2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Sunday the 28th of February.

3 (Telephone ringing) (Indiscernible female
4 voice in the background.)

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm going to mess up this
6 gentleman's desk, he's going to hate agents when we
7 leave this place.

8 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: I don't know,
9 if you leave (indiscernible) David's got our number.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Do they have any activity out
11 there?

12 (Telephone ringing)

13 TELEPHONE OPERATOR: Cellular One customer --

14 (Telephone ringing)

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Go out and check Penny with
16 Phil or Chuck or Krone. I think we might have lost one
17 of our walkies over there and they may have it or may
18 have to re-code all the radio traffic or they're going
19 to listen to everything we say, so -- well, because the
20 team might have lost one there. So many men were shot
21 they dropped -- are they -- well, just check for us --
22 he ain't answering.

23 (Indiscernible female voice in background.)

24 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Steve Snyder,
25 S-N-Y-D-E-R (indiscernible).

MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, okay, so and tell Krone

1 he needs to make arrangements with the communications
2 people, you know, Scheidler, to reprogram all our
3 radios.

4 (Telephone ringing)

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Could you clean all this
6 stuff off this desk that's not ours and stack it in the
7 corner or something? (Telephone ringing)

8 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: (Indiscernible)
9 car Beverly Road.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: He ain't picking up.

11 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: We need to find
12 out, there's a car going down Beverly Road. We need to
13 find out, there's a car going down Beverly Road.

14 MR. KORESH: I wish you knew what I've been
15 through.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, listen now, I --
17 you've explained them to me and --

18 MR. KORESH: No, no, I haven't. I've not
19 even scratched the surface. Just like I told, just
20 like I told Jerry, Jerry Gonzalez --

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

22 MR. KORESH: -- Robert Gonzalez --

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

24 MR. KORESH: -- I really liked that guy too.
25 I've always loved law enforcement because you all guys
risk your lives every day, you know.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I understand.

2 MR. KORESH: And --

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Let me --

4 MR. KORESH: -- I'm so, I'm so sorry that --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, listen, we, we know
6 that. Listen, let me ask you something.

7 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Your, your other wounded men,
9 can you tell me anything about their condition? I, I'm
10 just concerned for --

11 MR. KORESH: They're, they're not as bad as I
12 am, that's for sure.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Not as bad as you are?

14 MR. KORESH: No.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is anybody losing so much
16 blood that --

17 MR. KORESH: No.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- that we can't help them or
19 get some medical --

20 MR. KORESH: No, they're, they're bandaged
21 up. They're up and around.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Have you got them bandaged
23 up?

24 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Okay, and you think
they're stable?

1 MR. KORESH: Well, yeah, they're up walking
2 around.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: How are you doing? How is
4 that wound in the stomach?

5 MR. KORESH: It's, it's -- like I said, it's,
6 it's bleeding in both directions, you know, the --

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Bleeding bad, huh?

8 MR. KORESH: They got these towels wrapped
9 around my waist and stuff and, and, you know,
10 squeeze --

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Now see, you
12 keep -- you got to keep, you know, some -- little
13 pressure on that because it slows down the bleeding.
14 You got somebody can help you with that?

15 MR. KORESH: Well, it's -- the towel's real
16 tight --

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Tight, yeah.

18 MR. KORESH: -- the tourniquet, you know.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. Anything else hurting?

20 MR. KORESH: Just my feelings.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Your feelings, hey listen,
22 don't worry about that. We're, we're trying to, you
23 know, get this solved, and -- are you feeling sick or
24 dizzy or anything?

25 MR. KORESH: That's the way I've been ever
since I've been talking to you, but, you know, feel,

1 | you know, anyway --

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

3 | MR. KORESH: But like, you know, like I say,
4 | let's, let's get some preachers and teachers and stuff
5 | and get -- give me a call and, and tell them to show me
6 | the truth, you know?

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You know, I, I don't think
8 | there's two guys in the world other than you and me
9 | that can solve this and --

10 | MR. KORESH: I know, see, there you're,
11 | you're doing your job. Come on, you know, you're
12 | playing --

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, I'm, I'm being truthful
14 | with you, David, I, I want it --

15 | MR. KORESH: Oh, come on.

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- I want it to stop and I
17 | know you do too, come on.

18 | MR. KORESH: You know there's no way to stop
19 | this until, like I told you, just give me the coverage.

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I --

21 | MR. KORESH: If you let those, if you let
22 | those men, the so-called [cut off and on] let them talk
23 | to me, you know what I mean? And let them show me the
24 | seals where they're at in the Bible.

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, you one thing, David,
if, if you would let us help you, you know, your

1 | message would continue, your word would go out.

2 | MR. KORESH: Look, look, I didn't hurt any
3 | [cut off and on]

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I, I understand that.

5 | MR. KORESH: (indiscernible) some of the
6 | people that are following shot people, all right?

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Let me ask you --

8 | MR. KORESH: Now, I'm responsible for that,
9 | okay? In 1988 when the Sheriff's Department wouldn't
10 | get George Roden off the property --

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah -- yeah.

12 | MR. KORESH: It was '88, and --

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: '87, '88, yeah.

14 | MR. KORESH: -- we went down to the Sheriff's
15 | Department and we told them look, you know, we've got a
16 | restraining order against him. They're doing bad
17 | things. They dug up one of the caskets out here and
18 | the guy was crazy, thought he could resurrect people.

19 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

20 | MR. KORESH: And so that stuff [cut off and
21 | on] and they won't go out there. So I hired a guy
22 | named Sam Jones to come out and he was kind of like a
23 | friend of George, you know. And he took the pictures
24 | and we took them back up in '88 to the Sheriff's
25 | Department.

 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hold on, what's that, okay?

1 Hey, David?

2 MR. KORESH: Yeah?

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: I just got the word that --
4 from the radio people. Okay. Hold on just a second,
5 I'm talking to David. If you will give me your message
6 they will play it.

7 MR. KORESH: I've got to, I've got to do it.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, they, they said they
9 don't have the equipment for that.

10 MR. KORESH: Well, they do. I deal with
11 radio audio technology. Transfer from, from waves over
12 to analog.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Just tell him that
14 David's got to -- he wants to do it himself, see what
15 they can do. All right. That, that -- let
16 me --

17 MR. KORESH: And after that, and after that
18 like I say, you know, I just want to -- they never
19 would be honest with me before, they never would
20 confront me because when I first started opening they
21 always ran off --

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

23 MR. KORESH: -- started cussing me and stuff,
24 you know, in a religious way --

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

MR. KORESH: -- you know, and told me I was

1 | crazy and all that, but they're looking right at a
2 | book. You know if there's a God in Heaven, they're in
3 | trouble, now I'm in trouble.

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David, how are the kids
5 | doing? Anybody --

6 | MR. KORESH: They're, they're eating right
7 | now.

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Eating? Okay.

9 | MR. KORESH: They, they keep fit -- I love
10 | you daddy (groaning sound).

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: They're pretty scared. I
12 | guess they're scared aren't they?

13 | MR. KORESH: No, they're not scared.

14 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No scared? Okay. Well, we
15 | don't want nothing to happen to them and I know you
16 | don't either [cut of and on].

17 | MR. KORESH: Yeah said something about mean
18 | men, I told them, I said they aren't really mean men,
19 | they're just, they're just doing what they --

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

21 | MR. KORESH: -- because no one like's daddy's
22 | message.

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Dave, do you got somebody
24 | there taking care of you?

25 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, they're -- you know,
they're, they're -- like I said, we got some nurses and

1 they've tourniquet me and they, they want to give me
2 some alcohol and I said no, I, I don't want --

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, don't drink alcohol. No,
4 that's not good.

5 MR. KORESH: No, that thins the blood and all
6 that and --

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, you -- it'll, it'll
8 make you bleed, yeah.

9 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Don't do that.

11 MR. KORESH: So --

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, we don't want you to
13 bleed. Are you in a comfortable position?

14 MR. KORESH: No, there's no comfortable
15 position, my friend.

16 MR. KORESH: Can, can you stand up?

17 MR. KORESH: Only -- a little.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Little, well, but don't it,
19 it'll -- you'll hurt, okay?

20 MR. KORESH: The only comfortable position
21 right now I guess would be six feet under, huh?

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, buddy, hey, that's not,
23 that's not it.

24 MR. KORESH: Hey, that's, that's what they'd
25 do to me anyway if no one listens to my message.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey --

1 MR. KORESH: Come on, it's a federal crime, I
2 know the laws, I agree with the laws. I believe bad
3 guys need to be dealt with. There's too much bullshit
4 in the world, okay? There's too many people that
5 molest children, too many people that hurt people for
6 their own selfish gain, all right?

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

8 MR. KORESH: They need to be dealt with.
9 That's what Rome -- at least Rome got, got their crime
10 rate way down, they crucified people, they made an
11 example of them. But, you know, some, some --

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: David --

13 MR. KORESH: -- some of the times they
14 misjudged, you know, and those are the people
15 (indiscernible) to hear the prayer of Christ for
16 (indiscernible) all my life I never knew what I was
17 doing (indiscernible) if you ever get a kingdom based
18 upon (indiscernible) ignorance please remember
19 (indiscernible)

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, I understand --

21 MR. KORESH: And I said to them, I says, I
22 say unto to you today you should be with me in
23 paradise.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, I understand and I
25 believe you, but I want to know what do you think, how
could we resolve this? I mean, how could we save these

1 | children and women and everybody who -- I mean, how can
2 | we stop anymore of this and come on, you and me can do
3 | it --

4 | MR. KORESH: Why did you start the war?

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- you and me can do it.

6 | MR. KORESH: Why did you start the war? Why?

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, David, I,

8 | I --

9 | MR. KORESH: Ignorance, right? Man, you know
10 | (indiscernible)

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- you, you understand --

12 | MR. KORESH: -- you are the bad guys, now you
13 | found out we are (indiscernible) okay?

14 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, you're not the bad guys,
15 | you, you, you understand --

16 | MR. KORESH: Look, my father -- I know you
17 | don't [cut off and on] God said I'm going to bring a
18 | flood and the world said no you aren't, and it came.
19 | And God said I'm not going to bring a flood and the
20 | world says yes you will and they built this tower
21 | (indiscernible) the Tower of Babel, Tower of Babel, and
22 | babel means confusion.

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

24 | MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) working together
25 | trying to plan, plan a salvation against the next
coming flood and God said no so he went and changed

1 | their languages and confounded their, their words and
2 | sent them to different parts of the then known land and
3 | divided the nations. That's why all nations look like
4 | a puzzle; they once fit together.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David, I'm -- if -- I'm, I'm
6 | not having much luck with this radio station. Let me
7 | ask you something --

8 | MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) coming up now?

9 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Huh? I'm sorry? Nobody
10 | should be coming up. Nobody's coming up.

11 | MR. KORESH: Oh (indiscernible) like I
12 | said --

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Now listen, let me ask you
14 | this --

15 | MR. KORESH: The only --

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I, I'm having --

17 | MR. KORESH: They're still coming, my friend.

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Who is?

19 | MR. KORESH: The, the agents.

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, there are no agents
21 | coming.

22 | MR. KORESH: Yes, they are.

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Nobody's --

24 | MR. KORESH: We're watching them get closer
25 | and closer.

 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, we -- they were, they

1 | were pulling back to the highway. They're, they're
2 | not --

3 | MR. KORFESH: No, they're not, they're going
4 | down Double-E.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David, I want you to listen
6 | to the radio.

7 | MR. KORESH: He has a white truck, armored,
8 | huh?

9 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I want you to listen to the
10 | radio station at 4:55. We're, we're going to put a
11 | message on for you, but if you want your scripture
12 | message and your word to get out, if you'll tell me I'm
13 | going to try to get it on there. Now, I understand
14 | that it's not the best, the best would be for you to be
15 | on there. I understand that and I appreciate and I
16 | respect it. But I've got to be truthful with you: I
17 | can't -- I'm not going to trick you and I'm having a
18 | lot of trouble doing that. If you will dictate it to
19 | me I guarantee you I will have this guy put it out as
20 | your words, okay? Work with me and, and let's put it
21 | out. I mean, and, and then we can talk about maybe
22 | some of the wounded coming out.

23 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Let's do it, come on, you and
25 | me can solve this.

 MR. KORESH: Okay. Like I say, I told you

1 before, God didn't say nothing in heaven, right? Gave
2 the book to who? To the (indiscernible) to the
3 (indiscernible) right?

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I understand.

5 MR. KORESH: Okay. Now --

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Now, now, you got to give me
7 word-for-word what you want -- wanted to say.

8 MR. KORESH: Okay.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Word-for-word
10 and --

11 MR. KORESH: Is a truck coming in?

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Nobody's coming, I, I give
13 you my word.

