[redacted] was interviewed at his residence. After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agents and the nature of the interview, [redacted] provided the following information to Special Agents (SA) [redacted]

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[redacted] grew up in Michigan. In 2005, he moved to Florida with his parents. He has lived in Florida since that time. [redacted] previously worked [redacted] He left that job in 2011 to pursue a master's degree. [redacted] graduated from the master's program in May, 2013, and has worked odd jobs since that time. [redacted] currently works 10 hours per week as a [redacted] Florida. The home [redacted] resides in is a rental. He has lived in the home for approximately three years. He resides in the residence [redacted]

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Because he is not working full-time, [redacted] stated he has a lot of time on his hands. As a result, [redacted] spends a fair amount of time on the internet surfing web-sites. About one year ago, [redacted] described it as a posting site used to generate conversation. [redacted]

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[redacted] is one of those sites in which the more outrageous the information, the more likely it is that people will start to talk about it.

On Wednesday, [redacted] web-site looking at posts. He estimated it was sometime between 2 p.m. and 5 p.m., Eastern Time (ET), when he decided to start a thread of his own. [redacted]

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prior knowledge anything was going to occur in the northwest, he simply picked the area [REDACTED] did not have any prior conversations with anyone concerning violence in the northwest, and manufactured the entire thread on his own. [REDACTED] stated his goal was to generate conversation and continue to promote the thread like something was going to happen. After about a half-hour he intended to shut it down by saying something [REDACTED] [REDACTED] found some entertainment in stringing other posters along for a short time, and then making them feel like they were "punked".

Once [REDACTED] started the thread, he waited to see if he would get any responses. After receiving minimal responses, [REDACTED] decided to make second post in an effort to spur more conversation. He then wrote, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] then waited a bit longer, but only received posts indicting people were not interested. He monitored the post for 10 or 15 minutes, and then moved on to other areas of the internet. [REDACTED] stated he never returned to the thread stream, and does not know if any additional communication occurred.

The following day, Thursday, October 1, 2015 [REDACTED] saw news reporting concerning a school shooting in Oregon. [REDACTED] estimated it was around 2:00 or 3:00 p.m., (ET) when he returned to the [REDACTED]

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[REDACTED] watched the thread for about five minutes and did not see any significant response. When the thread stream did not start a dialog, he moved on to other areas of the internet.

[REDACTED] denied looking at his prior thread on October 1, 2015. He believed the threads on [REDACTED] and he did not think a thread he posted on [REDACTED] would be available for access the following day. [REDACTED] had no information concerning any posts made to the thread after he left it on [REDACTED] further denied ever travelling to Oregon, or knowing anyone who lives in Oregon. [REDACTED] did state he talks to unidentified individuals on the internet and their locations are unknown. At the time of the interview, [REDACTED] had no information on the identity of the suspect in the Oregon shooting. [REDACTED] was shown a photo of the suspect and stated he does not know the individual.

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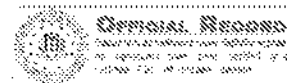
[REDACTED] stated he understands the severity of the issue and the potential impact of his thread stream. [REDACTED] stated his posting of the thread was something he made up in his head to spark conversation. [REDACTED] stated it was childish, stupid, and a result of him having too much time on his hands. [REDACTED] reported having no prior knowledge of a shooting in the

Summary of Possible Protest Activity

To: US Secret Service

CC: Roseburg Police Department, Douglas County Sheriff's Office, and Oregon State Police

FBI Portland has no information identifying a direct threat to President Obama's 9 October 2015 visit to Roseburg, Oregon.

FBI Portland is aware of internet postings concerning potential protests that may occur in conjunction with President Obama's visit. The identified posting and possible protest activity is presently assessed to consist of First Amendment and Second Amendment protected activity. Should these protests occur, there exists the potential for conflicts between the groups which could result in criminal activity requiring a substantial response by local law enforcement and impacting the Roseburg community. The identified potential protest activity is summarized below:

- The Westboro Baptist Church posted [redacted] immediately after the shooting indicating their possible interest in protesting victims' funerals. As late as 6pm on 6 October, Westboro Baptist Church posted a [redacted] indicating the potential for their members to protest. Recent protests by Westboro Baptist Church involve small numbers of members.
- Protests by Westboro Baptist Church usually draw a large number of counter-protesters. Several open source searches indicate the potential for members of the Roseburg and surrounding community to oppose the Westboro Baptist Church. Counter-protesters of Westboro Baptist Church generally well outnumber the Westboro Baptist Church members.
- Defend Roseburg – Deny barack [sic] Obama protests organized via [redacted]
[redacted]. This event was created on [redacted] approximately 5 October after the announcement of President Obama's visit. The event is planned to have protests starting at 9am in the following locations: 1) intersection of Stuart

