] recently made a statement that, given his current condition, raised concern of the CCSD. He advised that [redacted] recently telephonically contacted [redacted]

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[redacted] and stated, "I thought I only had one to take care of but I got several in line. I'm going to go to the Federal Building in Beckley (West Virginia) and when I get back, we'll get together and have a party and ice cream." Detective [redacted] advised that Supervisory Deputy United States Marshal [redacted] Charleston, West Virginia, has been

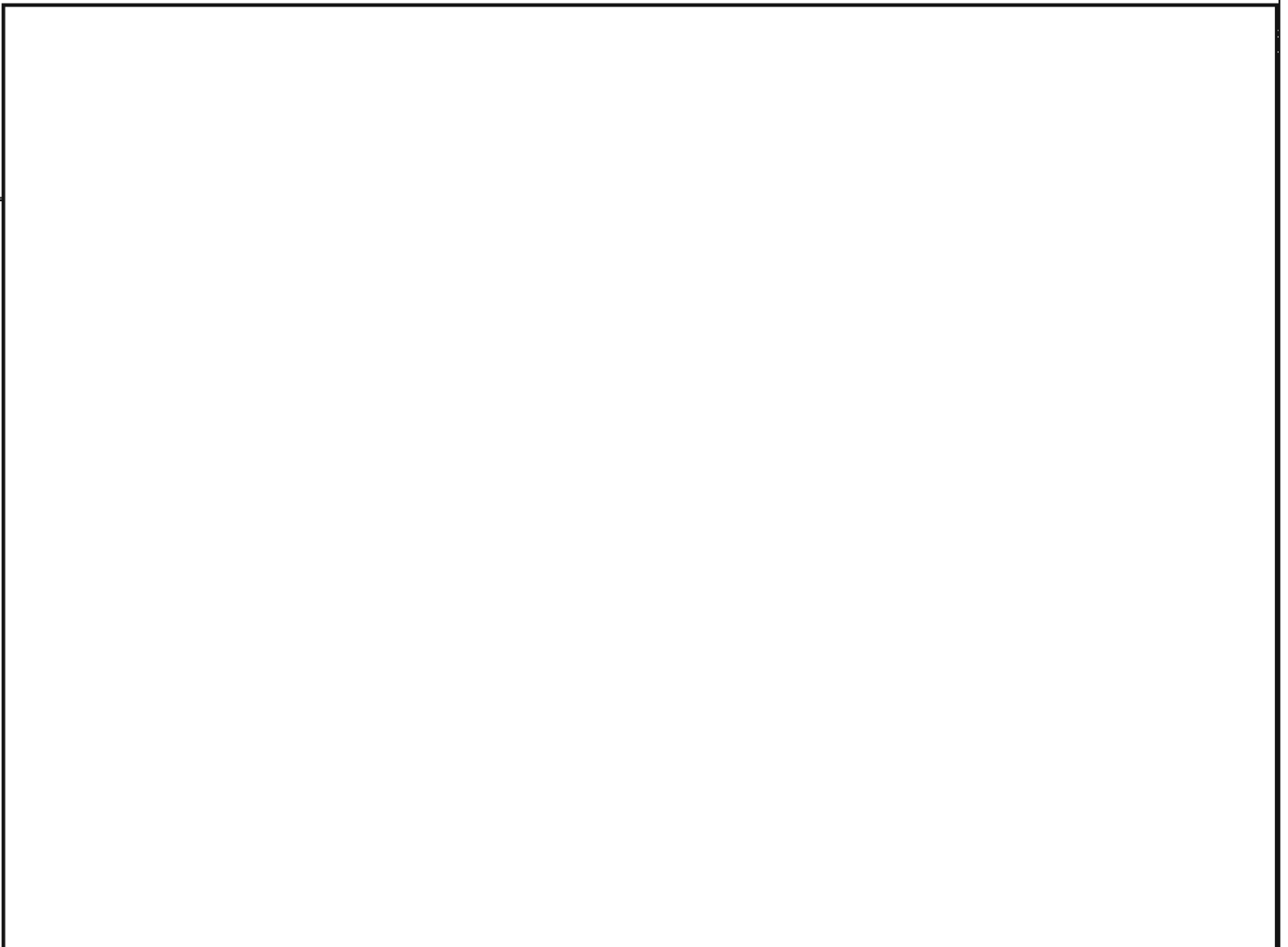
