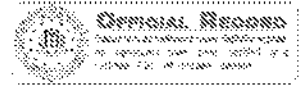

SUMMARY:

This supplemental report is to document the interview conducted with [redacted] who called and self-reported to the tip line that he had purchased ammunition from Chris Harper Mercer.

ACTION TAKEN:

On October 3, 2015 at approximately 9am I attended a briefing at Roseburg OSP and received an assignment to locate and interview a subject who called the tip line and reported that he had purchased ammunition from Chris Harper Mercer.

FBI Special Agent [redacted] and I drove out to a residence located at [redacted] [redacted] We introduced ourselves and explained we were there to follow up on the call [redacted] made to the tip line regarding the ammunition purchase. [redacted] invited us to have a seat on the back porch and said he was very happy to speak with us regarding the ammunition. The three of us sat on the large back porch of the house and conducted a brief interview.

The following is [redacted] statement in substance. He said in May of this year he met Mercer online at a website called www.armslist.com. [redacted] had been searching a category to purchase .40 S&W ammunition. Mercer advertised that he was selling 100 mixed .40 S&W rounds for \$10. [redacted] contacted Mercer by e-mail to confirm that the offer was legitimate.

Mercer said he could meet with [redacted] after 2pm and gave him a phone number to call. [redacted] called and then drove to Mercer's [redacted] and knocked on his door. Mercer answered the door and was not very friendly, he didn't step out and he didn't invite [redacted] in. He handed [redacted] a clear plastic baggy containing .40 ammunition and [redacted] gave Mercer \$15

because he thought it was worth it. Mercer told [redacted] he was selling the .40 ammunition because he was switching to 9mm.

[redacted] said that 3 weeks later Mercer e-mailed him and asked if he was interested in another bag of .40 ammunition. He drove back to the apartment complex and bought another baggy of .40 ammunition for \$10.

I asked [redacted] if there was anything more he could describe about the contact he had with Mercer at his apartment. He said it was very brief. Mercer had short hair and [redacted] asked if he had been in the military. Mercer said something to the effect of, "I've been in the Army" [redacted] said he thanked him for his service and Mercer just nodded. I asked if he had noticed anyone else in the apartment while he was there. [redacted] said he heard a young girl's voice talking or laughing and he thought Mercer said something about her being [redacted]

[redacted] said when he saw in the news what had happened at UCC and who the shooter was he felt sick. He was so upset about it he had to call and let someone know. He said he didn't want the ammunition he had left over and asked if we would take it and destroy it for him. I told him we would take the ammunition and it would be destroyed.

I asked [redacted] a little about his background, where he's from and what type of work he does. He said he went to high school in [redacted] graduated in [redacted] and then he worked for a few years until attending college at [redacted] where he studied [redacted] [redacted] said he lives a very private life, spending most of his time with his parents since breaking up with his last girlfriend and moving back home. He is currently working for the [redacted]

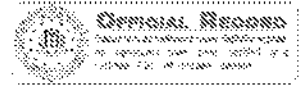
We obtained contact information for [redacted] and gave him our business cards and then concluded our interview. I secured the small clear plastic baggy of ammunition and a gun lock in the vehicle and then transported it back to the Roseburg OSP Office. I spoke with [redacted] [redacted] about the interview and the baggy of ammunition that we retrieved from [redacted] There was a discussion about the ammunition and it was determined that it would be secured in the Roseburg Evidence locker and eventually destroyed.

I secured the baggy of ammunition and gun lock in evidence. This concluded my involvement with this assignment.

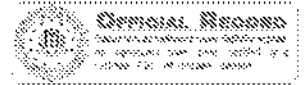

On 12/08/2015, due to lack of substantive activity, the MC3 was deactivated in accordance with the anticipated duration documented in the activation EC.

