


guys in law enforcement are sincere --1 2 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 3 DAVID KORESH: -- and you're really trying to 4 do good --5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 6 DAVID KORESH: -- then you're righteous with 7 God. 8 HENRY GARCIA: That's right. 9 DAVID KORESH: Because you can only, you can only walk in the light of the law as you know the law. 10 11 HENRY GARCIA: Exactly. 12 DAVID KORESH: You see, that's why God placed Israel in subjection to the nations of men. And Paul 13 explains: Look, Israel, Paul says, you're missing the 14 point. Does not even the Spirit of God even work in 15 the Gentiles? For if the Gentiles which have not the 16 law do by nature the things contained in the law --17 like do you have to have a law to tell you to feed your 18 baby or to give it some clothes or change its diaper? 19 20 HENRY GARCIA: Really. DAVID KORESH: Do you have to have a law to, 21 to, to see your friend, next-door neighbor over there 22 with the smile on his face and his, and his wife, and 23 here you're with your wife, and you see his grass is 24 growing a little bit high over there and he's out there 25 and his lawn mower won't start. Do you have to have a



law to say hey, friend, would you like to borrow my mower till you get yours fixed? No.

HENRY GARCIA: That's right.

DAVID KORESH: I mean, you know, you don't have to have a law to basically be obeying a feeling and emotion, to not only feel for yourself but feel for others that are of the same proportion of matter. I mean, you know, it's -- it -- this is what Paul tried to explain.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: So, Paul -- you know, Paul begins to explain to the Romans that the law of God was not revealed from Sinai, you know, to make people a righteousness -- a standard of righteousness, but it was revealed that all mouths might be stopped and everybody might become guilty before God.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: In other words, nobody's good.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: You know. But the desire and the spirit to do good is where Paul explains: For I know the law is spiritual, Paul says, but I am carnal so to understand. Paul says, that which I would do the law, I do not, but that which I hate, sin, that I do. Paul says, oh, wretched man that I am, who's going to deliver me from this body of sin and death?

1 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 2 DAVID KORESH: Paul says, in the flesh I do one thing, but in my mind I want to do another thing. 3 4 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 5 DAVID KORESH: Paul says, I thank God that 6 through Christ I can serve God through the spirit although I might make a mistake in the flesh. 7 8 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 9 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, this, this is where the enmity comes toward man begins to push 10 forward. Now, in 1985, I went to Israel because there 11 was a calling. Okay? 12 13 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 14 DAVID KORESH: Now, a lot of people will not really -- don't understand me from the years of 1978, 15 '79, to 1985 because a lot of transition took place 16 during that time. But at least I could play guitar --HENRY GARCIA: Right. 5 DAVID KORESH: -- and turn around and go play 6 7 football. 8 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 9 DAVID KORESH: At least I could play guitar and rock-and-roll and get people, you know, out there 10 moving and stuff or whatever, play ballads and get 11 people, you know, with a nice attitude, and still at 12 the same time get out there and ride motorcycle all day 13 long, you know, or, or run. 14 15 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 16 DAVID KORESH: So, you know, I just, I just 17 didn't need that stuff. 18 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 19 DAVID KORESH: So, in 1985 things had developed to a maxim (sic) to where, you know, there 20 21 had been just too much controversy over the concept of the purpose of scripture. Some people think that the 22 Bible is a record of other people's stories. So, you 23 could read them and know how God dealt with them and 24 you can have your own experience. Others believe that 25

the Bible has a prophetic utterance, that it forewarns



1 | of the last-day events. Others believe as others 2 believe that. But, anyway, after seeing and pursuing 3 and understanding so many things about, you know -- I, I, I've been, I've been rejected and I've been accepted. I've been, I've been the wellest (sic) and 5 I've been the sickest. I've had big money and I've had 6 7 no money. HENRY GARCIA: 8 Um-hum. 9 DAVID KORESH: I've been called special student, retarded --10 11 HENRY GARCIA: Hmm. 12 DAVID KORESH: -- and I've been called a 13 genius. 14 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 15 DAVID KORESH: I mean, you know, I get to 16 look at things from both sides of the coin. 17 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 18 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, in 1985 when I was in Israel I had an unusual -- a very unique experience. 19 I took my wife Rachel over there. That's when I 20 married Rachel. I'd already -- I'd al-- I was told to 21 come to Mount Carmel Center. Okay? So, I came there. 22 And through certain events I married a young girl named 23 24 Rachel Jones. 25 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: Of course, I wanted him to bear that name as a first name because of the involvement of what it had prophetically and, and the significance prophetically, which, you know, Cyrus is the English translation for the word Koresh.

HENRY GARCIA: Okay.

DAVID KORESH: Okay. And that's one of the words that -- the Hebrew terminologies or, or the ancient Hebrew, they don't, they don't know the meaning of this word. They don't know the meaning of it. The Revelation says Christ has the name of which no one knows but he himself. See? So, his name is the Word



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of God, but what does this Koresh mean? Anyway, so, when I was in Israel, I was, I was given all the details. Rumor had it that Russian cosmonauts were in their satellite stations and they had wired down to their headquarters that they were quite disturbed because they had saw seven angelic beings, angel-like

7 beings, coming towards the Earth.

HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.

DAVID KORESH: And, you know, that, that was kind of like, you know, was it, was it a, was it a pun? Was it a truth? Was it a joke? I mean, you know, was it a make-believe or whatever -- well, it, it doesn't make any difference. I mean, if it was true, the question would be why would Russia of all people want to give significance to angelic beings? But, anyway, I know it's true and I know why it was true. the seven angels of Revelation 14. You see, God chooses one person to judge the world. God chose one man, Noah, who had lived, who had thought, who had dreamed, who had experienced, who had cried, who had laughed, who had hungered, who had thirsted, who had been sad, who had been, you know, refreshed with drink, who had known woman and children. You cannot know 6 7 Christ unless you know the Word of God. referred to the scripture that was proclaimed to be the 8 words of God. Not the words of Moses, but the words of 9 God. 25	Eden, okay?



20 | There's where this mystery is finally revealed. Let me

21 show you now. I mean, this, this is, this is -- see,

22 | in the Dark Ages, man didn't even -- they lost the

23 whole knowledge of woman's image of the Godhead, you

24 know?

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HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: They just thought well, you



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1 | know, God just made me this woman here just to, you

2 | know, have fun with and all that. That's not the case.

3 Now, watch. Okay. In Chapter 11 of Revelation -- you

4 know, Chapter 10 the mighty angel comes down, so we

5 | know there's a message in the last days, right?

6 | Chapter 10, verse 7, days of -- seventh angel, time no

7 longer, seven thunders, right?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: So, in Chapter 11, there was given me a reed like unto a rod. The angel stood, saying rise and measure the temple of God, which is this -- this is how the temple is measured in heaven. It's counted. Okay? And the altar, and them that worship therein. Now, if you don't, if you don't come up hither and you don't learn these seven seals, you're not worshiping in the temple of God. But the court which is without the temple leave not and measure it not for it's given to the Gentiles. And the Holy City shall they tread under foot forty-and-two months. So, this period of time, they, they don't care about this truth of the sanctuary. They don't care about the mighty angel. They don't care about the seven seals. They -- you know, this has been taking place for quite awhile now and it's finishing up. And I'll give power to my two witnesses and they shall prophesy a thousand

two hundred three score days, which is the same period



of time, clothed in sackcloth, which means, you know, no one has the answers to these two witnesses because hey, you know, the Gentiles don't care. They trample under the foot. Okay. Now, in Zechariah's prophecy, Zechariah showed you a rock with seven eyes?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: He showed you seven

candlesticks --

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: -- and he showed you seven lamps on the candlesticks and two olive trees. And the Spirit says this has the word of the Lord to those who come from Babylon, saying they cannot do it under their own might nor by their own power, but only by God's spirit, which is God's word. You can't get out of Babylon by your own mind or by your own power. It's got to be something that's shown to you in the light of these seven candlesticks is what Zechariah says.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: So, it's just like, you know, the same as -- okay. God's the rock. Zechariah is true. God is the rock. He has seven eyes. He, he writes the book. Christ is the lamp. He has seven eyes. And, you know, the seven seals have to be known. These are the two olive trees and two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth. And if any man



