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(Tape 75) 1 2 DAVID KORESH: -- for I, saith the Lord, will be unto her a wall of fire round about and I'll be the 3 glory in the midst of her. That's how we identify. 5 Ho, ho, come forth and flee from the land of the north, saith the Lord, for I have spread you abroad as the 6 7 four winds of heaven saith the Lord. Deliver thyself, 8 O Zion, that dwelleth with the, not ancient, but the daughter of Babylon. For thus saith the Lord of hosts. 9 After the glory have they sent me into the nations 10 which spoiled you. Now what is this glory, do you 11 think? 12 JOHN: I don't know. 13 DAVID KORESH: Remember the white horse? 14 15 JOHN: Sure. DAVID KORESH: The truth was hearken, O 16 17 daughter, and consider, right? 18 JOHN: Um-hum. DAVID KORESH: And all those who believe in 19 that truth are going to be the bride of Christ, aren't That's the glory. The marriage of the Lamb. 21 For he that toucheth you, those who hurt the people 22 that believe --23 JOHN: Go over that again, David. 24 DAVID KORESH: Okay. For thus --25 JOHN: That para -- 8.

DAVID KORESH: Okay. Verse 7. Let's start 1 2 with there. 3 JOHN: All right. DAVID KORESH: See, remember. God's people 4 are scattered amongst the nations during this time. 5 Um-hum. 6 JOHN: 7 DAVID KORESH: Deliver thyself, O Zion, that dwells with the daughter of what? 8 9 JOHN: Babylon. 10 DAVID KORESH: For thus saith the Lord of 11 After the glory hath he sent me unto the nations which spoiled you. So the message has to go 12 13 around, doesn't it? For he that toucheth you, toucheth 14 the apple of his eye. It's like trying to poke God --15 your finger in God's eyeball. 16 Now, you'll find out here in a little bit how God sees. For, behold, I will shake my hand upon them. 17 You know what's in God's hand, don't you? A book. 18 19 JOHN: Now, how did, how did you -- what did you say about the apple of his eye? 20 21 DAVID KORESH: Now, you see --22 And I'm reading it. I'm following it JOHN: 23 with you. DAVID KORESH: Okay, okay. 24 25 JOHN: However --

DAVID KORESH: The pupil --

JOHN: -- how do you get the state -- the, 1 the statement, the slang that you've heard and I've 2 heard that somebody is the apple of their eye, you 3 Their child is the apple of the eye. 4 DAVID KORESH: Well, actually, actually in 5 the Hebrew the terminology refers to --6 JOHN: Uh-huh. 7 8 DAVID KORESH: -- refers to the pupil. a little round thing in the eye. 9 JOHN: Okay. 10 DAVID KORESH: You see? Poking someone 11 directly in the eye. 12 13 JOHN: Okay. DAVID KORESH: Okay? Now, so the hand God --14 see, those that don't believe the seven seals will not 15 know, who this angel is that spoke with Zechariah. 16 they won't know who I am either. You see? So, when, 17 when the judge throws the book at you, that means all 18 the laws are going to get you in trouble, right? 19 20 JOHN: Uh-huh. DAVID KORESH: For, behold, I will shake my 21 hand upon them and they shall be a spoil to their 22 servants. Like in the Book of Nahum. The belligerent 23 power comes in to scatter, you know, and God's people 24 were there at the mercy of God because they in -- like 25 in Psalms 18, they're too strong for us. What happens

is God intervenes and makes an example of the
belligerent power, brings that nation to an end and all
other nations realize that there is a living and true

God.

And ye shall know that the Lord of hosts has sent me. Sing and rejoice, O daughter of Zion. This is where the 144,000 begin to be sealed, because the Lord's going to choose the Jews again. For, lo, I come and I will dwell in the midst of thee, saith the Lord, and many nations shall be joined to the Lord in that day. See, it's not the end of the world yet. It's just the end of a few individuals that will not believe the truth.

And shall be my people and I will dwell in the midst of thee and thou shall know that the Lord of hosts has sent me unto thee. And the Lord shall inherit Judah his portion in the holy land, and shall choose Jerusalem again. Be silent, O all flesh before the Lord, for he is raised up out of his holy habitation.

Now, so we know the Father's going to rise up off his throne, don't we? Like in Psalms 18. Now, we know this man on the red horse was Christ before he became flesh. We know that the subject is God's still going to rule in Jerusalem, but one of the signs is going to be, he's going to be a wall of fire around

1 about Jerusalem. We need to know about it ahead of 2 time.

And he showed me Joshua, the high priest, standing before the angel of the Lord and Satan standing at his right hand to resist him. You know how Satan is, right?

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID KORESH: And the Lord said unto Satan, the Lord rebuke thee, O Satan, even the Lord that hath chosen Jerusalem rebuke thee. Is not this a brand plucked out of the fire?

Now, Joshua represents a person that's not so holy, but he wants to be saved, don't he? Now, Joshua was clothed with filthy garments and stood before the angel. And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him saying, take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, behold, I have caused iniquity to pass from thee and I will clothe thee with a change of raiment.