14 MR. KORESH: Military coming in?

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Nobody -- well, I mean on the
16 road there's everybody but they're not coming at you,
17 nothing, you have my word on it. If you tell me what
18 you want to say and I'm going to get it out. Now, give
19 me word-for-word. You want to talk the seven seals
20 first?

21 MR. KORESH: Word on the word.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Go ahead. Slow now, I
23 got to write it.

24 MR. KORESH: Okay. My, my God, who sits on
25 the throne --

MR. KAVANAUGH: My Father, my God, wait a

1 minute, sits on the throne --

2 MR. KORESH: In Heaven.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. All right.

4 MR. KORESH: Given me a book --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Has given me a book.

6 MR. KORESH: -- of seven seals.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Seven seals. Okay.

8 MR. KORESH: In Revelation 10, verse 7 --

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Revelation 10, verse 7.

10 MR. KORESH: -- this sealed book

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Sealed book --

12 MR. KORESH: -- the mystery of God.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- the mystery of God.

14 MR. KORESH: -- is to be finished --

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is to be finished

16 MR. KORESH: -- as God has declared

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: God has declared

18 MR. KORESH: -- to his servants the prophets.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: What is --

20 MR. KORESH: Revelation 22 --

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, just -- I just want --

22 what does that mean, Revelation, this sealed book,

23 mystery of God, oh, you know -- you have the sealed

24 book?

25 MR. KORESH: Yeah, that's what I was opening.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, okay. I'm sorry. Go

1 ahead.

2 MR. KORESH: In Revelation 22 --

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum. Okay.

4 MR. KORESH: -- I come --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Every word which is the book
6 is with me.

7 MR. KORESH: To give unto every man --

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Give unto every man. Okay.

9 MR. KORESH: -- the knowledge of the seven
10 seals.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: The knowledge of the seven
12 seals. Okay. Is that all?

13 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Now listen buddy,
15 you've got, you've got to hang in there for me. I
16 don't want you to faint now. Can -- you need to get
17 those towels changed?

18 MR. KORESH: Ah --

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Why don't you -- do you --
20 don't hang up.

21 MR. KORESH: No.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Just check with your nurses.
23 Do you want to change and we can just --

24 MR. KORESH: I've got more blankets here.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. You got some blankets?
Okay. All right. Now, I'm going to read this back to

1 | you, okay?

2 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Because, you know, I'm just
4 | not the greatest writer. I'm going to read this back
5 | to you and you tell me if there's anything you want to
6 | change or if it's what you want, okay? All right. You
7 | ready?

8 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

9 | MR. KAVANAUGH: My Father, my God, who sits
10 | on the throne in Heaven has given me a book of seven
11 | seals. In Revelation 10, verse 7, this sealed book,
12 | the mystery of God, is to be finished as God has
13 | declared to his servants the prophets. In Revelation
14 | 22, I --

15 | MR. KORESH: Come.

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- come my reward which is
17 | the book is with me to give unto every man the
18 | knowledge of the seven seals. Now, should I say this
19 | message was from David Koresh?

20 | MR. KORESH: David Koresh.

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David Koresh.

22 | MR. KORESH: David Koresh.

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Koresh.

24 | MR. KORESH: Koresh.

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Now, I'm going to get
this on, and let's you and me agree [gap]

1 MR. KORESH: What radio station is it going
2 to be on?

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: It's going to be on 1080 in,
4 in one minute.

5 MR. KORESH: Anybody, anybody know --

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, wait, hold on, hold on
7 just a minute, David, hold on.

8 MR. KORESH: Okay.

9 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #1: Let me cut a
10 deal before you play it. Don't play it yet.

11 MR. KORESH: 1080 --

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey listen, there's a message
13 coming on in one minute on, on 1080 for you, and the
14 reason -- we want to give you our word, we've told the
15 media that and that we're not going to come, there's --
16 no more agents are coming and, and I want you to hear
17 it from them and you know that they know we -- you
18 know, everybody knows what ATF said and what you said,
19 that we're going to try to settle it peacefully, okay?

20 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Can you -- do you have a
22 radio there?

23 MR. KORESH: That's -- I'm getting one now.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Get one -- he's
25 getting the radio. Okay, good. 1080 AM, David.

MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible)

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, well --

2 MR. KORESH: You guys have to go a -- it's
3 kind of, it's kind of hard to have to do what you all
4 got to do and --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, I have --

6 MR. KORESH: I know your destination's
7 heaven.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: I've, I've, I've been out in
9 the woods and I've had that happen to me [cut off and
10 on] raiding a moonshine still.

11 MR. KORESH: Oh, yeah.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: You know, we used to catch
13 those old boys making a little whiskey?

14 MR. KORESH: Oh, yeah.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: And what, what part of the
16 country are you from?

17 MR. KORESH: I was born in Houston.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Houston, yeah.

19 MR. KORESH: And there's, there's batteries
20 in there. I was born in Houston, raised in the Dallas
21 area.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, yeah, yeah.

23 MR. KORESH: Texas boy --

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Texas boy.

25 MR. KORESH: -- horses.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Horses, yeah.

1 MR. KORESH: You know about those Four Horses
2 in the Revelation.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: The Four Horses from --

4 MR. KORESH: That's right, the horses go to
5 and fro the earth and the heathen are at ease. They
6 don't care about them.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: The Four Horses of the
8 Apocalypse.

9 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is that right?

11 MR. KORESH: The Revelation, the Apocalypse,
12 yeah.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Horse is an interesting
14 animal.

15 MR. KORESH: Well, the thing of it is is
16 there's a truth about them in the Bible.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: I don't know. My wife used
18 to have some and she loves horses.

19 MR. KORESH: Oh, yeah. You should see the
20 horses where I come from.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Beautiful?

22 MR. KORESH: Gigantic, massive.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, David, on this message,
24 I'm, I'm working on the -- you should be hearing this
25 one any minute if you can get your radio on.

MR. KORESH: Can someone, can someone turn

1 the --

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: 1080 AM -- 1080.

3 MR. KORESH: 1080 AM. Tell him to play it
4 once or twice if we don't catch it.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, tell them to play it a
6 couple times if you don't -- tell them to play it a
7 couple times so he can hear it.

8 MR. KORESH: Is it a Country and Western
9 station or --

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: 1080, it's KRLD, yeah, it's
11 kind of a -- let me turn this radio on, David, and see
12 if I can get --

13 MR. KORESH: Okay. It's on now.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: It's on? Okay, good.

15 MR. KORESH: Pick it up. My name is Koresh,
16 tell them Koresh.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Tell them that his name is --
18 tell them David's name is Koresh.

19 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Koresh. Get it right.

21 MR. KORESH: Pick it up louder.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Here it is.

23 RADIO BROADCASTER: (Indiscernible)
24 negotiations are going on and both parties are seeking
25 a peaceful resolution to the situation.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Call him David Koresh, it's

1 | important.

2 | RADIO BROADCASTER: Negotiations are
3 | continuing. I'll be back with you in just a few
4 | moments. Join us at 5:05 with full details --
5 | situation.

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David?

7 | MR. KORESH: Sir?

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Now listen, he -- they
9 | kept their word. Now, the only thing is they didn't --

10 | MR. KORESH: I can't hardly hear you.

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Are you okay? Can you
12 | hear me?

13 | MR. KORESH: Turn that radio down.

14 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, sure.

15 | MR. KORESH: Okay. Here we go.

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. David?

17 | MR. KORESH: Sir?

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. I'm going to get your
19 | scripture message on there too. Now, I kept my part of
20 | the bargain here, I've got one message on there for
21 | you.

22 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Can you, can you do something
24 | for me?

25 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, what do you want?

 MR. KAVANAUGH: I, I want some of the wounded

1 | people, I want some of the wounded people.

2 | MR. KORESH: I mean, they're up and around
3 | now, you know?

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, but David, they're
5 | bleeding or hurt, they need treatment.

6 | MR. KORESH: Well, they're not bleeding.
7 | Most of it was -- where did Scott get hit, in the hand?

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Scott --

9 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Scott was hit in the hand?

11 | MR. KORESH: Where was Big Boy hit? In the,
12 | in the, in the side of the leg? Just a graze? Okay,
13 | just a graze. It, it scared him more than hurt him,
14 | huh?

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Okay, but how about
16 | some of the kids? Can we get some of the children out?
17 | I mean, we --

18 | MR. KORESH: When we, when we finish our
19 | working this stuff out then you can come and have the
20 | kids, all right?

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm sorry, David, say that
22 | again.

23 | MR. KORESH: I said when we get our message
24 | out and stuff then you can have the children, all
25 | right?

 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. Now, you give me

1 | your word?

2 | MR. KORESH: Hey, my -- I gave you my word.

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, buddy, I trust you and
4 | I believe you. I'm going to get this message out and
5 | then we can get the children, right?

6 | MR. KORESH: Right.

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. God bless you, I
8 | love you. Now, I want you to stay on with me, okay?

9 | MR. KORESH: All right.

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. I want to get
11 | this to the radio station right away.

12 | MR. KORESH: Let's, let's, you know, hear it.

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. Look, hold on,
14 | I'm talking to David.

15 | MR. KORESH: You're -- and you're, you're
16 | going to have those scholars call me up, right?

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I hadn't got to that
18 | yet.

19 | MR. KORESH: Try, try for me.

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I will try, I give you my
21 | word, but when we play this message as agreed, David's
22 | going to let us get the children out.

23 | MR. KORESH: But they're --

24 | (Gunshot)

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay?

MR. KORESH: They're shooting at us again

1 (indiscernible).

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Who's shooting out there?
3 Find out who's shooting out there.

4 MR. KORESH: Out in the field.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, he hears them -- tell
6 those agents whoever the hell's shooting tell them to
7 stop. Turn those people back.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: We don't know who's shooting,
9 David. It -- we're going to find out. It's not us.
10 We just got the word back that we are not shooting. It
11 might be one of your guys in the far corner of the
12 building.

13 MR. KORESH: No, no, no, no, they're
14 shooting -- what? Yeah, don't [cut off and on]

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: We're not firing.

16 MR. KORESH: No, I'm talking to the, to the
17 guys.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Now listen, okay, this
19 is our agreement, okay? I'm going to play the message,
20 I'm -- and I'm going to, I'm going to tell them to
21 pronounce your name right, okay?

22 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Because I'm sorry the way
24 they called you Vernon last time but I'm going to
25 get --

MR. KORESH: Yeah.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- David Koresh and then --

2 MR. KORESH: Koresh.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Koresh?

4 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: And then we're going to get
6 the children out, okay? And --

7 MR. KORESH: Well, like I said, I want these
8 scholars to call too. I mean --

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well --

10 MR. KORESH: -- you're not just going to come
11 up here and take them out, you're going to, you're
12 going to tell them, you know, that I want some replies
13 on that and I want someone to show me from scriptures
14 where the seven seals are found and then I know I'm
15 wrong.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: But David --

17 MR. KORESH: That's, that's all I'm asking --

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- I know that --

19 MR. KORESH: -- for life, man.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

21 MR. KORESH: Come on, bend a bit.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

23 MR. KORESH: Well, if I -- let, let's go one
24 step -- let me play this message and, and, and let's
25 get some -- all right --

MR. KORESH: Get some feedback back.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Let's play the message
2 and then we'll talk.

3 MR. KORESH: Okay. Turn the radio on.

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Well, they ain't going
5 to get it on that fast.

6 MR. KORESH: Well, that's too loud, I can't
7 hear my friend here.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Too loud?

9 MR. KORESH: Turn the treble up and turn the
10 bass down.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: (Indiscernible) David?

12 MR. KORESH: Yeah?

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Let me ask you this, buddy.

14 MR. KORESH: Uh-huh.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: I'll play the message, okay,
16 you send the kids out.

17 MR. KORESH: I'm not going to do that. You
18 play the message like you said --

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

20 MR. KORESH: -- and put me so-called
21 religious -- some leaders on there --

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

23 MR. KORESH: -- and put it on air, you
24 know --

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

MR. KORESH: -- and, and explain to me what

1 | the seven seals are.

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, David, I, I think you
3 | know more about that than anyone.

4 | MR. KORESH: Well, okay, then --

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: And I --

6 | MR. KORESH: -- then my position is, is, is
7 | standard isn't it?

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: It, it is, buddy, I mean you
9 | know more about it than anyone. There's no one can
10 | dispute you. I'm not trying to argue that point. I
11 | respect it.

12 | MR. KORESH: I know, but --

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I, I just want us to make a
14 | small movement toward a peaceful agreement.

15 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, but, but you're not just
16 | going to take our children.

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Well, would you, would
18 | you send some of the ladies out?

19 | MR. KORESH: Huh?

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Some of, some of the women
21 | out?

