2 JOHN DOLAN: Oh. Well, hey --

3 STEVE: I mean I'll tell you the truth --

4 JOHN DOLAN: Strong love.

5 STEVE: I love her to death myself. I mean I  
6 really love her.

7 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, yeah.

8 STEVE: And -- but you know, Judy's the one  
9 of course that bore her and so anyway --

10 JOHN DOLAN: You know she'd be safe, you know  
11 she'd be safe with me. You know that and --

12 STEVE: Oh, yeah. But of course if she would  
13 go anywhere she'd be going --

14 JOHN DOLAN: With her mom.

15 STEVE: -- I would want her to go to one of  
16 the relatives like Judy's mom or something so --

17 JOHN DOLAN: Who's, who's -- okay. Have we  
18 spoken to Judy's mom?

19 STEVE: I don't know to be honest with you.  
20 I don't know. I think --

21 JOHN DOLAN: Well --

22 STEVE: -- I think so. Because I think there  
23 was a message left or something like that from what I  
24 recall.

25 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. We, we could get that  
done. Steve, we could get that done. You know that.

1 STEVE: I do know that. But you --

2 JOHN DOLAN: We could get that done.

3 STEVE: -- know it still comes down to I can  
4 go mention it to Judy. She can get on the phone with  
5 you again. She wasn't happy because she was hoping  
6 that there would have been something shown to her about  
7 her finger being taken care of and --

8 JOHN DOLAN: Let me speak, let me speak to  
9 Judy.

10 STEVE: Okay.

11 JOHN DOLAN: All right.

12 STEVE: Who's -- anybody -- just a minute.  
13 There's nobody even nearby me --

14 JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

15 STEVE: -- right now. I'm going to have to  
16 call out. I don't want --

17 JOHN DOLAN: All right.

18 STEVE: -- leave the phone. Just a minute.  
19 Anybody here? Who's here? See if Judy -- is she, is  
20 she free to come to the phone? Check to see if she's  
21 free to come to the phone. I know she was having her  
22 finger looked at, but if she can if she's finished ask  
23 her if she wouldn't come to the phone.

24 Okay, they're looking for her right now.  
25 Hello?

JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Yeah.

1                   STEVE: Yeah, they're looking for her right  
2 now.

3                   JOHN DOLAN: Oh, good. Good. How's her  
4 finger doing?

5                   STEVE: Well, right now she just had it or  
6 was having it taken care of. But it's gone down.

7                   JOHN DOLAN: Good.

8                   STEVE: But she says she's got a lot of pain.  
9 I think the pain is becoming stronger now.

10                  JOHN DOLAN: Bad.

11                  STEVE: It's probably because the, you know,  
12 the finger's like twisted. It's, it's not -- it's  
13 definitely broke, and it's probably -- well, I don't  
14 know. It's, it's probably setting in a way it  
15 shouldn't or --

16                  JOHN DOLAN: Should not. Probably setting in  
17 a way it should not.

18                  STEVE: It's crooked, you know. It's --

19                  JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. It's going to be crooked.

20                  STEVE: -- it's definitely crooked so --

21                  JOHN DOLAN: So she's got to get that --  
22 hopefully there won't be any infection in it. But you  
23 know, you know, you and I both know that the heat is  
24 there is probably not that great, you know, so --

25                  STEVE: The heat. Oh, yeah. The lack of it  
you mean.

1 JOHN DOLAN: Lack of heat.

2 STEVE: Okay.

3 JOHN DOLAN: Some of the windows are out.

4 It's just not a good place for any children.

5 STEVE: In honesty?

6 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

7 STEVE: That thing, you know, that's one  
8 thing that does not bother these people.

9 JOHN DOLAN: Oh, okay. Okay.

10 STEVE: Just so you know. I mean --

11 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

12 STEVE: -- it would be nice. The only thing  
13 that would show, you know, like the electricity. They  
14 don't care being without it. Because you've got to  
15 remember, they chose to like me originally in '87 to go  
16 over to Palestine, Texas where all they had was  
17 lanterns, outdoor toilets, things of that nature.

18 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

19 STEVE: No running water. So that way you  
20 find out if people are really honest in searching for  
21 truth. Or are they coming to a place to live free and  
22 live off of someone else. So see, that's what that was  
23 all about. So number one, these people want eternal  
24 life. That's what it --

25 JOHN DOLAN: I, I appreciate that.

STEVE: -- always gets back to.

1           JOHN DOLAN: Well, if, you know, if someone  
2 comes out, we can always have Judy's finger looked at,  
3 attended to in the ambulance Bradley, and Judy can  
4 return to you. You know, that's, that's no problem at  
5 all.

6           STEVE: Okay.

7           JOHN DOLAN: Okay? So we can do that. And,  
8 and if we just -- I think that may go a long way in  
9 getting some momentum, plus it would serve, serve --

10          STEVE: I'll tell you the truth ahead of time  
11 from what she told me --

12          JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

13          STEVE: -- just a few days ago. She does not  
14 trust anybody now. She doesn't. She's, she gets, gets  
15 the feeling that if she'd go to the Bradley you might  
16 pull something like take her away.

17          JOHN DOLAN: No, no, no, no, no.

18          STEVE: But you know, but if that would  
19 happen I mean --

20          JOHN DOLAN: No. Didn't you --

21          STEVE: -- just let me say this. Because  
22 this is what David has that if that would happen, it  
23 would all be over with. There would no more --

24          JOHN DOLAN: Oh.

25          STEVE: -- I mean it would be all over with.

          JOHN DOLAN: Don't, don't you think we know

1 | that?

2 |           STEVE: I think -- I'm hoping you do.  
3 | Because I want to, I want to make sure that I can keep  
4 | on working that every aspect from every angle is  
5 | understood so we don't -- I don't want to pull anything  
6 | on you people. I really don't. And I expect the same.  
7 | So when you give --

8 |           JOHN DOLAN: How, how about this --

9 |           STEVE: -- me your word I want to keep on  
10 | seeing it followed through.

11 |           JOHN DOLAN: I do too.

12 |           STEVE: You know, it bothered a lot of people  
13 | though, and of course it's your, the nature of your  
14 | agency of course to do bugging. And --

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: All right, how about this? How  
16 | about this? Let's just get off that -- just we can go  
17 | back to that. But how about this while we're talking  
18 | about Mayanah. Mayanah and Judy come out. Judy gets  
19 | fixed up. Judy returns and then we, we take care of  
20 | Mayanah.

21 |           STEVE: It would never happen.

22 |           JOHN DOLAN: To grandmother.

23 |           STEVE: I'll let Judy answer for herself  
24 | but --

25 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

          STEVE: -- I just know Judy. And I know how

1 she is. But --

2 JOHN DOLAN: And then you and I talk.

3 STEVE: -- I'm not going to say -- she hasn't  
4 come to the room yet. So she doesn't hear me talking.

5 JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

6 STEVE: And when she does, I'll tell you what  
7 I'm going to do. I'm going to exit this room.

8 JOHN DOLAN: Because she's --

9 STEVE: So she can talk to you by herself  
10 with nobody here.

11 JOHN DOLAN: You don't think she would, she  
12 would want to go for that.

13 STEVE: I just, you know, 22 years I've been  
14 with her. It's a lot --

15 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

16 STEVE: -- of time. In fact actually it's  
17 been --

18 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

19 STEVE: -- closer to 23. But after all that  
20 time, I do know her. I know what she's about, you  
21 know. The love she has for Mayanah. I mean she would  
22 not want to let her go. Not unless it was so totally  
23 impairment that, you know, the child had no kind of  
24 chance whatsoever and --

25 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Yeah.

STEVE: So --

1                   JOHN DOLAN: Mayanah would go to Judy's mom.

2 You know that.

3                   STEVE: Yes.

4                   JOHN DOLAN: And you know, that's, that's  
5 guaranteed. You know, I mean if we couldn't do that  
6 then we can't do anything --

7                   STEVE: She actually -- I'll tell you the  
8 truth. She was ready to come out that Tuesday. Not  
9 maybe. It was -- everybody was. They was already set.  
10 It was in everybody's minds. It was over. It was  
11 done. They were coming out. We knew nothing else but  
12 that it was decided upon. Everybody chose to do that.  
13 They were coming out. All of it. It was done. It was  
14 already settled.

15                   So we were just as surprised when the  
16 turnabout of the situation as it was. But at the same  
17 time, it's, it's not something that's unusual because  
18 it's happened before.

19                   JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

20                   STEVE: But I mean there's still, you know,  
21 these people still they weight out the issues day by  
22 day. But you know, there's still always this thing to  
23 overcome, how they were attacked in the innocency --

24                   JOHN DOLAN: I know.

25                   STEVE: -- and in the privacy of their home  
and all that.

1           JOHN DOLAN: How do you -- just, just Steve,  
2 you know, you know Judy better than anybody else in  
3 this world.

4           STEVE: I do.

5           JOHN DOLAN: How would she feel about Mayanah  
6 being placed with, with Judy's mom? What's Judy's  
7 mom's name by the way? I hate to keep calling her  
8 Judy's mom.

9           STEVE: Well, I'll let Judy tell you, okay?  
10 Because I don't know --

11          JOHN DOLAN: Oh, okay. Or just a first name.

12          STEVE: -- I don't know what she wants to say  
13 about her or how or, you know --

14          JOHN DOLAN: Oh.

15          STEVE: -- she's close to her mother, so you  
16 know. I'll let you talk to her about it.

17          JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

18          STEVE: You can ask her anything you want.

19          JOHN DOLAN: All right. And I, I, you know,  
20 in all, in all honesty I'd like to see her, see her  
21 finger taken care of.

22          STEVE: Right.

23          JOHN DOLAN: Because you know, does it  
24 have -- besides the pain are we seeing anything more in  
25 the finger?

          STEVE: It seems like it's gone down to a

1 | small degree so I --

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. This --

3 |           STEVE: -- I hope that's a good sign.

4 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- this would be good for  
5 | everybody. This would be good for Judy and, and  
6 | Mayanah and everybody. And there would be bosses here.  
7 | It would be really kind of a momentum that we lost, you  
8 | know what I mean? I don't know how you feel. Tell me  
9 | how you feel.

10 |           STEVE: Well, I don't know really. Because I  
11 | mean the damage was so great from last Friday that  
12 | that's -- I, I just don't know that. I haven't -- it  
13 | seems like I haven't been able to get a handle on  
14 | anything for sure.

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: I know.

16 |           STEVE: You know, people are looking out the  
17 | window when I went out there and talked with Byron and  
18 | so forth. But at the same time, everybody reported to  
19 | me that two young men behind Byron and Jack Harwell and  
20 | the way they acted and so forth, the way that was --

21 |           JOHN DOLAN: They're a different, they're a  
22 | different type of person than you and I are. Let's  
23 | face it.

24 |           STEVE: Well, the FBI agents also. Do they  
25 | spend their days in that capacity, 365 days out of a  
   | year? Or are they guys that also wear suits and go

1 through other --

2 JOHN DOLAN: They have suits, and they have  
3 families and they have children also.

4 STEVE: Yeah, but I mean the way they were  
5 acting there and so forth. I mean, you know, they --

6 JOHN DOLAN: Well --

7 STEVE: -- they could see that. They watched  
8 it from a distance.

9 JOHN DOLAN: I'm sure they did. And I'm  
10 sure, I'm sure they felt the tension in the situation  
11 too --

12 STEVE: Well, yeah, and the fact, the way --  
13 I'll tell you the truth. When I got out there, I  
14 expected to see Jack as he was. That didn't surprise  
15 me. And Byron.

16 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

17 STEVE: I don't know what Byron was wearing  
18 around his --

19 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

20 STEVE: -- his middle and waist. But it  
21 was --

22 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

23 STEVE: -- it was sure I mean beside looked  
24 like a bulletproof jacket maybe or a double one --

25 JOHN DOLAN: I'm sure it was.

STEVE: -- or I don't know even what he all

1 | had on. But --

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: I'm sure --

3 |           STEVE: -- if you'd have looked at Wayne and  
4 | I, we had nothing just like we told you. We didn't  
5 | have any flack jackets, bulletproof jackets, nothing.

6 |           JOHN DOLAN: Sure. I know. You certainly --

7 |           STEVE: And, and when these guys are jumping  
8 | around, moving their guns toward us and, and the stare  
9 | and so forth. I mean it was the whole --

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: I know.

11 |           STEVE: -- you know, here they're out there  
12 | they say and with, with a good intent. And we're  
13 | looking at them. But how can you help but not look at  
14 | the guys behind so fidgety that they're about ready to  
15 | shoot Jack Harwell in the back by accident.

16 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Well, on the vest, you  
17 | know, I, I think Byron's just following regulations.  
18 | But look, you and I can show the others by, by the  
19 | example of what we do here today in the example of  
20 | getting Mayanah out, Mayanah cared for, Mayanah to her  
21 | grandmother --

22 |           STEVE: Now, now don't get your hopes up.

23 |           JOHN DOLAN: No --

24 |           STEVE: Because you haven't talked to Judy  
25 | yet. And --

          JOHN DOLAN: Okay, I'm just --

1                   STEVE:  -- I'm telling you ahead of time  
2 knowing Judy --

3                   JOHN DOLAN:  Knowing Judy, huh?

4                   STEVE:  You, you take, you can take any hits,  
5 or you can try anything on her.  You can say anything.  
6 I don't care.  I've not talking to her.  I haven't  
7 talked to her about going out, anything.  So you have a  
8 complete open opportunity with her.

9                   JOHN DOLAN:  Open field, huh?  Okay.

10                  STEVE:  Positively.  Positively.

11                  JOHN DOLAN:  All right.

12                  STEVE:  I can even help you out by saying  
13 this is the nicest guy I've talked to yet.  I like the  
14 guy.

15                  JOHN DOLAN:  I -- and --

16                  STEVE:  And you know, spent some time with  
17 him and --

18                  JOHN DOLAN:  I appreciate that, Steve.

19                  STEVE:  -- you can do what you want.

20                  JOHN DOLAN:  And I wouldn't be on this end if  
21 the feeling weren't mutual.  And, and the nice part of  
22 it is we're both trying to do the same thing.  That's,  
23 that's really the best part of it.

24                  STEVE:  Just for the future if it means  
25 anything from a guy that's on the inside my, the  
highest recommendations would go to your department in

1 | your behalf.

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Thank you, Steve.

3 |           STEVE: If anybody was to do any negotiations  
4 | in the future in anything closely like this, I would  
5 | tell them to let you be involved as much as possible.

6 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Look if there's --

7 |           STEVE: I hope they hear that because it's  
8 | the truth. Whatever happens to me coming in, out or  
9 | when I do if it's very soon which is always possible,  
10 | whatever else, I mean that is a statement I'd like to  
11 | make and --

12 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well, when that happens, Steve,  
13 | I'll tell you one thing. I'm, I'm going to -- I'll  
14 | want to meet you then too. And you know, regardless of  
15 | what we do before. But I will also meet you then.

16 |           STEVE: Okay. I'll --

17 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. And --

18 |           STEVE: -- but today if you want -- 3:10, the  
19 | reason I said 3 -- 10 minutes after 3 is because we're  
20 | done with the daily --

21 |           JOHN DOLAN: The daily, yeah.

22 |           STEVE: -- at 3 o'clock.