Doesn't Christ have power to forgive? And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments and the angel of the Lord stood by. And the angel of the Lord protested unto Joshua, saying, thus saith the Lord of hosts. If thou wilt walk in my ways and if thou wilt keep my charge, then thou shalt also

judge my house and thou shalt also keep my courts and I will give thee places to walk among these that stand 2 3 by. Now, how will Joshua know God's ways and God's laws? How will he know? Hear now, O Joshua the 5 high priest, thou, and thy fellows that sit before 6 thee, for they are men wondered at. People can't 7 figure these guys out. For behold I will bring forth 8 my servant the Branch. Now, that's another mystery. But the only way we know that mystery is this. 10 behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua -- you 11 know who the stone is, don't you? 12 JOHN: Who are we talking about in, in 8? My 13 servant the Branch? DAVID KORESH: Well, that's what we're 15 getting to. You won't know who the Branch is until you 16 know verse 9. 17 All right. 18 JOHN: 19 DAVID KORESH: For behold the stone. 20 the rock in heaven? The Father.

JOHN: The Father.

DAVID KORESH: That I have laid before

23 | Joshua. Joshua was shown this vision. Upon one stone

24 | shall be how many eyes?

JOHN: Seven.

DAVID KORESH: How many eyes does the Lamb

have? JOHN: 2 Seven. 3 DAVID KORESH: How many seals does the Father have? 4 JOHN: Seven. 5 DAVID KORESH: Behold, I will engrave the 6 7 graving thereof. Who writes on this rock? God's rock is his truth, isn't it? So God says he's the writer, 8 just like in Psalms 45, saith the Lord of hosts and I'll remove the iniquity of that land in one day. 10 Awesome! Learn the seven seals and the truth will make 11 you free. God will not make mention of any of your 12 13 sins you ever committed, you'll be thoroughly forgiven, and you'll be set free. 15 In that day, saith the Lord of hosts, ye shall call every man his neighbor under the vine of the 16 17 fig tree. We don't like war. Just like Isaiah 2 and Micah 4 teaches in the last days. There's no reason 18 Okay. Now here's the next key. 19 for war. 20 JOHN: Well, I don't think any sane, 21 rationale person does, do they? 22 DAVID KORESH: No, they shouldn't. 23 JOHN: No. DAVID KORESH: And the angel that talked with 24 me came again, and waked me as a man wakened out of his 25 sleep. So what happened to Zechariah when he heard

this? I mean, you know, Zechariah was back when they 1 were keeping the law and all that. All those rules and 2 regulations, you know, to be righteous. But here he 3 sees a plan that deals with God, seven eyes, you know, the rock. And all we have to know is about this 5 Branch, right? And we on -- we can only know about 6 7 this Branch if we know about the stone, right? You know what a branch is, don't you? You're a father? 8 JOHN: 9 Sure. You have a wife? 10 DAVID KORESH: JOHN: Sure. 11 12 DAVID KORESH: Well, you have an offspring, don't you? 13 14 JOHN: Several. DAVID KORESH: The branch. Your children. 15 16 JOHN: Uh-huh. DAVID KORESH: Is the son, is the Branch. 17 It's like Jeremiah says, in that day will I cause the 18 19 branch of righteousness to grow up into David and this is the name wherewith he shall be called the Lord our 20 righteousness. And then it talks about his wife. 21 22 that day I will cause the branch of righteousness to grow up into David and this is the name where she shall 23 be called the Lord our righteousness. You know, the marriage of the Lamb. Beautiful. It's a great party. 25 I want you to come, but you got to learn about it

1 | first.

Now, so Zechariah, he passes out, like this is a far better plan than the law of Moses. He said to me, what seest thou. And I said, I have looked and behold a candlestick all of gold, with a bowl upon the top of it, and his seven lamps thereon. In other words, I've seen the light! I've seen the light! You know what this lamp represents, don't you? Psalms 18, the Lord will light my candle. The seven candles. The seven spirits of God. The seven eyes of the Lamb. The seven spirits of God. One and the same thing. The way Christ sees is the way God sees. That's the light of the world.

Now, and his seven lamps thereon and seven pipes to the seven lamps upon the top thereof and -- here's the real neat thing. And two olive trees by it. One upon the right side of the bowl and the other upon the left side thereof. So I answered and spake to the angel that talked with me saying, what are these, my lord? Then the angel that talked with me answered and said unto me, knowest thou not what these be? And I said, no, my lord. But he answered and spake unto me saying, this is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel.

See, yedabubel (phonetic sp.) means those who come from Babylon, saying not by might nor by power, but by my spirit said the Lord of hosts. So whatever

the seven seals contain, no matter what the hand of God contains, God is going to finish it. Now this great mountain is called Babylon -- great mountain Babylon 3 Jeremiah talks about in all the prophets? 4 thou, O great mountain before Zerubbabel? Those who 5 believe in God's word --6 The mountain is Babylon you say? 7 JOHN: DAVID KORESH: Oh, yeah. The fiery 8 mountain --9 I thought they said -- earlier it was JOHN: 10 an area, an area of Babylon and there was a city within 11 the area. 12 DAVID KORESH: No, no, no. See, see, for 13 lack of knowledge of the prophetic language --14 15 JOHN: Uh-huh. DAVID KORESH: Ba -- a mountain is a 16 difficulty. A mountain is something that's hard to get 17 over and God calls this Babylon the great mountain. 18 shall become a burnt mountain. God says he's going to 19 bring it down to the ground. Now, who -- whatever this 20 mountain is, before Zerubbabel is will become a what? 21 Plain. For he shall bring forth the headstone. 22 really in charge of the empires of men? Who really has 23 the final say? 24 JOHN: The Lord. 25

DAVID KORESH: God.