22 | MR. KORESH: The -- any women -- the women
23 | don't want to go -- they'll go, everyone of us will
24 | go --

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

 MR. KORESH: -- once we get our chance to

1 discuss this with the so-called minds that think that
2 they know the seven seals.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Well, what, what
4 answer --

5 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) it's against
6 religion --

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: What, what would you -- what
8 -- if -- what message are you looking from them, David?
9 I don't think --

10 MR. KORESH: I want them to show me from the
11 prophecies where the seven seals are found, just give
12 the references so everybody can hear them.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, you know the
14 references. You tell me and I'll have it on the radio.

15 MR. KORESH: I know it.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

17 MR. KORESH: But the thing of it is, do they?

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, you, you want to know?

19 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: I don't think they know.

21 MR. KORESH: Well, okay, so --

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: So -- we know --

23 MR. KORESH: -- I mean they're in trouble
24 aren't they?

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I agree with you.

MR. KORESH: Then my Father is fixing to do

1 | some very awesome things in this little world. Read
2 | Isaiah 24. That's what you all boys have done in
3 | Isaiah 24, you know, it's a terrible [gap]

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You're, you're not going to
5 | die, come on, we're going to -- we, we got some --
6 | we're taking some shots from your guys.

7 | MR. KORESH: Where?

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hold on, David.

9 | MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible)

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, this is David. Are his
11 | people shooting?

12 | UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: (Indiscernible)

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, your people are
14 | shooting our guys behind the rear barn and we're not
15 | firing at all.

16 | MR. KORESH: No, we're not.

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: He says -- David says they're
18 | not shooting.

19 | MR. KORESH: Go, go down -- because
20 | (indiscernible) go down there and (indiscernible)

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, you'd better check. He
22 | -- they keep telling us --

23 | MR. KORESH: Got to hold off on those boys.

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, tell them to hold off I
25 | mean, you know, I'd tell them don't shoot them but if
people are shooting at them, you know --

1 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Let's work, let's work out
3 something. Is there anybody in there?

4 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #2: Our guys are
5 taking fire.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Our guys are taking fire.
7 Our guys are taking fire. Now, that's not keeping your
8 end of the bargain. See if you can stop them, buddy,
9 come on.

10 MR. KORESH: They're, they're down there.
11 We're not shooting at them.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, we're taking it. I've
13 confirmed it three times. We are taking fire. They
14 need the word from you, you're the top man. Tell them
15 not to fire.

16 MR. KORESH: Okay.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Don't break your word now.

18 MR. KORESH: I'm not breaking my word.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

20 MR. KORESH: We -- there [gap]

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Everybody stop, everybody --

22 MR. KORESH: Who is down at the barn right
23 now? Go and try --

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Dave --

25 MR. KORESH: Someone's shooting up towards
here.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: David said maybe it's not ATF
2 shooting but somebody's shooting from the barn. Okay.
3 We're going to suppress everything from the barn.

4 MR. KORESH: Yeah, go find out what's going
5 on down there.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Tell them to stop shooting,
7 everybody stop shooting.

8 MR. KORESH: No one here is shooting.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, no shooting now?

10 MR. KORESH: Huh (indiscernible) firing --

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, okay, okay. There's,
12 there's no shooting now, right?

13 MR. KORESH: No.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, good.

15 MR. KORESH: We never have shot.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is there any elderly people
17 that might want to come out, you know?

18 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) and then you're
19 just firing at us? How did -- what, they got the
20 binoculars on him?

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: In the distance? Well, that
22 might be some crazy rancher. We'll, we'll check on it.
23 They say they took a round from way, way off somewhere.
24 They don't think it's ATF. Put the word out, anybody
25 who's shooting at them --

MR. KORESH: Hey, you got, you got, you got

1 | the zoom on him? Is he ATF or what?

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: They got a spotting scope on
3 | the guy who's doing the shooting. Might be some crazy
4 | rancher or redneck out there. I don't know. We'll,
5 | we'll -- we're going to put a stop to it.

6 | MR. KORESH: Hey, could you get a -- where's
7 | Steve? What's the name of my buddy across the street?
8 | What's his name? Can you get Robert Gonzalez on the
9 | phone so I can talk to him?

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, he's, he's, he's gone.

11 | MR. KORESH: Where did he go?

12 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I, I don't know where they
13 | sent him. He's not around.

14 | MR. KORESH: Tell him, you know, I --

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I'll tell him whatever you
16 | want.

17 | MR. KORESH: -- I really did like that guy, I
18 | really did. I -- you know, I -- oh, they're dropping
19 | snipers on the Double-E?

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, tell your guys that's --
21 | just the perimeter, that's all, nobody's coming in.
22 | Just the perimeter, that's all --

23 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- nobody's coming in.

25 | MR. KORESH: Well, you all need to, you all
need to, you all need to go to the scoped rifles.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: He's telling his guys to go
2 to the scoped rifles. Better pass that on
3 (indiscernible) hey, hey, and they can see them, they
4 can see them on the Double-E Road over there David
5 says.

6 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Sandra. David said they can
8 see agents on the Double-E Road.

9 MR. KORESH: Yeah, we got, we got powerful
10 zooms on those guys.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I'll tell them to back
12 up. I, I wish we could get something out on this
13 message.

14 MR. KORESH: Well, let's do it, let's --

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, let's do it. I'll tell
16 you what, you got my word I'll give you one message,
17 I'll give you this second message. I'll have it
18 played, I'll do it first --

19 MR. KORESH: See what you can do now.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and then you send some
21 kids out.

22 MR. KORESH: Not yet, no, you have the
23 scholars call me first.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Let me ask you this:
25 if I can do this --

MR. KORESH: Is your name Kavanaugh?

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, sir.

2 MR. KORESH: Kavanaugh.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Jim Kavanaugh.

4 MR. KORESH: I thought your name was Lynch.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, no, Jim Kavanaugh, that's
6 right, yeah, Jim Kavanaugh, um-hum. I talked to Steve
7 earlier, you know.

8 MR. KORESH: All right.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: We, we, we, we stopped all
10 the gunfire. Here's what I --

11 MR. KORESH: You guys located down in Waco
12 there?

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, down in Waco, uh-huh.

14 MR. KORESH: Got that, got that old steel --
15 steel-walled room in there, huh?

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, it's nothing like that.
17 Hey David, I mean if I could get us to make an
18 agreement here, I can't get --

19 MR. KORESH: Do another thing, tell Sheriff
20 Thorn that I really liked him.

21 MR. KORESH: Sheriff Thorn that you like him?

22 MR. KORESH: Yeah, that, you know, I, I
23 really thought he was a decent man and everything and
24 tell him I'm sorry that he doesn't know really where
25 we're coming from and --

MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

1 MR. KORESH: -- of course, you know, tell
2 Harwell, you know, after we're gone he can still come
3 fishing.

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: You're not going to be gone.

5 MR. KORESH: Well, it depends on what you all
6 going to do for me.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, we're not coming in
8 there. I want to get --

9 MR. KORESH: Well, it depends -- look, look,
10 it depends on what you guys do for me.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

12 MR. KORESH: You got all the technology, you
13 can hook me up, you know? People like stories, they --
14 you know, or TV, come on.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, yeah, I know.

16 MR. KORESH: And look, I'll make myself look
17 like a fool on TV, if you all just let me, you know, on
18 TV just, you know, blank it just like [gap] my words
19 and stuff and, and then, you know, people will like
20 that. It's kind of like, you know, not like the
21 president talking, it's kind of like the [gap]

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, the thing is if, if I
23 play -- if I get them to play this scripture, I mean
24 it's like I want you to, you know, do something from my
25 side, I mean --

MR. KORESH: I am. I, I gave you the

1 | scripture so you could know what you're fighting
2 | against.

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I understand that, but
4 | I mean, I'm going to get it played on the radio and I'd
5 | like to see some people that are hurt come out.

6 | MR. KORESH: What the --

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: One person, one person,
8 | that's all, just one person. If you'll agree to send
9 | one --

10 | MR. KORESH: Well, you've already got, you've
11 | already got some people down at the, the shop. You've
12 | already got --

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I don't know. I haven't been
14 | at the shop.

15 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, you know, you already got
16 | those guys, they're with you.

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: If you send out --

18 | MR. KORESH: You already got Paul Fatta and
19 | (indiscernible).

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. I, I wasn't aware of
21 | that.

22 | MR. KORESH: You know?

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, but I mean if you'd
24 | send out any mother and child, one or two. I'm not
25 | asking you to send out all your people, I'd just like
to get somebody maybe that's hurt or scared out, I'll,

1 | I'll get this played and then we'll go to Step 2. Let,
2 | let's do it.

3 | MR. KORESH: All right. Let me go run and
4 | ask again and see if anybody wants to leave, you know.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: They're going around and
6 | asking again if anybody wants to leave.

7 | MR. KORESH: So you want to call me back?

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, let's not hang up. Let's
9 | not hang up. I'll tell you what, if you want to rest
10 | why don't you just lay the phone down and, and leave an
11 | open line because what happens is all these neighbors
12 | and stuff get on these phones and I couldn't get you,
13 | you know? And you and me have to work it out. I mean,
14 | and everything, and everything is okay if you and me
15 | are talking and, and that's the main thing. Because
16 | you care for people and, and you're sincere and honest.

17 | MR. KORESH: I care about my Father [gap]

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: That's right.

19 | MR. KORESH: -- in Heaven.

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I know you do.

21 | MR. KORESH: I care about --

22 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I don't know why they call
23 | you a cult when you're just religious people. I can't
24 | believe that the radio says that stuff, but you know we
25 | don't tell them that. Do you understand, David?

MR. KORESH: But that's what they say and

1 | that's why you can't blame them.

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, people call you that, I
3 | don't, I don't -- we don't feel that way. I mean, we,
4 | we know you just --

5 | MR. KORESH: Come on, come on, look --

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, listen, hold it, you're
7 | a Christian man, that's all.

8 | MR. KORESH: I'm not a Christian man.
9 | Remember, in the sight of the world I'm a cult leader,
10 | remember, let's take it at that.

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well --

12 | MR. KORESH: I'm not offended, all right?
13 | I'm just hurt because the seven seals, my friend, and
14 | whatever God says he's going to do in those seals.

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. What, what can we do
16 | on this, on this agreement, I mean, if I can get this
17 | message played? And, and I'm going to do my best to
18 | get just your words exactly, would you just -- I mean,
19 | I've got all these bosses too and I mean, you're,
20 | you're --

21 | MR. KORESH: Don't worry about no bosses,
22 | like I say, if, if they're going to come here and shoot
23 | us all up, they're going to come and shoot us all --

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I ain't going to let nobody
25 | shoot you up, I ain't going to let nobody --

 MR. KORESH: Well, you know, you --

1 MR. KORESH: I'm the guy that's putting a
2 stop to --

3 MR. KORESH: -- you're going to smoke bomb us
4 or you're going to burn our --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: No.

6 MR. KORESH: -- building down or whatever,
7 you know?

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: We're not doing it, I'm not
9 going to let them do it.

10 MR. KORESH: But the thing of it is is that
11 you let them come in in the first place. Those guys
12 are not like us, they don't know what they're doing
13 (indiscernible) they're, they're doing a job, they're
14 trying to make a living, they're trying to raise their
15 families. You know, you guys from the top, man, you
16 just put it to me straight, those guys were scared when
17 they came out here, those guys are probably crack
18 shots, you know? But no, they were scared, you know
19 (indiscernible).

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm trying to get them on our
21 side, it's important, very important.

22 MR. KORESH: We told them to get out. You
23 know, people here are marksmen too, you know what I
24 mean?

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, I understand that.

MR. KORESH: But the thing of it is is that,

1 | you know, God also has an army. You need to read
2 | Isaiah 13, see what can happen on you. It's nonsense
3 | to have so many -- there's no heros in this kind of
4 | stuff, man.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: What's that? Hold on, David.
6 | What's that? A radio guy? You tell him that I --
7 | that -- you tell them Jim Kavanaugh said he -- we might
8 | have a message for him to play and I -- and he's going
9 | to have to do it. All right. Hang on a minute.

10 | MR. KORESH: All right.

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, get that message back
12 | to him, you tell him that I -- yeah, that's right,
13 | okay. All right. Hold on. All right. Look --

14 | MR. KORESH: You can tell them I've been
15 | wounded and shot if you want to, that might make them
16 | happier.

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well -- no, well, I don't
18 | know -- you know, I can't -- you know how the news
19 | media is? I mean, they're -- they do things on their
20 | own but we're, we're trying to do everything we can to
21 | do what's right by you. And let's do this: let's make
22 | an agreement. I'm going to get this thing on the air,
23 | the word about the seven seals will be out. We'll have
24 | an, an agreement, a couple of people, once the word
25 | comes back if anybody wants to go and then the message
 | will be out, then we'll talk further. I, I, I like

1 | dealing with you because you're the guy in charge and,
2 | and, and those people believe in you like no others in
3 | the world and they --

4 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- will do what you tell them
6 | to do, what you ask them to do.

