Dear Director Wray:

We write to request an immediate and urgent briefing on the steps the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) is taking to investigate and pursue for prosecution the instigation, planning, and execution of the deadly terrorist attack on the United States Capitol on January 6, 2021, by President Donald Trump, his supporters, and outside groups, as well as to disrupt any further activity designed to attack our government.

President Trump repeatedly incited his supporters to travel to the District of Columbia and carry out violence against the Capitol and Members of Congress. On December 19, 2020, President Trump published a tweet inviting his supporters to come to D.C., stating: "Statistically impossible to have lost the 2020 Election. Big protest in D.C. on January 6th. Be there, will be wild!"¹

At a rally yesterday morning, the President told his supporters that "we got to get rid of the weak congresspeople, the ones that aren't any good" and that "we fight like Hell and if you don't fight like Hell, you're not going to have a country anymore." President Trump ended his speech by telling his supporters, "We're going [to] walk down to the Capitol ... you'll never take back our country with weakness. You have to show strength, and you have to be strong."²

The President's personal lawyer, Rudolph Giuliani, also spoke at the rally, encouraging the President's supporters to engage in "trial by combat" to overturn the results of the 2020 Presidential election. The President's son, Donald Trump Jr. warned Republican Members who supposedly do not support the President that "we're coming for you."³

Following the rally, thousands of the President's supporters followed his direction and marched to the Capitol with the goal of preventing Congress from certifying the November 2020 election. Some of the rioters were armed and carrying Trump campaign flags.⁴

As the violent mob stormed the Capitol, President Trump, who reportedly was watching the carnage unfold on television and "was initially pleased by the disturbance."⁵ When President Trump finally released a videotaped statement several hours later, he repeated his false claim that the election was "stolen" and praised the insurrectionists, telling them, "We love you."⁶

In response to President Trump's dangerous behavior, former Attorney General Bill Barr stated that "[o]rchestrating a mob to pressure Congress is inexcusable" and that the President's conduct was a "betrayal of his office."⁷

The attack against the United States Congress resulted in the deaths of at least four people, endangered Members and staff and law enforcement officials, caused damage to the U.S. Capitol building, and disrupted Members of Congress from fulfilling their constitutional responsibility to certify the results of the 2020 Presidential election.

Given the incendiary environment caused and exacerbated by President Trump's rhetoric, along with the upcoming inauguration of President-Elect Joe Biden, it is imperative that the FBI leverage all available assets and resources to ensure that the perpetrators of this domestic terrorist attack and those who incited and conspired with them are brought to justice, and that this domestic terrorist group is disrupted from further actions against our government.

We request an urgent briefing for the Chairs and Ranking Members of the undersigned Committees on how the FBI is working to investigate and hold responsible the domestic terrorists who incited and executed yesterday's attack on the Capitol, as well as how the FBI has been tracking this domestic terrorist group, how it prepared for the events on January 6, 2021, and how it plans to disrupt any further violent plans. This briefing should include detailed information about how the FBI is working to collect evidence and to track these individuals. Please contact our staffs to schedule the briefing.

Dear Director Wray and Administrator Pekoske:

I write to request that you expeditiously place individuals known to have breached the U.S. Capitol building on January 6, 2021 on the No-Fly List to ensure the future security of the United States and its sacred institution of free and democratic elections.

Incited by President Trump, the insurrectionists that violently breached and ransacked the U.S. Capitol on January 6th did so in an attempt to stop the business of the government, including the administrative, ceremonial Electoral College vote count by the joint session of Congress. Americans made their voices heard through elections, through the Electoral College, and through a lawful, constitutionally mandated democratic processes. By all reasonable measures, this attack sought to stop a lawful, democratic event in the elections process. It is an attempt to stop democracy as we know it, using domestic terrorism to assault our system of government, thereby qualifying these insurrectionists for the No-Fly List.

This event was not a demonstration of free speech under the first amendment. A demonstration of free speech would have been a peaceful march in Washington, D.C. Instead, incited by President Trump, thousands of insurrectionists stormed the Capitol building and more than 1,000 unlawfully entered the Capitol building resulting in the death of two Capitol Police officers, numerous other severe injuries, and the wanton destruction of federal and personal property as members and staff of Congress fled for their lives.

Not since 1814 has the U.S. Capitol been desecrated by a violent force—and in that instance it was a British troops who burned the Capitol to the ground. For 207 years, and despite all of the challenges America has faced in those 207 years—including the Civil War—America has resolved its differences without desecrating or burning down the sacred locations that symbolize democracy.

In contrast, this was a domestic terrorist attack against the homeland carried out by violent insurrectionists with a flagrant disregard for the rule of law. The perpetrators must be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law as they have pledged to continue to disrupt the democratic elections process to further their anti-democratic agenda. This starts with placing known individuals who breached the Capitol Building on the Terrorist Screening Center's No-Fly List.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this serious and grave matter. I look forward to your swift response. Should you wish to speak further, please do not hesitate to contact me or my staff.