Therefore with shoutings

crying grace, grace unto it. You see, we want Babylon to fall mercifully, not with war. Not with God's judgments, but with truth. The truth will enlighten our eyes to see the importance of these seven seals.

Moreover the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, the hands of Zerubbabel laid the foundation of this house, his hands shall also finish it, and thou shalt know that the Lord of hosts has sent me to you. For who

hath despised the day of small things.

You know, like today we don't care about this world. For they shall rejoice and see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven. They are the eyes of the Lord, which run to and fro through the whole earth. So you got to see the way the Lamb sees, don't you? Seven seals, right? Then answered I and said unto him, what are these two olive trees upon the right side of the candlestick and upon the left side thereof?

And so again it says, what be these two olive branches which through the golden pipes empty the golden oil out of themselves. And he answered and said unto me, knowest thou not what these be and I said, no. Now pay attention. Then he said, these are the two annointed ones that stand by the Lord of the whole earth.

Well, let's turn right here to Revelation 11

real quick and let's see what happens to these two See when this will meet its fulfillment. 2 witnesses. 3 JOHN: Go ahead. DAVID KORESH: Remember, 2,000 years ago when 4 5 Christ walked on the earth he had some help, didn't he? 6 On the Mount of Transfiguration, do you remember who appeared to him? With his disciples? Moses and 7 Elijah, right. 8 9 JOHN: Okay. 10 DAVID KORESH: Okay. Now, we already know in 11 Chapter 10 that the mighty angel's going to come down having a book in his hand, right? 12 13 JOHN: Sure. Remember that? 14 DAVID KORESH: 15 JOHN: It's right there. 16 DAVID KORESH: Okay. And we know in verses 7 17 of chapter 10 from the days of the voice of the seventh 18 angel when he begins to sound the mystery of God, those 19 seven thunders, those seven seals, should be finished. How? 20 21 JOHN: As he hath --DAVID KORESH: Declared to his servants, the 22 23 prophets. 24 JOHN: Sure. Okay. Now, during this period 25 DAVID KORESH:

of time in chapter 11 there was given to me a reed like

unto a rod and the angel stood saying, rise and measure
the temple of God. Now, we know that in Zechariah's

prophecy the young man was trying to see how big

Jerusalem was. But God set him straight by saying, no,

5 Jerusalem will be inhabited with men as towns without

6 | walls, because God will be a wall of fire around about

7 | it. So we can't mistake that coming, right?

Now, the altar we know is in the sanctuary. Okay?
Well, this temple of God is in heaven and we can come up hither, because the door is open, especially when the Lamb comes because the Lamb's message is to direct our minds, not to tabernacles made by the hands of men, but to the truth that's been developed by the testimony of God, heavenly places. We've got to come within ourselves and find truth, don't we? The kingdom of God is not within you. By knowing the truth first, you won't be in the kingdom of God.

Now, but the court which is without the temple leave out and measure it not, for it is given to the Gentiles and the holy city shall they tread under foot forty and two months. And I will give power unto my two witnesses as they shall prophecy a thousand two hundred and three score days, clothed in sackcloth.

Now, these guys don't make much money, do they? Huh?

JOHN: They're not expected to.

DAVID KORESH: Exactly. Who are these witnesses? Who are these two annointed ones? These are the two olive trees. Oh, remember Zechariah? And the two candlesticks standing before the God of the earth. This is exactly what Zechariah said, right? And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth and devoureth their enemies, and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy. Just like Elijah, right? And have power over the waters to turn them to blood and to smite the earth with all plagues as often as they will. Just like Moses, right? No wonder Moses and Elijah appeared to Christ, right? Two thousand years ago.

And when they shall have finished their testimony, mind you in sackcloth. I mean, nobody thinks they're worth anything, right? The beast — the nasty old beast — that ascends out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them and shall overcome them and kill them. And their dead bodies shall line the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt. Not literal Sodom, not literal Egypt, but spiritually they're the same thing.

Where also our Lord was crucified. And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations

shall see their dead bodies three days and a half and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves. And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them and make merry and shall send gifts one to another, because these two prophets tormented them that dwell on the earth. And after three days and a half, the spirit of life from God entered into them and they stood upon their feet and great fear fell upon them which saw them.

and they heard a great voice from heaven saying come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud and their enemies beheld them. And the same hour was there a great earthquake and the tenth part of the city fell and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand and the remnant were frightened and gave glory to the God of heaven. The second woe is past and behold the third woe cometh quickly. And the seventh angel sound — remember, this is the last trumpet of the seventh seal, remember?

In the seventh seal the seven trumpets are revealed. Now, here's the last trumpet. The seventh angel sounded and there were great voices in heaven saying, the kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord and of his Christ, and he, Christ, shall reign for how long?

JOHN: Ever.

DAVID KORESH: And ever. And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces and worshipped God, saying we give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come because thou has taken to thee thy great power and hast reigned. And the nations were angry. Remember Psalms 2? And thy wrath is come and the time of the dead, that they should be judged. Thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants, the prophets, and to the saints, and to them that fear thy name, small and great, and should destroy them which destroy the earth.

And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament and, this is the serious one up hither, and there were lightnings, voices of thunder, and an earthquake and great hail. There appeared a great wonder in heaven and behold — oh, this is my mother here, John. I know you don't know her, but nonetheless — a woman clothed with the sun, the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars.