will hurt them, prophecies out of their mouth and devour them, their enemies, if -- if any will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed. 3 4 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 5 DAVID KORESH: These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not on the days of their prophecy, 6 and have power over the waters to turn them to blood 7 and do smite the earth as often with plagues as often 8 as they will. Now, you know Moses and Elijah did they 9 10 anciently, right? 11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 12 DAVID KORESH: No. Really, Christ did it 13 through them. 14 HENRY GARCIA: Oh, okay. 15 DAVID KORESH: You see? See, that's the whole meaning. 2,000 years ago the two witnesses of 16 Christ's kingdom was is that -- well, they were the 17 mode of transfiguration. Both Moses and Christ and 18 19 Elijah stood together, didn't they? 20 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 21 DAVID KORESH: As one. Right? 22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 23 DAVID KORESH: I mean, Christ worked through Moses and Christ worked through Elijah. Right? 24 HENRY GARCIA: Through the two of them. 25 DAVID KORESH: Exactly. But they all were of



one spirit, weren't they? 1 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 2 3 DAVID KORESH: Only Christ was perfect 4 though. 5 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 6 DAVID KORESH: And those other two were just 7 looking to him that was perfect? 8 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 9 DAVID KORESH: So, that's why they're called 10 the olive trees, the anointed ones. Okay. Now, it says here: when they shall have finished their 11 testimony, and after this three-and-a-half year period 12 of time, the beasts -- this is out of the bottomless 13 pit which scripture says is carnal man that comes out 14 of a woman's womb without knowledge, right? 15 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 16 17 DAVID KORESH: You know, shall make more 18 against them and shall overcome them and then kill Okay. Now, what happens is, is that -- you see, 19 them. I'm supposed to teach this stuff so it don't happen. 20 Prophecies, prophecies are given so that they can be 21 avoided and instead a blessing can be given. 22 23 HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh. DAVID KORESH: You know? Now, it says here 24 -- remember the lamblike beast that speaks as a dragon? 25 Anyway, it says here -- okay: kill them and their dead



bodies shall lie in the great street of the city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt where our Lord was crucified.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And there the people, and of the kingdoms, the nations, and tongues, shall see their dead bodies three days and a half and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves. And it says here: and they have the people that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them and make merry and shall send gifts one to another because these two prophets tormented them until up on the earth.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And I beheld after three days and a half that the spirit of life from God entered into them and they stood upon their seat and this great fear fell upon them which saw them. Okay. So, what happens is -- and then the judge when this, when this is, when this is fulfilled -- excuse me. I'm going to need some -- okay. We see over here that -- verses 11, the same hour there a great earthquake, which this is the resurrection of the 200 million that the sixth seal talks about. And it talks about the city falling, the men -- I mean, people were slain and the, and the remnant that are -- remain after God destroys the wicked, they were involved in this. Because not



everybody's involved in it.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: They give glory to the God of heaven.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And it says here that the seventh angel sounded with -- thus the mystery is finished now. That there were great voices in heaven saying the kingdoms of this world become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ, which is the fulfillment of Psalms 2. You know, God told them to kiss the son least they be angry.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: Right?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And to be wise judges. You know, to be wise ye kings. And it says here, and he shall reign forever and ever. And the four-and-twenty elders which sit before God -- which they are the ones judging you'all right now. You know, they're the -- I mean, while you'all are, are, are ready to judge me, and I don't mind that. I understand that's, that's what has to be done.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: You know. That right now -- I know it sounds kind of funny, but I've got to speak the

1	truth. Right now where I was taken and, and brought
2	back from, you know, Christ, God I mean, the Father
3	of us all, the one that created us all, right?
4	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
5	DAVID KORESH: He is on the throne and the
6	judiciary is actually discussing and, and, and actually
7	passing judgments on attitudes that are being developed
8	and characters that are being developed in regards to
9	the situation that's taking place right now.
10	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
11	DAVID KORESH: That's why, that's why I'm,
12	I'm told to wait. Otherwise, I'd be out. You know. I
13	mean, I know it's complicated. Let me, let me finish
14	here. Maybe we can get a little more insight
15	HENRY GARCIA: Say that
16	DAVID KORESH: on it.
17	HENRY GARCIA: one more time.
18	DAVID KORESH: Huh?
19	HENRY GARCIA: Say that one more time.
20	DAVID KORESH: Okay. While see, see, I
21	remember, I'm of, I'm of this world.
22	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
23	DAVID KORESH: Okay. I've just, I've just
24	been taken to another world I mean, other worlds.
25	It sounds funny, but I'm saying that while, while we're
	doing right now is taking place, everyone already knows



that Christ was terribly misjudged 2,000 years ago. Right?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: Okay. Now, we know that 2,000

years ago who that Christ was. That was God, wasn't

he?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: I, I mean the original number one in the beginning. I don't mean son number one, number two, number three. I mean the first one. I mean God. And, and he was on the cross. And what was he doing up there? Man's judgment, right?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: Now, whoa. That was bad. But he says, Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do. Right?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And he did everything he did as an example that it might be written. He said to the disciples on that day you will know that I'm in the Father and the Father's in me, I and my Father are one. Okay? But the one thief up there on the cross, he says to him, you know, Lord, I've never known what I've done all my life. I mean, I've always done so wrong. He says, if you have a kingdom that's based upon forgiving people because they don't know what they're doing, can

1	you remember me? I mean, I lived my whole life and ah,
2	ah, ba, da (weeping/talking sounds). You know, I'm
3	ready I deserve this punishment. I deserve to be
4	crucified. You know. But aahh, I've never known what
5	it was for in the first place. Can you forgive me?
6	And so that's the whole key, you see. That's the
7	position I'm taking, that even if I you know, if I
8	you know, look, I'm in trouble. Let's just face the
9	facts.
10	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
11	DAVID KORESH: Nonetheless, I know the one
12	I'm looking over to.
13	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
14	DAVID KORESH: See, by, by people misjudging
15	God, naturally they're going to misjudge me.
16	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
17	DAVID KORESH: I mean, that's that goes
18	for all of us.
19	HENRY GARCIA: Sure.
20	DAVID KORESH: You know. So, so, you know,
21	we've got to put our grudges down and all that. We've
22	got to say now, just look. I'm just going to keep
23	looking to the one on the middle of the cross. And,
24	so, you know, one thief, unlike the other one, was just
25	like David. He you know, he was, he was saying I've
	got to take this punishment. Now, I've done some evil.



I've hurt some people. I didn't mean to, but nonetheless, you know, I've had some good at the expense of others.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, you know, Christ turns to him. And then we're talking about Christ being really God.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: He says I've saved you today. You know, this is the kind of heart that God accepts, a poor and contrite heart, broken spirit. You shall be with me in paradise.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, now, as Christ sits on the throne, which is the rock, God, all of a sudden he gives this book to this lamb. Okay, now. Now, it says here that in Chapter 11 we were learning, something to do -- after Chapter 10. After Chapter 10 we know that a mighty angel comes down to earth, right? HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And there's seven thunders uttered, right?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And we know that there is going to be a judgment to where only those who are in the temple of God who come up hither and say, hey,



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what's going on up hither? -- will be numbered amongst the righteous.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: And the rest of them who don't care about learning these seven seals, these seven thunders, will be on the outside, and they trample the truth or they trample God's judiciary kingdom under foot. Remember, this earth is a part of heaven too, you know.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: All in heaven belongs to God
and all the fullness thereof.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: We're still on God's real estate here now.

16 | HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: So, what happens is is that in so doing, finally what happens is is that the ones who don't understand, scripture warns that those who are of the flesh, those who come out of the carnal womb, you know, without being born again by knowledge and truth, they come out and they'd kill these witnesses. Well, all they're killing is they're killing, they're killing -- for instance, Zechariah said he saw in vision a rock with seven eyes, didn't he?