(Stewart) Parkway and Aviation Dr., 2) intersection of Edenbower Blvd and Hwy 99, and 3) intersection of College Road and Hwy 99. Open carry is permitted in Roseburg and people communicating on this [REDACTED] page and other online locations are encouraging open carry in protest of President Obama's stance on gun control. As of 10:45 am on 7 October 2015, the event site indicates 4,172 people plan to attend. This number is almost certainly much larger than the number of people who will actually attend. It is estimated, [REDACTED]

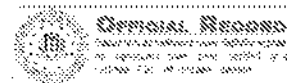
- Presidential visits and motorcades can draw crowds. It is possible that the President's activities will draw an unknown number of other onlookers who are not affiliated with any of the previously mentioned events.

[redacted] is a Lieutenant and a Paramedic for Douglas County Fire District #2 working out of Station #2 in Green, Oregon. At the time the active shooter incident at UCC occurred, [redacted] was driving with [redacted] in Ambulance #1172. At that time, they were participating in training at Station #3 in Melrose, west of downtown Roseburg. They were engaged in what [redacted] described as "nozzle forward firefighting training." They were finishing up the training when the call for EMS at UCC regarding an active shooter came over the radio.

[redacted] initial understanding was that there was only one patient needing transport to a hospital. [redacted] was advised by Captain [redacted] to respond to the scene. [redacted] directed him without going through dispatch to respond. During their drive towards UCC, [redacted] confirmed the location on the UCC campus was Snyder Hall. They also heard there may be 20 people injured. While driving to the college, they considered staging away from campus to determine if the active shooter was still ongoing, but ultimately proceeded directly onto the campus. They parked their ambulance on the main road in front of the buildings, offloaded their gurney and additional response gear they needed and moved toward Snyder Hall.

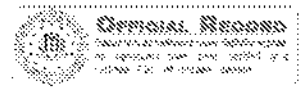

After being advised of the identity of the interviewing Agent, Marlar provided the following information.

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Marlar was at Fire District Headquarters when the active shooter incident occurred at UCC. Marlar and Medical Services Chief Teresa Mutscher responded to the scene at UCC together in Marlar's vehicle. They were followed there in a separate department vehicle by the Fire District's Public Information Officer(PIO) Ray Shouffer. Marlar recalled following Oregon State Police(OSP) Troopers onto the UCC campus.

Marlar was initially under the impression the incident was limited to a singular female victim. However, while they were traveling to the campus, they called for additional units and ambulances to also respond to the scene. Upon their arrival on campus, they immediately learned there were multiple victims.

Marlar immediately became the On-Scene Commander(OSC) for Emergency Medical Services and went into the role. Marlar looked in the classroom where the shooting occurred and observed [REDACTED]

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Marlar recalled that Firefighters [REDACTED] and Chief Mutschler began triaging the victims in the classroom. Marlar recalled calling for more of the tags typically use in their triage system. Anyone designated with a black tag was left in place, while those designated with a red tag were identified as critical and the most viable and moved as quickly as a possible to a hospital.

Marlar did not recall seeing guns at the scene. He was not aware of where they were or if they were moved. If any weapons had been moved, he

CASE FACTS

On October 1, 2015 at approximately 10:37 AM the Douglas County 911 Center received a call regarding an active shooting at Umpqua Community College. Police officers from multiple agencies responded to the call. Officers arrived on scene at Snyder Hall and identified the suspect who they exchanged gunfire with. Officers entered the classroom and put handcuffs on the suspect. I entered the classroom with other officers and observed multiple victims with gunshot wounds. The victims ranged from deceased to walking wounded. I observed approximately 20 victims within the classroom and immediate area.

The handcuffed suspect was in the front of the classroom near the center. I observed three handguns lying on the floor as I entered the room. One of the guns was empty with the slide locked back. I cleared the other two handguns which were chambered with live rounds.

Detective [REDACTED] told me that he spoke with Deputy [REDACTED] who identified the shooter as Christopher Harper-Mercer through UCC student identification and his driver's license.

His driver's license listed his home address as [REDACTED]
Detectives from the Oregon State Police contacted Harper-Mercer [REDACTED]

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[redacted] at the listed address. Det [redacted] interviewed [redacted] and she told the detectives [redacted] Christopher Harper-Mercer has had mental issues since he was young. She also told detectives [redacted] has numerous guns and on this morning she noticed a .380 pistol was missing. [redacted] that Christopher has a computer in his room that he uses all the time.