And she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered. And there appeared another wonder in heaven and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns and seven crowns upon his heads. His tail drew the third part of the stars

of heaven and did cast them to the earth, and the dragon which stood before the woman, which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born. And she brought forth a man child who was to rule all nations with a what? Rod of iron -- remember Psalms 2?

JOHN: Um-hum.

unto God and to his throne. Okay. Now, nations.

There's a nation in heaven fighting. You know, war started off in heaven first. Remember that. Sin, sin started in heaven, it didn't start on earth. Remember that? So we look at chapter 13 when (indiscernible) stands upon the sand of the sea and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, upon his horns ten crowns and upon his heads the names of blasphemy.

The beast which I saw was like to a leopard.

Huh! That was what Daniel says was a nation of Grecia

His feet the feet of a bear was Medo-Persia. His

mouth, the mouth of a lion, that was Babylon. All

commingled I guess. So this is Rome now, see, and the

fourth beast of Daniel says it will devour the other

three beast and become still all four beasts together

as one. And the dragon gave him his power and his seat

and great authority. Who's the dragon? Do you know?

JOHN: Well, I don't know if they're -- who 1 they're referring to, no. Satan. 2 DAVID KORESH: Satan. Okay. 3 Let me ask you before you go any 4 further. 5 6 DAVID KORESH: Sure. In, in chapter 12:2 --7 JOHN: DAVID KORESH: 8 Uh-huh. And she being with child, who's the 9 JOHN: 10 child? DAVID KORESH: Well, the, the same one who's 11 to rule all nations with a rod of iron. 12 Who's the child, David? JOHN: 13 Christ. Christ. DAVID KORESH: The same one 14 as in Isaiah 66. That's me. Second time around. 15 16 JOHN: Okay. DAVID KORESH: Now, I know you don't realize 17 that, but let me just read the verse here, let me read 18 19 the verse here of how this works according to Isaiah 66. Okay? In Isaiah 66 -- people think the prophecy 20 of Isaiah was for the Jews, but it's really not. Okay? 21 It says here --22 Where are you? 23 JOHN: DAVID KORESH: Chapter 66 of Isaiah. 24 25 JOHN: Okay. I'm sorry.

DAVID KORESH: Verse 5. It says, hear the

word of the Lord ye that tremble at his word. And wow! Just think, you know, in Psalms 45 the Lamb's a real tough guy, but really he's not. He really wants you just to believe God so we can have a party, be sanctified, be made holy, and made ready for the heavens to come. Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for my name's sake said let the Lord be glorified. That's what people do to me. They say, look, I know the Lord Jesus. I love him very much. You need to know Christ.

I go, now, wait a minute. You know Christ, right? Well, do you know the seven seals? No, I don't need to know that. They don't care. But he shall appear to your joy and they shall be ashamed. Why? Because they don't know the guy their fighting at is really who? Christ. So a voice of noise from the city, a voice from the temple, a voice of the Lord that rendereth recompense to his enemies. Somebody's in trouble, right?

Now, before she travailed -- remember

Revelation 12 -- she brought forth. Before her pain

came, she was delivered of a man child. I mean, Christ

was born in the flesh before he comes back in the

flesh. Yes or no?

JOHN: That's what it says.

DAVID KORESH: Who hath heard such a thing?

Who hath seen such things? Shall the earth be made to bring forth in one day? Yeah. You see, what's going to happen here in the near future, I mean very near, is there's going to be a great big resurrection. And Luther's going to be there and John Knox and Wesley and Campbell and Hush and Jerome and Tyndall and Weinert and a lot of men who sought after truth who Christ has made atonement for them, although not knowing all the truth they still fought for the light and although they were killed and martyred.

there have been faithful people who have stood up for truth and when the Lamb comes he is the resurrection, you know. When he goes through his last passion and when he's rejected because people just don't care about those four horses, do they? Nah! They're at ease, they're sitting back, they don't -- what's that four hor -- ah, we don't care. It might be a revelation of Christ. Well, we love the Lord, we don't care about those horses though.

That's all right. We'll find out about the rock with seven eyes. We'll find out about the candlestick. The light will be made known to all. For as soon as Zion travailed, she brought forth her children. Shall I bring to the birth and not cause to bring forth, saith the Lord. Shall I (indiscernible)

cause to the -- bring forth and shut up the womb, saith
thy God? You'll find out there's going to be a lot of
people coming up out of the ground and they're going to
-- well, I know it sounds kind of crazy as of yet, but
they're going to do some real whooping.

Rejoice you with Jerusalem and be glad with her all ye that love her. Rejoice for joy with her all ye that mourn for her. Now, anyway, we find out over here that this will take place in verse 15 -- for, behold, the Lord will come with fire and with his chariots like a whirlwind. The Psalms will tell you, the prophets will tell you -- there's 20,000 of these -- to render his anger with fury and his rebukes with flames of fire.

Same as Psalms 18 we already heard about.

For by fire and by his sword will the Lord plead with all flesh and the slain of the Lord shall be many, not all. But, you know, they that sanctify themselves.

You see, you cannot sanctify yourselves with your own imagination or your own opinions. You have to come up hither, acknowledge your father who sits on the throne and he's got seven things he wants you to look at.

Otherwise you're going to be in trouble.