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: But I can only do what my
8 | Father has written for me to do, that's why those
9 | people are supposed to know that I'm not crazy. If I
10 | did not --

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I don't think you're crazy.

12 | MR. KORESH: -- look, look, if I did not show
13 | people from the book the word of God what God has
14 | stated shall be in the last days --

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

16 | MR. KORESH: -- about my coming and why I
17 | come this way --

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

19 | MR. KORESH: -- that I will not allow anybody
20 | to believe me. You cannot be flesh and blood. But
21 | what is written in the testimony from those who started
22 | the Christian Church, you know, Moses [gap] Malachi --

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Let me ask you something, let
24 | me ask you something, you may know about this. What
25 | about that thing they call the, the Ark? Do you know
about that? I --

1 MR. KORESH: Noah's Ark?

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Noah --

3 MR. KORESH: Or the Ark of the Covenant?

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: The Ark of the Covenant.

5 MR. KORESH: Oh, it's a beautiful thing, yes.
6 I'm fixing to show you where it's at.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, no, no. Noah's Ark,
8 that's where all the people were saved?

9 MR. KORESH: Well that's (indiscernible)
10 Mount Ararat.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Huh?

12 MR. KORESH: It's in Turkey right now. When
13 the earthquake took place, the glacier busted --

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

15 MR. KORESH: -- and exposed it.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

17 MR. KORESH: That's the -- one of the signs
18 at the end.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Like Noah was a messenger and
20 you're a messenger and, and you say your function --

21 MR. KORESH: Well, no, what happens is our
22 message is to the world but the scriptures saw that it
23 was time no longer it'd be like in Noah's day --

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

25 MR. KORESH: -- you know?

MR. KAVANAUGH: But they were saved, the

1 | people that carried the word.

2 | MR. KORESH: That went into the Ark, yes.

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, they were saved

4 | and --

5 | MR. KORESH: So Isaiah testified the day will
6 | come when God will make a man a hiding place [gap] in
7 | Christ unless you know what he knows, as
8 | (indiscernible) says the knowledge of the holy is
9 | understanding, the fear of God is made of wisdom and if
10 | you don't know what's on God's mind with those seals
11 | then you won't know what's on my mind.

12 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm checking with the people
13 | (indiscernible).

14 | MR. KORESH: If you don't know what's on my
15 | mind then you don't know what's on the mind of the
16 | prophets. If we're not in perfect harmony with all of
17 | that the scriptures have spoken, we're not walking that
18 | straight [gap]

19 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

20 | MR. KORESH: So --

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Man's a sinner and --

22 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, but there's only one
23 | (indiscernible) unforgivable.

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You, you told me earlier that
25 | you -- you know, you couldn't -- they couldn't
understand and, and I believe you, I believe you.

1 MR. KORESH: That's because they're not here.
2 Isaiah says in Isaiah 6 where he talks of the six-
3 winged seraphim --

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum?

5 MR. KORESH: -- it's the same as Revelation
6 Chapters 4 and 5. And Isaiah says [gap] and he talks
7 about an event that'll take place to, to bring it all
8 down to the nutshell. And so here we are at the Day of
9 the Lord, all the prophets talk about the great and
10 dreadful Day of the Lord when God will make inquisition
11 for blood.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: That's not today, David.

13 MR. KORESH: Oh, it is.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: We're going to -

15 MR. KORESH: It's, it's a progress.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, your, your people are,
17 are going to continue on and, and you're going to
18 spread your message and, and, and your message is even
19 going to go further.

20 MR. KORESH: There's ATF agents who are now
21 dead, right?

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm not sure. There were
23 some guys hurt bad on the roof but, you know, I don't
24 know.

25 MR. KORESH: They're dead.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Hold on. Give me a

1 confirmation some agent's dead. I got to tell him.
2 They heard it on the news. Okay. Check on that. I
3 know we had some, some in intensive care.

4 MR. KORESH: Fourteen wounded --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

6 MR. KORESH: -- two of them were dead.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Yeah, he's got --
8 yeah, that's right. They confirmed, you're right, four
9 dead.

10 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Uh-huh.

12 MR. KORESH: Tell me --

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Uh-huh.

14 MR. KORESH: -- that we're going to be able
15 to present our truth. If you can lie that good --

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, I wouldn't tell you that,
17 that we could -- that there's not consequences to that.

18 MR. KORESH: Exactly.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: I wouldn't lie to you, but
20 that doesn't mean --

21 MR. KORESH: If I -- and if I --

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- your word doesn't go out.

23 MR. KORESH: -- if I'm wrong [gap] to me as
24 you wish. I've always -- have to check my school
25 records, always was a good citizen --

MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, if, if you --

1 MR. KORESH: -- you know? If I've done wrong
2 then I need to be punished. Psalm 7 says if I have
3 rewarded evil to him that was at peace to me, that
4 there be iniquity in my hand, you know, that book is
5 wrong.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes.

7 MR. KORESH: It says, yea, I have delivered
8 them. How you get delivered?

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

10 MR. KORESH: The truth is to set you free --

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

12 MR. KORESH: -- you know? Then let the enemy
13 trample my glory to the ground.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I'm here, buddy, I
15 heard you and I --

16 MR. KORESH: My hearing seems to be going out
17 for some reason.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, I -- we've got to, we've
19 got to do something. I want to get that message out
20 for you like I promised, and have they come back to
21 tell you if anybody wants to go out?

22 MR. KORESH: No, I think they're still
23 checking. It's a big place, you know?

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, oh, I know it is, yeah.

25 MR. KORESH: A lot of people here.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I understand that, I

1 | understand that. Did the kids get some dinner?

2 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, yeah, we got some MRE's we
3 | been -- we sell MRE's and stuff [gap]

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You get them MRE's?

5 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: What's your favorite one? I
7 | ate one of those yesterday.

8 | MR. KORESH: Beef stew.

9 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Beef stew?

10 | MR. KORESH: The only good one there --

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I like that applesauce they
12 | have.

13 | MR. KORESH: Oh, yeah, that's good.

14 | MR. KAVANAUGH: That's not bad, yeah.

15 | MR. KORESH: Maple nut cakes.

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

17 | MR. KORESH: You all guys, you know, if
18 | things don't work out the way we want, come on and help
19 | yourself, there's plenty of --

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh --

21 | MR. KORESH: -- plenty of, plenty of MRE's.

22 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, it's going to work out.

23 | We're -- you and me are going to work it out. You and
24 | me -- let me tell you something, we're -- we --

25 | MR. KORESH: We come from two different
worlds, you know what I mean?

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: We, we come from two
2 different worlds and we're the only two people in the
3 universe that can solve this and you and me can --

4 MR. KORESH: Well, actually, actually, don't
5 disqualify my Father.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I understand.

7 MR. KORESH: I've been a good boy, I admit,
8 but you can say the same thing for yourself.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I think we're --

10 MR. KORESH: But I do believe in his seven
11 seals.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes.

13 MR. KORESH: I do believe in the truth he
14 gave me.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

16 MR. KORESH: You know, when you confer with
17 God you can't turn away from it.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

19 MR. KORESH: You got to do the truth no
20 matter what they do to you.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I understand. It's
22 starting to hurt a little?

23 MR. KORESH: Well, about an hour or two ago
24 it -- the numbness went away and the, the bite and the
25 fire and the, and the (indiscernible).

MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. I got your message to

1 the sheriff that --

2 MR. KORESH: Harwell?

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, sir, I did, I got the
4 message to him --

5 MR. KORESH: Yeah --

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and --

7 MR. KORESH: -- and to --

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- Sheriff Thorn.

9 MR. KORESH: He's a good man, I like that
10 guy.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: He's a good man, and I got
12 the message to him.

13 MR. KORESH: Man, I love those guys.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: (to sheriff) Give me your
15 message back. You can't talk to him but give me your
16 message back that you love him and you care for him,
17 okay?

18 MR. KORESH: Of course, you know --

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, the sheriff's reply to
20 you is that he loves you and he cares for you.

21 MR. KORESH: Thanks. Tell him I don't hold
22 no grudges in '88 either.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: No grudges from him either in
24 '88.

25 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

MR. KAVANAUGH: He just wants all those

1 | people out, and he, he, he doesn't want anybody hurt.

2 | MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible)

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay?

4 | MR. KORESH: Do what now Brad? No, it's just

5 | --

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Trying to get -- play a
7 | scripture on the radio to give us some kids.

8 | [gap]

9 | MR. KAVANAUGH: What's the matter, Dave?

10 | MR. KORESH: Oh, I'm just trying to -- these
11 | latter days watching the baby get some titty here.

12 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Has, has the -- has --

13 | MR. KORESH: It's beautiful. Have you ever
14 | seen a baby take titty from his mother?

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: It's beautiful, yeah.

16 | MR. KORESH: Oh, man, you know, Christ died
17 | 2,000 years ago for that?

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

19 | MR. KORESH: You know, only Christ is
20 | righteous for glory for a woman, you know?

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand, uh-huh.

22 | MR. KORESH: Christ came to redeem men from
23 | their -- you know I'm a songwriter, right?

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Uh-huh.

25 | MR. KORESH: You'll never get to hear my
music.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, that's -- too bad, I, I
2 would like to.

3 MR. KORESH: But --

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, maybe some day you can
5 sing for me.

6 MR. KORESH: One song goes, "Three angels
7 flying -- " I can't really sing now because I can't
8 talk loud, but --

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

10 MR. KORESH: -- it goes, "Three angels flying
11 in the mist of [gap] when the everlasting [gap] who
12 really knows (indiscernible) who amongst the babes can
13 (indiscernible) four angels (indiscernible)" -- not
14 going to remember it anyway. But --

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey --

16 MR. KORESH: -- that took too much energy out
17 of me, my friend.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, hey, save your energy,
19 save your energy. I, I, I want you to relax.

20 MR. KORESH: You ever been shot before?

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I've been shot at a lot
22 but I --

23 MR. KORESH: Well, man, let me tell you what
24 it's like when you get shot. First of all, it feels
25 good.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. I've been shot at and

1 | it's, it's, it's hard, you know?

2 | MR. KORESH: It -- to me it's like, it's like
3 | it's warm, it's numb, and if you get shot two more
4 | times --

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, man --

6 | MR. KORESH: -- and then they're both nice
7 | and warm and --

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I feel for you, Dave.

9 | MR. KORESH: -- you're kind of stunned and
10 | then you kind of [gap].

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hip's broken?

12 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, it went in towards --
13 | close towards my belly button and went over and hit
14 | my -- I think the pelvic --

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: The pelvic --

16 | MR. KORESH: -- went around and came up my
17 | butt.

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, that's --

19 | MR. KORESH: Ricocheted or something.

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

21 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, I think, I think it was a
22 | .9 mm I guess.

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Oh, gee, how big is
24 | your wounds in the front, can you tell me?

25 | MR. KORESH: Well, yeah, in the front it
looks like it's not that big, you know?

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Not that big, but --

2 MR. KORESH: In the back it's [gap]

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Are you sitting up or laying
4 down?

5 MR. KORESH: I'm half laying.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Half laying on a, on a bed or
7 what?

8 MR. KORESH: No.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Just on the floor?

10 MR. KORESH: Floor.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Can you get another -- can
12 you leave the phone open and get another towel on your
13 wound on your back and I'll wait here for you?

14 MR. KORESH: Oh, well, I, I can, you know,
15 I'm not going nowhere [gap] I don't know --

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: You're a brave man, I'm going
17 to tell you something --

18 MR. KORESH: Just -- well, look, I've got my
19 Father, he's watching this.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: You're a brave man, I'm going
21 to tell you.

22 MR. KORESH: I'm not -- well, this time it's
23 a little bit worse if I (indiscernible).

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, is, is Wayne with you?

25 MR. KORESH: I think Wayne's --

MR. KAVANAUGH: Is Steve, is Steve okay? You

1 know, me and Steve talked for about 45 minutes.

2 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is he okay?

4 MR. KORESH: He's okay.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. I know we worked out
6 getting that all [gap].

7 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) you know, and
8 (indiscernible) ought to listen.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, you got a bunch of --
10 (Tape 2)

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: How is your side doing?

12 STEVE: Hello, Jim.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Steve?

14 STEVE: Yes.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: How is he doing? Is, is he
16 bleeding a lot?

17 STEVE: Well, he's, he's hanging in there
18 but, you know, he's, he's hurt.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes (indiscernible) all
20 right. Look, what, what we talked about and so we're
21 all square --

22 STEVE: Okay.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- is the, the girls will
24 come out --

25 STEVE: Right.

MR. KAVANAUGH: -- do, do you have a

1 flashlight you could give them.

2 STEVE: Do we have a flashlight we could give
3 the girls? We only have big ones I guess.

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Anything they could -- just
5 so they could see. I don't want them to get lost.