23 |           JOHN DOLAN: Look, and if there's any way  
24 | that, you know, someone will come out to stay with us,  
25 | you know, whether it be an adult or a child, you know,  
when you and I would meet that would be just so

1 | important to get this matter resolved.

2 |           STEVE: Meaning what you -- are you saying  
3 | you'd like me to maybe like bring who out or what --  
4 | how are you -- what are you --

5 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, anybody. Anybody. You  
6 | know, you're on the inside. You name it.

7 |           STEVE: I mean would you feel more  
8 | comfortable if I had somebody with me? Is that what  
9 | you're saying?

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: No, no, no. I mean somebody  
11 | who's going to stay permanently. Like Mayanah or --

12 |           STEVE: Oh, that would stay with you.

13 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Yeah. Yeah.

14 |           STEVE: Oh, wow.

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: I mean voluntarily.

16 |           STEVE: Here we go again.

17 |           JOHN DOLAN: Oh, here we go again.

18 |           STEVE: Oh, no.

19 |           JOHN DOLAN: Just --

20 |           STEVE: I was trying to pick up on what Byron  
21 | was saying yesterday about meeting face to face and  
22 | trying to do that, continue with that, drop off the  
23 | information but not by him but by yourself.

24 |           JOHN DOLAN: Oh, I see what you're saying.

25 | Okay.

          STEVE: And then maybe tomorrow, maybe

1 tomorrow. I mean you guys, I know you want this done  
2 so quickly. But that's what I'm trying to tell Byron  
3 even. Don't -- like David says --

4 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

5 STEVE: -- when you give these people time,  
6 that's why it came to the place --

7 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

8 STEVE: -- with you finally working in the --

9 JOHN DOLAN: Sure.

10 STEVE: -- manner it did that Friday.

11 JOHN DOLAN: I know.

12 STEVE: Seriously.

13 JOHN DOLAN: I know, seriously. I, I was  
14 there. You know.

15 STEVE: I tell you what. I wonder how this  
16 thing would have worked out if you'd have just  
17 continued on the phone right through the evening.  
18 These, these guys that were behind the scenes didn't  
19 get involved. You -- I swear you would have seen those  
20 so, such, so many people out by Sunday. It was, it was  
21 going to happen.

22 Then all of a sudden, David did get involved  
23 in that the electricity was cut off and all those other  
24 things, the Newsweek, the promises weren't kept. That  
25 was a big deal to him. He had a smile. I tell you, I  
don't care -- even though I brought those bugs to where

1 he was, I did purposely. You -- if you listen back we  
2 talked about this thing is bugged.

3 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

4 STEVE: We knew it. So we purposely sat it  
5 down. We didn't care if you listened.

6 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, yeah.

7 STEVE: So that's why we wanted to give you  
8 an opportunity to hear how it goes. And of course, you  
9 know, we exaggerated a lot of things purposely. And  
10 we, we had a little humor about it. But I mean overall  
11 the truth of the matter he was in good spirits about  
12 it.

13 And there were certain things that needed to  
14 be done because of the attitude of certain people here  
15 in regards to such a serious thing as to what took  
16 place. I mean this is, this is an extremely serious  
17 thing as you and I agree. And no one --

18 JOHN DOLAN: No.

19 STEVE: -- disagrees. But it was their, some  
20 people's reaction to that in the next few days it's  
21 things as a body you wouldn't understand. But it's  
22 things we don't do. We don't just go out and, you  
23 know, just go get drunk or abuse things like that. We  
24 want to be alert and to think about what has happened  
25 so they can make right decisions. And you know --

JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

1           STEVE: -- not influenced by alcohol or  
2 anything. So see, these things came into play. So  
3 that's why we, he told them seriously, you know, that  
4 they may have to go out whether they wanted to or not.

5           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

6           STEVE: Whether they wanted to or not.

7           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, yeah. Well --

8           STEVE: So that's what he was trying to say  
9 to Byron yesterday that, you know, we had -- or I think  
10 it was Byron he was talking to.

11           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum. Well, getting back to  
12 Rita. What's, what's her status with David? She's on,  
13 not under expulsion so to speak or --

14           STEVE: Just a minute. Someone just came in.

15           JOHN DOLAN: Okay, who's there?

16           STEVE: They're asking me a question. Just  
17 hang on.

18           JOHN DOLAN: Sure, go ahead.

19           (Steve speaking in background indiscernible.)

20           STEVE: Oh, by the way.

21           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

22           STEVE: Okay, it appears like -- a couple  
23 people reported to me that it appears like your men on  
24 the outside have dumped something in the lake.

25           JOHN DOLAN: Dumped something in the lake.

          STEVE: They don't know if it's liquid, if

1 | it's poison or whatever else.

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: I don't think it's poison. I've  
3 | got no idea. I can check and find what they're doing  
4 | in the lake.

5 |           STEVE: But if it's that, you know, they've  
6 | ruined this property for good. If --

7 |           JOHN DOLAN: Uh-huh.

8 |           STEVE: -- anybody were to come back to it --

9 |           JOHN DOLAN: I don't --

10 |           STEVE: -- the most valuable thing about this  
11 | property for miles around is it has it's own small,  
12 | little lakes on it.

13 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, Steve, I don't, I don't  
14 | really see how that would be possible to be honest --

15 |           STEVE: I --

16 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- with you. I'll check on it.

17 |           STEVE: If you -- yeah, check and let me  
18 | know --

19 |           JOHN DOLAN: Just give me a little -- do you  
20 | know the facts of how, what got dumped or where it was  
21 | or what?

22 |           STEVE: Someone just came and said that to  
23 | me. I'd have to get up and go ask who saw, who's been  
24 | watching. I'm sure a number of people have.

25 |           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

          STEVE: So of course it could be verified. I

1 | know that for sure your people would know, because  
2 | they're in contact with them.

3 |                 JOHN DOLAN: Sure.

4 |                 STEVE: No one does anything here without  
5 | their, without their knowing.

6 |                 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Okay. Was it --

7 |                 STEVE: It came from about --

8 |                 JOHN DOLAN: -- on the other side like over  
9 | by the Double E?

10 |                STEVE: Yeah.

11 |                JOHN DOLAN: Kind of over there.

12 |                STEVE: Exactly. It's the only place we have  
13 | them. You'll get to see that today. You can look  
14 | around when you come out here.

15 |                JOHN DOLAN: Okay. So basically --

16 |                STEVE: If you want to even, if you want you  
17 | can walk around with me or I'll point -- David would  
18 | actually like me to point out what they're doing around  
19 | here. So you can take a look for yourself so when we  
20 | negotiate with you in the future you can see what  
21 | they've done.

22 |                Take a look over by the side he's going to  
23 | say. Or go look over at that dump truck. Take a look  
24 | in the front. Look over at those five carcasses of  
25 | those dogs that were shot that Sunday. Take a look  
   | over at the lakes. Look how they've ripped up the, the

1 | grass and the -- I mean everything.

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

3 |           STEVE: Take a good look at it.

4 |           JOHN DOLAN: I'll definitely look at --

5 |           STEVE: And if you want tell Ricks let them  
6 | report on that tomorrow. Tell them how they've been  
7 | agitating and provoking these people instead -- on one  
8 | hand, they're smiling and want something cordial and  
9 | nice going. On the other hand -- the two don't work  
10 | together.

11 |           JOHN DOLAN: I see what you're saying.

12 |           STEVE: I mean look at psychology. Look at  
13 | the past dealing with people. If it's worked with  
14 | others, it's not working with these people. I can't  
15 | imagine why it would work with anybody else.

16 |           JOHN DOLAN: I see what you're saying. You  
17 | know, I --

18 |           STEVE: I mean if he wants to do one thing,  
19 | let him do it wholeheartedly. Let him rip up the  
20 | building, us included, or don't do it that way. Try  
21 | the other way. But give it a, give it a try like they  
22 | did Friday if we'd have continued. Well, anyway, we're  
23 | not going to beat it to death. But it's --

24 |           JOHN DOLAN: No, no, no. We --

25 |           STEVE: -- but it's the truth. And it, and  
it was working. So they should have considered that.

1 | You know, they would have been wise, Dec would have  
2 | been wise to have impressed upon them let's quickly  
3 | flip on the electricity as a measure of our, of our  
4 | good will to these people. Maybe we can quickly pick  
5 | up on what we just lost. And it looks like we're  
6 | losing it with them.

7 |           Dec should have picked up on that so hard and  
8 | quick Saturday. Three conversations I had with him  
9 | that day. I actually thought it was going to be  
10 | totally over with you and us. I really did.

11 |           JOHN DOLAN: No, I --

12 |           STEVE: When, when you finally got off the  
13 | phone and they put John-3 on and Mike, two new guys  
14 | that were coming on more hard with a different  
15 | attitude. It was like what now is the sense in even  
16 | talking? What is the sense --

17 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well, my, my feeling was that it  
18 | was, you know, you and I had great rapport. You know  
19 | what I mean? I really thought we, we --

20 |           STEVE: Well, I kept on asking for you.

21 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Uh-huh.

22 |           STEVE: I mentioned that so --

23 |           JOHN DOLAN: I know.

24 |           STEVE: They wanted to try something new  
25 | apparently. But I mean what can I do?

          JOHN DOLAN: Okay, let, let me understand

1 | what, what we're going to, what you want to, we want to  
2 | try to accomplish, and let me run that by the team  
3 | leader which is you met Byron. And then he's going to  
4 | run it up, up to, to you know, everybody.

5 |           Okay, basically you want to get what we have  
6 | which would be the copy of the search warrant, the  
7 | cover page on the search warrant.

8 |           STEVE: Um-hum.

9 |           JOHN DOLAN: And which shows a violation and  
10 | the address and all that. And you want that and what  
11 | else? And the, the --

12 |           STEVE: Well, you know, the tape that you  
13 | people mentioned.

14 |           JOHN DOLAN: The tape of the --

15 |           STEVE: I mean today Ricks acted --

16 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- of Dr. Arnold.

17 |           STEVE: -- today Ricks acted like it was no  
18 | big deal. He acted like nothing could be proved. It's  
19 | interpretive -- Ricks has no understanding of the  
20 | Bible, of spiritual things. Look at. Let -- here's  
21 | how it works. It says in Revelation that no one --

22 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay --

23 |           STEVE: Okay, let me just say it.

24 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. Okay.

25 |           STEVE: Because this is what it comes down  
to. And then you can react. But no one can look

1 | thereon. No one can open the seals but one. This guy  
2 | says let me serve you. Let me show you in your Bible  
3 | where the seals are located. He is telling you there's  
4 | no other human being on this earth that can show you.  
5 | And you're the judge.

6 |           Number one, let's get to the fifth seal.  
7 | Have a scholar at least give his opinion or theory then  
8 | or his feelings about it. Where are these things  
9 | located in the Bible? Then I'll look in my Bible to  
10 | see if there's something there, if there's some kind of  
11 | a connection. Do you understand how it works?

12 |           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum. Yeah, I started to  
13 | say --

14 |           STEVE: That's simple enough.

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

16 |           STEVE: We're not dealing in interpretation  
17 | and so forth. It either connects like a puzzle like  
18 | the Bible says or it doesn't. But it's one -- I -- all  
19 | day long I can theorize. So can Ricks. So can  
20 | theologians. Well, I think this and I think that and I  
21 | feel this and my opinion -- sure, we can do that all  
22 | day long.

23 |           But you start tying the Scripture together so  
24 | it's so plain and clear in its own context. I've not  
25 | seen scholars do that. I can give you the names of  
   | some of the best in the world. And I know and love

1 | these guys. I've spent a lot of time with them. I've  
2 | studied with them. These men don't have the ability  
3 | David has.

4 |           Why -- it has something to do with God says  
5 | in the book how he chooses who he wants in his time.  
6 | And it's usually contrary to what people expect as in  
7 | the days of Christ 2,000 years ago. The pharisees did  
8 | not have inspiration. These were learned men with  
9 | doctor degrees who were proud and arrogant as men are  
10 | today. And they didn't know God even though they  
11 | thought they knew the book. They had it memorized, but  
12 | they didn't understand its context. So that's what  
13 | we're talking about. So this guy Arnold or this guy  
14 | Taber, James Taber from --

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: University of North Carolina.

16 |           STEVE: Yeah. Exactly.

17 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

18 |           STEVE: You know, you get a dialogue going.  
19 | Let these people -- if you want them out, they're not  
20 | going to come out by running over vehicles outside or  
21 | being coerced or, or like what's-his-name said to me,  
22 | Byron yesterday, don't take this as a threat, but then  
23 | he gave a threat. You know what I mean?

24 |           JOHN DOLAN: (Laughing.)

25 |           STEVE: Don't take this as a threat but, you  
know, we're, they're planning on doing this and that to

1 | you. So --

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well --

3 |           STEVE: -- well, let them do it.

4 |           JOHN DOLAN: If Byron said that he's not,  
5 | didn't do it out of a threat. He did --

6 |           STEVE: I know he didn't. As --

7 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- it out of, out of concern,  
8 | you know?

9 |           STEVE: -- as a person I know that. And I --

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: You know that.

11 |           STEVE: -- I have -- I, I want Byron to know  
12 | that I like him. I respect him. He's probably done a  
13 | good job through the years. He's done it to the best  
14 | of his ability. I hold nothing against Byron.

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: He's --

16 |           STEVE: You know, he's not probably a  
17 | negotiator. But yet he does have a very good ability  
18 | to speak and express himself and the opinions and that  
19 | what needs to be done from his perspective and from the  
20 | Bureau's perspective. So that came across loud and  
21 | clear. I understood it. I saw it. I realize how  
22 | important it is to him too. How all of you want to get  
23 | this done, so he tried it his way. But these people,  
24 | it's a unique situation dealing with that book called  
25 | the Bible. And --

          JOHN DOLAN: I know.

1           STEVE: -- and as Ricks said, which is true.  
2 He said something that was very true today as he has  
3 before. These people are concerned for their eternal  
4 damnation or their eternal life. That's true. That's  
5 where, that's where it is involved in. That's the  
6 focal point in fact.

7           JOHN DOLAN: Okay, let me just understand so  
8 I can run it by. Because I've got to bring it up to  
9 the -- well, to Byron, to the bosses. So it's kind of  
10 a two or three step process. And if they, they call  
11 Washington, then it's a four step. But in any case  
12 that basically it would just be to drop off the items  
13 that we have for you, the tape --

14           STEVE: Do you have a People? I heard that  
15 he was on People magazine. If you can get one of  
16 those, that's fine too. I'm sure you must have one.

17           JOHN DOLAN: People, yeah.

18           STEVE: People, Newsweek, Time --

19           JOHN DOLAN: That's correct.

20           STEVE: -- drop those off. We've been  
21 really -- you know, you know what's happened with  
22 those -- those magazines actually mean nothing.  
23 Originally when it was me that raised it, someone heard  
24 it on the news. And they thought well, I wonder what  
25 they're saying about us. You know, it's a curiosity  
thing. David could care less.

1                   But then he is involved in the principle.  
2 Ricks acted like he -- what was his statement? Let's  
3 see. Where is it here? Where is it here?