And that purify themselves in the gardens behind one tree. Remember when God told Adam and Eve not to partake of that forbidden fruit? So the same is

today. God's telling us there's seven things we've got to know, John. And if we do not listen we're going to taste the full effect of the evil that we've brought upon our ownselves. Okay. Eating swine's flesh and the abomination in the mouth shall be consumed together saith the Lord. For I know their works and their thoughts.

It shall come that I will gather all nations and tongues and they shall come and see my glory and I will set a sign among them. And I will send those that escape of them into the nations. This is where the 144,000, you'll find when you understand this a little more clearer, go to all nations, because there's a lot of people that don't have a chance to know these things. To, to really back up, to get a, a better understanding of these things, we look at 65, verse 1.

And this is where we're at right now. See, there's a lot of people here and a lot of other people that wanted to come here but, you know, I wouldn't let them come, because like I say, things got kind of late in time. But, you know, this is an honest truth. It says, I am sought -- are you there in 65:1?

JOHN: Hang on. I am there.

DAVID KORESH: I am sought of them that asked not for me. I am found of them that sought me not. I mean, nobody knew who I was, John. You know what I

1 | mean? I said, behold me, behold me --

JOHN: Hey, there aren't a lot that do.

DAVID KORESH: I know. But I'm saying,

4 | behold me, behold me to a nation not called by my name.

5 And I have a new name now. I have a new name that

6 | nobody knows but I, myself. But to those who know

7 about the key of David, I will give you my new name.

You know, I have spread out my hands all the day to rebellious people. This I've been doing since 1985, which walking a way that's not good. Do you know what that way is? After their own what? Thoughts. A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face. Right in front of me this has happened to me. That sacrifice in gardens and burn incense upon altars fo brick. Which remain among the graves and lodge in monuments.

I mean, these people, they like to look at Luther's grave and Knox and Wesley -- they like to always build on sepulchers of the dead prophets, of the dead wise men, of the dead reformers. But you know what? These people eat swine's flesh and broth of abominable things is in their vessels. You see clam chowder, oysters, you know, all these things that God says don't eat.

Now, you know, I could forgive people for something like that, you know what I mean?

JOHN: I certainly hope so.

DAVID KORESH: Because, you see, a lot of people don't realize the importance of something like that. But what really causes the anger is that they have the nerve to turn and say stand by thyself. Come not near me for I'm holier than thou. They think they're holier than me and they don't even know who I am yet.

These are a smoke in my nose and a fire that burneth all the day. You know why? In Psalms 45 it says thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things, right? The father gave me the book. I know the book backwards and forwards. Behold, it is written before me. I will not keep silence, but will recompense, even recompense unto their bosom. Your iniquities and the iniquities of your fathers together, saith the Lord, which have burned incense upon the mountains and blasphemed me upon the hills. Therefore will I measure their former works to their bosom and those works are not in harmony with the seals.

DAVID KORESH: Okay. And that furnish the drink offering to that number. Do you know what the number is? Six, six, six. That's the number, my friend. All the prophets talk about the mark of the beast. And if you listen long enough, I'll even show you what the number of that name is. And it's not the Pope either. You can tell these Protestant baloneys that they're no different than the pontiffs.

Now, the Pope is a man like anybody else and I don't condemn anybody. If I could, I'd like to sit down in front of a pontiff and try to show him the seven seals. The pontiff would say, he's a devil, he's

Mount Zion, aren't you? Are you out there preparing a
table for that troop? Are you furnishing drinks for
that number?

Therefore will I number you to the sword and ye shall bow down to the slaughter. You know why?

Because when I called, you did not answer. And when I spake, you did not hear. But you did evil before mine eyes and did choose that wherein I delighted not.

Therefore, let me tell you something said the Lord. My servants shall eat, but you're going to be hungry. My servants are going to drink, but you're going to be thirsty. My servants shall rejoice, but ye shall be ashamed.

My servants shall sing for joy of heart, but you're going to cry for sorrow of heart and howl for vexation of spirit. And you will leave your name for a curse unto my chosen. For the Lord God will slay thee and call his servants by another name. Why? That he who blesseth himself in the earth, shall bless himself in the God of what?

If you take a look 2 and take a listen, God says I will remove the iniquity 3 of -- and one day God said I am more than willing to forgive everybody's iniquities. This is the son's 5 This is the -- have you, have you had enough party. 6 after 6,000 years of doing it your own way? 7 Christ died for you 2,000 years ago. 8 you like it? Do you love this world? Six thousand years later, Christ comes in the latter days. 10 11 the best you can do? Right before the end of the world, this is the best you can do? Because the former 12 troubles are forgotten because they are hid from mine 13 14 eyes.

For behold I create new what? Heavens and a new what? Earth. And the former shall not be remembered nor come into mind. But be ye glad and rejoice forever in that which I create, for behold I create Jerusalem and rejoice in her people a joy. And I will rejoice in Jerusalem and joy in my people and the voice of weeping shall be heard no more in her, nor the voice of crying.