6 STEVE: Right.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: And, and they come down the
8 driveway --

9 STEVE: Right.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and then we'll have a car
11 slowly pull right behind your guard shack.

12 STEVE: All right.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Now, our guys want to feel
14 like they're not going to get shot, you know?

15 STEVE: Well, you know --

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I, I take you word,
17 hey --

18 STEVE: Right.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- I trust you.

20 STEVE: Right.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: But, you know, I mean just
22 like, you know, the guys out there -- doesn't want to
23 get --

24 STEVE: Exactly, I understand.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, and then the kids will
get in, okay?

1 STEVE: Right.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: And then we'll take them
3 back.

4 STEVE: Okay.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: And I'll get the kids back
6 over here --

7 STEVE: And give us a call.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: And I'll let you talk to
9 them.

10 STEVE: Thank you.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay?

12 STEVE: Okay.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Now, that's, that's what
14 we're going to do. Now, what I'm -- and we're going to
15 get two kids?

16 STEVE: Yes, two of them.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Two kids.

18 STEVE: Angelica and Crystal Senobe.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Angelica and Crystal Senobe.

20 STEVE: Six and three.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Six and three, okay. God
22 bless you.

23 STEVE: Okay.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Just hang on with me because
25 we're going to get this done here in the next few
minutes, but we, we, we've got to get the -- you know,

1 I don't want any mistakes and I don't want the
2 commanders on the ground to do anything, that we agree,
3 you know?

4 STEVE: Right, okay.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: And how are the little girls?
6 Are they okay?

7 STEVE: They're okay, they seem to be. I'm
8 looking at them right now and they're just -- they're,
9 they're a little puzzled of course.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Would it help if I talked to
11 the older one and tell her this is Jim and she'll be
12 all right and meet the man and he'll come to me? Do
13 you want to do that?

14 STEVE: Okay. Just a minute. David wants to
15 talk to you first.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

17 STEVE: He wanted to know if you'd
18 (indiscernible).

19 MR. KORESH: All right. Okay. Listen to me.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

21 MR. KORESH: Okay. We're going to send Sita
22 out.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Sita?

24 MR. KORESH: Yeah, she's their mother.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Their mother, okay.

MR. KORESH: She wants to come back.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

2 MR. KORESH: So and she'll be the one taking
3 each child out, okay?

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. Can she take them out
5 one time just so we can, you know, do it --

6 MR. KORESH: Yeah, well --

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

8 MR. KORESH: -- she's going to take two at a
9 time.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Two at a time, okay, yeah,
11 that's fine.

12 MR. KORESH: And like I say, she's unarmed.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, there will be no problem.

14 MR. KORESH: And you let her come back
15 otherwise you're going to make us real mad.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, no, she'll come back.

17 MR. KORESH: Okay?

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: She can walk the two children
19 to the driveway.

20 MR. KORESH: Yeah, that way, you know, they,
21 they, they -- you know, make sure -- can even get them
22 there.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

24 MR. KORESH: Okay?

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: And then I'll have the
children brought to me and I'll let you talk to them so

1 | you know they're safe.

2 | MR. KORESH: Okay. You're going to have them
3 | brought out to you, right?

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: To me, okay?

5 | MR. KORESH: Okay, and then they call on the
6 | phone and then you all play that thing and we'll send
7 | you two more out.

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You've got a deal.

9 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. Now --

11 | MR. KORESH: Hey man, like I said, I don't
12 | hold nothing against you or the ATF guys.

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, I love you, buddy, I --

14 | MR. KORESH: They may not understand me, but
15 | we'll work it all out a little bit later, okay?

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, there's a lot of people
17 | here that love you and I --

18 | MR. KORESH: Oh, I --

19 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- I want you to know that.

20 | MR. KORESH: -- I wish they knew my truth.

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I want you to know that we're
22 | going to do it and this is going to be unbelievable, I
23 | mean, the people are going to know that --

24 | MR. KORESH: Oh, we're not murderers.

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, I know that.

 MR. KORESH: Remember that we did everything

1 in our power to stop -- it's just like in 1988, you
2 know, the Sheriff's Department told us there was
3 dangerous people out here, you know. Anyway, we did
4 kind of back then like what you all guys were doing
5 now, you know, you all were trying to make a diversion.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

7 MR. KORESH: But oh, I wish you all had just
8 -- I wish Robert -- I mean I wish -- what's his name?
9 Robert Gonzalez had been more honest. I asked him
10 several times to go ahead and confess, you know? But
11 he chose not to. Okay.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. I'm, I'm, I'm supposed
13 to get the word here in just a --

14 MR. KORESH: Well, they're -- she's fixing to
15 come out now, all right?

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right now, wait, hold it
17 up just because I want to make sure the car comes
18 first --

19 MR. KORESH: Okay.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- because I don't want her
21 to -- you know, I want her to see it that she knows
22 what -- you know, and he's not surprised or anything.

23 MR. KORESH: Okay.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: And, and the car will come,
25 just one car.

MR. KORESH: All right.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: So just give us a minute.

2 MR. KORESH: Remember, she's going to have a
3 flashlight so, you know --

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, that -- okay, we'll see
5 her but I, I don't want her -- I, I'd, I'd like her to
6 look out where she feels safe and sees the car.

7 MR. KORESH: Okay. All right.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Okay. They're
9 getting, they're the car.

10 (Groaning sounds)

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Have you -- is your side
12 hurting?

13 MR. KORESH: Oh, man.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Do you got any morphine out
15 there, David?

16 MR. KORESH: No, we don't, we don't do drugs.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh -- well, I was just
18 thinking of painkiller.

19 MR. KORESH: We just, we just have alcohol
20 and I don't drink alcohol, you know, I'll have an
21 occasional beer (indiscernible).

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: If we're going to do it --
23 well, they agree, let's do it (indiscernible) I'm just
24 trying to -- hey, tell them you'll do it and I'll tell
25 them to send the car. Come on, we're going to lose it.
Okay. All right. The car --

1 MR. KORESH: Okay.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- is coming, okay?

3 MR. KORESH: Uh-huh.

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: It, it, it is -- it's coming
5 from about six miles. We're not sending -- we're not
6 letting those guys that are on the road there, okay --

7 MR. KORESH: Okay.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- that were involved in the
9 deal today, we're, we're sending other people.

10 MR. KORESH: Okay.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay? So I want you to know
12 that. So in other --

13 MR. KORESH: Bring, bring, bring a woman,
14 too, if you can, you know how they're better with kids,
15 little kids.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. I, I --

17 MR. KORESH: If, if you, if you can.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: If we can, we'll bring a
19 woman if we can, but we're sending other agents, not
20 the ones that were there. They're going to come up,
21 they're going to drive up to the guard shack with their
22 lights on --

23 MR. KORESH: Okay.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and Sita will walk out,
25 Senobe and Angelica.

MR. KORESH: Yeah, and we'll watch with the

1 | car lights come on --

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, oh, yeah, they'll --

3 | MR. KORESH: -- and I'm talking about the
4 | inside, and then we'll -- when Sita comes back we'll
5 | know and then you give us a call back when they get
6 | there.

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, and you can talk to
8 | them, okay?

9 | MR. KORESH: All right.

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: All right, and, and hey --
11 | and the mother has to go back.

12 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: The mother has to go back.
14 | Tell them no mistakes. Only the children are coming.

15 | MR. KORESH: Now, let me tell you something
16 | too. If you do us wrong on this deal --

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

18 | MR. KORESH: I'll come out after you.

19 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I know, David. No
20 | mistakes. Okay. We'll --

21 | MR. KORESH: Is the car coming down now?

22 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, it's going to be a few
23 | minutes because we don't want to send those guys from
24 | the roadblock, so we're going to send other people.
25 | Well, I'm sending them right from here with me --

 MR. KORESH: Okay.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- because I want the
2 children to come back to me.

3 MR. KORESH: All right.

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, because that --

5 MR. KORESH: You're a good man, I appreciate
6 that.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. I don't want
8 nobody that's, you know, out there or something that
9 was --

10 MR. KORESH: Hey, you go all around and tell
11 them that a car's coming --

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

13 MR. KORESH: -- that -- and that we're
14 sending our kids out two, two-by-two every time they
15 play that thing on the, on the radio.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Every time we play they'll
17 send them out two-by-two.

18 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: You, you got it, you got it.
20 We will do it, we will do it.

21 MR. KORESH: Local radio station in Dallas?
22 Well, you know, it'll, it'll get around.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, it'll get -- it's
24 already got around, it's already got around. Is
25 there --

MR. KORESH: Go give, go give daddy a hug.

1 Okay?

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: David, do you want me to talk
3 to their mom here for a minute so she can feel like she
4 trusts me, I will?

5 MR. KORESH: Well, you know, like, like you
6 say, she trusts me.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. That's good.

8 MR. KORESH: Just make sure she comes back.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Here -- okay. Okay. Okay.

10 MR. KORESH: Hey, and you need to bring a --
11 some car seats if you can.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Some car seats? Okay. We'll
13 make sure we seat-belt them in.

14 MR. KORESH: Because some, some of them are
15 (indiscernible)

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: You've got to bring them
17 here. Our agreement is -- just put them on the phone.
18 Okay. Okay. I was just telling the commander that you
19 had to bring them here --

20 MR. KORESH: Okay.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- to me and, and so we can
22 put them on the phone to you.

23 MR. KORESH: All right.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: What -- tell me what they
25 look like.

MR. KORESH: Well, these two are little

1 Oriental girls.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. I'll bet they're
3 beautiful.

4 MR. KORESH: They're really cute. They're
5 good little girls.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oriental girls, okay.

7 MR. KORESH: Yeah. Well, I'm glad you're
8 letting them come out. I think that's great.

9 MR. KORESH: Well, like I said, you know, I
10 (indiscernible).

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: I know what's in your heart
12 now, I know what's in your heart. I --

13 MR. KORESH: Hey, all I wanted was to show
14 the seals that (indiscernible).

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, David I'm telling you,
16 it's been on the radio, your, your, your message has
17 gotten out more than ever, you know.

18 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) pull my leg out,
19 pull my leg out. Oh, it's cramped. (Groaning sounds)

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh man, are you okay?

21 MR. KORESH: (Groaning sounds) oh, do you
22 know what pain is.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh man, I feel for you,
24 David.

25 MR. KORESH: Man --

MR. KAVANAUGH: You sound good though. I

1 | mean, can you hold on for me? You sound better. I
2 | know --

3 | MR. KORESH: It's sad, you know. It's -- I,
4 | I got to stay alive at least long enough to --

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: To get these kids out, come
6 | on. We got to.

7 | STEVE: Get these kids out, yeah.

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You're a good man, God bless
9 | you.

10 | (Groaning sounds.)

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: You got to hang with me.
12 | What you got to do is you got to tell Steve too he's
13 | got to hang with it.

14 | STEVE: Lift the leg, lift the leg, please,
15 | lift the leg -- back (groaning sounds).

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: He said he's -- that he's
17 | trying to stay alive long enough to get the kids out
18 | and he's going to send two out every time we run the
19 | message. But no glitches, man. We got to stay with
20 | this. No glitches. Okay.

21 | STEVE: Be sure and have them play that thing
22 | right after the two kids, okay --

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

24 | MR. KORESH: -- and they call back here.

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Get, get the radio
station on the line, okay, and tell them that we're

1 going to -- want them to play the message again once we
2 get two children. Don't play it until we get the
3 children and then -- but I want them to be on an open
4 line with somebody next door and I -- when we have the
5 children I'll tell David and then I want it played,
6 okay? That's our agreement and I don't want any
7 glitches. I'm sticking up for you, buddy.

8 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: I got a lot of people around
10 me.

11 MR. KORESH: They're angry too, aren't they?

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, they're not. They're --
13 I'll tell you, they're just --

14 MR. KORESH: Well, they have to be, you all
15 lost some of your buddies, man.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, they're just kind of
17 sad.

18 MR. KORESH: Yeah, but you know --

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hold on.

20 MR. KORESH: -- I'll do what I can for them
21 when I get back home, all right? Because I don't, I
22 don't contend these guys because most of them they did
23 a good job, you know what I mean?

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. Man --

25 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: The children
are there (indiscernible).

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, you're, you're going to
2 lose this if you don't do it. I can't keep -- you've
3 got to do this. I can't keep this going if you don't
4 do it. The car's got to go. You tell them the car
5 goes out, the mother walks the two kids out, the two
6 kids get in the car, the agent leaves, they bring the
7 children here, I put them on the phone with David, then
8 we play the message. That's our agreement and we got
9 to do it now let's go.

10 MR. KORESH: They're not -- they're not
11 scared are they?

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, they just don't want to
13 get shot, I mean, you know?

14 MR. KORESH: I understand.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Can -- we can have two
16 agents, right?