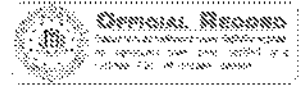

The FBI initiated an investigation in connection with the school shooting at Umpqua Community College (UCC), 1140 Umpqua College Road, Roseburg, Oregon. Investigation included a review of ATF 4473's, [redacted] & digital media relating to Christopher Harper-Mercer, [redacted]. As detailed below, the investigation focused [redacted] possible violation of aiding and abetting Christopher Harper-Mercer, in violation of Title 18, US Code, Section 922(g), which states, in part: it is unlawful for a person who has been adjudicated as a mental defective or who has been committed to a mental institution, to knowingly possess a firearm that had been shipped or transported in interstate commerce.

Details:

On October 01, 2015 at approximately 10:37 a.m., the Douglas County 911 Center received a call regarding an active shooter at Umpqua Community College (UCC) located at 1140 Umpqua College Road, Roseburg, Oregon. Police officers from multiple agencies responded to the call. Officers arrived on scene at Snyder Hall (SNY) and located the suspect, subsequently identified as Christopher Sean Harper-Mercer (Harper-Mercer). They exchanged gunfire with him and wounded him, subsequent to which Harper-Mercer shot himself in the head. Officers then entered SNY classroom 15, put handcuffs on Harper-Mercer, and observed multiple victims with gunshot wounds. Ultimately, it was determined that Harper-Mercer shot and killed nine victims and injured another seven. Harper-Mercer died of the self-inflicted gunshot wound to the head. Prior to the shooting, Harper-Mercer [redacted]. The [redacted] manifesto, which was included on the thumb drive, indicated fascination with and research of historical mass shootings, admiration for previous perpetrators of mass shootings, and Harper-Mercer's hope to inspire others by his act. He also wrote, "My advice to others like me is to buy a gun and start killing people."

Six weapons and one flak jacket with steel plates were recovered at the scene. The six weapons—Smith & Wesson, Model SW40VE, .40-caliber pistol s/n [redacted] Taurus, Model PT24/7G2, .40-caliber pistol, s/n [redacted] Glock, Model 19, 9mm pistol, s/n [redacted] Del-Ton, Model DTI 15, .556-caliber rifle, s/n [redacted] Smith & Wesson, Model 642, .38-caliber revolver, s/n [redacted] and Hi-Point, Model CF380, .380-caliber pistol, s/n [redacted] were purchased by Harper-Mercer. None of these firearms were manufactured in Oregon, and all of them traveled in interstate or foreign commerce.