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There shall no more thence be an infant of days or an old man hath not filled his days. For the child shall die an hundred years old, but the sinner being a hundred years old shall be accursed and they

DAVID KORESH: And in the hand of God, there is Christ. And that's why in Psalms 75 it says for in the right hand of God there is a cup. The wine is red. Now, the Word of God is the cup. Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Now, outside on this banner, on this flag that's flying --

Isaiah what? 10 DAVID KORESH: Isaiah, Chapter 13. 11 12 JOHN COX: Go ahead. 13 DAVID KORESH: The burden of Babylon. we don't want Babylon to be destroyed, do we? 14 JOHN COX: Uh-uh. 15 16 DAVID KORESH: So, what Isaiah, the son of Amoz, did see. Lift ye up a banner. Remember Psalms 17 60? 18 19 JOHN COX: Um-hum. 20 DAVID KORESH: A banner is given to his people that it might be displayed because of the truth. 21 22 There's a truth. Right? That thy beloved, which is the lamb, may be delivered. Right? They have kept a 23 banner upon the high mountain. Exalt the voice unto 24 them. Do not think that I will accuse you to the Now, there is one that accused you, even Moses in whom you trust, but had you believed Moses you would havé believed me for he wrote of me. It's found in Deuteronomy 32. As ye believed not his writings, how should ye believe my words? Now, that's not it. Let's just keep going. Okay. Over here in Chapter 6 Christ is confronted again and he states in Verse 29, Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath, what?

DAVID: Sent, okay. He says in Verse 35, I am the bread of life; he that cometh to me shall never

hunger; he that believeth on me shall never thirst. But I said to you, That ye also have seen and believe not. All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; 3 and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. I came down from where? Heaven. 5 JOHN: Heaven. 6 DAVID: Not to do my own will, but the will 7 of him that sent me. And this is the Father's will 8 which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me 10

which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day. And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I raise him up at the last day. Huh. What does that mean?

Now, when a 10 person tells you, now the first seal in Revelation is 11 very symbolic. We understand that Christ is a king. 12 The bow represents his word of God and the horse 13 14 symbolizes the purity of the church. We know the 15 Christian Church went forth conquering, conquering With the spirit of truth. Now, notice the man on the red 16 horse is a symbol of martyrdom. Blood is definitely 17 red. And the sword killing one another was definitely 18 a picture of the wicked slaying the righteous in the 19 time of the martyrdom. Now, baloney. That's not what 20 21 the prophets teach is it, John? No. Those people are seeking their own glory, aren't they? I bet you 22 they're going to pass the plate after they give you 23 their opinion aren't they? Now, I'm speaking my 24 25 Father's words. He showed them to me, he gave them to me. I've already gotten my glory. I'm going to go

back to it and take my real glory back with me those 1 | who believe in the truth. But he that seeketh his 3 glory, that sent him, the same is true, and no unrighteousness is in him. Now -- Verse 24. came the jews round about him, and said to him, how long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly. That's what I get told all the time. Well, are you Christ or not Christ, you the Lamb or what are you, huh? And Jesus answered, I told you, and you believe not the works that I do in my Father's name, they bear witness of me. I'm supposed to reveal the seven seals today, right? Back then we did miracles and all that kind of stuff. But ye believe not, because you're not of my sheep, as I said unto you. My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me and I give unto them eternal life and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one. wrote it, he wrote the word. I am the word, the word is given to the people who are of the word, you know? So anyway, it says right here, that the Jews took up stones again to stone him. Man, they didn't believe in

As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me, but I kept the matter in my heart. Now, here's the second way it's revealed. Chapter 8, Verse 2 says, I saw in a vision and it came to pass, when I saw, that I was at Shushan in the palace, which is in the province of Elam and I saw in a vision, and I was by the river of Ulai. Then I lifted up mine eyes, and saw, and, behold, there stood before me the river a ram which had two horns. The two horns were high but one was higher than the other, and the higher came up last. I saw the ram pushing westward, northward, southward so that no beast might stand before him. Neither was there any that could

Heard a man's voice between the banks of the Ulai, which called, and said, Gabriel, make this man understand the vision. So don't believe my interpretation, believe Gabriel's interpretation.

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he came near where I stood and when I came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face but he said unto me, understand, 0 son of man for at the time of the end shall be the vision. Now when he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep upon my face towards the ground. Daniel fainted, right? But he touched me and set me upright. He said, behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation for at the time appointed the end shall be. Now, the ram which thou sawest having two horns are the kings of Media and Persia, which was Cyrus and Darius. And the rough goat is the king of Grecia, which was Alexander the Great. And the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king, that's Alexander. Now, that being broken, whereas four stood up for it, four kingdoms shall stand up out of the nation, but not in his power, which, you know, is Kasander, Ptolemy, Lethushemus, Lisinemus (phonetic spellings), these four generals took the kingdom and divided it. And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the (Indiscernible) when everyone is just doing wicked, a king of fierce countenance -- grwwww -- and understanding dark sentences, meaning passages from the scriptures, shall stand up. His power shall be mighty, but not by his own power -- the devil gives it to him. He shall prosper and destroy wonderfully and shall