4                   JOHN DOLAN: Well, I'm sure we could get  
5 something, something --

6                   STEVE: Let me take a look here.

7                   JOHN DOLAN: -- going if we can get something  
8 of a substantive exchange. But at least you know --

9                   STEVE: David believes so he, you can  
10 consider him to be some kind of a nut or whatever. But  
11 he believes that he will be heard irregardless of the  
12 press or the world.

13                   JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

14                   STEVE: And he will show you the chapters in  
15 the Bible that show how it's going to come about.

16                   JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

17                   STEVE: Contrary to what this world thinks.  
18 You know, man thinks they're in control of this world.  
19 We're so self-deceived when we're subject to death.  
20 Any one of us could die any day. We're expendable.

21                   JOHN DOLAN: Is that, is that the truth.

22                   STEVE: That is -- isn't that --

23                   JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

24                   STEVE: -- the truth?

25                   JOHN DOLAN: That's the truth, you know.

Hey --

1           STEVE: Okay.

2           JOHN DOLAN: -- just wait --

3           STEVE: But, but David more than anything  
4 realizes more than anybody there is a plan. But anyway  
5 let's -- okay, I won't get off on that --

6           JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Let me, let me check, run  
7 this up through Byron, run it up through the, the team  
8 leader.

9           STEVE: Okay.

10          JOHN DOLAN: Who is Byron --

11          STEVE: Those answers he obtained, if he's  
12 got them written out or on tape in regards to what  
13 Wayne Martin and I raised, those questions with him, if  
14 you could bring that or --

15          JOHN DOLAN: Let me, let me just see where we  
16 are. Okay, basically what, what, where we are right  
17 now is, is as follows is that basically you and I would  
18 meet approximately halfway between Double E and halfway  
19 between the compound.

20          STEVE: Exactly.

21          JOHN DOLAN: Okay. I would give to you the,  
22 the things that Byron had for you the other day.

23          STEVE: Right.

24          JOHN DOLAN: Then after a conversation and so  
25 on, you go back to your residence, and I go back to the  
vehicle. And --

1 STEVE: Right.

2 JOHN DOLAN: -- but nobody would come out.

3 STEVE: Right.

4 JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Let me just run it by  
5 them. And I just wanted to make sure that we had it  
6 clear. Is it --

7 STEVE: Okay. Do you want me to call you  
8 back or stay on the phone.

9 JOHN DOLAN: No, I, I going to have to --  
10 I'll have to run this through them and if -- I'll give  
11 you a buzz. Because I don't know how long I'll be in  
12 there.

13 STEVE: Okay. I'm at the, I'm at the phone  
14 where I pick it up and it just rings you automatically  
15 if you ever, if you know which one that is.

16 JOHN DOLAN: All right. Okay. That's  
17 Wayne's, Wayne's office phone.

18 STEVE: Yes.

19 JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Very good. Let me, let  
20 me give it to the team leader. Let me have them run it  
21 up and see what the bosses say.

22 STEVE: Okay, and if you have -- now look.  
23 Here's how -- this will work in your behalf for these  
24 people. If you have any other information dealing with  
25 the legal process written out on tape, suggestions. If  
you can bring more or you can give more answers --

1 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

2 STEVE: -- in talking to me I can tape that.  
3 Then I can take it back. These people can study it,  
4 listen to it. Think about it. That's what makes a  
5 difference. Don't push them. They might even make a  
6 decision overnight. But don't say come on out tonight  
7 and, or, or come out and then we'll give it -- it's not  
8 going to work. You might as well just run us over.

9 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

10 STEVE: That's as plain as I can tell you  
11 right now. But if you give them something to look at,  
12 it was the, the commanders that changed the perspective  
13 of things from Friday. Start doing some good things  
14 like were, what were being done there, or finish the  
15 promises that were given Friday and Friday night in  
16 regards to the Newsweek and that just as the principle  
17 of the thing.

18 JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum. I see what you're  
19 saying. I see what you --

20 STEVE: Okay.

21 JOHN DOLAN: -- I just wanted to make sure  
22 that I, that we --

23 STEVE: I need tools to work with. They were  
24 taken from me. I don't have anything anymore.

25 JOHN DOLAN: Okay, Steve. I see where you're  
at.

1           STEVE: Okay, I'll wait right here by the  
2 phone. So I'm going to be sitting right here. I'm not  
3 going to move.

4           JOHN DOLAN: I'll talk to you later.

5           STEVE: Okay, bye.

6           JOHN DOLAN: Okay, thanks. Bye.

7                           \* \* \*

8           (PHONE RINGING.)

9           UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: It works.

10          STEVE: Hello?

11          JOHN DOLAN: Hey, Steve?

12          STEVE: Hey, John. I can hardly hear you.

13          JOHN DOLAN: I can hardly -- let me make an  
14 adjustment here, yeah.

15          STEVE: There you go. There you go.

16          JOHN DOLAN: Okay. This electronic stuff.

17          STEVE: Okay.

18          JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Basically Byron ran it  
19 up, and then they ran it up, and they ran it east. And  
20 I'm surprised it got back so fast. Okay, basically  
21 what they would like to see is a substantive exchange.  
22 When I'm talking substantive exchange, they would like  
23 to see an adult or some children be exchanged for the  
24 meeting. Okay. So that's where the bosses are at.

25          STEVE: Okay. I thought that the meeting  
itself was one of those goodwill things again where we

1 | could --

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well --

3 |           STEVE: -- continue and move from there

4 | but --

5 |           JOHN DOLAN: I -- okay, but --

6 |           STEVE: Let me just --

7 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- that's what they've -- okay.

8 | Let me tell you what else they, they said. I said -- I

9 | told --

10 |           STEVE: Okay. Do you want me to react to

11 | that, or do you want to say more first?

12 |           JOHN DOLAN: I want to say more first.

13 |           STEVE: Okay, go ahead.

14 |           JOHN DOLAN: I told them that. I said hey,

15 | look. It's really important that we have this

16 | relationship. I want to, I want to continue this.

17 | It's something that we need that Steve and I have

18 | established that, that, you know, and what I used the

19 | terms that money can't buy.

20 |           So they said well, you know, that's the

21 | point. They said, they said well, what does he want?

22 | We went through the things, and they said okay. Let's

23 | at least take a half step. And the half step that they

24 | want to take is they want to drop off the legal

25 | documents, run those out there, the letters, the search

warrant and all that stuff.

1           STEVE: Okay.

2           JOHN DOLAN: Is that okay?

3           STEVE: Yeah.

4           JOHN DOLAN: So we're making -- call it a  
5 gesture. Whatever you want to call it. But I think  
6 it's at least a half step.

7           STEVE: Are we talking about also those  
8 magazines, or are they not being given?

9           JOHN DOLAN: They wouldn't want to go for  
10 those right now.

11          STEVE: Tell me -- now see you've got a lot  
12 of people -- so is there information in there that  
13 might be detrimental if we look at it, we have another  
14 view of how the world is seeing? I hear there was  
15 pictures that were taken of the place originally.

16          JOHN DOLAN: Well, there are -- yes. I, I  
17 read it --

18          STEVE: There's no question. There's got to  
19 be reasons like that. Because I can't -- it wouldn't  
20 make any sense to anybody why --

21          JOHN DOLAN: All right. Do you want me to  
22 tell, do you want me to tell you?

23          STEVE: Yeah.

24          JOHN DOLAN: The word is derogatory.

25          STEVE: Really. Okay.

          JOHN DOLAN: That's what -- yeah, I'm being

1 | honest. You know, I never --

2 |         STEVE: It's derogatory against us?

3 |         JOHN DOLAN: David.

4 |         STEVE: Oh, yeah. That's -- well, one  
5 | expects this. That doesn't hurt anybody or change  
6 | anybody's opinion. Honest -- I mean seriously.

7 |         JOHN DOLAN: I know. I know.

8 |         STEVE: When I've gone around the world even  
9 | myself challenging scholars and ministers and so forth,  
10 | I'll say to them let me ask you some questions.

11 |         JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

12 |         STEVE: If they can't answer the questions, I  
13 | say will you give me the time to show you something?  
14 | You will have lost nothing but a little time. So I'm  
15 | not offended by anything anybody says. That's between  
16 | them.

17 |         JOHN DOLAN: All right, let me --

18 |         STEVE: Words don't hurt people.

19 |         JOHN DOLAN: All right. I'll, I'll carry  
20 | that message back. But in the meantime, let's get  
21 | those legal documents out to you.

22 |         STEVE: I'm telling you it will -- it would  
23 | go much further if they -- because they were promised  
24 | by two Johns, yourself and Cox.

25 |         JOHN DOLAN: I'm fully aware of that. And  
I'm, I'm not, you know --

1 STEVE: (Laughing.)

2 JOHN DOLAN: -- I'm not changing that. And,  
3 and what I said I know.

4 STEVE: It, it -- all right. So you know --

5 JOHN DOLAN: Know what I said. I know. Hey,  
6 I know what I said. And --

7 STEVE: Okay.

8 JOHN DOLAN: -- I'm not, you know, I'm not --

9 STEVE: Okay. Yeah. I, I won't bring it up  
10 to you --

11 JOHN DOLAN: I will never -- Steve, I will  
12 never lie to you. And that's the bottom line on that.  
13 You can rest assured --

14 STEVE: Okay.

15 JOHN DOLAN: -- of that. But let's get this  
16 out there as a kind of a call it a gesture or a half-  
17 step --

18 STEVE: All right.

19 JOHN DOLAN: -- or whatever you want to call  
20 it.

21 STEVE: So they're not bothered about you and  
22 I meeting halfway out in the -- I don't want the  
23 Bradleys like before.

24 JOHN DOLAN: I understand what you're saying.  
25 You're concerned about the --

STEVE: And I guarantee my life to yours.

1 | You'll --

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Vice versa. That's not the --

3 |           STEVE: You're safe. You're okay. Believe  
4 | me.

5 |           JOHN DOLAN: Oh, you know, you know I know  
6 | that. And I --

7 |           STEVE: And I think we've more than shown  
8 | that from day one. I mean in -- I mean they, they  
9 | can't forget we're the ones, Wayne and I and everybody  
10 | here that wanted those wounded off to be able to be  
11 | taken care of.

12 |           JOHN DOLAN: I know that.

13 |           STEVE: Don't forget it.

14 |           JOHN DOLAN: I'm not. I'm not. I, I know  
15 | about it and I was --

16 |           STEVE: That's what blew me away the other  
17 | day when Wayne and I walked out there though. I mean  
18 | the way they were acting. We're not out to hurt or  
19 | take someone's life.

20 |           JOHN DOLAN: I'm sure of that.

21 |           STEVE: I mean it's still a person. I mean  
22 | everybody's got a probation until they're dead. You  
23 | can't do anything for anybody when they're dead.

24 |           JOHN DOLAN: You got that right.

25 |           STEVE: So I mean even like Byron, I don't  
care if it's the, the bosses over you, I don't have

1 anything against them personally.

2 JOHN DOLAN: I know that. And I, and I know  
3 that. And I know our relationship. And that's not a  
4 problem.

5 STEVE: Okay.

6 JOHN DOLAN: So let me, let me do this. What  
7 I'm going to do is I'm going to go in, tell them they  
8 can go ahead and do that. And I, I really hope this  
9 gesture will, you know, get a good response from David  
10 and --

11 STEVE: Judy had been here. She waited for  
12 about oh, 20 minutes or so or a half hour --

13 JOHN DOLAN: Okay. I'm --

14 STEVE: -- and then she just left here about  
15 10 minutes ago.

16 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, I'm sorry I missed her.

17 STEVE: Well, that's okay.

18 JOHN DOLAN: Tell her, tell her I hope she's,  
19 her finger if feeling better --

20 STEVE: Well, she, she had come down to talk  
21 to you of course and all.

22 JOHN DOLAN: I know. I know. Okay. Let's,  
23 let's get this done as a little half step.

24 STEVE: You want to call me right back then?

25 JOHN DOLAN: No, I'll just tell them to go  
ahead and do it.

1           STEVE: Okay.

2           JOHN DOLAN: So that you can watch for the  
3 delivery, the usual thing and take care of it. When  
4 you read those documents however you want to give us a  
5 buzz back or, or we'll give you a buzz back.

6           STEVE: Oh, so what you're going to do is  
7 just drop the stuff off?

8           JOHN DOLAN: The -- yeah. Um-hum. The legal  
9 documents.

10          STEVE: Okay.

11          JOHN DOLAN: As a good, as a goodwill gesture  
12 so to speak. Okay?

13          STEVE: Okay, so you're not going to meet  
14 with me then.

15          JOHN DOLAN: No. No. We'll set that up for  
16 another time when we get something substantive going.

17          STEVE: All right.

18          JOHN DOLAN: I will -- I want to do that.  
19 But basically the bosses say hey, we really need  
20 something in the form of a substantive at least --

21          STEVE: Well, tell me what, what they want to  
22 drop off again. It didn't sound like it was much  
23 because I was hoping --

24          JOHN DOLAN: Well, what --

25          STEVE: -- the more they give, the more these  
people have to base a decision on.

1 JOHN DOLAN: I know. What they're going  
2 to --

3 STEVE: And, and their goodwill.

4 JOHN DOLAN: Sure. What they're going to  
5 drop off right now is a little bit of stuff that, that  
6 I know David wanted to see was the search warrant.

7 STEVE: Okay, the warrant. What else?

8 JOHN DOLAN: Search warrants and the legal  
9 letters.

10 STEVE: What kind of legal letters? Do you  
11 mean like --

12 JOHN DOLAN: Attorneys. Attorney  
13 representing you and David and so on.

14 STEVE: You mean that --

15 JOHN DOLAN: Firearms, Firearms Act  
16 information about the Firearms Act, what's the  
17 provisions of the Firearms Act and so on.

18 STEVE: Okay.

19 JOHN DOLAN: Okay?

20 STEVE: Now remember, any information you  
21 have in regards to the involvement of the ATF as of  
22 even right now on through this thing, I want to know  
23 about that. I really do.

24 JOHN DOLAN: Well, what --

25 STEVE: I mean I forgot to tell you also, we  
were all bothered by what the man again had to say

1 | today, this ATF agent.

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Okay. Let me -- my  
3 | understanding is what's in the package is, is some  
4 | information regarding the Firearms Act. Okay? What  
5 | the Firearms Act is. In other words, what is referred  
6 | to in legal terms as the statute.

7 |           STEVE: Okay.

8 |           JOHN DOLAN: Secondly, the search warrant  
9 | information on the, on the cover sheet of the search  
10 | warrant and the law, the letters from attorneys who  
11 | represent your, will represent you and will represent  
12 | David --

13 |           STEVE: Well, you know, they read that to me  
14 | yesterday. So you can throw that --

15 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well, you --

16 |           STEVE: -- in. It don't matter.

17 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay. We'll throw it -- it's  
18 | good for your records. You know, you know you know  
19 | where to --

20 |           STEVE: It doesn't matter to me --

21 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well --

22 |           STEVE: -- in honesty. But you know, if you  
23 | want to throw that in, it's okay. I'd rather --

24 |           JOHN DOLAN: You know, it's -- I'll be  
25 | honest.