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

1 DAVID KORESH: Zechariah said he saw a candle, a lamp with seven, with seven lamps. 2 there's two witnesses by two olive trees, right? 3 4 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 5 DAVID KORESH: Moses and Elijah, the sons of oil. Now, we know that Christ is delight of the world 6 according to the New Testament. That's already been 7 made plain for us. And we know in the mount of 8 transfiguration the kingdom of God deals with Christ 9 standing on the mount, Moses and Elijah standing by 10 him, and they all three are one. 11 12 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 13 DAVID KORESH: They've got one work to do, and that's to save souls with the word of God. 14 15 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, so, when it comes 16 down to this final revelation when, when God 17 sends his Son into the world to reveal the seven seals, 18 then all the sons of God are going to want to learn the 19 20 seven seals, aren't they? 21 HENRY GARCIA: Yes. 22 DAVID KORESH: Okay. So, the thing of it is -- but man, whose carnal in-- remember, wisdom says she 23 hates pride and arrogancy and carnality? She says now, 24

I've built my house, I've hewn my seven pillars? You

know, we know that wisdom built Christ. Let me

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
explain. And wisdom builds everybody. Now, here is, here is the clincher to it. It says here: 2 3 kingdoms of this world becomes the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ and he shall reign forever and ever. 4 5 And the four-and-twenty elders which sit before God on their seats fell down upon their faces and worshipped 6 7 God, saying we give Thee thanks, oh, Lord, God Almighty, which art and was and are to come, because 8 Thou has taken a great power in his reign -- which this 9 is where God has to intervene. For the nations were 10 angry -- which is like Psalms 2, the heathen raged --11 12 and Thy wrath has come -- which the sixth seal went -what's going to happen is is that the sum of the stars 13 are going to be dark and all the natural elements of 14 light and the heaven is going to depart and everyone in 15 this world is going to get to look up and see something 16 17 they never seen before, something I was already shown. But, of course, what happens is is that I'm supposed to 18 show it through a book. And then what happens is 19 they're going to realize that, that -- see, all I've 20 ever wanted out of my life is peace. 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happening right now. And Thy wrath has come and the 2 time of the dead that they should be judged, that Thou shouldest give reward to Thy servants, the prophets, 3 and to Thy sayings, those that were sanctified by the 4 5 prophets, knowing their truth, to them that fear Thy 6 name, small and great, and shall destroy them which 7 destroy the earth. God doesn't like the way our economic system is doing to our world today. And the 8 9 temple of God -- now, watch this. This is, this is off of -- remember wisdom said those who find me find life? 10 11 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 12 DAVID KORESH: Remember? 13 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 14 DAVID KORESH: They shall obtain the favor of 15 the Lord? Now, watch this. And the temple of God was opened in heaven. See, this is the -- this is, this is 16 the, the thing that causes the sin against the Holy 17 Ghost. Now, watch. Now, the temple of God was opened 18 In heaven. And there was seen in this temple 19 where? the ark of his testament -- which is what Moses made a 20 21 model of, right? 22 HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum. 23 DAVID KORESH: And there were lightnings and voices and thunderings and an earthquake and great 24 hell. Now, God's angry. And there appeared a great 25

wonder in heaven, a woman, clothed with the sun, the



different light than what we have been trained or

raised to look at mankind in. You know, it's -- but,

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but if you're looking -- you, you look -- like, for instance, when I looked out the window here the other day and I saw those ATF agents laying down there and blood dripping down, you know -- I mean, I had been shot too, but yet I was still alive.

HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.

DAVID KORESH: You know, and I was there when the first burst came into the front door. And I'm thinking like, you know, like we'll, we'll -- you know, like I'm looking on the same -- you know, God, are you going to, are you going to shelter me or, or what, what am I supposed to do now, you know? Because we, we had been -- I had been told about this long before. So, I'm like there and I'm looking at -- I'm thinking, you know, God, you know, what can we do? I mean, it's like, you know, those are friends of mine. They could have been just like with Robert. There's, there's, there's just no mean in this kind of stuff, you know? HENRY GARCIA: Really?

DAVID KORESH: I mean, I mean, they're, they're laying there on, on the top of the roof, you know, and, you know, I, I didn't even know, I didn't even know till I came around back to the side window over here that they -- that, that anyone had even been shot. And it's like -- I'm like thinking to myself, you know, this -- it's not necessary.

1	HENRY GARCIA: Really?
2	DAVID KORESH: You know, why? It's just like
3	here is somebody that was a baby just 20-something,
4	30-something years ago. A child
5	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
6	DAVID KORESH: that, that came into the
7	world, that, that was a baby that toddled, and now it's
8	over. You know?
9	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
10	DAVID KORESH: And, and it's just like it's,
11	it's so, it's so contrary to you know, like, like I
12	myself have got a lot of babies. Now, I'm now,
13	look. I know it's, it's funny and it's, it's strange.
14	You know, I have a lot of wives.
15	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
16	DAVID KORESH: And it's not according to your
17	law. I realize that. You know, I do realize that.
18	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
19	DAVID KORESH: And people say that I'm a
20	brainwasher on that. That's not the truth now.
21	HENRY GARCIA: That what?
22	DAVID KORESH: They say I'm a brainwasher.
23	HENRY GARCIA: Uh-huh.
24	DAVID KORESH: That's, that's not the truth
25	now. I'm I can't brainwash you. I mean, let's,
	let's face it. You're going to take what I say and

1	you're going to judge it for yourself. But here's the
2	thing. David of old was chosen of God. And David had
3	a spirit that God you know, the heavens look down on
4	us every day.
5	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
6	DAVID KORESH: And Psalms says that God looks
7	down from the heavens and beholds all the sons of men.
8	He fashioned all their hearts alike and he considers
9	all their doings.
10	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
11	DAVID KORESH: Right?
12	HENRY GARCIA: Um-hum.
13	DAVID KORESH: So, God chose David. He
14	didn't choose his seven other brothers, did he?
15	HENRY GARCIA: No.
16	DAVID KORESH: He chose David. He was the
17	youngest one who was who liked to care for

DAVID: How many wives did he have?

HENRY: About two.

DAVID: Too many -- 800, 800. Well, I never

have to worry about that.

(Laughter.)

DAVID: Because -- well, see, the -- here's how this works now. There's a lot of churches, okay?

HENRY: Uh-huh.

DAVID: I mean, like I said, I, I -- I was wanting to show Robert all this stuff. You know, I was really hoping that me and Robert could get this worked out because I really, you know -- what I do -- 'cause when I sit down and give studies to people, I show them out of the book and then I ask them. I go, well, well, what do you think? Am I crazy or -- if they, if they don't see a point, they'll go, well, I don't really understand it right now and I'll, then I'll show them from another angle.

Before they know it, they're learning the whole Bible. And I'll ask them, see -- this is what I've told my students -- look, I've had an experience in my life to where my life means nothing in this world. My life is only valued in regards to how much it will increase your life in the knowledge of God. So I'm going to always be in your hands, and any time any

and every one of you can do unto me or cause to happen to me anything you desire, because you know I will 2 alway-- only show you a truth and my life is in your hands. Okay? 5 So then I began to open up these seals. And every time that I have -- a person sat down and 6 7 listened, you know, they, they've, they've always had to say -- say, you know, David? It's right. One thing 8 about it is, it's different, it's strange, but it's right. 10 11 HENRY: Um-hum. 12 DAVID: And others who, like, say well, you know, they don't really listen, they, they get half of 13 what I say and they don't get the full picture and then 14 they start coming with all these ideals and crazy 15 16 things. Of course, from their point of view, you know, I'm this -- I'm claiming that I'm Jesus, I'm claiming 17 I'm the only Son, I'm claiming -- I'm a child molester 18 and all that kind of stuff. 19 Now, it gets -- like for instance, last, last 20 year we -- they were said three times on the news we 21 were going to commit suicide. Did we? 22 23 HENRY: No. 24 DAVID: No.