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[redacted] that Christopher has been in a mental hospital on three different occasions. The first time was when Christopher was 4-5 years old in Torrence, California. The second time was when he was in his early teens at UCLA. The third time was when he was in his late teens at Torrence, California [redacted] that Christopher was medicated from 4-18 years old for psychological and behavioral issues. [redacted] that Christopher stopped taking his medications when he was 18 years old.

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Detective [redacted] told me that [redacted] said that Christopher resides in the residence with [redacted]

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Detective [redacted] told me that he received a thumb drive from [redacted] a student at UCC. [redacted] said he found the thumb drive in a manila envelope near a smoking area. Detective [redacted] was informed by a student in the class that the suspect had given him the manila envelope seconds before the shooting started. The suspect told the student "they will want this after it is all done". The student said when the shooting started he ran and dropped the envelope near the smoking area. The thumb drive was reviewed by [redacted] and it contained a manifesto of the suspect's background and the reason for the shooting. Also on the thumb drive was historical information about other mass shootings.

This investigation is being conducted by local, State, and Federal agencies.

FACTUAL INFORMATION

I am a detective employed by the Oregon State Police and currently assigned to the Criminal Division at the Roseburg Area Command, which has responsibility for the investigation of property crimes, controlled substance offenses, sex crimes and assists with other investigations such as person crimes. I have been employed for approximately [redacted] years by the Oregon State Police. I am a certified peace officer qualified to make application for a search warrant.

I graduated from the Oregon State Police Academy in [redacted] which involved classroom and field training each day for approximately sixteen weeks. My training at the Oregon State Police academy involved classroom and field training each day

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including all phases of police investigations, including burglaries, thefts, motor vehicle crashes, person crimes and other crimes. The training included preservation of evidence, laboratory services offered by the Oregon State Police Forensic Laboratory, and the criminal code.

I have received classroom instruction and field training pertaining to the investigation of thefts, controlled substance violations, sex crimes, person crimes and other crimes. I have applied the methods that I have learned in my classes and about which I have read in many of the cases I have investigated. In these investigations my training and experience has helped to identify those responsible and assisted in their conviction.

That in addition to the general training described above, I have received training on the subject of criminal investigations to include homicide and assault, child physical and sexual abuse, burglary and theft, controlled substances, auto theft, DUII accidents, crime scene reconstructions, investigative techniques, interview and interrogation techniques.

I know from my training and experience that persons trained in investigations and, or forensics, can locate evidence necessary to identify those persons involved in a criminal event. I also know that the quality of the evidence seized, and the quality of the resulting forensic testing, can depend on the passage of time. For this reason, I know the importance of examining the scene, and collection of the evidence, should be completed as soon as possible.

I know that the "chain of custody" of evidence is of great importance and the evidence is needed to be gathered and preserved in the proper manner. As police officers, we are trained in the collection and preservation of evidence. That evidence can be broken down into a number of different areas. These areas include, but are not limited to the information contained in this affidavit.

I know through training and experience that the human body excretes oils through the skin. That oil can be transferred to objects which have been handled by humans. Objects which are handled with the human hand can leave behind an oil impression of the ridges and valleys of the skin of the fingers, which then are called latent fingerprints.

I know that these fingerprints can be transferred and preserved for forensic analysis. The forensic analysis, which is done in a laboratory setting, can identify the human which left behind the fingerprints, to the exclusion of all other humans. I know that the Oregon State Police Crime Laboratory has facilities which are specifically designed for the analysis and identification of fingerprints.

I know from experience that the Oregon State Police Crime Laboratory has on numerous occasions made a positive identification of latent fingerprints which have been submitted to them for identification, which has in turn lead to arrests and convictions of previously unidentified suspects.

I know from my training and experience that persons trained in investigations and, or forensics, can locate evidence necessary to identify those persons involved in a criminal event. I also know that the quality of the evidence seized, and the quality of the resulting forensic testing, can depend on the passage of time. For this reason, I know the importance of examining the scene, and collection of the evidence, should be completed as soon as possible. That evidence can be broken down into a number of different areas. These areas include, but are not limited to the information contained in this affidavit.

I know from my training and experience that it is possible to gather trace evidence of various types which can assist in identifying persons involved in the crime and assist in reconstructing the course of the crime. This evidence can consist of, but is not limited to, semen, hair, blood, fibers, fingerprints, saliva, handwriting, tool marks, and other trace evidence.

I am also aware that some evidence of the type described above can be gathered from the body and clothing of the persons who have been involved in criminal acts. Some evidence, including blood stains and fibers, can be gathered despite the lapse of days, weeks, and even years.

I know that most trace evidence may be destroyed after many days, but on occasion, trace evidence can still be located in cracks and other recessed areas not in the normal traffic or cleaning areas after an extended period of time.