          STEVE: -- I'd rather see those magazines --

1 JOHN DOLAN: I appreciate that.

2 STEVE: -- because of what was stated Friday  
3 and since so --

4 JOHN DOLAN: I appreciate that. But it's  
5 something you need to have, you know what I mean?

6 STEVE: Okay. All right.

7 JOHN DOLAN: You need to have. And I want  
8 you to have it. I want you to have it.

9 STEVE: There was something -- what about  
10 that 12-minute tape from Dr. Arnold?

11 JOHN DOLAN: We'll work that out at another  
12 time. But, but that's --

13 STEVE: Really?

14 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. That's what they told me  
15 they wanted to deliver.

16 STEVE: You guys, they're really --

17 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

18 STEVE: -- it doesn't -- I'm telling you.  
19 Keep the thing then. It does not --

20 JOHN DOLAN: No, no, no.

21 STEVE: No, no, no. You tell --

22 JOHN DOLAN: No, no. Look, Steve --

23 STEVE: -- no, listen. No, wait, wait,  
24 wait --

25 JOHN DOLAN: -- it's a little, it's a half  
step.

1                   STEVE: -- no, no, no. No, no, no. No. Now  
2 wait now. I'm going to put down the phone. We won't  
3 even need to talk. Now you listen to me careful, John.  
4 I like you.

5                   JOHN DOLAN: I like you too.

6                   STEVE: But I'm telling you something that is  
7 a fact here now.

8                   JOHN DOLAN: Go ahead.

9                   STEVE: You tell them to bring that  
10 information, leave it all off. We will look at it or  
11 I'm -- look, they can do what they want to do. That's  
12 as plain as I can put it. If they want to run over  
13 more vehicles and the building with us in it, tell them  
14 to do it today.

15                   Or do show some goodwill again like should  
16 have been from Friday. Show information we can look  
17 at. Don't worry about the derogatory magazines. We  
18 want to see a principle here that was put into effect  
19 that we thought we had. If, if we look at it that,  
20 I'll tell you exactly what they think. It's not going  
21 to make any difference. It comes down to God. It  
22 comes down to their seeing the kind of goodwill you  
23 people have. I mean I'm telling you those guys damaged  
24 a relationship that has really been hard to recover  
25 from Friday.

                  JOHN DOLAN: All right, I'll tell -- somebody

1 | just --

2 |           STEVE: If they wanted to flip that  
3 | electricity back on when John Cox and I --

4 |           JOHN DOLAN: All right, this -- I've got,  
5 | I've got something here --

6 |           STEVE: Okay.

7 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- from the commanders. This is  
8 | directly that came in with this. Okay, you ready for  
9 | this?

10 |           STEVE: All right.

11 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay. They said send us out a  
12 | person. We'll send in all the magazines. Now that's,  
13 | that's pretty blunt.

14 |           STEVE: Tell them I'll see them when God has  
15 | sorted this whole thing out, okay?

16 |           JOHN DOLAN: Wait a minute. Wait --

17 |           STEVE: Tell them that.

18 |           JOHN DOLAN: Wait --

19 |           STEVE: When God has sorted this whole thing  
20 | out, we and I -- they, myself, we'll stand in the  
21 | judgment. I'll take what's coming to me. They are  
22 | going to have to do the same thing. All that they've  
23 | done in their lives just like me. I'm willing to do  
24 | that. I want to do it. I want -- I'm telling you the  
25 | truth.

          JOHN DOLAN: I know.

1           STEVE: I'm not going to play -- these people  
2 aren't here to play anymore games. Nobody's coming out  
3 until they see something. They told me that. I went  
4 around this building. I can ask them to single file  
5 line up by this telephone. I'll walk away. Wayne will  
6 be away. David's never nearby the phone when someone's  
7 on it. Never has been --

8           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

9           STEVE: -- unless it's brought to his room  
10 and someone comes to his room. You tell Ricks that,  
11 and tell him to get his facts straight. I don't know  
12 where he gets that kind of nonsense from. He made all  
13 sorts of crap and nonsense that he gave out to the  
14 press. That doesn't, that -- those are the kind of  
15 things that damage any kind of a relationship you and I  
16 are trying to establish.

17           So when we hear this man over on the airwaves  
18 like that and the statements he's making and his  
19 statements making David look all the more like a mad  
20 cult leader on the -- these people, they already, they  
21 get to hear the logic coming from the book. And if  
22 they think they're brainwashed, these people would even  
23 sit down -- send some psychologists out. They'll spend  
24 hours with you.

25           JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

          STEVE: Give them any kind of a test you want

1 to. Try them out.

2 JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

3 STEVE: These are people that have to make a  
4 decision every day of their life. And they have long  
5 before you people came on us.

6 Let me say this. The ATF prepared for 9  
7 months for this. David told me to tell you people he's  
8 prepared as these people here have since '85 for this.  
9 That's quite a statement. And he can give that out on  
10 the airwaves if you want.

11 JOHN DOLAN: That's pretty -- that's '85?

12 STEVE: Since 1985.

13 JOHN DOLAN: Steve, there's one other thing  
14 somebody's --

15 STEVE: Yeah, go ahead.

16 JOHN DOLAN: -- I didn't even know this was  
17 in there. But I think this is important. And what it  
18 is is a response from the United States Attorney's  
19 Office concerning the property. So I think that's  
20 something that probably the people in there would like  
21 to know.

22 STEVE: Sure.

23 JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

24 STEVE: It's going to be in writing? It's  
25 going to be dropped --

JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, it's going to --

1 STEVE: -- off also?

2 JOHN DOLAN: Yes, sir.

3 STEVE: Great. So you know --

4 JOHN DOLAN: So I think you need that --

5 STEVE: -- tell those commanders send all the  
6 information including the tape from Arnold, the  
7 Newsweek. We'll look at all the information. And I'll  
8 start --

9 JOHN DOLAN: Oh, okay.

10 STEVE: -- and I'll meet you tomorrow out  
11 front. They can have 20, 50, 100 snipers out there if  
12 they want. It doesn't matter to me. I'll meet with  
13 you. We'll talk about these things, and I'm going to  
14 be as frank and forthright as possible.

15 JOHN DOLAN: That's, that's what --

16 STEVE: And I'll even bring tapes out from  
17 people as to what they think of the information or what  
18 they think of you and, and if they want to come out.  
19 If you want to, bring a list of questions that you  
20 would like to have them answer. Or if you would like  
21 to know some things, I'll hand out even -- anything you  
22 want to do, I'm willing to do.

23 JOHN DOLAN: I know that, Steve --

24 STEVE: But first let's really get on the  
25 ball together right here with them giving --

JOHN DOLAN: That's what I'm saying.

1                   STEVE: That's what I'm saying too. But  
2 don't tell them to hold back with that information.  
3 That only compounds the thing and, and more time will  
4 go on. And they're going to have to do then finally  
5 what they don't want, what they're telling everybody  
6 they don't want to do. So let's --

7                   JOHN DOLAN: You mean on the delivery --

8                   STEVE: -- let's start doing it the way that  
9 will work. And that's really showing openness. Let's  
10 really disseminate some information back and forth.  
11 They're in a capacity and a position where they can do  
12 that. We can't. They've got access to libraries, to  
13 individuals empowered, to things we do not have. So  
14 people need to know things here. Let them know these  
15 things. It will show your goodwill all the way  
16 through.

17                  JOHN DOLAN: I --

18                  STEVE: If those commanders can understand  
19 that --

20                  JOHN DOLAN: All right, let me --

21                  STEVE: I've got a feeling we could really  
22 start doing something here.

23                  JOHN DOLAN: Okay, and I, I understand that.  
24 I'll bring that message back. In the meantime, let  
25 them drop off the legal documents. It's stuff that you  
need to know about --

1 STEVE: All right.

2 JOHN DOLAN: -- the firearms law.

3 STEVE: Tell them not to bug us so we don't  
4 have to go rip the whole --

5 JOHN DOLAN: It's, it's just going to --

6 STEVE: I wanted to actually give all those  
7 things back, you know. I, I mean I don't know who owns  
8 it, if you guys just purchase it through the taxpayers'  
9 money or if it's the thousand we sent with the  
10 children. I mean we sent enough money to pay for  
11 everything that -- and you guys, like let me say this  
12 too.

13 JOHN DOLAN: Don't --

14 STEVE: Bob Ricks keeps on saying how much  
15 you guys have given to us. A lot of what you've given  
16 to us we never asked for. You know, the videos, the  
17 pictures, all that kind of stuff. We don't really care  
18 about that. We believe these children are going to  
19 live forever. If you read, you yourself, if you're a  
20 parent and you read Isaiah 49, you do God's will. You  
21 accept the truth, walk in the light of truth, your  
22 children will live forever. That's a promise by God.  
23 You read those last verses of Chapter 49 of Isaiah.

24 JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

25 STEVE: And you'll see -- so that's how these  
people believe. So remember that when you're trying to

1 | play on their passions and on their feelings as parents  
2 | with their children and all that. It works everywhere  
3 | in the world. But I'm here to tell you that these  
4 | people want their children to live forever.

5 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay, how about if I do this?  
6 | How about this? How about if we just get the legal  
7 | documents which are up there out there. And then we'll  
8 | talk more about the other stuff. At least --

9 |           STEVE: What -- say what now? Do what?

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay. We'll have the Bradley  
11 | deliver the information from the U.S. Attorney, the  
12 | information on the Firearms Act, the information on the  
13 | search warrant, and the information on the seizure of  
14 | the property and have that up there. Okay?

15 |           STEVE: You already got to hear what I -- I'm  
16 | not going to even, I'm not going to -- right now, it's  
17 | me talking on the phone. If you want to talk to  
18 | someone else, I'm going to tell you what my decision  
19 | is.

20 |           JOHN DOLAN: Go ahead. Go ahead.

21 |           STEVE: Me as a person.

22 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, go ahead.

23 |           STEVE: I want them to drop off all the  
24 | things that were stated up until this point of time,  
25 | the Newsweek, the Time. If they got a People magazine,  
I'd like to see that. This is for me. And when it

1 | comes to that tape, I want to see the tape. I want to  
2 | see all these other things you just stated. Drop that  
3 | all off. I'll send up Greg to pick it up. He'll bring  
4 | it back. We'll start looking at it.

5 | I'll tell you how it usually works. David  
6 | usually likes to have the first opportunity to look at  
7 | these things. Or me or someone else, and then it's  
8 | passed everybody.

9 | JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

10 | STEVE: But you know, of course because they  
11 | believe that he can open up the Scriptures, you know,  
12 | there's some respect. Let's, let's be real about it.

13 | JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Okay. Okay.

14 | STEVE: So you tell them to do that --

15 | JOHN DOLAN: I'll, I'll --

16 | STEVE: -- and you call me. And if, if  
17 | they're not going to do it, no one is going to go up to  
18 | get those documents can sit there out in the rain or  
19 | the weather. It doesn't matter.

20 | JOHN DOLAN: I'll, I'll pass them along right  
21 | away.

22 | STEVE: Okay.

23 | JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

24 | STEVE: Call me back -- oh, Judy wants to  
25 | talk to you right now.

JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

1 STEVE: Judy, here.

2 JUDY: Hello?

3 JOHN DOLAN: Hi, Judy.

4 JUDY: Hi, how you doing?

5 JOHN DOLAN: How are you?

6 JUDY: Good.

7 JOHN DOLAN: That's more important. How's  
8 your finger?

9 JUDY: It's good.

10 JOHN DOLAN: Tell me about it.

11 JUDY: Yeah, it's getting better. The  
12 swelling's gone down and it's healing up and --

13 JOHN DOLAN: Great, great, great.

14 JUDY: Yeah.

15 JOHN DOLAN: We were very concerned for a  
16 while.

17 JUDY: Thanks.

18 JOHN DOLAN: Very concerned. I saw it on the  
19 video and it looked pretty --

20 JUDY: Yeah. It was pretty scary, huh?

21 JOHN DOLAN: Pretty scary.

22 JUDY: Yeah.

23 JOHN DOLAN: Well, I tell you, I was  
24 concerned. When we looked at it and the doctor looked  
25 at it, the doctor said there's some really bone --

JUDY: They told me I was going to die.

1 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah. (Laughing.)

2 JUDY: (Laughing.) I was sad, because I  
3 didn't want to go before everybody else went here.

4 JOHN DOLAN: Well, you know, if they say, if  
5 they say you don't have a problem and they do, and you  
6 do, they'd rather err on the side of, of the problem.  
7 Because --

8 JUDY: Yeah, I know.

9 JOHN DOLAN: -- you can understand what  
10 happens as far as not --

11 JUDY: I wish I had some antibiotic cream or  
12 something to put on it or --

13 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah, well I think, you know,  
14 probably what, what would be a good idea too is maybe  
15 getting some treatment of that finger. You know what I  
16 mean?

17 JUDY: Yeah. Well, when, you know, when  
18 everybody comes out I'll definitely probably have to  
19 get it re-broke.

20 JOHN DOLAN: I would like to -- well, yeah.  
21 I'd like to get you --

22 JUDY: Sounds funny.

23 JOHN DOLAN: -- I'd like to get you to  
24 medical, some medical treatment. But how do you feel  
25 about that?

JUDY: Well, I'm waiting on God right now. I

1 | want to stay here with everybody else.

2 |           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum. Well --

3 |           JUDY: Because -- yeah, that's what I  
4 | believe. It's my religion, you know?

5 |           JOHN DOLAN: Um-hum.

6 |           JUDY: Freedom of religion.

7 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

8 |           JUDY: Remember that country that believes in  
9 | that? (Laughing.)

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: Hey, that's, that's number one.  
11 | That's not going to change whether --

12 |           JUDY: Okay.

13 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- you know, that's not going to  
14 | change whether any day of the week or whether you and I  
15 | talk or you and I, Steve talk.

16 |           JUDY: Yeah.

17 |           JOHN DOLAN: There's nothing going to change  
18 | that, you know?

19 |           JUDY: Yeah.

20 |           JOHN DOLAN: There's nothing ever going to  
21 | change that. That's the one of the --

22 |           JUDY: Free country, right?

23 |           JOHN DOLAN: You bet you.

24 |           JUDY: Free for you guys to come and run over  
25 | our stuff.

          JOHN DOLAN: No, no, no. We -- it's not us.

1 | That's --

2 | JUDY: Who's doing that?

3 | JOHN DOLAN: -- I don't do that. I don't --

4 | JUDY: Who's doing that?

5 | JOHN DOLAN: -- I'm not out there, you know?

6 | JUDY: No, I mean who's running over our  
7 | stuff? I thought that was you guys.

8 | JOHN DOLAN: Oh, they -- well, they're not  
9 | tank drivers, you know what I mean? They're not too  
10 | skilled in, in tank driving, you know --

11 | JUDY: No, they, they are skilled. They're,  
12 | they're going over all our things on purpose.

13 | JOHN DOLAN: Steve, Steve mentioned that  
14 | there was some. But there were --

15 | JUDY: But he doesn't care. I mean I don't  
16 | really care. It's just, you know, I'm just saying --

17 | JOHN DOLAN: Okay. How -- let me -- how's  
18 | Mayanah doing?

19 | JUDY: She's good.

20 | JOHN DOLAN: Okay. She's good.

21 | JUDY: Oh, I guess -- never mind. I  
22 | shouldn't say anything about it.

23 | JOHN DOLAN: No. No, she's good. That's  
24 | good. I'm glad she's good.

25 | JUDY: Yeah, she's fine.

JOHN DOLAN: Oh, that's wonderful.