17 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Two agents in the front,
19 that's it, and that -- no more, okay? Okay?

20 MR. KORESH: That's it.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: That's it, that's okay, we're
22 coming.

23 MR. KORESH: And then besides, you know,
24 there will be a woman there too, see what I'm saying?

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. It -- okay. Commander
passed on it's a minivan, okay, a little van.

1 MR. KORESH: Okay.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: It's all windows in it, you
3 can see it.

4 MR. KORESH: Okay.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: I mean, there's no tricks.

6 MR. KORESH: Well, like I say, we got night
7 vision on you guys.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I know you got night
9 vision. But there'll be two agents, I mean, and, and
10 you'll be able to see, they'll pull right up to the
11 guard shack. Will, will the mother have a light?

12 MR. KORESH: Yeah, she'll have a flashlight,
13 you'll see it coming.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Oh, she's got a
15 flashlight?

16 MR. KORESH: Yeah, and I'll hold -- I'll have
17 her hold it down to the ground so she doesn't flare it
18 in your eyes.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Tell, tell Steve if he
20 sees the car --

21 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- if he sees the car send
23 them out.

24 MR. KORESH: Okay.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. That's -- and that's
what -- I want to wait until the car gets there.

1 MR. KORESH: All right. Be sure --

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Huh?

3 MR. KORESH: I'm telling some people. Be
4 sure -- oh, I say, be sure tell all the guys to hold
5 fire, that I'm sending some of the children out and
6 there's going to be a car come in the front and not to,
7 not to fire on it, all right? Okay? Yeah, because
8 they'll be going out, okay? Go, go there and tell
9 them, okay?

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Tell everybody. That's good,
11 David. That was good. Steve's a good man.

12 MR. KORESH: Well, he, he loves the truth.
13 They're reading it again.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

15 MR. KORESH: Turn it down.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Now -- my agreement,
17 I'm playing it. That's it isn't it, David?

18 MR. KORESH: That's it.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right, buddy, I, I kept
20 my word.

21 MR. KORESH: And I'm keeping mine.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. You're a good man.
23 The radio is playing it again. They're already
24 (indiscernible).

25 MR. KORESH: Take care (Indiscernible)

MR. KAVANAUGH: David?

1 MR. KORESH: Huh?

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: We played it. I mean,
3 we're -- I'm trying to show you my good faith.

4 MR. KORESH: Well, I -- like I said, you
5 know, these children are not in this, you know?

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, I know it, buddy, I know
7 it, I know it, you know.

8 (Groaning sounds)

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: I can tell you're hurting,
10 man, I, I feel bad. I, I wish I could comfort you
11 somehow.

12 MR. KORESH: Well, just keep me a part of it,
13 be my comfort.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey, that's it. We know --
15 at least we --

16 MR. KORESH: Is the car here now -- not
17 coming in the gate.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, no. They're not coming
19 in the gate, they just pull up. Oh, okay, yeah. Let's
20 get the first (indiscernible) David, is, is the mother
21 okay?

22 MR. KORESH: Yeah, she's, she's fine.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. She's not scared is
24 she?

25 MR. KORESH: No.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Good.

1 MR. KORESH: No, she knows the book.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, yeah. She believes in
3 you.

4 MR. KORESH: She believes in God's word.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

6 MR. KORESH: Nobody can believe on me except
7 they believe God's word.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

9 MR. KORESH: It's impossible.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

11 MR. KORESH: That's why no one can just look
12 at me and talk to me and think of me being anything.
13 That's me allowed to be like everybody else, got to
14 establish His equity.

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

16 MR. KORESH: But the truth is the truth.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, I, I believe that, I
18 believe that. I think we should be getting close here.

19 MR. KORESH: Getting ready? Go -- going
20 down. You got a flashlight now?

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, man, you're taking --
22 you're taking too much time. Hey, send that goddamn
23 car -- get somebody up there, I'm going to lose it
24 (indiscernible) well, this is the only guy that cut the
25 deal. Can -- well, ask them while I'm on the phone
(indiscernible) can they come over here, and we can all

1 together work them here. I'll keep him on. And tell
2 Wayne he's coming here. We'll work on his phone.

3 MR. KORESH: Can you move my leg again,
4 please? Let's set it down. No, that one, the other
5 one. Yeah.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: That will be perfect because
7 they can --

8 MR. KORESH: Pick it up.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- switch on and off with me
10 and them.

11 MR. KORESH: Pick it up straight. Move the
12 chair. Bend it, bend it, bend it.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: David's hurt in his leg real
14 bad. It's cramping.

15 MR. KORESH: No, it's just -- okay. Back it
16 up a little more, please.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I've been on since 9:30
18 too but I mean, I mean I called them when they were
19 shooting so I mean --

20 MR. KORESH: Little bit more, please. Back
21 it up a little bit more.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: (Indiscernible) as far as
23 (indiscernible) we'd like them to come here, that's our
24 request so if you can do it I'd appreciate -- I mean,
25 we got -- we'll keep the line open. He can keep it
open until he gets here. Leave one guy with it open,

1 | come over --

2 | MR. KORESH: What now?

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, I was talking with a guy
4 | here.

5 | MR. KORESH: Oh.

6 | UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: (Indiscernible)

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

8 | MR. KORESH: Turn it up.

9 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Right. There's -- they're
10 | ready to come out as soon as we get the car there. The
11 | car needs to ge there, two agents and (indiscernible).

12 | MR. KORESH: Could you pull my leg up some
13 | more? Get the cat out. Push it up.

14 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I got to get them to move
15 | faster. They're too slow. I mean, the guy's wanting
16 | to deal.

17 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: He don't know. Yeah, but it
19 | doesn't do is any good to deal with the guy who's not
20 | the boss, you know? I mean -- well, that's true.
21 | Let's have them go right up. [gap] Yeah, she will,
22 | sure.

23 | (Child crying)

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David?

25 | MR. KORESH: Sir?

MR. KAVANAUGH: Is that a baby crying?

1 What's the matter?

2 MR. KORESH: Yeah, that's my little girl.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: What's her name?

4 MR. KORESH: Bobbie.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Bobbie. How old?

6 MR. KORESH: Bobbie (indiscernible) she's
7 almost a year.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: A year, bless her heart. She
9 got enough to eat in there?

10 MR. KORESH: Oh, yeah, plenty of food. She
11 (indiscernible).

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: I have two kids, I have two
13 kids myself. I have a little girl and a little boy.

14 MR. KORESH: Yeah. She's getting some titty
15 right now. Good woman.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is she? What's her mom's
17 name?

18 MR. KORESH: Rachel.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Rachel.

20 MR. KORESH: Who is that, Steve? No, that's
21 our next door neighbors are talking.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Huh?

23 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: (Indiscernible) get the first
25 one.

1 MR. KORESH: What did Mark say?

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: What happened, Dave?

3 MR. KORESH: He's probably sad isn't he?

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Who, who, who is -- who is
5 Mark?

6 MR. KORESH: Our --

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, your neighbor?

8 MR. KORESH: Our next door neighbor, yeah,
9 Mark, he's a good guy.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is he okay?

11 MR. KORESH: Yeah, he just was on the
12 interview.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, okay.

14 MR. KORESH: I like that guy. He gave us a
15 fair chance, didn't he?

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. When they pick up
17 the kids have them drop -- have them put the kids in a
18 different vehicle.

19 MR. KORESH: When do you think they'll get
20 here?

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and bring them to me.
22 It'll be just a few minutes. Keep that same vehicle
23 there but get two more kids in a few minutes. Don't
24 make him (indiscernible). Okay. It'll be just a few
25 minutes. Yeah. We're -- yeah, we, we want to, you
know, try to get it -- we're trying to do it slowly.

1 I, I don't want to get any of your people excited, you
2 know what I mean? I, I, I'm trying to keep my word,
3 you know?

4 MR. KORESH: You all be sure and tell
5 everyone not to fire on the car.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, they won't.

7 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible) all right.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: We want everybody to be safe.

9 MR. KORESH: As long as we can make it that
10 way.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, we can, I know we can.

12 MR. KORESH: I'll bet you talked to some real
13 psychos in the past haven't you?

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: You know, people -- we're all
15 different. I'll tell you, we, we, we're all so
16 different and we look at things so different and you
17 know, when you're a policeman -- I used to be a deputy
18 sheriff and, you know, ride in a uniform car and, you
19 know, I got a -- I used to help a lot of folks. I
20 delivered a baby once and I'll tell you it was real
21 exciting, David, I'll tell you it really was, you know?

22 MR. KORESH: Yeah, I'm fixing, I'm fixing to
23 have a couple more here.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, are you?

25 MR. KORESH: Yeah. I have two women
pregnant.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, that's great.

2 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm glad we are agreeing that
4 we love kids and I think that's, that's tremendous.

5 MR. KORESH: You know, kid -- children are
6 the most important thing to me in my whole life.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: I know, I believe you, I
8 believe you, because --

9 MR. KORESH: Because you can do so much with
10 them if you know the truth.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

12 MR. KORESH: Just like my attorney that
13 helped us in the '88 case --

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

15 MR. KORESH: -- Gary Coker.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Coker? Yeah.

17 MR. KORESH: We had this little pizza party
18 afterwards and he says --

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Pizza party?

20 MR. KORESH: Yeah (indiscernible) he, he
21 says, Dave, how do you -- how do your children -- how
22 come they're so well mannered?

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

24 MR. KORESH: And I kept trying to tell him
25 the seals, but he said no, I don't want to know
religion. He says, I just want to know how do you get

1 | your children so well mannered.

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

3 | MR. KORESH: I said, well, because they know
4 | the truth.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

6 | MR. KORESH: Well, anyway, he said, I can't
7 | ask you nothing about Bible study.

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. David, how did you,
9 | how did you -- you, you just know so much from the
10 | Bible, is that from the seven seals when you got that?
11 | Is that how you learned?

12 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

13 | MR. KAVANAUGH: That's unbelievable, it's
14 | amazing. I can't -- I've never --

15 | MR. KORESH: Well, you don't know nothing
16 | yet.

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I've never spoken to no one
18 | who knows --

19 | MR. KORESH: Well, there's -- like it's a
20 | simple man's doctrine, isn't it?

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

22 | MR. KORESH: Just pretend you're a simple-
23 | minded man --

24 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

25 | MR. KORESH: -- and you've read Matthew,
Mark, Luke, John, right?

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right, um-hum.

2 MR. KORESH: You read Acts, Romans,
3 Corinthians and Paul says a lot of things that's hard
4 to understand, doesn't he?

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, uh-huh.

6 MR. KORESH: Okay. Now, when you, when you
7 get to the last book of the New Testament after the
8 Book of Jude, there's a revelation Jesus Christ's God
9 gave to him to show to his servants and John was the
10 servant.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

12 MR. KORESH: And John wrote down that
13 revelation and sent it to the seven churches in Asia
14 and each church was given specific information about
15 their necessity and need.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

17 MR. KORESH: But in Chapter 4, the message to
18 Laodicea, in Chapter 4 the Angel says, come up here now
19 John and I'll show you that which must be hereafter.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

21 MR. KORESH: And John witnessed the Last
22 Judgment in regards to the case of this whole world.

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

24 MR. KORESH: And John saw that all the Heaven
25 was called together. It's a serious thing, you know.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

1 MR. KORESH: There are some heavy indictments
2 against you boys --

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum, I understand.

4 MR. KORESH: -- and against the nations, you
5 know?

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand, yeah.

7 MR. KORESH: And that's why I'm here. I'm
8 like your attorney.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right, uh-huh.

10 MR. KORESH: See, I'm a mediator.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

12 MR. KORESH: So what happened was the
13 question was asked in God's judgment who only is
14 worthy. Let me tell you about my world, okay?

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, yeah.

16 MR. KORESH: You see, when you read the story
17 of Genesis --

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

19 MR. KORESH: -- there was already a world
20 here wasn't there?

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, uh-huh.

22 MR. KORESH: It was void and darkness on the
23 face of the deep and the Spirit of God was on the face
24 of the waters and God said, "Let there be light,"
25 right?

MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

1 MR. KORESH: Well, you know why there was a
2 world here before?

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, I don't.

4 MR. KORESH: Well, you know why God said to
5 Adam and Eve, "Replenish and remultiply the Earth"?
6 That means put back something don't it?

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I understand.

8 MR. KORESH: Well, tell me about my Father --

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

10 MR. KORESH: -- let me tell you about me.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

12 MR. KORESH: After Adam and Eve sinned, they
13 took of the forbidden fruit, right?

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right, um-hum.

15 MR. KORESH: There's only one way to teach
16 men the lesson that God learned a long time ago. God
17 is not what you think he is --

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right, um-hum.