From my training and experience I know that each time two objects come into contact with each other there can be some transfer of material from one item to the other even if these transfers are not visible to the naked eye. This transfer is often referred to as the transfer of trace evidence.

From examining one item and locating trace evidence such as fabric and hair, an expert can evaluate the likelihood that the two items had been in contact with each other. From this analysis a determination can be made that a person or item was in an area without the presence of readily visible pieces of evidence.

That as a result of my training, and through professional and personal experience, I have learned:

In violent crimes which involve close physical contact between the assailants and the crime, body fluids like blood and semen can be exchanged. The victim or perpetrator may leave his blood, saliva, or semen at the crime scene, on clothing, on linen furniture, or other items.

Regarding Blood Typing:

I also know from my experience and training that blood samples can be compared by crime laboratory's against known blood standards for testing to

establish blood type, species type, and other information useful in identifying the sample's origin.

Regarding Blood, Hair, and Hair Standards:

From my experience and training, I know that the Oregon State Police Crime Laboratory and other crime laboratory facilities can examine controlled standards of human blood and hair, taken from a known source or person, and then compare those standards for physical and chemical characteristics against other blood and hair evidence.

From my training and experience I know that each person's hair, blood and tissue, has unique qualities and characteristics that can be determined by analysis by a trained individual. By taking a blood, skin, or other body fluid sample from a known source a criminalist can compare that sample to blood, skin, or other body fluid from an unknown source and reach an opinion as to the likelihood that the two samples came from the same person.

I know from my training and experience that blood can transfer from one object to another such as clothing, shoes and other items that come in contact with blood. I know that blood transfer can be compared to blood stains and/or a DNA comparison.

In order to make the comparisons and analysis referred to above it is necessary to have known samples of blood and hair from a suspect to compare to hair and blood seized from a crime scene or from another involved person.

Regarding DNA:

Through training and experience I know that DNA can be used to identify the origin from which it came. DNA testing is commonly called genetic fingerprinting.

The unique information is found in biological evidence including blood, semen, saliva, tissue, hairs, bone marrow, tooth pulp, and other cell material. With the forensic DNA profiling technology today, DNA identification characteristics can be ascertained from the crime scene body fluid stains and compared to criminal suspects and/or victims, to identify those criminal suspects and/or victims. Often blood is collected from the suspect and/or victim for DNA comparisons. A body fluid or cellular material left at the crime scene by the suspect or victim is analyzed by the DNA forensic lab technician. The result is the DNA profile which is a set of characteristics that can then be used as a basis of association. The crime laboratory compares the crime scene DNA profile to the DNA profile of the subject. If an association is established, the DNA expert can statistically describe how often the matching DNA profile occurs in the population. The DNA profile can be highly individualizing.

Regarding Fibers:

From my experience and training, I know that fiber samples recovered at a crime scene can later be compared by a criminalist, or in a crime laboratory to ascertain their origin, and to compare against known standards taken from a particular place or item. These fiber sources can include, but are not limited to clothing, carpets, and bedding.

Regarding Hair:

From my experience and training, I know that hair samples recovered at a crime scene, can later be analyzed by a criminalist, or in a crime laboratory to ascertain their origin, and compared against hair standards taken from a suspect or victim. I also know that as described above, hair can be used as a DNA source when properly collected. That collection includes removing the hair by pulling it together with its root, rather than simply cutting the hair. The collection can also include a combing of the area to obtain dislodged hairs and their roots.

I also know that it is common for pubic hair to become dislodged from the body and to remain on fabric such as blankets and sheets, or carpeting and rugs and can be recovered from such fabrics for examination.

I also know that pubic hair of one person can, when it comes in contact with another person's pubic hair, become dislodged and remain woven in the pubic hair of the second party.

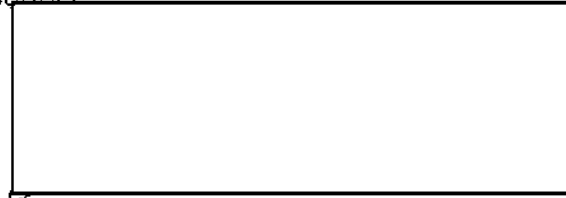
I know from my training and experience, I know that trace evidence such as blood, hair, and semen can be transferred to items which have been handled by a suspect after the commission of a criminal offense such as homicide.

I know from my training and experience that cell phones and computers are used for communication and storage of contacts and known associates. This information can be used to assist in investigations to locate persons associated with possible suspects or victims.

Based on the above information, the undersigned requests that the court issue a search warrant directing a search of the above described places to be searched in Douglas County, Oregon, and further, that the Court direct that testing necessary to analyze the evidence seized.

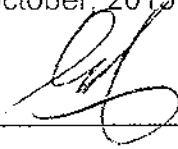