1 JUDY: Yeah.

2 JOHN DOLAN: That's -- you, you -- how do you  
3 feel about her coming out and being taken care of by  
4 her grandmother?

5 JUDY: How do I feel about that?

6 JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

7 JUDY: Which grandmother?

8 JOHN DOLAN: Your mother.

9 JUDY: Why, did she call you?

10 JOHN DOLAN: No -- oh, I'm sure she called.  
11 I don't know of any particular message. But I'm sure  
12 she's called in.

13 JUDY: Oh, really? Well, I didn't hear that  
14 she called.

15 JOHN DOLAN: Oh, okay. I don't have a  
16 specific message, but I'll check through the file. As  
17 you can imagine, it's getting a little bit thick here.

18 JUDY: Yeah, why don't you look and see. I  
19 would be --

20 JOHN DOLAN: Okay. How do you feel about  
21 though? I mean how would you feel about that?

22 JUDY: Well, if that's what had to be, that  
23 would be great.

24 JOHN DOLAN: All right? You think we could  
25 work that out?

JUDY: Well, I mean when the time is right,

1 | yeah. But I mean she's staying with me until --

2 | JOHN DOLAN: What's the time is right?

3 | JUDY: I mean I don't know. I, I want to  
4 | wait, wait on God. I want her with me.

12 |          JOHN DOLAN: Hold on. I'm writing it down.

13 | Keep going.

14 |          JUDY: That's good enough.

15 |          JOHN DOLAN: That will do it?

17 | already got that don't worry, God's in control.

18 something I wanted, wanted to pass by you, you know.

19 JUDY: Nobody I know anyway.

20 JOHN DOLAN: Okay. Well, it was nice talking  
21 to you. Tell Steve that they're going to make a run,  
22 and the documents will be there soon.

23 JUDY: They're going to send the magazines  
24 up?

25 JOHN DOLAN: I just -- the commander passed  
me a note through the team leader. It says the

1 | documents will be there soon so --

2 |           JUDY: The documents.

3 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yeah.

4 |           JUDY: He knows what that -- I'll let you  
5 | talk to him, okay?

6 |           JOHN DOLAN: Well, that's okay. I got to run  
7 | and see the boss. Now he's got something else he's  
8 | got, got me doing so --

9 |           JUDY: Oh.

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: -- I'll talk to you later on.

11 |           JUDY: So should he expect the magazines and  
12 | all that or what?

13 |           JOHN DOLAN: The message, the message, you --

14 |           JUDY: Yeah, hold on. Steve wants to talk to  
15 | you a second. I know you got to run but here he is.

16 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

17 |           STEVE: John?

18 |           JOHN DOLAN: Yes, sir.

19 |           STEVE: So now what am I -- have they come  
20 | around, or am I not going to bother or what? You tell  
21 | me ahead of time.

22 |           JOHN DOLAN: I don't know the answer to that.  
23 | Let me --

24 |           STEVE: Well, you, you tell me on the --  
25 | okay, you call me back --

          JOHN DOLAN: I -- okay. I told them what you

1 wanted. And, and the boss said we'll decide. We.  
2 We'll.

3 STEVE: Oh, they will? Okay.

4 JOHN DOLAN: We'll -- no, we'll decide. In  
5 other words not me.

6 STEVE: Okay, either it's going to be one way  
7 or none. You tell them that. And nobody's even going  
8 to go out there. They can go set anything they'd like  
9 out there.

10 JOHN DOLAN: I'll --

11 STEVE: I'll -- you pass on to them --

12 JOHN DOLAN: I'll pass it on.

13 STEVE: -- David is mad. And if they want to  
14 make him madder, go ahead. But they've already,  
15 they've damaged that dump truck. Tell them to do some  
16 more. They went -- and did you find out -- you tell me  
17 now what they poured in those lakes.

18 JOHN DOLAN: I'm going to --

19 STEVE: What did they pump in those lakes?  
20 Ask them right now. I'm waiting for you.

21 JOHN DOLAN: I, I can't answer that as we're  
22 on the phone, because it's going to take a little bit  
23 of time for communication. But as far --

24 STEVE: Okay, call me -- I'm -- I tell you  
25 what. Call me back in 10 minutes. Go talk to them  
about either they're going to drop off all those things

1 | that I've mentioned or they're not. And then also find  
2 | out about the, the, if they've poisoned those lakes.

3 |           JOHN DOLAN: I'll talk to you later.

4 |           STEVE: Okay.

5 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay, thanks Steve.

6 |           STEVE: I'll wait for about 10 minutes, and  
7 | otherwise I'm out of here.

8 |           JOHN DOLAN: Okay.

9 |           STEVE: Okay. Bye.

10 |           JOHN DOLAN: Bye-bye.

4 | there aren't, aren't accomplished tankers. And I think  
5 | that --

6 |           STEVE: I, I remember seeing the two guys  
7 | that were behind Jack Harwell and Byron the other day.  
8 | I remember their faces and, and what, what they wanted  
9 | me to see, their, their reaction to us. And I can  
10 | picture those kind of guys accidentally running -- and  
11 | by the way, it was done more than once. It really was.

12 |           So whether accomplished or not, I learned how  
13 | to operate a bulldozer in a day personally. And if  
14 | these -- and that's when I was about 18, 19. And these  
15 | guys are how old? And of course, they're chosen and,  
16 | and picked from the top of their class and all the  
17 | rest. It's hard for me to imagine that they can't  
18 | handle one of those things.

19 |           JOHN-3: Yeah. I -- well, I, I just don't  
20 | know the particulars on it, Steve. And like I say,  
21 | they checked on it, and they said that they weren't,  
22 | weren't out there. They weren't dumping anything in  
23 | the, in the lake is the word I got.

24 |           STEVE: Well, tell me -- see, I'm going to be  
25 | walking away from the phone here. Is John going to get  
back to me? Tell me when so I can get back to the

1 phone. Tell him to call me on the other phone if he  
2 calls me, not on this number.

3 JOHN-3: You mean the one -- I don't  
4 understand what you're saying, Steve.

5 STEVE: Well, you know, we've got a couple  
6 phones here. And I'm going to be at the other portion  
7 of the building. The phone I just picked up is the  
8 phone where of course it rings naturally just by  
9 picking it up. It's where Wayne is a lot of times.

10 JOHN-3: Yeah, but why was he going to call  
11 you? I, I don't understand.

12 STEVE: He was going to call me back in 10  
13 minutes to tell me if we, if you were going to drop off  
14 all those items or not. That's all.

15 JOHN-3: Yeah --

16 STEVE: If you weren't going to do it, I'm  
17 not going to worry about it. I'll go do something  
18 else.

19 JOHN-3: Yeah. What was there is, is my  
20 understanding is the legal documents that you had  
21 requested the other day that Byron was going to run  
22 around and get for you.

23 STEVE: One, one aspect of what we requested,  
24 yes.

25 JOHN-3: That's what they said that they  
would drop off. Because you had requested them --

1           STEVE: I've requested many things, John. So  
2 you, you're telling me the one --

3           JOHN-3: Well, we're giving you this.

4           STEVE: -- the one-tenth of what I requested  
5 they, they said they'd drop off. Is that right?

6           JOHN-3: No, I don't think it's one-tenth,  
7 Steve. Because you requested and Wayne did requested  
8 those legal documents. And you said that they were  
9 important --

10          STEVE: Yeah, amongst other things is right.

11          JOHN-3: Right?

12          STEVE: That's -- amongst many things that  
13 would help people make decisions.

14          JOHN-3: Well, we've got them now. And  
15 they're out there. And you know, you said that you  
16 wanted them --

17          STEVE: What do you mean, what do you mean  
18 they're out there?

19          JOHN-3: They're going to be delivered.

20          STEVE: So are you telling me then they're  
21 not going to deliver the other things?

22          JOHN-3: I'm telling you that the legal  
23 documents are going to be out there.

24          STEVE: Boy, I tell you what. It's like,  
25 it's like pulling teeth with someone like yourself,  
John.

1 JOHN-3: Steve --

2 STEVE: I'm, I'm asking you a very straight,  
3 plain question. And you're saying they're, the  
4 documents are going to be there. So you're trying to  
5 tell me in, in another way that nothing else will be  
6 then. Is that what you're saying to me?

7 JOHN-3: I'm telling you that the legal  
8 documents are going to be out there, Steve.

9 STEVE: And what about the Newsweeks, the,  
10 the tape --

11 JOHN-3: No, they're not going to be in  
12 there.

13 STEVE: Okay, well then let me tell you you  
14 can save some time. You can drop it off at the gate,  
15 the tree, anywhere you like, and that's where they're  
16 going to remain.

17 JOHN-3: Didn't Wayne and David want them  
18 though?

19 STEVE: They wanted all that I listed to John  
20 Dolan of which you heard over, at the conversation on  
21 the speaker phone on tape. Go back, listen to the  
22 tape. Otherwise, that is going to sit out there.

23 Give something holistically that these people  
24 can look at if you want to reach them. Try many  
25 angles. Try the spiritual aspect. Try all of it. But  
why -- I mean keep on doing this. Prolong it then. Or

1 | like I told John what David said and these people  
2 | concur. Can I make it plain? You can come in and run  
3 | them over, blow them up, do what you want with them.  
4 | Honestly.

5 |           JOHN-3: Nobody wants to do that.

6 |           STEVE: They believe they're going to stand  
7 | in judgment before a great authority. Just like the  
8 | judges of this world that is nothing compared to the  
9 | one that has kept a record of you and me since birth.  
10 | Now that's what they believe.

11 |           So you guys, if you don't want to try to help  
12 | these people to understand and -- because they sat here  
13 | in innocence that Sunday, John. You come out of your  
14 | home, and you go into prison, and you go through the  
15 | system. You show me how it works first. You give them  
16 | an example of that. We'll watch. But these people sat  
17 | here totally innocent studying their Bibles. They had  
18 | come from all over. Now you want to hurl them into a  
19 | system and you come on out. Come out and do it. Why  
20 | when you went against their rights as American  
21 | citizens.

22 |           So you know, keep that in mind. It's not an  
23 | easy thing for me to deal with when I'm talking to them  
24 | day by day. That's the realism of it all. So help me  
25 | to show them some substance and show them something  
   | they can look at to read and so forth, to look at, at

1 the picture from different angles. Do you understand  
2 what I'm asking?

3 Give me some tools to work with, just like I  
4 had a week ago Wednesday, Thursday, Friday when Dolan  
5 and I were doing so well. And it would have turned out  
6 so much better. And now you keep on saying you don't  
7 want to hear about it, but you've done a lot of damage  
8 to that relationship. Then when you came on the phone,  
9 you and Mike, with a different kind of an attitude.

10 When I was on the phone all day long that  
11 Saturday with Dec, I was really hoping you guys would  
12 still show goodwill, turn the electricity back on, and  
13 let's pick up. No, it didn't happen. So from there  
14 it's deteriorated. You may have to be where you guys  
15 have to do what you got to do anyway.

16 JOHN-3: Steve --

17 STEVE: But I'm telling you the only way I  
18 can see after these people have come to me all day and  
19 yesterday. I've gone to them individually. I've  
20 talked to them. Do you want to talk to John Cox? Do  
21 you want to talk to these guys? Do you want to share?  
22 Do you want to go out?

23 And then I hear Ricks on the radio today  
24 making all those statements about how David controls.  
25 That guy's been in bed laying with the door closed,  
doesn't even want to be bothered by anyone. The phone

1 is not even near him. It's got a long cord. Once in a  
2 great while I'll try to get him to talk to somebody in  
3 his sickness. He's bleeding bad because he came down  
4 to where I was yesterday.

5 Ricks -- I even told these people that like  
6 Byron that that happened to him. Oh, no, but he used  
7 the excuse he had to go to the bathroom and never came  
8 back. Well, number one, when Byron didn't listen to  
9 what he was saying but rattled on for hours about  
10 everybody coming out, let's be real. He knew it wasn't  
11 going to happen in the first place. Let's be real.

12 And I told him that yesterday. I said drop  
13 off those items that were promised last Friday when the  
14 negotiations started souring. Keep your word from  
15 then. Let's keep on going from then. Let them look at  
16 something, see something. Let's see that you really  
17 are real. Unless you want this to go a long, a long  
18 time yet.

19 JOHN-3: Steve, can I --

20 STEVE: Or end it today by doing some extreme  
21 measure.

22 JOHN-3: Can I talk for a second, Steve?

23 STEVE: Yeah. Now you can. I am glad  
24 you've, you let me speak. Now I'll let you speak as  
25 long as you want.

JOHN-3: Okay. Steve, I think we had a

1 | misunderstanding between the two of us. And I, I don't  
2 | know what gave you that impression. I haven't lied to  
3 | you. I haven't promised you anything that I haven't  
4 | given you personally I'm talking. Okay? And you know,  
5 | I'm here because I want to help. You know, if I were a  
6 | jerk or the biggest jerk yet, you know, I wouldn't be  
7 | here. I'd be home. Do you understand that?

8 |           STEVE: I do.

9 |           JOHN-3: Okay.

10 |           STEVE: No, I see --

11 |           JOHN-3: So I just want to clear that up.

12 |           STEVE: Okay, I have nothing against you.

13 | But maybe they had a new way of approaching us or  
14 | something. But it seemed like you and John 3 -- or I  
15 | mean this is John 3. You and I believe it was Mike  
16 | came on a little bit differently than John Dolan and  
17 | Cox the way we had that going Wednesday, Thursday,  
18 | Friday. There seemed to be a little bit different  
19 | spirit in the air.

20 |           And it's not to take anything away from  
21 | yourself as a person. I don't know you. I've not  
22 | spent much time with you. But of course, there's been  
23 | a stronger push and as -- when people on your side are  
24 | pushing all the harder without backing up to give the  
25 | things that they have already promised it's, it's near  
an impossibility for me to do anything at all. I don't

1 understand why they can't see that. I really don't  
2 understand why they, they're lacking insight.

3 JOHN-3: Steve, have I pushed you?

4 STEVE: Someone's -- right now they're  
5 talking on the loudspeaker. I only can hear -- let me  
6 put the phone down so I can hear what's being -- is  
7 that Byron again? Just a minute.

8 JOHN-3: I'm not sure. It probably is. I  
9 would imagine it is.

10 STEVE: Yeah, I guess -- apparently -- is  
11 that a tape from Byron from yesterday?

12 JOHN-3: I think it is, yes, you know --

13 STEVE: So they're going to play that  
14 morning, noon and night now?

15 JOHN-3: I'm not sure. I have no idea.

16 STEVE: Yeah, you know. Tell me the -- are  
17 they going to -- what do you think? Have they -- what  
18 are they going to do? Tell me ahead of time so I can  
19 see you're telling me the truth.

20 JOHN-3: Steve, I am the go-fer here, all  
21 right? I'm the middle man. You're the middle man  
22 there. I don't make the decisions. You know that. I  
23 just wanted to assure you --

24 STEVE: Who does? Can you -- hey. Can you  
25 give me some names of who's making some decisions?

JOHN-3: We --

1                   STEVE: And why wouldn't you? Tell me.  
2 Who's making some -- give me some names of people  
3 making decisions.