HENRY: Now, where do these stories come from that you're a child molester?

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1	DAVID: Well, what happens is is that it goes
2	back to, to a young lady that was 12 years old,
3	Michelle.
4	HENRY: Um-hum.
5	DAVID: Okay? And what happened was is that
6	they say that when she was 12 years old that I was
7	having relationships with her and that's not true.
8	HENRY: Who's Michelle?
9	DAVID: Michelle is one, Michelle is one of
10	the Jones girls.
11	HENRY: Okay.
12	DAVID: Now, this was back this is what I
13	mean like she's like, what? Nineteen? How old is she
14	now? Nineteen? Anyway, she's like 19 or so, but you,
15	you'll get to meet her and everything. But, see, what
16	happens is is when certain individuals okay. For
17	instance
18	HENRY: Well, who, who was it that was saying
19	that?
20	DAVID: Marc Breault.
21	HENRY: Who?
22	DAVID: Marc see, he was a student that I
23	had for the first four and a half years
24	HENRY: Uh-huh.
25	DAVID: since 1986 when I first came back
	from Israel with this message.

HENRY: Uh-huh.

DAVID: Now -- so what happens is this, in
the scriptures it talks about a king of the north. In
other words, the last political power that has
capitalistic power reaches over all nations. This
power is the one that's supposed to confront Messiah
because of a message. It says, and he shall have
intelligence with those that forsake the Holy Covenant.

Now, if we could find out what the Holy Covenant is, which we know is the seven seals, then we know that those who forsake it are those who have heard a portion and have not wanted it and have said like, like in Psalms 2, let us break his bands asunder, you know. They don't want it.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: They don't want the truth. They don't want to -- see, if they don't acknowledge that I'm the Son of God by God's Word, then God will not acknowledge them that they're His son. So that's the beauty of this message. You know, after, after I teach -- soon as people look at me like, you know, like wow. It's like Psalms 4 says, stand in awe and sin not. God will hear when I call unto Him.

But they're like, wow, yeah, like man you're Christ. I go well, now, let me explain. There's something more to it than this, you know. It, it

brings out an incredible value in us as a people. 2 HENRY: Um-hum. 3 DAVID: I mean, you know, we got to respect -- we're all sons and daughters of God. I mean 4 5 literally, you know. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 Okay. So, so when I began to show them how I got this, then it goes on to say, you know, 8 thus said the Lord to His anointed, ask Me concerning 9 My sons and the work of My hands. Command ye Me. I 10 have made man upon the earth and forged him from the 11 12 dust of the earth. I have given him My Spirit and I will raise him up and direct all his ways. 13 See, God begins to explain things and, of 14 course, you know, my advantage is that I never was very 15 good in literature, reading or anything, but if -- once 16 I was shown all these things, and it's like wow. It's 17 like whew! You know, the Bible calls the quickening. 18 The quickening is a process of learning where knowledge 19 is implanted -- right into your spectrum of 20 21 comprehension. 22 HENRY: Um-hum. DAVID: It's just like, Bing! You're 23

quickened! Like, I know it all. You know. It's kind

of like -- have you ever seen the movie, "Lawnmower

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Okay. See, Satan is a counterfeiter.

Course Satan has all the money in the world. So see

ever since I started, right?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: With this communication between, you know, Orion and, and myself.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: All of a sudden, everything that I was experiencing -- Satan came out and inspired men in this world to try to counteract and counterfeit it by making movies and stuff. Like "Terminator-2" and all that kind of stuff?

HENRY: Yeah.

DAVID: Where you've got these fighting machines and stuff that just blow everything up and destroy everything? Well, that's the same as what Joel through the prophecies talk about with regards to Messiah and all that. You know, the mind and the world is getting so close to the fulfillment of all the events that the ancients have been inspired to see. In their day they couldn't explain it, because they couldn't explain modern -- modernized, you know, technology.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: They were still (indiscernible) of



the natural realms of social life. That's why God caused Israel to have an economy which revolved around agriculture, you know. The harvest, the feast days, the planting, the sowing, the harvest.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: The offering of the first and second fruits and then such and so forth.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Okay? But in our day the, the time when all the vision, the effect of our vision is at hand, you know, we have to emphasize that well -- not, like in Nahum where it says well, here's a prophecy about Messiah and there are these mighty men and they're in these torches that run like the lightnings and like people up here, they're like looking out the window going like -- they're going look how fast that thing is. 'Cause these guys really cut out real fast.

I mean, it, it's kind of, it's kind of -it's not funny, but it's really exciting for us in the
fact that, you know, here's like little kids still
remaining, a people like looking out here right in our
backyard, you know, and it's, it's such a terrible cost
too, to get to this point and yet here we see this
heavy piece of metal, you know, with men in it, a
chariot right?

HENRY: Um-hum.



DAVID: And you think, man, these things move. And this thing like it can, it can like peel out and shoot across this back field like you wouldn't believe.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: You know, and it said they run like lightnings, right?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And have these flaming torches.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: You know, the next thing, you know, we're, we're hoping not to see, 'cause we already believe God anyway. Okay, God, we believe you. You don't need to do it. You know?

HENRY: Yeah.

DAVID: They don't need to flame for us. Because they'll probably flame in our direction, you know.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And that gun barrel will go right to where the guy's looking, you know, on the, on the screen. And I'm pretty sure they have these things in there also. They have them in Israel, I know that.



HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: So, you know, so like I've had to sit a lot of times and let people tell me and then I'll have to sit there and go, well, that sounds good, but have you ever thought about — and then I start showing them out of the Bible. Like, for instance, the — one of the easiest ones is the sixth seal, which — here in Joel tells about the sun, moon and stars being darkened. Here in Zephaniah, sun, moon and stars being darkened. 


DAVID: See, 'cause in this, in this

DAVID: Now, these seals is to open the blind eyes, to bring out them that are sit in darkness, and out of the prison houses.


HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: They told me what they were going to do, but I realized their bosses are over them. So you might tell me a lot of things and when I get out of here, boy! I may, I may have a real hell, you know.

HENRY: Yeah, I know.

DAVID: But the thing of it is this.

HENRY: No.

DAVID: But -- well, let me explain. Let me just make, make, make it clear.

HENRY: Okay.

DAVID: But -- 'cause this is what I have to remind the people that have believed God through what I have shown them.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Okay? But still nonetheless, we have to keep our eyes single to the glory of God, because, you know, y'all more or less have a harder time to realize that I am taking orders, you see, and that, and that my boss is making decisions on whether not to pounce you or not. HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: -- a certain, you know, a bit, a bit of liberty to, you know, call shots and all that? So, for some reason because of my experience being in this stupid flesh in the first place for so many years and



making so many mistakes, God has given me also a heart, or a liberty, to be able to, to, you know, ask for 3 additional or extra, you know, time in regards for y'all. 5 HENRY: Well, let me ask you this. 6 DAVID: That sounds funny. I know, it's --7 HENRY: Let me ask you this. You know, one 8 of the concerns that I have now is remember when you 9 told me, you know, last night and early this morning about the, the experience that you had with the 10 sheriff's office? 11 12 DAVID: Right. 13 HENRY: Okay. You --14 DAVID: I forgive those guys. That was, that 15 Was --16 Yeah. But you're not thinking that HENRY: 17 that's going to happen again, do you? 18 DAVID: Well, no, not really, but it 19 doesn't --HENRY: Tell me the truth.

That night they were out and a few of them having a few beers, you know, and somebody said that, that they called up on the talk show and they said they were out here at one of the local clubs and three of those guys were in the bar there and they were drinking, you know, Saturday night?

And that they were in there talking about coming out here to Mount Carmel and, and busting us up real good in the morning and it was going to be, you know, they were talking to each other about it and they were laughing about it and, you know, and then this guy said he heard about it and then when it happened it really made him mad because, I mean, they were really sounding -- well, they were just being human, you know what I mean?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: You know, get those bad guys, so to speak.