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prosper and practice and shall destroy the mighty and 1 the holy people, right? Right. And through his 2 policy, which is a lie, also he shall cause craft to 3 prosper in his hand. He shall magnify himself in his heart, and by peace -- remember the lamb-like beast? --5 shall destroy many. He shall also stand up against the 6 Prince of princes. Hi, John. But he shall be broken 7 without hand. Why? Because the rock's going to get 8 him, right? The Father is going to come down and whup 9 he and all of his butts, right? Right. And the vision 10 of the evening and the morning which was told is true, 11 therefore shut up the vision, for it shall be for many 12 days. And Daniel fainted, and was sick certain days. 13 After that, he rose up and and did the king's business, 14 right? Okay. Now, in Chapters 10 and Chapter 11 we 15 get the last picture about this vision, okay? Now, 16 Christ says, When you see the abomination and 17 desolation spoken of by Daniel the Prophet -- now, we 18 know Christ said Daniel is a true prophet, right? 19 Okay. We need to look at some things here. Without an 20 21 understanding of the minor prophets and the major prophets, the Book of Daniel might in some degree be 22 hard to comprehend. It's more for the advanced 23 students. But nonetheless, I'm going to give you some 24 chief verses just to prove a point. Okay. In Chapter 25 10 of Daniel, we see in Verse 14 that Gabriel comes and

says, Now I am come to make thee understand what shall befall they people, when? In the latter days. 2 JOHN: In the latter days. 3 DAVID: For yet the vision is for many days." Um-hum. JOHN: 5 DAVID: Okay? Now, it says in Verse 21, But 6 I will show thee that which is noted, where? In the 7 scripture of truth, right? And there is none that 8 holdeth with me in these things, but Michael your 9 prince. Now, whatever we're going to learn in 10 Chapter 11, remember it has to be backed by Moses, 11 Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Amos, Hosea, Obadiah, 12 13 Zephaniah, right? Amos, all of them, okay? So we're not going to sit here and give you an interpretation by 14 my mouth, but we're going to simply point out some 15 certain points that you might find interesting. Now, 16 17 it says here in Chapter 11, it says here in Verse 27, And both these kings' hearts shall be to do mischief, 18 and they shall speak lies at one table. They that understand among the people shall instruct many; yet they shall fall by the sword, by flame, and by captivity, and by spoil, many days. Now when they shall fall, they shall be (indiscernible) with a little help: but many shall cleave to them with flatteries. Okay?

Now it says over here in verse 36. And the king shall do according to his will; he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god. He shall speak marvelous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

Neither shall regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women. What's -- who's the desire of women? We know Psalms 45, the Lamb, hearken, O

daughter, consider? What girl would not want to marry
the Lamb, right? Or any God. For he shall magnify
himself above all.

But in his estate he shall honour the God of forces. That's military. And a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things. Thus shall he do in the most strong holds. You know, strong, fortified, military. With a strange god, whom we shall acknowledge and increase with glory: he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

Okay. Now what does it mean over here when it says verses 43. He shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver. Pretty nice, isn't it?

JOHN: Um-hum.

DAVID: And of all the precious things of Egypt; and the Libyans and Ethiopians shall be at his steps. But all of sudden, but tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him. Isaiah says I've raised up one from the north, and he shall come from the rise in the sun. I bet that guy's going to rise up and give a message that's going to trouble this guy. Therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many. He shall plant

the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the
glorious holy mountain.

On Mount Zion, what sits on Mount Zion right now, do you know?

STEVE: Dick, truly I believe as the rest 3 here that 6 gallons of milk would have showed up within about an hour. From the way we were talking that day 5 the -- was that you on the other side of the phone? 6 7 I -- it's so many days ago, and it's gone back and forth so many times. I don't -- was it originally put 8 9 out to Henry? I think it was, wasn't it? DICK: It was. 10 11 STEVE: And it seemed like from the response like it was not a big deal. It seemed like it have 12 been just sent right out when we were still bringing 13 14 children out and all the rest. Well, all of a sudden 15 being that it -- well, we're, we're not going to do it Well, see after a while it starts 16 or this or that. 17 becoming a very sour, and I don't mean that to be 18 funny, but a very sour issue. DICK: Well, you know, we've done so many 19 20 positive things for you in return received little or 21 nothing. 22 STEVE: What positive things? You mentioned 23 the sutures, and that's about it. What, what else have 24 you done? 25 DICK: Well, the, the written statement from

David.

STEVE: We have sent Heather. We've sent 1 Kevin. We've sent Mark. 2 3 DICK: Open up the phone line. I mean we opened up communications with you right after the Sunday thing as quickly as possible. 5 STEVE: Wait a minute, now. With that, with 6 7 that phone business, it was our -- we are the ones that initiated with --8 DICK: Absolutely. You asked us to --9 STEVE: -- with you people on the, wait now, 10 with the telephone even in behalf of trying to get your 11 wounded out. 12 DICK: I understand. We appreciate that. 13 14 STEVE: We, we didn't want anybody hurt and wounded in the first place. But in fact, we wanted 15 them to even move quicker than what they were. 16 17 DICK: And that works to your advantage. Absolutely true. Absolutely true. You could have --18 someone could have shot the agent that was down in the 19 back --20 21 STEVE: That's true. 22 DICK: -- and you allowed to bring them out. 23 So that obviously is in your favor. ATF appreciates that as does we -- as do we. You offered -- you asked 24 25 for a couple of other things. Play a tape on national TV and you'll come out. We play the tape. We see no

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1 response. Rita asked play the tape during prime time.
2 And we did. The rest of the children will come out.
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3 No. David wants 150 feet of cord and a telephone. We

4 send it in. In response, we get nothing.

STEVE: No, no. Wait, wait. What that was about -- now let's not, let's not take it out of the context of that it was spoken about. That was asked for for your benefit and mine in that we could communicate without a break in the line.

10 DICK: Okay. Okay.

STEVE: And mostly as much for yourselves as

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13 DICK: Steve, you --

STEVE: Because originally when Jim was talking to me, the phone would stop and break. He says what can we do about it? I says we're -- look. Here, David's going to send some money. He -- the two of them talked it out. And that's why the phone because we'd accept another phone with a line so that we can continue.