19 MR. KORESH: -- you know? God says, "Behold,
20 man has become as one of us -- "

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

22 MR. KORESH: -- "only good and evil."

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

24 MR. KORESH: Now, you know God has not always
25 been holy.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

1 MR. KORESH: All you got to do to learn the
2 lesson is search the scriptures and find for every
3 child that's born into this world --

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

5 MR. KORESH: -- it has to learn good and
6 evil. Those who realize that there are stars above the
7 Heaven and there's got to be worlds past Orion --

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: -- they realize this doesn't
10 work.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

12 MR. KORESH: You know, when you break the
13 commandments of God all you're doing is you're losing
14 the lack of love --

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

16 MR. KORESH: -- you know? So God had to
17 separate from men and give them a choice to do their
18 own thing and then when men have found that their own
19 ways are not working and their own ways have brought
20 sorry and sin and suffering upon them, the wages of sin
21 is death, then God sends a message into the world and
22 says, Children -- talking to me, you know? And it says
23 like this, Who sits on the throne --

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right.

25 MR. KORESH: -- who do you give the book to?

MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

1 MR. KORESH: And so the one who loves you
2 more than you could ever realize and it comes in the
3 flesh and that's where we get our problem. After the
4 order of (indiscernible) God in the flesh. Anytime you
5 come looking like mortal man --

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

7 MR. KORESH: -- men don't respect men, they
8 don't, they don't love one another. You know, if a
9 brother is wrong and erring you with your spiritual,
10 Paul says, restores (indiscernible) consider yourself
11 least you also be tempted.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

13 MR. KORESH: Christ says, Christ says, "By
14 this they shall know that you're my disciples and that
15 you love one another." You know, we live together. I
16 mean, in the beginning, you know, getting this many
17 people from all over the world living together --

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

19 MR. KORESH: -- you know, they have to learn
20 love after a while.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand, yeah.

22 MR. KORESH: So, you know, the thing that
23 binds us together is that our Father in Heaven has
24 given us knowledge and an understanding and we, we
25 realize that in our own humanity we fell far short of
the things that we know we should and shouldn't do, you

1 know?

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right, um-hum.

3 MR. KORESH: But still in this great country
4 God has blessed this nation because it's said it's a
5 nation that's concerned about the religious beliefs and
6 convictions of people.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

8 MR. KORESH: Now, it says it believes the
9 Bible.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

11 MR. KORESH: Now, we have found in scripture,
12 I found in Israel on Mount (indiscernible).

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

14 MR. KORESH: But the people that have
15 studied, we found in scripture, that God requires
16 obedience [gap] because we're all to keep the law in
17 the name of love --

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

19 MR. KORESH: -- but to the spirit of His
20 will. So then the will of God is revealed in seven
21 seals and we've done so.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

23 MR. KORESH: And we've been -- we're in a
24 tight situation now, my friend.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: We are, we are.

MR. KORESH: But, you know --

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: But because you're a good man
2 you're -- well, maybe more than man, but --

3 MR. KORESH: There's none good, but there's
4 one good in Heaven, your Father --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

6 MR. KORESH: -- you know, and far as I'm
7 concerned I'm just a dixie cup. In the [gap] Psalm 89
8 -- you got a Bible there with you?

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

10 MR. KORESH: Let's take a look at the story
11 in Psalm 89 real quick.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

13 MR. KORESH: The promise to ancient David
14 (indiscernible).

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Psalm 89? Let's see, I got
16 it right here.

17 MR. KORESH: They're coming? The light's on
18 outside?

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, they're coming. They
20 said they were --

21 MR. KORESH: You've got a radio on with them
22 don't you?

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, they, they said they
24 were about -- three-quarters of a mile.

25 MR. KORESH: Okay. They're at the gate now,
right?

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Do they see them there?

2 MR. KORESH: Are they at the gate now?

3 (Female voice in background)

4 MR. KORESH: Okay.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Send them out so they
6 can --

7 MR. KORESH: Send them out and give them a
8 kiss and tell them to remember --

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: They're sending them out.

10 MR. KORESH: -- what they learned. Okey-
11 dokey. Okay. Bye-bye. Give me a kiss. Come on.
12 Going to be all right, okay. Remember what you
13 learned, okay? Okay. I love you. Bye-bye. Tell them
14 good-bye. Hey, go tell them who David really is, okay?
15 Yeah, okay, listen.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

17 MR. KORESH: We want you to send them to
18 their grandparents, okay?

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Send them to their
20 grandparents?

21 MR. KORESH: Right.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

23 MR. KORESH: Their grandparents are like I
24 say know nothing about this message, they're good
25 people --

MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

1 MR. KORESH: -- the Senobe's and they're in
2 Hawaii.

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. How could I reach
4 them?

5 MR. KORESH: Yeah, Scott. I know that, but
6 they'll know it. Your, your dad treated me good,
7 Scott, and that's all that makes any difference. He
8 didn't know what I thought but he treated me
9 respectful, remember that, you know? He'll do it.
10 They're going to call -- they're going to -- the kids
11 are going to talk to you afterwards. And you got their
12 address and phone numbers? Okay. Take this number
13 down.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, go ahead.

15 MR. KORESH: The phone number is (808) --

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

17 MR. KORESH: -- 689 --

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

19 MR. KORESH: -- 4457.

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Where is that at?

21 MR. KORESH: (808), right, (808) --

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: 689 --

23 MR. KORESH: -- 689-4457.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Got it, and, and what's their
25 name? Do you know?

MR. KORESH: What's, what's, what's their

1 name? Ken and Mollie Senobe.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Ken and Mollie --

3 MR. KORESH: And Cerila Vera, Cerila Vera
4 (indiscernible).

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Cerila. Where do they live,
6 David?

7 MR. KORESH: They live in Hawaii.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Hawaii?

9 MR. KORESH: Yeah. It's 91674 --

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

11 MR. KORESH: -- K-I-L-A-L-H-A Street.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: K-I-L-L-A-H-A Street?

13 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

15 MR. KORESH: 1333 --

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: 133 --

17 MR. KORESH: -- Hala, H-A-L-A Drive,
18 Apartment L-3, E-W-A, B-E-A-C-H, Hawaii.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. Give me that last
20 line, David. I got up to Apartment L-3.

21 MR. KORESH: Apartment L-3 --

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

23 MR. KORESH: -- E-W-A --

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: E-W-A.

25 MR. KORESH: -- yeah, B-E-A-C-H.

MR. KAVANAUGH: B-A-C-H, Hawaii.

1 MR. KORESH: Hawaii.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

3 MR. KORESH: Okay?

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: We'll get in touch with them,
5 okay?

6 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible)

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

8 MR. KORESH: Okay?

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. Hold on, let me brief
10 one of my guys, guys here.

11 MR. KORESH: Well, we need to send them out.
12 I don't want to get them spooked out.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, I understand. We got to
14 get in touch with them, okay? This is the grandparents
15 of these children that are coming out, okay? And see
16 if we can get in touch with them and David wants to
17 make sure, you know, they get together --

18 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible)

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- so we're going to, we're
20 going to do that.

21 MR. KORESH: Is there anymore (indiscernible).

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, that's good.

23 (indiscernible) hey, are you hurting, David?

24 MR. KORESH: You know, after a while it's
25 like --

MR. KAVANAUGH: Can you move at all, because

1 | if --

2 | MR. KORESH: No, I, I just barely can move my
3 | right leg and then, you know [gap] we're going to send
4 | -- every time they play this -- after they get the kids
5 | they're going to play it again --

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

7 | MR. KORESH: -- and then we're going
8 | to -- they're going to come back and we're going to
9 | send them two more until they're all gone.

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Right. We're going to --
11 | hey, he's agreeing to send every kid, every time we
12 | play two kids he's agreeing.

13 | UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER: What's that radio
14 | station?

15 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Don't play it, don't play it
16 | until we tell them. Get them on the line.

17 | MR. KORESH: Hi, son. Hi, baby.

18 | MR. KAVANAUGH: David, are they going down
19 | the driveway?

20 | MR. KORESH: Are they going down the drive --
21 | no, they'd be telling us if they did. You got a radio
22 | with them don't you?

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, but it's, it's in the
24 | next room. They're there? Can you tell me is the car
25 | there?

 MR. KORESH: Tell, tell them we're sending

1 | them out. They'll be -- you'll see a flashlight at the
2 | front door and, and they'll -- and she'll be down there
3 | in just a few minutes, okay? Are you there?

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I'm here.

5 | MR. KORESH: Okay. So tell them not to drive
6 | off just, you know, get back behind that thing there,
7 | if they're kind of uneasy.

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, they will. They'll get
9 | behind the guard shack and, and --

10 | MR. KORESH: Yeah.

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and then they'll, and then
12 | they'll go out.

13 | MR. KORESH: No, you'll go right out to them.
14 | Yeah. And, you know, so okay get them ready. They're
15 | there now, right?

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Are they there?

17 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, we're going -- she's going
18 | unarmed.

19 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, absolutely.

20 | MR. KORESH: Unarmed.

21 | MR. KAVANAUGH: They lady's coming unarmed,
22 | absolutely. We, we know that.

23 | MR. KORESH: Okay. I only see the -- who?
24 | Okay. They're on their way now.

25 | MR. KAVANAUGH: The -- is the car there?

MR. KORESH: Is the car there yet?

1 (Indiscernible female voice in the
2 background.)

3 MR. KORESH: Okay. The car is at the gate.

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, and the kids are
5 coming. The car's at the gate.

6 MR. KORESH: And the children will be out in
7 just a second or two.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: They're coming out in just a
9 second or two. Okay, good.

10 MR. KORESH: And then you'll -- when you --
11 when they get there you'll have them talk to us, right?

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: When I get -- when they get
13 right here to me I'm going to hand them the phone,
14 okay?

15 MR. KORESH: Yeah, because their mother wants
16 to talk to them bad.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, I understand, we're
18 going to do that.

19 MR. KORESH: Okay. You got the Bible now?

20 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I got it. Are, are,
21 are they coming out for --

22 MR. KORESH: Yeah, they're coming out. I'm
23 not going to let you down on this.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: I know you won't let me down.

25 MR. KORESH: Okay. You got Psalms 89 open?

MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Wait a minute. David

1 can't see them. He thinks they're coming out. If the
2 car's there they're coming out he said.

3 MR. KORESH: Yeah, well, they'll be out.
4 Just tell the guys to be --

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

6 MR. KORESH: -- don't be uneasy.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, yeah, just be patient,
8 he's sending them out. He -- we need to get a car with
9 a radio so we can talk to them. Well --

10 MR. KORESH: They're uneasy I guess.

11 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, they just -- they, they
12 sent a van that didn't have a radio or just a walkie-
13 talkie --

14 MR. KORESH: Oh --

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- so they couldn't reach
16 them and that's what the delay is.

17 MR. KORESH: Get, get a radio so we can, you
18 know, make sure no mess-ups happen.

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. What I'll do is on the
20 next time --

21 MR. KORESH: Uh-huh.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- I'm going to put them in a
23 different car --

24 MR. KORESH: All right.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- that has a big radio.

MR. KORESH: Okay.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay? Different car the next
2 time, not this time, with a big radio so we can talk to
3 them and we don't have anymore of these delays because
4 we got to get these babies taken care of.

5 MR. KORESH: Yeah.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: (Indiscernible)

7 MR. KORESH: All right. Okay. Are you ready
8 to be enlightened?

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah. Okay. Go ahead.

10 MR. KORESH: Okay. Now, David is promised by
11 God that God would rule over Israel through his seed.
12 So David writes in the psalm and the Psalm is 89. You
13 got it there?

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, wait, hold one second.
15 If they take that lady (indiscernible) something and
16 he's going to get real upset. Make sure they know.
17 David said the lady doesn't want to go and that she's
18 going back. Is that -- that's right, isn't it David?

19 MR. KORESH: Yes, she wants to come back and
20 she'll be bringing out each of, each of the children.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: She's going to bring out all
22 the children. She's coming back. She's going to bring
23 them out every time, the same lady so we have the same
24 drill. No mistakes. All right. Okay. Go ahead.

25 MR. KORESH: They understand there, right?

MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, they do.

1 MR. KORESH: Okay.

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Psalm 89.

3 MR. KORESH: Got it there?

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Let me look here, yeah wait a
5 minute.

6 MR. KORESH: (Indiscernible)

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Wait a minute, one --

8 MR. KORESH: Psalms --

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Psalm 89, what number?

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Psalm 89.

11 MR. KORESH: Okay (indiscernible) you know,
12 what I mean by Psalm 89 we're going to read the whole
13 thing.

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, okay.

15 MR. KORESH: Okay.

16 (Baby crying)

17 MR. KORESH: What's, what's wrong with her?

18 Okay. She don't want to leave? Who? (Indiscernible)

19 The car -- is she out there now? The car's driving
20 away?

21 (Indiscernible female voice in the
22 background.)