HENRY: Well, you know, I don't know anything about that, but I can tell you this, you know. The bosses have gone, you know, on TV, on the press conference and said that everybody's safety is paramount. Now, that means that if you tell me right now I'm -- we're ready to come out right now --

18 I mean, you're not going to be put in jail first.

19 You're going to be put in a situation where you are 20 taken care of medically first. Okay?

DAVID: Right.

HENRY: Now, in terms of being put in a situation where you're with some big guy, you know, one of the things that, that you need to understand is, your reputation precedes you. You are, you are a man of the cloth and as such people are going to perceive



2 DAVID: Oh, they're going to --3 HENRY: -- and they're going to want to hear 4 your message. 5 DAVID: They're going to first -- they're 6 going to want to bend me over to show me that I'm 7 nothing. 8 HENRY: Well, you know, I -- you, you 9 can't --10 DAVID: Look, God knows -- I understand what 11 you're saying. 12 HENRY: -- you can't assume that and you -see, that's right. have a stepbrother. 2 HENRY: Do you have any brothers and sisters? 3 DAVID: Well, I have -- like I say, my original father was not -- he was -- I was a mistake 4 child, right? 5 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: Supposedly? 8 HENRY: Um-hum. 9 DAVID: And I got brothers and sisters in Houston that I've never really met but one sister. 10 11 HENRY: Uh-huh. 12 DAVID: And I have the one brother that I was raised with and he, he's a, he's, he's Roger Haldeman. 13 He's always been in and out of trouble. I've always 14 tried to help him. You know, and, you know, he's just 15 -- he, you know, he has problems, you know. He, he, 16 he's gotten to the drug scene and all that. 17 HENRY: Is he in Dallas? 18 19 DAVID: No, he's in, he lives in Tyler. was living in Waco for a while, but --20 21 HENRY: Uh-huh. DAVID: You know, he has -- everywhere he 22 goes he, he finds these people and he's weak in that 23 area. 24 25 **HENRY:** Um-hum. I mean, I've always told him I says, DAVID:



1 | well, Roger, you now, you, you've got to realize that God understands these weaknesses and you have to, you 3 know, you have to fight against them to make them stronger. Anything you exercise in your will is going to be made stronger. 5 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: But, you know, it's just -- I tell 8 you, there's powerful drugs today. Once you do it 9 once --HENRY: Yeah. 10 11 DAVID: -- you're, you're hooked. Um-hum. Now, I -- if you have any 12 HENRY: 13 questions about, you know, what will happen, you need 14 to ask me and if I don't know the answer, I will find 15 answers for you. Okay? And what happens is, if, if it's 24 25 done otherwise, according to the other opposition -- if what I've, what I've already said creates the other



opposition, I already know what happens then too.

2 HENRY: Okay. 3 DAVID: So, you know, it's just like -- the, the more, the more you learn -- you know, the more you -- and then I, I know that Mike too, you know, he's, 5 6 he's got a Catholic background too, you know. 7 HENRY: Um-hum. 8 DAVID: And don't get me wrong, I mean, you 9 know --10 HENRY: Thanks a lot. 11 DAVID: The --12 HENRY: You don't like Catholics, do you? 13 DAVID: No, no, no, no, no. 14 HENRY: Thanks a lot. 15 DAVID: No, no, no. What I'm saying is, like I said -- Antonio Munoz --16 17 HENRY: Um-hum. 18 DAVID: The best people that I've ever known have been Catholics that have treated me good. Antonio 19 Munoz is a devout Catholic. He had a shrine, you know, 20 the Mother Mary in his house and everything. He, he 21 owned a tile company; he did tile work. And like I 22 said, that, that kind of business during the '70s and 23 24 '80s was very, very prominent. 25

He made lots of money and he has a brand new -- well, he has several homes in Dallas, but a brand



new home. He owns them all and when I used to go around to the streets and stuff, you know, after '78, 3 '79, '80, you know, and I used to go and talk to people of my experiences, you know, trying to bring them 5 closer to God, I lived in my car. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: And I would drive and I would go out and I would take on subcontracting and I would do decks 8 or roofing or whatever I could find to do by myself or 9 10 with maybe one other person and make a pocketful of money and then get in my car and, and live a couple of 11 12 months or so without any worries. And I had all the time in the world to talk with people and, and get 13 familiar with, communicate with people. 14 15 HENRY: Where, where was this guy Munoz from? 16 DAVID: Okay. 17 HENRY: Was he --DAVID: Originally he was from Mexico years 18 19 ago. 20 **HENRY:** Was -- is he Hinter or Antonio? 21 DAVID: His, his name is Antonio. 22 HENRY: Okay, Antonio. 23 DAVID: Antonio Munoz. 24 HENRY: And he was from Mexico? 25 DAVID: Yeah.

So we made friends and he found out 21 I didn't have a place to stay so he let me stay there 22 in the shop on the, on the lumberyard grounds. So, you 23 know, I built motors and then one day this guy came 24 along and his name was Eddie Munoz --25

HENRY: Um-hum.



DAVID: -- a young man, you know, kind of nice looking and everything and he came along and he wanted me to build a motor, so, so I did, so his dad, which is Antonio, came by and met me. And so I built some engine stuff for his truck, 'cause he always had these trucks which he used in the business, tile setting and all that. So he wanted me to do one over at his house, so I went over to his house and he told me, he says, he goes -- my name is Vernon, right?

He says, he goes hey, Vernon, then he says, you know you, you work on my truck, you know, and he says I give you some money, he says. I tell you what, he says, you, you don't sleep in your car. You stay here in the night with -- you know, in the house for the night. You know, you stay out in the den there, you know. I said, oh, I can't do that, Mr. Munoz. He goes, no, you, you stay out here. You work on my truck, I give you some money, and you stay at my home, you stay at my house tonight, you know.

So I, you know, I was very grateful and I took a shower and I stayed there and he had his shrine in there, you know, and everything and, and, you know, Hilda was his wife -- beautiful family.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: You know, just really good people and I'd, I'd give him Bible studies, you know, and stuff,



1 you know. 2 HENRY: Um-hum. 3 DAVID: Not, not to what I know now --HENRY: Um-hum. 5 DAVID: -- but to what little light I had back then. 6 7 HENRY: Sure. 8 DAVID: And he'd, he'd sit back and --9 HENRY: See --10 DAVID: -- he'd look at me and smile, you know, and he'd go --11 12 HENRY: See, that's what I --13 DAVID: -- he'd go --14 See, that's what I think is going to HENRY: 15 happen, you know. HENRY: Yes.

DAVID: -- when this, when these young guys back here, who were, you know, who were approximately, 'cause they finally moved, and I'm not calling because I'm so much worried about us, but, I mean -- I'm going to feel awful bad when, when these young men back here, who are sitting back here in this tank, you know, right back here where our trash thing is, which is about -- what is that, about 50 -- what 100 and something feet? About, you know, about 150-175 feet from, you know, a perimeter of our building.

That, that's -- I mean, that's, you know, they're back there and they're, they're back there moving their thing around and revving their motors and they're not supposed to be there, but what I'm saying is what -- it's, it's going to be real sad, 'cause, you know, we've made these negotiations, it's going to be real sad that all of a sudden, you know, something's going to hit them and that tank's not going to be there in complete pieces, you know.

HENRY: What are you talking about?

DAVID: I'm talking about, I'm talking about -- there, there are tanks with, with -- and especially that tank, which is high armored tanks, you know. But





there are also projectiles that can hit that tank and 2 incinerate a part of that tank and blow part of that tank inside that tank and hurt somebody. 3 HENRY: Is that what we want? 5 DAVID: No! That's what I'm saying. 6 don't want that. We want God's will to be done. 7 HENRY: Then --8 DAVID: Okay. HENRY: And, of course, you're going to have, you know, another audience at, you know, at that time, so you're going to have the, the opportunity to have a lot of people listen to you. Okay? Well, now, one of the things I want to go back to is something that you talked about. Now, I want you to tell me, and I know that you could have picked off, you know, some of the guys, you know, before. I want you to tell me that we are going to continue working, you know, for safety.