4                   JOHN-3: Well, I'll tell you --

5                   STEVE: Well, you and I know that's -- okay,  
6 I've got a name Sessions. He's the director of course.  
7 Then I've got all these levels that are bypassed. Then  
8 we pick up at your level and somewhat maybe below that.  
9 Why are certain ones -- why can't their names be given?  
10 Is it because they don't want to associate their name  
11 with bringing tanks against American citizens, against  
12 pregnant women, against babies and children? Is that  
13 why? They don't want to have their name associated  
14 with that? Is that it? Tell me.

15                   JOHN-3: You've heard Bob Ricks and --

16                   STEVE: I've heard Bob Ricks. Does he want  
17 to get on the phone with me?

18                   JOHN-3: No.

19                   STEVE: Why not?

20                   JOHN-3: Because I've been assigned to, to  
21 sit down and talk to you. That's --

22                   STEVE: Assigned by who?

23                   JOHN-3: By --

24                   STEVE: Who's in control here?

25                   JOHN-3: By the bosses here.

                  STEVE: What, what bosses?

1 JOHN-3: There's several of them, Steve.

2 Just --

3 STEVE: Give -- from where? Where are they  
4 from? Are they from Washington, D.C.? Are they from  
5 districts or what? Tell me --

6 JOHN-3: Yeah.

7 STEVE: -- something about the bosses.

8 JOHN-3: What would be different talking to  
9 them than, than to me?

10 STEVE: Well, I don't know. Tell me  
11 something about them. Because they have the control.  
12 And a lot of times what you people are saying and, and  
13 working out with me have no substance. It's why am I  
14 talking to you for, John? Why don't I talk with,  
15 directly with the men that they're making the  
16 decisions?

17 JOHN-3: Steve, that's, that's my, my job,  
18 you know. It's what I've been told to do.

19 STEVE: This is like a broken record. It's  
20 like we're lacking communication and understanding  
21 here. Give me a -- that's your job. That's not a good  
22 reason.

23 JOHN-3: Right now --

24 STEVE: You want me to give an analogy to  
25 that and you -- of course you know what I'm asking and  
what I'm saying. Why, why should I insult you to even

1 | give you an illustration or an analogy.

2 |           JOHN-3: Steve, I just wanted to assure you  
3 | that I wouldn't be here unless I wanted to be here and  
4 | help you.

5 |           STEVE: I don't doubt that. I don't --

6 |           JOHN-3: Okay?

7 |           STEVE: -- doubt that you're the most sincere  
8 | person on the face of the earth. But how does that  
9 | help this situation right now?

10 |           JOHN-3: And all of the people that you've  
11 | talked to here are the same.

12 |           STEVE: Tell me something about the bosses so  
13 | I can -- I'm trying to look at it from another angle  
14 | myself. Because right now I feel like I'm stuck.  
15 | Because you people have not -- if Ricks says suppress,  
16 | you guys have done so much for us. You've done this.  
17 | You've done that. You've done -- we're saying that's a  
18 | lie.

19 |           I'll go right down a list with you. And you  
20 | can tell me what you think about it. I'll go right  
21 | down a list of things he stated today, and you tell me  
22 | the truth about these issues.

23 |           JOHN-3: Steve, I can tell you one thing,  
24 | that you the other day and Wayne had requested some  
25 | answers. You were upset that the warrants were sealed.  
You were upset that the hearings were closed. All of

1 | that information. You were concerned about the seizure  
2 | of the property. All of those things. And --

3 |           STEVE: Just about the --

4 |           JOHN-3: -- what I'm telling you is that  
5 | those items are out there. And now you say you don't  
6 | want them. So --

7 |           STEVE: No, because --

8 |           JOHN-3: Every time --

9 |           STEVE: -- no, because you keep on wanting to  
10 | forget Friday when certain things were promised. You  
11 | have not come around. You have lied about that. You  
12 | have broken the promises. And you want to forget that.  
13 | But I'm not going to allow that. They're not going to  
14 | allow you to do that.

15 |           You can talk all day long about one, couple  
16 | questions that we raised. You are the people that  
17 | asked us to come out there and meet with you. Don't  
18 | act like that's some big deal that we wanted. We're  
19 | trying to work this out with you. And when you asked  
20 | us to do that, and we came out unarmed, there were guys  
21 | fidgeting right behind us looking at us, you know,  
22 | moving around with their guns in total, complete  
23 | bulletproof coverings and all the rest. I mean come on  
24 | now.

25 |           So now from that point of time -- and I would  
like to hear some of these other things stated on the

1 | airwaves that have been taking place. He leaves so  
2 | much off when he, when he speaks to the press. Now why  
3 | is that I wonder? It's such a one-sided thing. Let  
4 | them know that I'm trying to initiate something here  
5 | also. All day long I'm asking drop off all this  
6 | information. Let the, let the people know this. So  
7 | that the people inside can look this over. Okay, what  
8 | are you saying to your, to your comrade?

9 |           JOHN-3: I'm saying that you can come out,  
10 | Steve. You can come out. You know that Kathy had  
11 | access to the media, has access to the media. You know  
12 | that Ollie does. And if that is your concern --

13 |           STEVE: It is not my concern. If I wanted  
14 | media --

15 |           JOHN-3: Well, what is your concern?

16 |           STEVE: -- if I wanted media 5 weeks ago, 2  
17 | years ago, don't you think that I would have tried to  
18 | gain financial means to get on the press or on the  
19 | airwaves myself, by time and so forth? That's not the  
20 | big deal. If I believe in the Bible, God's got a way  
21 | to disseminate information that's so beyond my human  
22 | ways.

23 |           And in fact throughout the history of man  
24 | it's always been contrary to man's planning and  
25 | devising. I mean that's, it's the most common thing  
you can see in through the threads of Scripture when

1 | you read it. And I already know how God's going to  
2 | work.

3 |           But I'm more concerned about your soul, men  
4 | that don't really believe in the same God I do, the God  
5 | of that book, and how he's going to fulfill every word  
6 | that he has said as stated in Acts 3, Matthew chapter  
7 | 5. Every word. But I know you don't believe that.  
8 | But the day is come upon the world like in the days of  
9 | Noah where only eight people were saved.

10 |           I know there's a lot of cults out there and,  
11 | and it's a stumbling block for you to even listen to a  
12 | person like myself. But I'm concerned for you as a  
13 | soul, as an individual.

14 |           JOHN-3: Steve --

15 |           STEVE: I really am. But getting -- I know,  
16 | getting back to this, let's drop off those things that  
17 | were promised from Friday. We talked 2 nights ago  
18 | about --

19 |           JOHN-3: Steve, who promised those to you?

20 |           STEVE: -- wait, wait. Now let me finish.  
21 | Let me finish. About Dr. Arnold. And I've been told  
22 | over and over again you've got a 12-minute tape. So  
23 | let us hear it. Let us hear it.

24 |           JOHN-3: We have it. We have it.

25 |           STEVE: Okay, so drop it off. Drop it --

          JOHN-3: Why don't you show us something?

1           STEVE: -- off with those documents, and drop  
2 off the, the magazines. And let's see your goodwill,  
3 good faith. Otherwise I have nothing to work with.  
4 I'm going to tell you that.

5           And when it comes to that warrant, David is  
6 not concerned. He's concerned when you're running over  
7 dump trucks and damaging more property. It is making  
8 him mad to the place where he might, you might get a  
9 verbal threat. And then you can do what you got to do  
10 anyway. Do you understand? So you know, do it the one  
11 way, or don't do it at all, or do what you've got to  
12 do, John. That's the best way I can say it.

13           JOHN-3: Steve, number one, yelling and  
14 screaming at me isn't going to get us anywhere.

15           STEVE: I'm not yelling and screaming.  
16 I'm --

17           JOHN-3: It, it sounds it.

18           STEVE: -- trying to make it as plain and --  
19 well, I'm sorry. Let me -- okay. Let me try to be a  
20 little softer. I didn't --

21           JOHN-3: Okay.

22           STEVE: -- see, let me tell you first of all  
23 the connection's always not so good. I can't hear you  
24 always so well on this phone. And a lot of times the,  
25 the signal gets weak. So let me try to tone down a  
little. It's nothing against you or anybody. But I'm

1 | trying to make it plain and simple.

2 |           And you, you and I keep on running around off  
3 | on tangents. You -- you're seeing something, and  
4 | you're going to say it over and over again. But I see  
5 | what you're saying and it's not acceptable. And the  
6 | only thing I can say is we're at a loss then. I can  
7 | sit on the phone morning, noon and night, but we're  
8 | going nowhere.

9 |           JOHN-3: Steve, if we weren't showing good  
10 | faith, if we weren't trying to help, we --

11 |           STEVE: Could, could you tell them to turn  
12 | that thing off for a minute so I can hear you? That,  
13 | that recording is competing with you. And it's, it's  
14 | really annoying.

15 |           JOHN-3: What the, what the --

16 |           STEVE: The, the loudspeaker out here. I  
17 | mean it's about as loud as you are to show the poor  
18 | connection we got here.

19 |           JOHN-3: What do you mean, the one outside?

20 |           STEVE: Yeah, I can't -- I'm having a hard  
21 | time hearing you, because that thing is going on here.

22 |           JOHN-3: Okay. All right. I'll, I'll see if  
23 | I can get somebody to do that. But just --

24 |           STEVE: I hope they got a radio control where  
25 | they can just stop it for a moment. You can turn it  
back on, but right now it's hard to hear.

1 JOHN-3: Steve, you know, we're going to send  
2 somebody to check on that, all right?

3 STEVE: All right.

4 JOHN-3: But I just wanted to let you know  
5 that, you know, if we weren't trying to help and if we  
6 weren't working in good faith, you wouldn't have those  
7 documents that you asked for the other day, okay?

8 STEVE: It's not enough though. Come on --  
9 where's Dolan at by the way? Where is he?

10 JOHN-3: He's up checking with the commanders  
11 right now.

12 STEVE: How many do you have? Can I ask you  
13 that?

14 JOHN-3: What's that? There's --

15 STEVE: How many commander, how many  
16 commanders?

17 JOHN-3: I'll tell you, Steve, there are more  
18 bosses here than --

19 STEVE: Than there are --

20 JOHN-3: -- than you can shake a stick at.  
21 Indians --

22 STEVE: -- than there are indians, huh?

23 JOHN-3: -- more chiefs than there are  
24 indians, okay?

25 STEVE: Can I ask you, John, where are you  
from?

1 JOHN-3: I'm from Boston.

2 STEVE: You are?

3 JOHN-3: Yeah.

4 STEVE: So you had to come all the way from  
5 Boston?

6 JOHN-3: Yeah, they asked me to come down  
7 here.

8 STEVE: I hope it's a little warmer here for  
9 you if, if that's anything.

10 JOHN-3: It, it sure is. It sure is.

11 STEVE: So you're from Boston, John. Wow. I  
12 was there on my honeymoon years ago.

13 JOHN-3: Did you see anyplace there or travel  
14 down there?

15 STEVE: I like the place. I love New  
16 England.

17 JOHN-3: Yeah.

18 STEVE: Super place. I like the history and  
19 all that. I like the people. I like -- I really did  
20 like the area.

21 JOHN-3: Steve, I just wanted to clear up  
22 that, you know, I'm not a jerk and, you know --

23 STEVE: I know you're not. I really don't --  
24 okay, in honesty --

25 JOHN-3: The biggest jerk yet, you know?

STEVE: It was just because of what had

1 | happened over that weekend that by the time I talked to  
2 | more new people and nothing had changed back to the  
3 | days prior that, you know, it was a extremely  
4 | frustrating thing.

5 |           I don't think you're a jerk, John. I really  
6 | don't. I know you're trying your best to get this  
7 | thing taken care of. And I know you don't understand.  
8 | You're trying to understand these people that are  
9 | hooked on the Bible and that believe in an eternal and  
10 | after life and -- just a minute. Someone's talking to  
11 | me. Just a minute. Someone just came in. One second.

12 |           [gap]

13 |           STEVE: Oh, someone just said that by  
14 | listening to this tape on the outside of the building  
15 | you ought to read Isaiah 36 and 7 where I believe it  
16 | was Sennacherib, the armies of Assyria that surrounded  
17 | Jerusalem, and he kept on taunting and, and coaxing,  
18 | and they did the same thing in those days.

19 |           JOHN-3: I'm not --

20 |           STEVE: But that, but that -- see, these  
21 | people always look to the Bible, because they see  
22 | prophecy being fulfilled before their eyes like the  
23 | book of Nahum about the tanks. I mean since when in  
24 | the history of America has, have Americans had the  
25 | Government use tanks on its own citizens. Can you tell  
me an incident? I don't know of an incident unless you

1 | do. Do you?

2 |           JOHN-3: No, Steve, what, what -- they're  
3 | playing Isaiah over the speakers out there?

4 |           STEVE: No, no. The people that reminds them  
5 | of it. Two chapters out of the Bible, Isaiah 36 and  
6 | 37 --

7 |           JOHN-3: Oh.

8 |           STEVE: -- what's happening out there. You  
9 | read that, and you'll see the similarities.

10 |           JOHN-3: I thought you were saying that they  
11 | were playing Isaiah over the --

12 |           STEVE: No, that would be wonderful if they  
13 | would. It would help a lot.

14 |           JOHN-3: Steve, you know, like I said, this  
15 | has got to be a give and take thing. You know that and  
16 | I, I do too. Don't -- you know, we've been here for  
17 | how many days? And we gave you the documents you asked  
18 | for.

19 |           STEVE: No, you -- not yet you haven't.

20 |           JOHN-3: Huh?

21 |           STEVE: Not -- we didn't -- did we really --  
22 | okay, we asked for them. But in a package. We asked  
23 | for a number of things together.

24 |           JOHN-3: Could you tell me who promised you  
25 | that you would get Newsweek and Time? Do you know who  
it is?

1 STEVE: Yes, I -- yes. Two people. John  
2 Dolan and John Cox.

3 JOHN-3: Did he say that he would get them  
4 for you? Did he promise --

5 STEVE: They said --

6 JOHN-3: -- that he would try to --

7 STEVE: Yes. In fact, they said that they  
8 first checked this area. They weren't to be found. So  
9 they did obtain new, brand new they said, new copies  
10 in, in mint condition from Dallas. They brought them  
11 down. John Dolan or John Cox told me it would take an  
12 hour from where your command post is out here  
13 basically. And he said he would do it even that night.  
14 I says okay, I'll sit up a little longer then. If it  
15 will take about an hour, go ahead, get -- he said and  
16 he, and he told me he would.

17 So we waited. We were going to call him  
18 back, or he was going to call us back. While we were  
19 waiting as your bugs were, you know, where David and I  
20 were, you could hear us talking. And as we were  
21 talking all of a sudden 11:15 the electricity went off.  
22 I went to look out to see, check the fuses to see and  
23 the, and so forth if everything was okay. It was. And  
24 I thought well, now, what's this all about?

25 It didn't -- and so immediately David agreed  
with me let's call John and see what's going -- he

1 acted surprised. I don't know if it was just a ploy or  
2 what. But he acted surprised that that had happened  
3 himself. And then he said he'd call us back about it.  
4 He never did.

5 Next thing I know I'm talking to you in the  
6 morning, about 6 in the morning I believe it was. Then  
7 I'm talking to Dec. Got nowhere with him. Round and  
8 round in circles we went. I tried to lay out man,  
9 everybody's unhappy now. Those people that would have  
10 been out between 9 and 12 in the morning, forget it.  
11 And then Sunday would have been 20, 30 people. And you  
12 didn't know, understand why. I didn't say anything  
13 about the numbers then. But it would have been a nice  
14 surprise to you people I'm sure.