23 MR. KORESH: Okay. So they're -- I guess
24 they got them now.

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: David says he thinks they got
them, the car is driving away. Tell us right away, we

1 | need to know. Okay. I think we got them and --

2 | MR. KORESH: They can't open the door. What
3 | do you mean you can't open the door? Our front door
4 | is, is jammed? Well --

5 | (Indiscernible female voice in the
6 | background)

7 | MR. KORESH: Why is it driving away for?

8 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Where is the car?

9 | MR. KORESH: Yeah, let them, let them, let
10 | them go out the back or something or just get them on
11 | out there. We need to, we need to get these kids out.

12 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hold on.

13 | (Indiscernible female voice in the
14 | background.)

15 | MR. KORESH: No, make sure it's the front.
16 | Just open a window or something, let them go out the
17 | window.

18 | (Indiscernible female voice in the
19 | background.)

20 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, but -- they're looking
21 | for the car (indiscernible).

22 | MR. KORESH: But they -- the car left?

23 | MR. KAVANAUGH: No, it couldn't have left.

24 | UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Okay. They're
25 | out.

 MR. KORESH: Okay. They're out.

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: They're out there. Now, is
2 it the kids out or the car is out there?

3 MR. KORESH: The -- okay, the, the car is out
4 there they say but then they said it started leaving.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: Oh, it wasn't, it wasn't
6 leaving.

7 MR. KORESH: Okay. Okay. Okay. That's
8 good. All right.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: Where's the mother and the
10 children?

11 MR. KORESH: She's -- they're on the way out
12 now.

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: They're on the way out now
14 walking down the drive?

15 MR. KORESH: Get a radio, that way you can
16 know whether, you know, they see the flashlight.

17 MR. KAVANAUGH: He's telling me to get a car
18 with a radio. Get a car with a radio next time! Okay.
19 We're going to do that.

20 MR. KORESH: Okay.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: This thing -- it was just a
22 glitch, David, on the walkie and the reason was we were
23 trying to, you know, use the van that had all the
24 windows so, you know, none of your guys would think --

25 MR. KORESH: Yeah, I know.

MR. KAVANAUGH: That's all, buddy, it was --

1 | that's the only thing. You, you know how things work,
2 | I mean, sometimes communications, you know --

3 | MR. KORESH: Just make sure nothing messes
4 | up.

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Nothing will mess up.

6 | MR. KORESH: It's your responsibility now.

7 | MR. KAVANAUGH: The kids are coming?

8 | MR. KORESH: No, we just -- Sita's got to
9 | come back.

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, they see the light.
11 | Sita will come back.

12 | MR. KORESH: Keep down Jess, okay. So, the
13 | psalm says --

14 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay, and the kids are coming
15 | down with a flashlight with the mother.

16 | MR. KORESH: They see it, right?

17 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

18 | MR. KORESH: Okay.

19 | MR. KAVANAUGH: They're coming.

20 | MR. KORESH: You love those kids now as long
21 | as you can.

22 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Wait. Tell Chuck to come in
23 | here and tell me something. Chuck (indiscernible) hold
24 | on a minute, David. Is, is the truck there? Man
25 | you're going to lose this. Drive some goddamn truck to
 | the gate.

1 MR. KORESH: Something's messing up, huh?

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: Well, I, I think it's just
3 communications, the, the walkie-talkie.

4 (Indiscernible male voice in the background.)

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right, a car? It's okay
6 if it's a car just send it. He just wants you to send
7 it.

8 MR. KORESH: Make sure they don't try to get
9 her.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, the kids are at the guard
11 shack waiting. The kids are at the guard shack
12 waiting. Okay. Just tell you guys it might be a car
13 instead of the van was slow but we're -- it's, it's
14 going to be just one vehicle.

15 MR. KORESH: Okay.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: I don't want them to get --

17 MR. KORESH: It all going now?

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I think it's [gap] hey,
19 I want to apologize to you for the delay. I feel real
20 bad about it.

21 MR. KORESH: People are human.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I guess that's what it
23 is, you know. We're all human and we're trying and
24 you're trying and, and that's what's going to make it
25 work. I wish it could go a little quicker but I think
we're going to have it in a few minutes.

1 MR. KORESH: What are they saying? What,
2 what are --

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Is the car there? All right.
4 It's coming.

5 MR. KORESH: Okay.

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. It's --

7 MR. KORESH: Ready for the psalm?

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, go ahead.

9 MR. KORESH: Psalm 89.

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

11 MR. KORESH: It says, "I will sing of the
12 mercies of the Lord forever: with my mouth will I make
13 known thy faithfulness to all generations. For I said
14 your mercy shall be built up forever: thy faithfulness
15 shalt thou establish in the very heavens." Now, you
16 know where God sit on the throne in Revelation, right?
17 He's got a rainbow over this throne don't he?

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, sir, yes, sir.

19 MR. KORESH: Okay. Now, that God spake to
20 David and David is talking about God. "I've made a
21 covenant with my chosen," that's the seven seals. "I
22 have sworn unto David -- "

23 MR. KAVANAUGH: I'm afraid they're going to
24 turn around and go back if they don't get a car there.
25 Okay. They see the kids, David.

MR. KORESH: Okay. They see them?

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: They see them and they're,
2 they're getting together right now, I think.

3 MR. KORESH: Okay. Just don't take her, she
4 don't want to go.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: He's talking to the kid --
6 the agent's talking to the kids. Make sure the mother
7 stays there.

8 MR. KORESH: She'll bring out other ones.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: And she'll bring out the
10 rest. Don't take the mother. She doesn't -- leave her
11 there.

12 MR. KORESH: Baby (indiscernible) yes, yes
13 [gap] so what's going on now?

14 MR. KAVANAUGH: I, I -- tell me, tell me
15 something, I want to tell him, he wants to know.

16 MR. KORESH: Okay. They're driving off now?

17 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: They driving
18 off?

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. They're getting
20 in the car he said.

21 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: They're driving
22 away.

23 MR. KORESH: They're driving away now.

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: They're, they're driving
25 away.

MR. KORESH: Sita's coming back?

1 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Sita's coming
2 back?

3 MR. KAVANAUGH: Sita's coming back?

4 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Yes.

5 MR. KAVANAUGH: All like we agreed.

6 MR. KORESH: Okay.

7 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay?

8 MR. KORESH: Good boy.

9 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right. Now listen, have
10 another car with a big radio right from Double-E Road
11 that's going to go in and get the next set of kids,
12 okay? And bring those kids here. Okay. Dave, we, we
13 got them. We're --

14 MR. KORESH: Okay. Okay. Ready?

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

16 MR. KORESH: Verse 3, "I have made a covenant
17 with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant, thy
18 seed will I establish forever, and build up thy throne
19 to all generations. And the heavens shall praise thy
20 wonders, oh Lord: thy faithfulness also -- "

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: (Indiscernible) repeating all
22 of it.

23 MR. KORESH: Are you listening?

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I am, go ahead. Guy's
25 talking -- I'm here. Your seed and I will establish
forever --

1 MR. KORESH: Yeah --

2 MR. KAVANAUGH: -- and build up your throne
3 to all --

4 MR. KORESH: -- David's, David's seed, that
5 was Christ wasn't it?

6 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, sir, uh-huh.

7 MR. KORESH: Okay. So it says, "For who in
8 the heaven can be compared unto the Lord?" You know
9 who Christ is, right?

10 MR. KAVANAUGH: Who -- where it says, "Who
11 among the sons of the almighty"?

12 MR. KORESH: "Can be compared unto the Lord?"

13 MR. KAVANAUGH: Lord, uh-huh.

14 MR. KORESH: "Who among the sons of the
15 Almighty can be likened to the Lord?"

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: All right.

17 MR. KORESH: All right? I mean, only the
18 Lamb, right?

19 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

20 MR. KORESH: And God's going to reign
21 (indiscernible) his faithful, he means what he says.

22 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

23 MR. KORESH: "God is greatly to be feared in
24 the assembly of the saints" --

25 MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

MR. KORESH: " -- and to be had in reverence

1 | of all them that are about him."

2 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

3 | MR. KORESH: That's why, "Oh Lord God of
4 | hosts -- " which is my Father, " -- who is the strong
5 | Lord like unto thee?" --

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay.

7 | MR. KORESH: " -- or to they faithfulness
8 | round about thee?" -- which means you're going to do
9 | just what he says in that book, right?

10 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yes, sir.

11 | MR. KORESH: "Thou rulest the raging sea,"
12 | which is the heathen that raged. The prophecy says
13 | that the rage of the great ocean the sea. "When the
14 | waves thereof arise, thou will still them or thou
15 | stillest them," you know, God's going to put the
16 | enemies out after this. "Thou has broken Ra-had in
17 | pieces, as one that is slain." Now, Ra-had was a
18 | harlot in Jericho and the way she was saved, she wasn't
19 | really killed with the rest of the people, the reason
20 | but -- the reason being is, is that the spies came in
21 | and they were being searched out --

22 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

23 | MR. KORESH: -- and they came to her house
24 | and they asked her to help them. Well, she had known
25 | the God of Israel was greater than her god, risked her
own life in trying to defend the spies of Israel. So

1 | they made a covenant saying, look, when we destroy this
2 | city --

3 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Hey --

4 | MR. KORESH: Are you there?

5 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, I'm here.

6 | MR. KORESH: -- we will spare you and all
7 | that you bring into your house so she was the only
8 | ordained minister from God and all she brought to her
9 | house they were saved. But she was as she was
10 | (indiscernible) spiritual --

11 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum, I understand.

12 | MR. KORESH: (indiscernible) a strong arm.
13 | Now, the way I get rid of my enemies is I teach the
14 | seven seals and people realize they can't fight against
15 | God --

16 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

17 | MR. KORESH: -- because, "The heavens are
18 | thine and the earth is also thine, as for the world and
19 | everything thereof, thou has founded them. The north,
20 | the south, thou has created them: Ta-bor and Her-mon
21 | shall rejoice in thy name." That's the places where
22 | Moses had visions in Deuteronomy 32 about the end of
23 | the world. "Thou has a mighty arm: strong is thy
24 | hand, and high is thy right hand." God imposed his
25 | word in heaven. He said this is what I'm going to do
--

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

2 MR. KORESH: -- I'm going to send my son back
3 again this time being a sinner like the gentiles and
4 I'm going to have him teach the truth to the gentiles,
5 you know, and those who receive it will be redeemed and
6 those who fight against it I'll make an example of in
7 the sight of all the world.

8 MR. KAVANAUGH: Um-hum.

9 MR. KORESH: "Justice and judgment are the
10 habilitation of they throne: mercy and truth shall go
11 before they face," that's me.

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

13 MR. KORESH: See, before God comes and whips
14 you all guy's butts --

15 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah.

16 MR. KORESH: -- I'm trying to teach the seven
17 seals, man.

18 MR. KAVANAUGH: I understand.

19 MR. KORESH: This the key of David, it
20 unlocks the mysteries.

21 MR. KAVANAUGH: Right.

22 MR. KORESH: "Blessed are the people that joy
23 the -- know the joyful sound: they shall walk, oh Lord,
24 in the light of thy countenance." See, my Father is
25 watching me right now, he's --

1 MR. KAVANAUGH: We on now? Is it coming on?
2 Red light?

3 (Telephone ringing)

4 MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, David, they just moved
5 [gap] they're not coming toward you.

6 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: It starts and
7 then it quits. The batteries are right.

8 UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPEAKER #3: You need AA
9 batteries?

10 UNIDENTIFIED FEMALE SPEAKER: Um-hum.

11 STEVE: Yes?

12 MR. KAVANAUGH: The news conference. Okay.
13 What happened? I didn't hear it.

14 STEVE: Well, anyway, David wanted to know if
15 you got his message out yet on the airwaves.

16 MR. KAVANAUGH: No, that -- no, here's what I
17 was trying to work out with David. I can get the
18 message played -- I know, but he, he just --

19 STEVE: I'm going to get off the phone
20 because, you know, that's, that's the thing that -- he
21 said to you and that's what's going to be.

23 STEVE: Yeah?

24 MR. KAVANAUGH: Can I talk to him?

25 STEVE: You walk to talk -- no.

MR. KAVANAUGH: Okay. Well, I, I really want

2 | we've, we've already put one message on there and --

3 | STEVE: I haven't heard any.

4 | MR. KAVANAUGH: Yeah, David heard it. [gap]

5 | STEVE: We want to resolve it.

6 | MR. KAVANAUGH: I want to resolve it, and you
7 | do too. And what I'm saying is, let's make an, an
8 | agreement -- going to have it played and then I'm going
9 | to -- I, I want to get some kids or wounded out, okay?
10 | I'm going to do the thing first. We've already played
11 | one message, you know. [gap] Okay. Okay. I need to
12 | sack -- the sack.

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