I don't want, you know, I -- there -- in addition -- see, this perimeter thing that these guys are, are safeguarding is because there's also a lot of curiosity seekers, okay? People want to get close to see what's going on and I'm not just talking about our people. I'm talking about curiosity people, civilians, press people, or whatever. Okay? I want to make sure that nobody gets -- that there is no mistake, okay? Either from your side or our side. But I need you to tell me that you're going to continue in this spirit of cooperation that we've -- that I know that, that you've had.

DAVID: Right. Okay. Here's what, here's what I can guarantee. I can guarantee that if, that if these, if these young men who are driving these tanks





and stuff, you know, stay their proper distance like we asked and stop rolling over our buildings and stuff like this, 'cause see, like I say, a lot of the young 3 men here are looking at this and they're, and, and 5 they, they are, you know, they get angry real quick. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: You know, not like me. I mean, but 8 they have, they've, they're going by the words of the 9 They're not going by the vision that I've been 10 shown. Okay? And they keep forgetting that somebody that's doing that is very ignorant of what they don't 11 12 know. You see? 13 HENRY: Um-hum. 14 DAVID: And so, you know, so they, so they, 15 they, they sit here and, you know, they've all been trained, you know, and they understand some things and 16 stuff like that. And, and they're, and they're like, 17 you know, they get to the point to where they don't 18 19 care if they die. 20 HENRY: I understand. 21 But, you know, they feel like, they feel like that, that this big brother, the big arm of 22 this simple little measly old nation --23 24 HENRY: Um-hum. 25 DAVID: -- you know, is just trying to -- but

I'm trying to -- them, I said, look, this is like --





let's pretend they're little brother. 2 HENRY: Um-hum. 3 DAVID: And we're big brother. HENRY: Um-hum. 5 DAVID: You know, and all they're doing is they're like little brother that's coming out there 6 7 taking your basketball --8 HENRY: Yeah. 9 DAVID: -- and trying to play with it and 10 they're just --11 HENRY: Yeah. 12 DAVID: -- misusing, you know --13 HENRY: Yeah. 14 DAVID: And you have to tolerate that to some 15 degree. 16 HENRY: Yes. 17 DAVID: You know? And the thing of it is is that they're coming out here and they're -- they don't 18 believe in the spirit, you know. The things that are 19 unseen right now at this time are more powerful and 20 bigger than the things that are seen. 21 22 HENRY: Um-hum. DAVID: The events that are to take place in 23 this world, which have sternal, eternal, more or less 24 25 say, consequences --HENRY: Um-hum.





DAVID: -- either for life or death --1 2 HENRY: Yeah. DAVID: -- are things that we need to keep 3 our minds open to realize so, you know, a lot of 4 people, they come run, you know, I'm laying here, like 5 this tanks back here and they're like, you know, 6 they're like oh, oh, oh. And I says, just relax. Just 7 rest in the Lord right now. Now, now utilize 8 9 everything you've learned. 10 HENRY: Yes. 11 I said, we've done everything we could in the first phase to try to get to happen what, 12 13 what -- not to happen what happened --14 HENRY: Well --15 DAVID: -- and it did. 16 HENRY: Yeah. 17 DAVID: So now we already know that much about the nature of these people, but now secondarily 18 is is that what we tried to avoid, they got in front of 19 and now they're out there, you know, and, and in their 20 pride and arrogancy, they're all getting mad and upset, 21 22 you know --23 **HENRY:** See --24 DAVID: -- because, you know, they got their 25 behinds whipped, you know? HENRY: Yeah --





1 DAVID: Which should have never happened. 2 HENRY: Exactly. It's -- let me ask you 3 this. Can I ask you to go beyond and stretch as far as you can stretch and please ask for Divine intervention with as much concentration, sincerity as you can, because I think one of the things that is happening is 6 7 young people are under strain and young -- for young 8 people, patience is very difficult. 9 DAVID: Right. 10 HENRY: Can you please stretch and see if you 11 can get your message now so that we can get everybody out of there now, before people -- these young people 12 13 reach the limit to their patience? Please. 14 DAVID: Well --15 HENRY: Do me that favor. Can you tell me that you'll try to --16 DAVID: -- that's what I've been doing every 17 day and every night. 18 19 HENRY: David, please. 20 I really, really am. And then DAVID: I am. my god says wait. See you don't know about these gods. 21 22 HENRY: What I do know is what you've told me. And one of the things that you told me is that you 23 were in a situation where you were at your wit's end 24 and you reached out to God and He responded to you. 25 DAVID: That was earlier in life.



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1 HENRY: I --2 DAVID: That was simple. That was, that was 3 no problem stuff. But my, my, my level of maturity in handling problems came through many different simple 5 events till finally, today, resting totally in the Word 6 of God, not just by a bunch of words that I have tried 7 to interpret, but by being shown, you know, the whole 8 picture --9 HENRY: I understand. 10 DAVID: -- now my concern is that -- well, like Elijah said to his servant, fear not, they that --11 us are more than they that be with them, for they are 12 flesh and blood, for our side is Spirit. 13 14 HENRY: That's right. 15 DAVID: Okay? HENRY: And we, we have a lot of Doubting 16 Thomas', you realize that, you know. 17 18 Oh, yeah. I -- me and you, we're DAVID: one, one communication, one bloodline, but some of the 19 20 other bloodlines are clotted. HENRY: Exactly. And that's why we need for 21 you to, even though you can't get down on your knees, I 22 want you to, in your mind, be down on your knees so, so 23 that --24 25 DAVID: Well, I'm on my back, looking upwards --



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HENRY: (Laughter.)

DAVID: -- and, and waiting.

HENRY: I, I really, I really feel that there is an awful lot of people that are on, you know, that are under pressure, because of the waiting. And I'm not talking about you and me. I'm talking about the young people, you know, within the compound and the young people outside of the compound.

DAVID: Yeah.

HENRY: You know? So, if there's anything that you can do to speed the process up, I tell you, you know, I think it'll be in the best interest and, and everybody will be served, you know, greatly because your message needs to get out. It needs to get out and there are lots of people that you're going to -- whose lives you're going to touch. You've touched a lot, a lot of people's lives, but there are thousands more that you need to touch.

DAVID: Well, it's, it's going to be, going to be definitely worked out. That's for sure.

HENRY: Good.

DAVID: So that's why, like I said, I was just simply bringing up that like last night, you know, these guys that are creeping around out here, thinking they're hiding and all that, they're not.

HENRY: Um-hum.





DAVID: You know, and the darkness doesn't 1 cover them and the, and the fog doesn't. It covers 2 3 them to a degree. HENRY: Yeah. 5 But there's a certain point of degree to where, you know, you know, infrared and stuff like 6 7 that, you know, you can just about today purchase from like Excaliber and places like that. 8 9 HENRY: Um-hum. DAVID: Just about any of the, you know, 10 Series 1, Series 2, or Series 3, you know, technical 11 12 scoping and stuff like that. 13 HENRY: Uh-huh. 14 DAVID: And, of course you know there's, there's, there's units that you can sense, you can 15 sense when you're using infrared and stuff like that. 16 17 HENRY: Um-hum. 18 DAVID: But it's not so much that as it's when you're using the, the shadowed light, you know, 19 the, the lights that have the, you know, you, you, you 20 21 put a filter on them and --22 HENRY: Uh-huh. 23 DAVID: -- then you're able to see. 24 HENRY: Uh-huh. 25 So, you know, you know, and like, DAVID: like -- okay, this tape back here -- it's not there

now. It's, it's been moved and that makes everybody more at rest. You know, it's kind of like someone out 2 there sticking their tongue at you --3 HENRY: (Laughter.) 5 DAVID: -- you know, the thing is it shouldn't, it shouldn't, it shouldn't, it shouldn't 6 7 hurt our feelings --8 HENRY: I know what you're saying. 9 DAVID: But the thing of it is is that, you 10 know, I just don't want, you know --11 HENRY: Yeah. 12 DAVID: -- to make a bad thing worse --13 HENRY: Exactly. 14 DAVID: -- by, by somebody out there finding out a hard way that you, you don't violate, you don't 15 violate trust and promises like that by doing those 16 things, 'cause that stuff is made out of, you know, 17 18 high-strengthened steel --19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: But, you know, there are things that, you know, are available, you know, whether illegal or 21 elegal (phonetic), you know. They are available that 22 can, that can penetrate those little buggies out there. 23 24 HENRY: Um-hum. 25 DAVID: You know? HENRY: Um-hum.