15 Maybe it wasn't to happen that way. I guess  
16 these, these so-called bosses wanted to do it another  
17 way. Well, now we're working on their way. And it  
18 doesn't seem to be doing so well.

19 JOHN-3: What -- was there any agreement made  
20 and if somebody came out you would get the magazines?

21 STEVE: No. It was all because people were  
22 definitely coming out the next morning. So they -- it  
23 was already two had come out Friday. So it was already  
24 such a good spirit. You go back and listen to those  
25 tapes between Dolan and I. I'm telling you the truth.  
It was real good. I just expected that the magazines



1 | looked at those magazines and --

2 |           STEVE: Yeah, what do you think?

3 |           JOHN-3: Huh?

4 |           STEVE: What did you think?

5 |           JOHN-3: Well, I thought that it portrayed

6 | David as a lunatic --

7 |           STEVE: Egomaniac.

8 |           JOHN-3: -- a crazy man.

9 |           STEVE: A lunatic. Yeah.

10 |           JOHN-3: A child abuser.

11 |           STEVE: Okay.

12 |           JOHN-3: And you know --

13 |           STEVE: That doesn't hurt him. We -- that

14 | already was known years ago that that would come out

15 | that way. Read the Bible.

16 |           JOHN-3: Takes other men's wives to

17 | himself --

18 |           STEVE: Uh-huh.

19 |           JOHN-3: -- you know. You know, all of those

20 | things. This is the -- and I've got to clarify this.

21 |           STEVE: Okay.

22 |           JOHN-3: This is the impression to the

23 | American public that is, is given by the press. Okay?

24 | It's not --

25 |           STEVE: I understand that.

          JOHN-3: -- the FBI. It's not --

1 STEVE: No, I understand that.

2 JOHN-3: -- the ATF.

3 STEVE: I believe that.

4 JOHN-3: It is the press.

5 STEVE: I would never, you know, would never  
6 associate what the press does to what you people are  
7 doing even though in the past few weeks, of course,  
8 you've controlled the press, and they have succumbed to  
9 you. And we even heard that you passed out pizza or  
10 that one of the agencies, I don't know if it was the  
11 ATF or whoever, but passed out even pizza to the press  
12 when they moved them back another mile and a half or  
13 whatever it was. So you know, I mean we get to hear --

14 JOHN-3: But --

15 STEVE: -- information about -- I mean the  
16 press, let's be real, you and I. You and I know  
17 they're nothing anymore, that the AP, the one gets a  
18 bit of news, they all get the same thing. It's not  
19 like years ago where you had little town newspapers,  
20 and they all had their own opinions and spoke out, and  
21 those days are over and gone. But I don't care.  
22 That's neither here nor there. You know, God will sort  
23 it out.

24 But where we're at right now, I'm still  
25 asking you people to pick up where we left off Friday.  
Give all that together. Let me take it inside. The

1 | people can look at it and so forth. I guarantee the  
2 | magazines are not going to have a negative -- we've  
3 | expected, anticipated this for years.

4 |           JOHN-3: You know, here, Steve, you know, I  
5 | just wanted to mention to you that, you know, it  
6 | describes adultery which is, you know, what --

7 |           STEVE: That's okay.

8 |           JOHN-3: -- David is doing. And I don't  
9 | know, do you prescribe that, or do you subscribe to  
10 | that?

11 |           STEVE: I, I do not prescribe adultery in no  
12 | way --

13 |           JOHN-3: Okay.

14 |           STEVE: -- shape or the Ten --

15 |           JOHN-3: How about --

16 |           STEVE: -- Commandments are -- let me say  
17 | something.

18 |           JOHN-3: How about child molestation?

19 |           STEVE: Positively not.

20 |           JOHN-3: Okay. Isn't the Bible against that?

21 |           STEVE: It most definitely is against that.

22 |           JOHN-3: Okay. That is what the American  
23 | public perceives is going on with David, okay?

24 |           STEVE: I don't doubt that. Because number  
25 | one, there's a man by the name of Mark Breault that was  
part of this, that he's the one that got this whole

1 | thing going about 2, 3 years ago. I've been in  
2 | communication with him up until about oh, a year ago.  
3 | And he was telling me some of the things he was doing.  
4 | It was being reported back to me. He's worked hard to  
5 | try to get every agency of the American Government  
6 | involvement, making up lies, rumors, slander, all the  
7 | rest. I don't mind. I really don't. God will deal  
8 | with him as he'll deal with me. And it's, it's coming  
9 | down very soon.

10 |           JOHN-3: But all of it is portrayed as him  
11 | having multiple wives, sex with 12-year-olds. And you  
12 | know, that's --

13 |           STEVE: Some of this is true by the way. But  
14 | not, not the latter what you just said. But --

15 |           JOHN-3: Beating children.

16 |           STEVE: -- when, when it says, when it says  
17 | multiple, what did he tell you on the -- he, he did a  
18 | tape for you people and gave it to you, did he not?

19 |           JOHN-3: Yeah. I think they've got it here.  
20 | But --

21 |           STEVE: Well, sure they do, so --

22 |           JOHN-3: -- how about beating children? The  
23 | thing is that's in there --

24 |           STEVE: That is totally untrue.

25 |           JOHN-3: Uh-huh.

          STEVE: Never, ever has, not even once. The

1 first thing that ever impressed me about the man, one  
2 of the first things was when I met him in San  
3 Bernardino, California back in '86. When I met him and  
4 came over there, there's a little boy was whining  
5 around. He says Cyrus, stop that. He said it real  
6 firm but kindly. The boy continued. He says Cyrus,  
7 bring your spoon. Come here.

8           And he didn't make a big deal in front of  
9 everybody to embarrass the child. He took him around  
10 the corner, and he explained to him why he was going to  
11 spank him. And he spanked him with the spoon, not his  
12 own hand, on the child's fleshy part of his buttocks,  
13 on his butt. Not hard. Just enough to show as  
14 displeasure as the book of Proverbs says. Then they  
15 hugged each other and kissed each other on the cheek.  
16 The child was happy. I was amazed at the behavior of  
17 the child. And I watched that.

18           He told every parent that's what they need to  
19 do. That's what the Bible says. And all these unruly  
20 children, children being raised nowadays with the way  
21 they are and wanting this, wanting that, their  
22 selfishness. All of the breakdown and so forth comes  
23 from parents just allowing the free total run of  
24 children that have no minds to make decisions because  
25 they don't understand. The Bible is against that.  
God's against that. David does not beat children.

1                   Robyn Bunds beat her own little boy once so  
2 his bottom was bleeding. All a number of women and men  
3 saw it. They warned her about it. She now blames  
4 David for that. That's where that has started.

5                   All his adversaries, those that have chosen  
6 now to become enemies are the ones that put out those  
7 kind of reports. It can be printed. Let it be  
8 printed. I wouldn't want to be those people. When  
9 this is all said and done, they'll get it worse than  
10 anyone that's ever lived for 6,000 years. Because  
11 truth is a big deal. Lies are a big deal. So if  
12 I'm --

13                   JOHN-3: Okay.

14                   STEVE: -- telling lies, he's telling lies,  
15 believe me he will answer.

16                   JOHN-3: Steve, here's what, here's what is  
17 understood out here that he's having sex with 12-year-  
18 old children, that your child, Mayanah, was fathered by  
19 David. Or, or --

20                   STEVE: Okay, who's saying these kind of  
21 things? Tell me --

22                   JOHN-3: The press. Everybody.

23                   STEVE: -- where is it coming from?

24                   JOHN-3: That's, that's the perception.

25                   STEVE: What do you mean everybody? Who  
knows David?

1 JOHN-3: Is it, is it true?

2 STEVE: It's not true.

3 JOHN-3: That, that Judy Schneider Koresh --

4 STEVE: I tell you what. Why don't you send  
5 in the Newsweek and the Time, let us take a look at it.  
6 And I'll give you more answers than you might even be  
7 ready for. How's that?

8 JOHN-3: I'll tell you --

9 STEVE: Or let's, let's -- I'd rather even  
10 put David right -- I want you to ask David that. I  
11 really -- I want you --

12 JOHN-3: Do you see the inconsistency in the  
13 message?

14 STEVE: -- and you tape it. Listen, you tape  
15 it. And you can play it to the, on the, on the press  
16 conference.

17 JOHN-3: Do you believe --

18 STEVE: You ask him anything you want.

19 JOHN-3: All right. Do you believe David  
20 should have sex with 12-year-old girls?

21 STEVE: I don't think that David should have  
22 sex with anybody unless they're both consenting or of,  
23 of an age where they understood --

24 JOHN-3: Adults or a --

25 STEVE: Exactly. Positively.

JOHN-3: -- a 12-year-old consenting?

1                   STEVE: That's what I'm -- who's ever said  
2 such a thing?

3                   JOHN-3: That's, that's --

4                   STEVE: His adversaries have said that we and  
5 he have done -- that's nothing compared to some -- why  
6 haven't you even got into things are even worse than  
7 that.

8                   JOHN-3: But that is what --

9                   STEVE: This, this has been coming for years.

10                  JOHN-3: That's what's happening in there.

11                  STEVE: That is nonsense.

12                  JOHN-3: You know? And the press like I say  
13 there was something about a beating of a child, a 10-  
14 month-old child or an 8-month-old child.

15                  STEVE: Never. I'm telling you, John, it's  
16 not happened. I'm telling you that.

17                  JOHN-3: Isn't it true that David's sex --

18                  STEVE: What -- can I ask you something?  
19 What child? What -- did you say 10 months?

20                  JOHN-3: A 10-month-old child being beaten --

21                  STEVE: What child is 10 month -- what's the  
22 name. So let me go observe and look and check out and  
23 ask the mother or whatever else.

24                  JOHN-3: Judy Brunds or is it Bunds or Robyn,  
25 Robyn Bunds?

                  STEVE: Robyn Bunds?

1 JOHN-3: Yeah.

2 STEVE: That's the one I just -- that's the  
3 name I just gave you.

4 JOHN-3: Yeah.

5 STEVE: She's the one that beat on her child.  
6 And it was not 10 months. It was over a year old. But  
7 she did. And it was at, when she was at the white  
8 house in La Verne, California. I was around in those  
9 days. I remember how everybody was very -- they  
10 couldn't believe that she lost it and that she did such  
11 a thing. No one ever has a right to do such a thing  
12 like that. It, it doesn't -- how can it help the  
13 child? People --

14 JOHN-3: What about sex with 12-year-olds? I  
15 keep getting back to that, because you and I know  
16 that's not right, Steve.

17 STEVE: It isn't right.

18 JOHN-3: You know?

19 STEVE: And it's not happened.

20 JOHN-3: Well, with a 14-year-old?

21 STEVE: Fourteen-year-old. What can I say?  
22 It's true.

23 JOHN-3: Yeah. Okay. And you know --

24 STEVE: What can I say?

25 JOHN-3: Those -- a 14-year-old is not a  
consenting adult. You know that.

1 STEVE: The person was. The person was.

2 JOHN-3: Oh, don't give me that. They're not  
3 an adult yet.

4 STEVE: I wasn't even here. This was with  
5 Rachel --

6 JOHN-3: It's rape.

7 STEVE: -- Jones.

8 JOHN-3: It's child rape. You know it and I  
9 know it.

10 STEVE: The parents consented before it even  
11 happened.

12 JOHN-3: Oh, the parents can consent for a  
13 child?

14 STEVE: This is what I have heard anyway.  
15 This is what I've been told. But what, but what has --

16 JOHN-3: Steve, if you had, if you had a 14-  
17 year-old daughter --

18 STEVE: -- listen to me. Listen to me.  
19 Listen to me.

20 JOHN-3: -- would you consent to David having  
21 sex with her?

22 STEVE: From your perspective and mine the  
23 way we understand things to be, of course not.

24 JOHN-3: Well, you know --

25 STEVE: Now listen to me, John. Listen.

JOHN-3: Do you agree with that?

1 STEVE: Now listen to me.

2 JOHN-3: All right. Go ahead.

3 STEVE: Now first of all I want David to  
4 answer for himself. Because I don't know. You're  
5 asking me questions that, okay, what I'm sure of  
6 because of what I've heard is that David took Rachel  
7 Jones as his wife some years ago even before I met him.  
8 This is what I was told. And I heard that from him.  
9 That's between her and him, the parents, the, the, in  
10 fact the State of Texas. All of that together.

11 So what do I think about that? Well, let me  
12 take a look at the Bible and see if there isn't some --

13 JOHN-3: What kind of man would have sex with  
14 a 12- or a 14-year-old child? Can you tell me that,  
15 Steven, honestly?

16 STEVE: Yes, I, I --

17 JOHN-3: You know, the Messiah?

18 STEVE: Listen. You're not going to allow me  
19 to answer.

20 JOHN-3: Well, go ahead. Go -- tell me.

21 STEVE: Okay. The answer comes from the  
22 Bible. It comes from what God said he wants --

23 JOHN-3: What --

24 STEVE: -- in the last days.

25 JOHN-3: What the --

STEVE: Did you know I can -- let's you and I

1 | go back to the book of Genesis and see what the 12  
2 | patriarchs did.

3 |           JOHN-3: Steve.

4 |           STEVE: No, no, no. See, you're not going to  
5 | allow me to answer. So you want me to answer --

6 |           JOHN-3: I'm going to let you answer right  
7 | now.

8 |           STEVE: -- yes or no and in your mind. But  
9 | you're going to -- have you had --

10 |           JOHN-3: Go ahead.

11 |           STEVE: -- have you had more than one  
12 | girlfriend that you've had sex with? Have you ever had  
13 | sex with more than woman in your --

14 |           JOHN-3: Not a 14-year-old girl. I'll tell  
15 | you that much.

16 |           STEVE: Let me ask you -- okay. So you have  
17 | had sex with more than one woman.

18 |           JOHN-3: Not a 14-year-old girl, and I've  
19 | never raped a child. And that's what's going on in  
20 | there.

21 |           STEVE: Listen. You won't even answer. You  
22 | think that you're going to hit me with straight on  
23 | questions, and I give you yes, no. But look at you.  
24 | You're twisting -- but God --

25 |           JOHN-3: What --

          STEVE: -- did you -- no, you listen to me,

1 John. Do you know that in the Bible, and I'll show  
2 you. If you've had sex with a woman, she is your wife.  
3 If you've laid with her I will show you clearly --

4 JOHN-3: Have you had sex with your wife?

5 STEVE: Pardon?

6 JOHN-3: Have you had sex with your wife?

7 STEVE: I most certainly have. And you know  
8 that she's David's --

9 JOHN-3: -- has too. So who does she belong  
10 to?

11 STEVE: -- no, now listen to me. Listen to  
12 me. She's the only one in the world that I ever have  
13 had with. Isn't that awesome?

14 JOHN-3: Okay, so if the Bible says --

15 STEVE: But if you, but you have had --  
16 you've got a number of wives. I don't know how many.  
17 You just acknowledged to me you've had sex with more  
18 than one woman. The Bible before the eyes of the  
19 living God you're married to those multiple women then.  
20 I will show you that in the Bible. Before God, that's  
21 what the book says. Unless you don't want to see it.  
22 If you want to close your eyes to it. It's your  
23 choice.