DICK: Okay.

STEVE: Because they wanted as much as us.

DICK: But I'm just showing -- I know. But

24 I'm -- what I'm saying is we're trying to work together

25 with you.

STEVE: I, I know what you're trying to say

and do. I see what you're trying to do and what you're 2 saving. I, I do see it clearly. 3 DICK: You know, the public sees our effort on the one side and sees nothing coming from you. 4 STEVE: This is true. And this is the way --5 6 DICK: Isn't that true? -- this is the way you would have it. 7 STEVE: 8 DICK: No, this is the way it is. 9 STEVE: No, this is the way --10 DICK: But we're trying to work together. You are right. We are cut off from 11 STEVE: 12 But you have total access as we have watched to make any kind of a statement you want. And we've got 13 14 to spend days trying to correct little things. After a 15 while, you know, you tell them what you feel you need to tell them. Because you know we have nothing to say 16 about it anyway. 17 18 DICK: Listen. Let me read you an article 19 today. I, I want to point out to you folks in there. 20 I know you're concerned about support. Let me read just excerpts from, from an article that appeared in 21 the paper today that I think --23 STEVE: What paper? The local --24 DICK: Yeah, the local -- no, it's the Fort 25 Worth Star Telegraph.

STEVE: Fort Worth Star Telegraph.

DICK: Right. Let me read you just some paragraphs from this thing. It quotes this man that, that by Tim Sullivan of the Star Telegraph. He's a --

STEVE: All right.

DICK: -- reporter that had spoken with a local person up there. He said, this is quote what this fellow is saying. He said that the February 28th raid on the compound by federal agents was an attempt to suppress religious activities because its members live communally and by their own rules. He goes on to say the government has become a police state. They want everybody to bow down to them.

Again, he said the raid's violence which left four ATF agents and at least some Branch Dividians dead was the fault of the government. You attack a man's home, and he will fight back. I think this was a setup, this man says, by the government. I want people to understand that government doesn't act properly. This is the kind of support that people are giving you out there. But when, when --

STEVE: What, what do you think of a statement like that?

DICK: I think that a man that you're able to make a statement like that in this country you can make statements like that every day, and we all respect that ability and that right which is given to us by the

Constitution. I'm not, don't oppose that. Certainly I don't oppose that. 2 I may not always agree with what I read. But 3 people have the latitude in this country to do that, 4 and that's exactly what you're going to be able to do 5 when you guys come out of there is make these kinds of 7 statement. I mean it's -- you're not isolated in there. You're going to have the ability to make these kinds of statement to the press. You'll -- they'll have total access. And, 10 and we're going to address that issue I hope on this 11 morning's press conference. Because I, I suggested to 12 the folks that you were concerned about your inability 13 to talk with people at some point in time. And I said hey, tell the media that. They will know that you're 15 concerned about that. And I'll tell you, they'll beat 16 your doors down to get the story. They will beat the 17 doors down. They'll have you lined up on --18 STEVE: Dick --19 20 DICK: -- to be interviewed at length. STEVE: Okay. What time did you leave 21 yesterday? 22 23 DICK: What time did I leave? STEVE: Yeah. 24 25 DICK: Oh, probably, you know, 9 o'clock last

night.

STEVE: There was --1 DICK: 9:30, 10. 2 STEVE: Did the guys in the Bradleys, what 3 did they think of the music? 5 DICK: (Laughing.) The guys in the Bradleys, what did they think of the music, huh? 6 STEVE: Yeah. 7 DICK: Well, I don't know. Some of them I 8 guess would like everybody else would like the music. 9 STEVE: Some did, huh? 10 11 DICK: Others would find it not to their 12 liking. It's like me down here in Texas. I'm, I'm, you know, I'm listening to these Texas stations here 13 with the cowboy music. And --14 STEVE: Right. 15 DICK: -- where I live I don't hear much 16 cowboy music. So you know --17 STEVE: See, what the prophecies actually 18 stated was that the final message to the world -- this 19 was, this was shown to me 6-1/2 years ago. I wasn't 20 even into music. I've never really cared for that kind 21 of music myself. But --22 DICK: Um-hum. 23 STEVE: -- finally it grew on me. But here's 24 the thing. In the prophecy of Habakkuk it talks about shigionat (phonetic), the turbulent lyrics, there is to

1 | be a message of salvation, seven seals that were to be given by this form of communication, music, the highest form of communication that there is. 3 DICK: Um-hum. 4 STEVE: And we decided, David decided to at 5 least play something for the guys. And so --6 7 DICK: Well, they've -- some of them appreciated it. Others I'm sure did not appreciate it. 8 But you know, that's -- you guys go ahead --9 STEVE: Oh, yeah. 10 DICK: -- and do whatever you want in terms 11 of playing music. 12 STEVE: The lyrics are what are very awesome. 13 14 I mean --DICK: Yeah. 15 STEVE: -- very, very deep (indiscernible) --16 DICK: Well, did you appreciate it in there? 17 I mean you liked it, didn't you? And that's all that's 18 important. 19 20 STEVE: Oh, yeah. Because I know you did it for your, DICK: 21 for the good of your folks in there. 22 23 STEVE: Yeah --DICK: Let me talk to David. And let's try 24 to work this deal out. 25

STEVE: I'm, I'm trying to. Okay, let me see