DAVID: And, and the thing of it is is like I say, you know, it's a government -- it's, it's a political thing now. It's a political thing to where, you know, my god is a political ruler and, and I am, I am embannered to my god. Now, I would not be doing this if what I had experienced was not true.

HENRY: Well --

DAVID: If, if I did not know this god, and if the president of the United States had come to me one day and says, you know, Mr. Howell, I want you to work with the United States of America, you've been a good citizen. I've, I've seen your report cards. You've been a good citizen and I want you to work on a tactical force with the FBI and I want you to help deal with, with bad guys and everything and I'd like to give you this position and then, then that's -- I would have been so honored and so proud that somebody would have overlooked my apparent bad English and bad history, you know what I mean?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And bad spelling and all that and would have looked basically at my citizenship and my commitment, you know, and to give me such a position. And then, then I would be where you're at right now.

HENRY: Uh-huh.

DAVID: And some, some other goofy would be

1 | where I'm at right now.

HENRY: Um-hum. Well, see, one of the things though is, as a matter of fact, on behalf of the FBI and on behalf of the ATF, I am asking you, you know, to help us with this situation that we have at hand.

DAVID: Right.

know, that you have helped us, because like you said, you've, you've kept the young guys within the compound who feel that they're being taunted, you know, and could have picked off some of these guys, you, you've kept them from doing that. Now, I, I ask you with all sincerity, to please do whatever you need to do so that we can bring this thing to a conclusion as soon as possible. I think that the world needs to hear your message and it will hear your message. And I look forward to that. I will continue to follow what happens to you from now on.

DAVID: Well, that's good. I hope so. But, you know, that wisdom, you know, can, can you, can you imagine being a big macho guy and standing before God in the judgment and there has to be a woman there too?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Isn't that wild?

HENRY: Really.

DAVID: And to think that the way we treated

women is the way we're going to be judged in the 2 judgment? 3 HENRY: Um-hum. DAVID: Oooh. 5 HENRY: I know it. 6 DAVID: And you know --7 HENRY: I know --8 DAVID: -- all -- a lot of Hebrews, see, they already know about -- key to being feminine, but, you 9 10 know, the Greek and the Roman systems, they were very, 11 you know, they were paganistic and they were very masculine-predominant in their religions. 12 13 HENRY: Uh-huh. 14 DAVID: And they, they just totally went to the manuscript and -- especially the Aramaic New 15 Covenant manuscript, and everywhere the, the Shekhina 16 17 was brought to pass, which is the spirit that Christ refers to, Chachma Wise Woman --18 19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: -- they change it to masculine. change it to Paraclete Numa, made it either the spirit 21 of neuter or masculine. That's funny how people can 22 decide, well, I don't like God in the concept of being 23 male and female and being a family. 24 25 HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: That's where the Star of David



1 originally originated from. It, it based itself in two
2 triangles linked together --

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: -- an incorporation of what the pyramids were. It showed that at each angle or pivot there was a connection between the father, the mother, both coming together into one, the offspring. So the symbol of the Star of David was the family in heaven being united with the family on earth. That's why they interlock together, making the six sides of the pointed Star of David.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Of course, you know they -- some people consider that to be a cultic sign, but of course, anything in the world that you look at and have regard to, not knowing the meaning or significance to the reality of it, is a cultic sign. Even if it's a cross of Jesus.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: You know?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: So anyway, I'm going to go ahead and let you go and in the morning Heather will be coming out.

HENRY: At first light?

DAVID: Yeah, you know. Give, give us a



little chance to, to crank up in the morning. HENRY: Okay. 3 DAVID: And --4 HENRY: Are you coming out with Heather? 5 DAVID: I, I can't answer that right now. 6 Possibly. Maybe. I don't know. 7 HENRY: Okay. 8 DAVID: I mean I'm being --9 HENRY: I want you to --10 DAVID: -- honest with you now. 11 HENRY: Okay. I want you, I want you to work 12 towards that. I really --13 I've been praying every day which DAVID: plan. Okay. Let me explain. In the prophecies, 14 Isaiah 28 for instance. Well, let me just go back. 15 From the time of Moses, God refers and says, Moses, 16 Moses. The prophecies all throughout the prophetic 17 rise of the scripture, and this is very unique and a 18 mystery that I've shown to a lot of people, the 19 prophecies stutter. Statements are repeated twice. 20 21 all the prophecies. Now, a person might not even know this or 22 not, not -- may not be aware of it for the longest 23 time --24 25 HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: But of course in the prophecies



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Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen?

HENRY: Um-hum.

3 DAVID: Isaiah 28 talks about a strong and mighty one that God raises up, that's going to be as a 5 overflowing scourge, as tempest and hail, and you know, mighty fire overflowing that's going to cast down to 6 the ground the crown of pride. And it says that, that 7 it'll be as an overflowing scourge that the wicked --8 it'll be like their beds will be too short to sleep in. You know, so God says -- about this event, God says, 10 whom shall he teach knowledge and who shall he make to 11 understand doctrine? 'Cause the whole subject revolves 12 around all the prophecies about this event. 13

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: It says them that are weaned from the milk and drawn from the breast, for precept must be upon line upon line, precept upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little. For with stammering lips -- stammer means stutter, right?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And all the prophecies do this. They all come to a point of importance and it repeats itself twice.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: In another tongue when he speaks to



this people to whom he said, this is the rest where ye shall cause the weary to rest and this is the refreshing, but yet they would not hear. Now, the seventh day of the Lord thy God is the day where we find rest. God's commanded a law that thou shalt work six days, but on the seventh day, it's the day of the Lord thy God. And he explains that God made heaven and earth in six days and chose a day to sit back and have a good time. Right?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And so what happens is that many people, they, they don't really know which day the Sabbath is. Some people are not even convicted on it, but, but, but nonetheless, one day of the seven God commands to have a day that's dedicated to God. Right?

HENRY: Right.

DAVID: But Christ says the Sabbath is not made -- man is not made for the Sabbath, the Sabbath is made for man. Now, on the original Sabbath, Eve was created in the evening of the sixth day, wasn't she?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Adam had already been hired in the Garden of Eden and already had a job, hadn't he?
Naming the animals.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: But the scripture says there was no



1 help meet for Adam. Now, Adam just didn't know what to do, did he? So, the Lord God caused Adam to rest. A deep sleep fell upon Adam and while Adam was resting, God began to work to form the Shekhina, or to reveal 5 the mystery of the inner man. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: You see? And now God formed the woman and brought them to the man and he says, now this 8 9 is Isha, for out of man she was taken. For she is bone 10 of my bone and flesh of my flesh. In other words, now I'm complete. 11 12 HENRY: Um-hum. 13 DAVID: Now, the Bible commands the Sabbath 14 to be observed from even to even, okay? 15 HENRY: Um-hum. 16 So on that sixth day as the sun began DAVID: 17 to dawn -- I mean, the sun began to draw into the evening, Lylatov, what took place was is that God 18 commanded the man and the woman to enter into the 19 20 Sabbath covenant. 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 So, now, you know what that was, DAVID: 23 don't you? 24 HENRY: What now? 25 DAVID: The Sabbath covenant.

HENRY:

Oh.