24 You can say the book is perverted. Maybe it  
25 is. But I choose to believe that that book has more  
consistent answers --

1 JOHN-3: Steve.

2 STEVE: -- and that's the source that I'm  
3 turning to.

4 JOHN-3: I've got to be honest with you. I'm  
5 not arguing with you. I'm just telling you that this  
6 is --

7 STEVE: No, no. But let's --

8 JOHN-3: -- what is perceived. You know what  
9 I mean?

10 STEVE: Pardon?

11 JOHN-3: This is what is perceived out here  
12 from the press.

13 STEVE: Fine. Fine. I'm going to tell you  
14 something. I believe in this world there's a spirit of  
15 Satan, a spirit of the world and a spirit of God. And  
16 one is into truth. The other is into lies.

17 And so what you have is in the Bible. God  
18 shows how it works through history and how it will work  
19 in the future. Now we can buy it or we can leave it.  
20 You can take all the information and believe it or  
21 throw it out. I'm, I'm either into this thing or I'm  
22 not. If part of this is false, I'm off back to Hawaii  
23 to live like I was before and not to have anything to  
24 do with religion again.

25 JOHN-3: You can come out of there. Because  
I'll tell you, what about the --

1 STEVE: I don't, I don't choose to at this  
2 moment.

3 JOHN-3: What about the commandment I shall  
4 not commit adultery? Is that one of them that's been  
5 excluded?

6 STEVE: Well, you -- have you committed  
7 adultery?

8 JOHN-3: Huh?

9 STEVE: You have definitely committed  
10 adultery, haven't you?

11 JOHN-3: Yeah, and I'll pay for that. But  
12 I'm telling --

13 STEVE: Yes, you will.

14 JOHN-3: -- you this.

15 STEVE: So will this man if that's what he's  
16 done.

17 JOHN-3: Yeah. You know --

18 STEVE: Are you -- if he says that whatever  
19 he's doing he can show you from the Bible, are you  
20 willing to first listen and then make your condemnation  
21 or your condemning statements?

22 JOHN-3: Okay

23 STEVE: Then, then he will accept that. And  
24 he'll walk right out with you today. That's why I  
25 would like to -- if you've got something you would like  
to ask him, I would like to have you ask him directly,

1 and he will answer it.

2 JOHN-3: But this is --

3 STEVE: He's already given that one videotape  
4 out to you. He's definitely making some kind of a  
5 statement, isn't he?

6 JOHN-3: The 12-year-olds is what really  
7 concerns me and all the American public.

8 STEVE: What 12-year-olds? Now he will  
9 acknowledge what the truth is. So listen to me, John.  
10 Ask --

11 JOHN-3: Fourteen years old?

12 STEVE: -- listen. John, listen to me. Ask  
13 him about the 14-year-old. Ask him about Rachel. Let  
14 him tell you directly. And see, see how could you dare  
15 twist the Scriptures if it's not there? How could you  
16 take any Scriptures and show something like that to me  
17 and my mind is so perverted? Why don't you say  
18 something like that to him? Then sit back with your  
19 mouth closed. Open up your ears. Give him  
20 opportunity.

21 If he can't -- I mean there is no question  
22 about what you're saying. But if you can, listen  
23 carefully. Why would God of the Bible, John, have  
24 Isaiah in chapter 20 walk around nude and barefoot for  
25 3 years? That's against the moral code of, of Moses,  
of Israel. But yet, God had this prophet do that. No

1 wonder the man was rejected by Israel 2,700 years ago,  
2 John.

3 And what about other men in the Bible that  
4 were chosen by God? One was told in fact -- let's see,  
5 it was Hosea that was told to marry two prostitutes.  
6 That's against the laws of Moses. It's against the Ten  
7 Commandments. Now how is it that God told him not only  
8 to marry two women by two prostitutes? Read the story  
9 in the book of Hosea.

10 Now so what -- who is this God that has been  
11 behind or through and with the Bible all these years?  
12 Who is he? How does he work and why? What's he up to?  
13 What's he trying to say to mankind? Let's ask those  
14 questions. Good, logical questions along with the ones  
15 you're asking. Talking about perversion. Talking  
16 about all the rest of it. Let's bring the issues out.

17 JOHN-3: That's the --

18 STEVE: But are, but are you willing to hear?

19 JOHN-3: That's the only side that people are  
20 seeing out here. And what, what is the thing is he is  
21 using the Bible as an excuse to have sex with 14-year-  
22 olds and, and do all this other stuff, and he claims  
23 that, you know, the Bible let him do it.

24 STEVE: From your, from your perspective it  
25 may --

JOHN-3: Not just mine.

1 STEVE: Listen. No, but --

2 JOHN-3: Not just mine.

3 STEVE: -- or from their. No, but I'm  
4 talking to you. I'm not talking to them now.

5 JOHN-3: Right.

6 STEVE: But from your perspective, maybe so.  
7 And if so, I'm totally with you in that certain things  
8 probably should be prosecuted. But on the other hand,  
9 if there's something that can be logically, clearly  
10 drawn --

11 JOHN-3: How could you serve him --

12 STEVE: -- from the Bible --

13 JOHN-3: How could you serve him if you think  
14 that if it's true he should be prosecuted?

15 STEVE: You would have to -- John, you would  
16 have to close your mouth for a little bit of time and  
17 listen to something shown from the book in context.  
18 And you with your good mind, your faculties, your  
19 ability to discern, you would be able to see if he was  
20 twisting what the writings of that book is clearly on  
21 its own merit. Is that not true?

22 You should have enough insight into humanity.  
23 Right now you're making a judgment. But you're making  
24 it based upon not having given the man opportunity to  
25 show you something but from your own feelings, what,  
what you see and what you've heard along with possible

1 truths mixed with rumor and slander and error.

2 JOHN-3: Listen. I think David won't come  
3 out because he knows he'll be shown as a fraud. But  
4 you remember --

5 STEVE: Not at, not at all. Not at all. You  
6 weren't here that Tuesday when he said he would come  
7 out. I guarantee he was -- I was here. I saw him. No  
8 maybe about it, he was coming out.

9 But I do believe there is a power that talks  
10 to him. As weird and strange as it is. And that is  
11 weird. It's bizarre. I've never in my life believed  
12 in any such thing as a modern-day prophet, a guru. I  
13 mean I've dealt a lot with people that are Hindus and  
14 Buddhists and those into Shinto and all the rest.

15 Who are you talking to? Can -- what do they  
16 got to say? They giving you other things to say or to  
17 bring up?

18 JOHN-3: No, no. Somebody just walked in.  
19 They're --

20 STEVE: Oh, come on. They are.

21 JOHN-3: -- trying to find out -- well, you  
22 can believe me or not, Steve, like I say.

23 STEVE: Okay, well, tell me what's going on  
24 then. Because you're --

25 JOHN-3: Okay.

STEVE: -- half hardly listening to me.

1 JOHN-3: No, I am listening to every word  
2 you're saying.

3 STEVE: It's just that someone else is  
4 talking to me just now has just walked in. Just a  
5 minute.

6 [gap]

7 STEVE: Could you turn that, that box off  
8 during, the speakers off during our worship hour? It's  
9 now --

10 JOHN-3: I'll, I'll do, I'll see --

11 STEVE: -- it's 5 minutes after 2, from 2 to  
12 3 we would definitely appreciate that. You will  
13 absolutely get nowhere with these people if you don't.  
14 If you show such disrespect, there's no sense in even  
15 talking to me.

16 JOHN-3: Steve, I just want to ask you one  
17 thing. Would a good God believe in, in people having  
18 sex with a 14-year-old?

19 STEVE: Do you want to get in that -- are you  
20 asking because you --

21 JOHN-3: I just, I --

22 STEVE: -- listen to me now.

23 JOHN-3: I just want to ask you personally.

24 STEVE: Are you asking me a question that  
25 you're really willing to hear an answer?

JOHN-3: I want to hear what you have to say.

1                   STEVE: And I want to give you an answer. I  
2 want to give you an answer that may save your life. In  
3 fact, you know that I believe it will.

4                   JOHN-3: Go ahead.

5                   STEVE: And the answer is going to be I'm  
6 going to -- I want to turn the phone over to David who  
7 will give you the answer for his actions. And I want  
8 you to be able to ask him all the things that you  
9 raised to me.

10                  JOHN-3: Fine.

11                  STEVE: Because there is -- you know what?  
12 When it comes right down to it, only he knows what he's  
13 really done. And if you've got some information, you  
14 can nail him down on that. Say we have this. We have  
15 that. We want to know. And then listen. Then listen.  
16 I really believe he will tell you, John. I really  
17 believe that. And if he doesn't, I'll get back on the  
18 phone with you, and we'll talk about it.

19                  JOHN-3: Steve, I just want to leave this  
20 that, you know, you know, I'm here to help, okay? But  
21 these are some issues, those magazines are a big thing.  
22 Frankly, they don't serve you well if, if David's  
23 trying to get his message out.

24                  STEVE: That's okay. You don't -- see,  
25 you've got this cult, this mentality about cults and so  
forth, what they are, their mind set and so forth.

1 | You've talked to psychologists, theologians that are  
2 | supposed to be versed in these kind of things. They  
3 | don't know what they're talking about. The  
4 | philosophies of men are always so full of holes and  
5 | fallible as you should already know.

6 |           Let's, let's be real here. I mean we already  
7 | know. I mean things like this have been coming for  
8 | years. If it wasn't one thing, it was another. It's  
9 | always been this way. You've got Martin Luther  
10 | stepping out aside from the Roman papacy. And right  
11 | away he's -- they want to take his life. Read history.  
12 | And right away they're slandering the man every which  
13 | way possible. It's the way the spirit of Satan has  
14 | always been.

15 |           Now I know you see this as some rambling on  
16 | about someone, how cults always do this. Maybe so.  
17 | Maybe there's a --

18 |           JOHN-3: Steve, you know you're not going to  
19 | convert me, right? You, you know --

20 |           STEVE: I'm not trying to convert you.

21 |           JOHN-3: You know, but --

22 |           STEVE: I'm trying to help you understand how  
23 | I think and how these people think here.

24 |           JOHN-3: All right. Now --

25 |           STEVE: And if it sounds like we're  
brainwashed and like we're stuck on something, maybe we

1 are. But in this world what are you brain -- what do  
2 you fill your mind full of? Things that pertain to  
3 catching a vision of something better or something that  
4 you, you think that you have some hope in this earth  
5 where it's a cemetery, everything dies here? Do you  
6 see a way out of this mess yourself? If you've got a  
7 better way, a better plan, a better idea --

8 JOHN-3: I'll tell you what, Steve. I'll  
9 interrupt you right there. I'll settle with the God  
10 that I believe in when I die. But I will not hide  
11 behind a bunch of innocent children, you know? I'll  
12 not hide behind a bunch of innocent little children.

13 STEVE: If you want to know about these  
14 children, read Psalms chapter 8.

15 JOHN-3: Because that's what he's --

16 STEVE: Did you hear what I said?

17 JOHN-3: -- that's also the perception, okay?

18 STEVE: I don't really care what the --

19 JOHN-3: That David is using the --

20 STEVE: This world is ripe for judgment just  
21 like in the days of Noah. You have no ears to hear,  
22 John. You really don't. You have a God. What is your  
23 God based upon, John? Is it based on the Bible? Is it  
24 based on your feelings? What is it based on, your  
25 experience in life? Can you tell me something about  
your God? Maybe I'll go over to your God.

1           JOHN-3: I'll tell you what, Steve. I keep  
2 that personal. I don't try to force other people to  
3 believe in it.

4           STEVE: Well, then your God is -- whatever  
5 your God is he may, must not be too strong. If you  
6 keep it personal, he must not be worthwhile sharing  
7 about, or maybe he's not able to do anything. But if  
8 he's -- if your God is good, if you've got something  
9 there, I don't know why you wouldn't want to share it  
10 with me. Maybe it would cause me to come out of here.

11           JOHN-3: Steve, my God doesn't promote having  
12 sex with 14-year-old girls, I can tell you that.

13           STEVE: Does he promote having sex with  
14 multiple women but not claiming that they're your  
15 wives?

16           JOHN-3: I told you --

17           STEVE: Because that's the way God looks at  
18 it in the Bible.

19           JOHN-3: -- I haven't done that. And I will  
20 settle for my sins, whatever they may be, with the God  
21 I believe in. And I respect your faith. But you know,  
22 not with having sex with 14-year-old girls.

23           STEVE: I haven't had.

24           JOHN-3: David has.

25           STEVE: Ask him.

          JOHN-3: He's already admitted it.

1           STEVE: Okay, ask him why. Ask him if there  
2 might be a reason from the Bible for that.

3           JOHN-3: How does he -- you know, this is --

4           STEVE: Well, well, if you want to know give  
5 him -- John, come on. Give him opportunity. Maybe  
6 you'll learn something on the way maybe some nut works  
7 or something like that. And in the future you would  
8 know how to handle him better. Give him opportunity to  
9 show you or explain to you why and how, the reasons for  
10 it.

11           Wouldn't it be awesome if there was some kind  
12 of a logical reason? It's hard to believe that there  
13 could be, isn't it? But maybe if you waited to hear  
14 for just a little bit of time, those people that are  
15 there listening right now, who knows what they might  
16 pick up on and might be able to utilize in the future.

17           JOHN-3: It's -- Steve, it -- no matter what  
18 he tells me, the perception of him from the press, all  
19 over the country, is that he's a child molester and  
20 he's hiding behind a bunch of children. Now I wanted  
21 to ask you one thing.

22           STEVE: Sure.

23           JOHN-3: Your wife, Judy, the one -- she's  
24 got an injured finger?

25           STEVE: Now, I'm going to tell you before you  
ask anything. I'm not going to answer any personal

1 | questions about Judy. Because I'm going to answer for  
2 | myself. If you've got any questions for her, you can  
3 | ask her.

4 |           And when it -- if it comes to anything aside  
5 | from you not wanting to hear or ask David first of all  
6 | about the 14-year-old, some of those questions I'm  
7 | going to wait for him to give you a foundation and a  
8 | platform. If you don't want that, I'm not going to get  
9 | into your personal life any further. Because it's  
10 | obvious you didn't want to talk to me about it. And  
11 | the reverse is going to be true and on my side in my  
12 | case. So we're not going to talk about your multiple  
13 | wives. And I, I don't really want to talk any further  
14 | about my one and only wife.

15 |           JOHN-3: Whose wife is she? Is she your wife  
16 | or is she David's wife?

17 |           STEVE: Did you hear what I just said? If  
18 | you want me to start asking you questions about your  
19 | multiple affairs and so forth, we'll talk about that.  
20 | If you want to talk about my one wife, my one, the one  
21 | person I've had intimate relations with, we will do  
22 | that.

23 |           JOHN-3: Do you agree and do you like --

24 |           STEVE: Did you hear what I said?

25 |           JOHN-3: -- him having sex with David? Huh?

          STEVE: You're going to -- it's going to fall

1 on deaf ears. I'm going to tell you ahead of time. If  
2 you're --

3 JOHN-3: What about Judy having sex with him?

4 STEVE: -- going to try to insult me about  
5 Judy, it's not going to happen. I'm not --