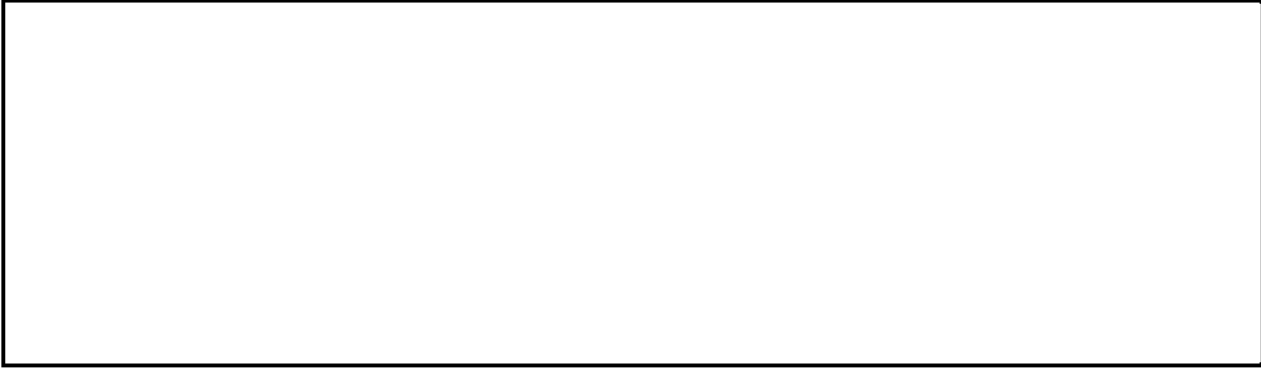

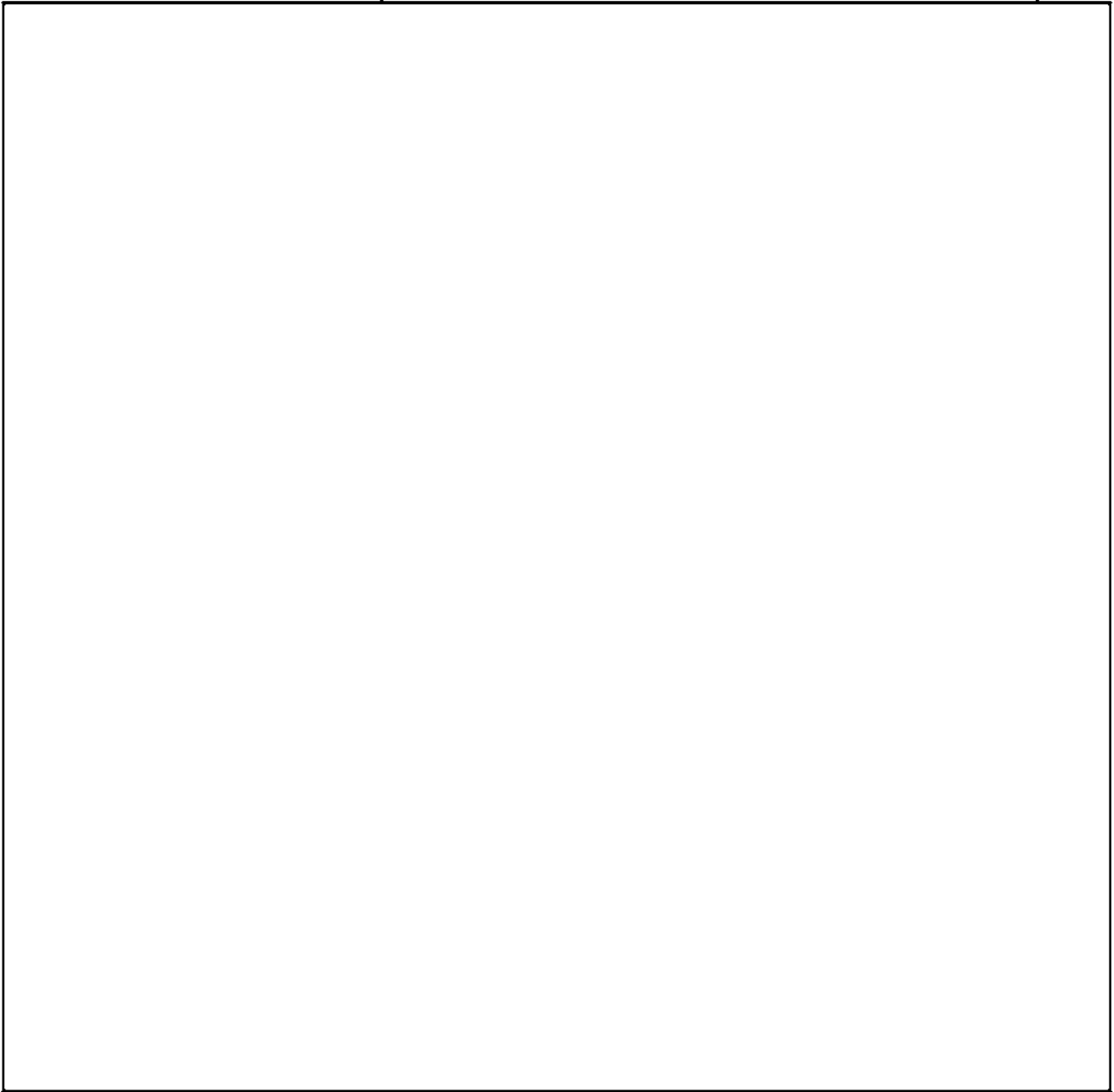

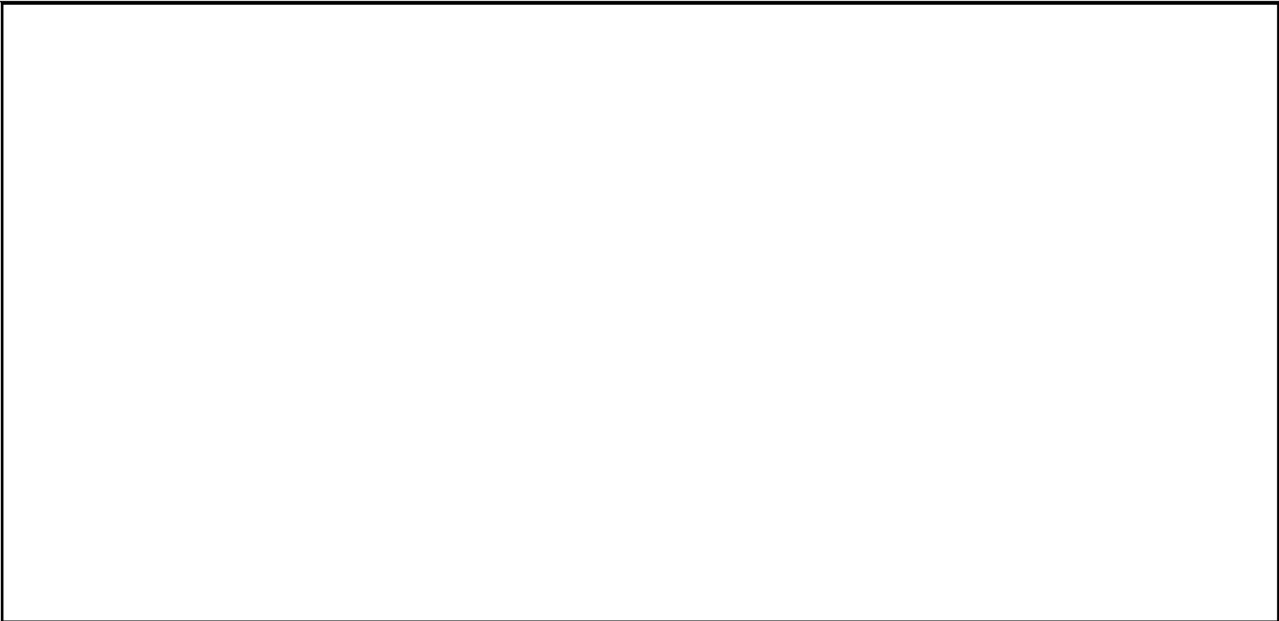

On application, subject failed to disclose his mental health history. While enlisted, Harper-Mercer was admitted for suicidal ideation. At that time, it was recommended that Harper-Mercer be separated from the US Army for failure to meet medical procurement standards IAW AR40-501, Chapter 2-27 a, d, and j.

No record of Harper-Mercer having a full-time or part-time job, and only source of income was from or selling guns, ammo, etc.

The FBI initiated an investigation in connection with the school shooting at Umpqua Community College (UCC), 1140 Umpqua College Road, Roseburg, Oregon. Investigation included a review of ATF 4473's, [REDACTED] & digital media relating to Christopher Harper-Mercer, [REDACTED]. As detailed below, the investigation focused [REDACTED] possible violation of aiding and abetting Christopher Harper-Mercer, in violation of Title 18, US Code, Section 922(g), which states, in part: it is unlawful for a person who has been adjudicated as a mental defective or who has been committed to a mental institution, to knowingly possess a firearm that had been shipped or transported in interstate commerce.

On October 01, 2015 at approximately 10:37 a.m., the Douglas County 911 Center received a call regarding an active shooter at Umpqua Community College (UCC) located at 1140 Umpqua College Road, Roseburg, Oregon. Police officers from multiple agencies responded to the call. Officers arrived on scene at Snyder Hall (SNY) and located the suspect, subsequently identified as Christopher Sean Harper-Mercer (Harper-Mercer). They exchanged gunfire with him and wounded him, subsequent to which Harper-Mercer shot himself in the head. Officers then entered SNY classroom 15, put handcuffs on Harper-Mercer, and observed multiple victims with gunshot wounds.