DAVID: Well, that's, that's the whole purpose of the Sabbath.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: A memorial of the living God. God's made -- God made man after God's image and to God's likeness, right?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Well, in Isaiah 58, Isaiah is commanded to proclaim a message of Israel, saying lift up thy voice like a trumpet, you know, lift up thy trumpet, show my people trans -- show my people their transgression and the house of Jacob their sins.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And God says, this is the fast that I have chosen, for you to bow your head as a bulrush and to spread ashes underneath you and to hang your head, you know, and to grow mournfully. God says is, is this not the Sab -- the fast I've chosen for you to, to feed the hungry and to clothe the naked and those that are cast out into your home and to hide not yourself from your own flesh?

Now, the Sabbath day is a day where God blesses mankind with the end of the work of the week and the joys of having husband and wife and they becoming one flesh.

HENRY: Um-hum.





DAVID: That's why the word Shabbat is Abba, 1 which means Father, and Shabbat is feminine, which 2 means the father is in the mother. 3 HENRY: Um-hum. 5 Now, that's pretty nice, isn't it? DAVID: 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: Okay. Now, so what happens is is that Jeremiah talks about lo, the day has come saith 8 the Lord, when Judas shall say, they shall use this speech in the Lion of Judah, behold a woman shall 10 compass a man. Now, you know when a, when a man and a 11 woman are together, united together --12 13 HENRY: Uh-huh. 14 DAVID: -- the man is complete in the woman, 15 isn't he? 16 HENRY: Um-hum. 17 DAVID: Okay. You see? Now, that's the memorial to the god of creation. 18 19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 Now, when the -- Constantine and them DAVID: changed the, the laws of God, they took on a different 21 22 spirit. 23 HENRY: Um-hum. DAVID: And they proclaimed the first day of 24 the lunar week as the Sabbath, which was Sunday, and 25 that institution went on and took in additional laws



being inspired from a different spirit and they began 2 to command men not to marry. And of course what 3 happens is the natural purposes of creation, these men entered up into all kinds of problems, such as homosexuality in the priesthood and things like that. You know, Martin Luther, though, he, he began to 7 research and he, he put things back right by mar -- by 8 marrying Catherine Van Borne (phonetic sp.) in 1525. I 9 -- that's a beautiful story. Have you read it? 10 HENRY: Um-hum. 11 Yeah, you know, he, he was going to DAVID: give her to somebody else and she says, no, Luther, I'm 12 going with you. So -- you know it's funny how people 13 can get wild ideas about things and they can think --14 15 HENRY: Hold on a second. Hold on a second. 16 DAVID: -- something's true. 17

HENRY: Hold on a second. Hold on --

DAVID: Sure.

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Listen. They just gave me a message **HENRY:** here -- hold on a second. Okay. Some of those tanks are going to be moving around during the night, but they want me to, to tell you that, that it's going to be routine in terms of, of the shifting of the, you know, a shift change and to ensure that the perimeter is okay, nobody's going to come in there or anything. But they want you to know that there's no danger to



anybody in the compound. 2 DAVID: Okey doke. 3 HENRY: Okay? DAVID: Let me, let me get the message But tell them, just please be careful. 5 around. 6 HENRY: I will. 7 DAVID: Okay? 8 HENRY: I will. 9 DAVID: I, I appreciate that. 10 HENRY: Okay. DAVID: 'Cause if something messes up on this 11 side or on your side, then World War III again. 12 13 HENRY: No, we don't need that. 14 DAVID: You know what I mean? HENRY: We do not need that. 15 DAVID: I know. It's crazy. Let's, let's 16 let, let's, let's look at these passages of 17 scripture I've been sharing with you --18 19 HENRY: Yes. DAVID: -- and I wish your other agents, they 20 would look at them and, and, you know, take a look at 21 them and, and, you know, it would be so awesome if 22 everyone could just sit down and have --23 24 HENRY: I know. 25 DAVID: -- one honest Bible study in this great nation of America.



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Well --HENRY:

DAVID: You know, America does not have to be 3 mutilated or destroyed.

HENRY: Well, you're right, see --

DAVID: It can be exonerated still above all

other nations. 6

HENRY: And that's why I'm telling you, that's why I'm telling you, because one of our weaknesses is the number of people that we have in, in prisons. Okay? Here you have a perfect opportunity to make a difference. You know? For people that are forgotten, that nobody cares about.

DAVID: Well, no one is forgotten in God. That's for sure.

HENRY: Well, I know but I'm saying within, you know, within our system here, within our system here, who -- you know, there's very few clergy that go into the prisons to, to teach the Word. I don't know why. You know, I mean, it shouldn't be that way, but that's the way that it is. It's a shame. The flock should be growing and, and instead, you know, the -it's the other way around. Peop -- more and more people are moving away from the religion. And that's that, you know, I think that's that's one of the problems --

DAVID: That's the abomination of the



churches. They have no knowledge to give them. 2 HENRY: Exactly. Exactly. 3 DAVID: Okay. Well, let me get this out to 4 them and --5 HENRY: Okay. DAVID: -- and, and, you know, tell the guys 6 to give us a few minutes out there on your side --7 8 HENRY: Okay. 9 DAVID: -- and we'll get this underway. 10 Okay? 11 HENRY: Okay. 12 DAVID: And I'll, I'll talk to you in the 13 morning. Is that okay? 14 HENRY: Okay. I'll call you in, in the morning at, you know, like I did this morning and we'll 15 16 get --17 DAVID: You ever get any sleep over there 18 where you're at? 19 HENRY: No. I don't get any sleep during the night, you know. I got to be here to make sure if, you 20 know, if you need something I'm, I'm here to respond to 21 you. If you get the word in the middle of the night, 22 you know, you can call me. I want you to be able to 23 24 call me at any hour. 25 DAVID: I see. Okey doke then.

HENRY: You will?



DAVID: Well, yeah, if I need you. HENRY: Okay. DAVID: I mean the thing of it is is that, you know, we've just been telling Jim and all that -today we kind of got hard with him, because, you know, I've, I've allowed, you know, y'all to infringe closer and closer against the original agreements --HENRY: Well, see --DAVID: -- and we've told him --HENRY: -- this, this --DAVID: -- we've said, point blank, we said we don't mind you using your psychology to negotiate with us, but the keynote is this, is that you're fixing to get one of these vehicles out of here blown to

HENRY: We don't want that.

DAVID: -- and then you're going to find

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For God's sakes, don't say that. HENRY:

DAVID: -- you're going to find out --

HENRY: Don't even say that. Don't even say

22 that.

> Well, I know, but see, look. DAVID:

HENRY: See, because what they're trying to do is they're trying to ensure the perimeter, okay? This is not a situation --





1 DAVID: But when we are told --2 HENRY: -- that they're trying to, to threaten you. It's, it's to ensure that nobody --3 4 DAVID: I know. 5 HENRY: -- everybody wants -- there is a lot of people, they're civilians. They're not --6 7 DAVID: But they're not going to be coming 8 right down here right behind our gymnasium. 9 HENRY: Yes, they are. We have to ensure that nobody walks into that place. I mean, when they 10 say that walks in -- you know, they're curiosity 11 seekers. Do you have any idea how many people are 12 13 around this town as a result of this thing? 14 Everybody's going crazy. DAVID: Well, maybe I should send some tee 15 16 shirts out or something. 17 HENRY: Well, you -- I'll tell you what. You'll -- if you come out, you'll be -- and, and you 18 want to sell some tee shirts --19 20 I wouldn't sell them, no. They'll DAVID: put them up and use them for toilet paper. 21 22 HENRY: (Laughter.) 23 DAVID: Oh, boy. 24 I'm telling you, I'm telling you. HENRY: DAVID: We're a mess, aren't we. 25 HENRY: I know it.



1 DAVID: I'm sorry that -- oh, boy. 2 HENRY: Do you know --3 DAVID: This crazy humanity. 4 HENRY: -- you know, the media will do anything for a story. And everybody's curious because 5 6 there's no stories coming out. 7 DAVID: Oh, yeah. No matter, no matter how 8 it hurts anybody. I know. 9 HENRY: I know. 10 It's, it's sad, but you know --DAVID: 11 HENRY: Listen --12 DAVID: -- God's got it underway. 13 HENRY: Listen.
