He's not answering. So that, that must mean 1 2 that's an insult --DICK: No, it's -- I, I -- it's not an 3 insult --STEVE: Because he had 4 --5 DICK: -- at all. 6 STEVE: -- at least I know it was at least 4 7 days ago. Maybe it was 5. I can't even --8 9 (unidentified male voice in background not 10 discernible) --DICK: Well, listen. 11 STEVE: Like he said. He gave \$1,000. He 12 never thought that would be a consideration 13 (indiscernible). 14 DICK: Well, we're going to, we're going to 15 send it in to you at no cost to you. 16 STEVE: All right. 17 DICK: Okay? 18 STEVE: Well, that's what was expected back 4 19 days ago. Because we were -- at that time if you 20 recall, Dick, we were sending children out. And they 21 would have kept on coming out. And my kids weren't happy in that 8 picture. 9 10 DICK: Not -- absolutely untrue. Absolutely 11 untrue. Those were --SITA: What I saw --12 -- all beef hot dogs. What we'd ask 13 DICK: them to give them --14 What I saw in that picture --15 SITA: DICK: I know. But listen, Sita. Let me 16 explain that to you. Because if that's what you're 17 unhappy about I can tell you --18 SITA: No, not --19 DICK: We have told those folks that turkey 20 or all beef as a substitute, but there is to be 21 22 absolutely no pork. Maybe they had some 11 medical problems. Maybe there were some bugs in the 12 13 hair. Buas! And that's completely reasonable. And we want to honor any reasonable request. And we have done that. The kids do not get pork.

SITA: And one thing too. When the kids were supposed to come out we, we sent a letter where their, where they were going. And they are still here also.

addressed that issue before. This cannot be done overnight. We're hoping to reunite you and your kids. We're hoping to reunite the two of you. And we understand where you want those kids to go in the event that's not done. But these things, you know, it has to be done on a timely basis. And I know your time and --

SITA: Jim promised me that he'll call their grandparents or whoever they were going to the next

day. That's what's my understanding. That's why I went out for my life with my kids. 2 DICK: Um-hum. 3 And now not even one word. And I SITA: 4 5 cannot even speak to them. DICK: Well, yes, you can speak to them. 6 That's, that's your choice. You said that you wanted 7 8 to stay in there. Yes. I want to speak to them. SITA: 9 Well, you can speak to them. But you DICK: 10 know, it was your choice. We asked you to come out. 11 We're ready to have you come out any time you like. 12 But until you do that --13 SITA: Yes, I can come out any time I want. 14 Sure. David said you could. 15 DICK: But what you guys been doing, coming 16 inside the property which you were told, were told not 17 to come in. that and so that I can run that down. Because that's unacceptable. And I told him that.

SITA: It's very childish.

DICK: Yeah, it's more than that. It's unprofessional. If it was just childish, maybe we would deal with that. But it's unprofessional, and we're not going to allow it. And there has been a great deal of consternation about that. And you can bet that it better not happen again. Because the man that did that if he's an FBI agent is going to be fired, period. End of story. He's gone. That's not going to happen.

Now did Steven tell you that, that we've, we've tried to get the milk in and done those kinds of things? And that we're trying to honor your requests? We have some of the parents there that say hey, send the kids out to, to the folks who have been designated by those people. And others say keep them all together. Don't move them into foster homes.

You know, we have to confront these issues one by one. And what you want and what someone else wants may be different. And we have to deal with all those issues as soon as we can and in the best way we can. In the meantime, those kids are being well cared for.

And the reason we sent the pictures in is

because there was some suggestion from somebody inside 2 there that, that the kids had been sent to foster We said absolutely untrue. And then what, what 3 do we get? We get you're lying. So instead, we went out and took videotape which we sent in to you that 5 we're tell, told did not work. And we send in hard 7 copy --There's nothing, there was nothing in SITA: 8 9 the --10 DICK: Okay. Well, we're making arrangements to get you another copy of that. Okay? We'll, we'll 11 send that in again so you can take a look at it. But 12 that's what we're doing, Sita. We got to work 13 together, and we're doing that for you. 14 And I can appreciate your position as a 15 16 mother. Because I would have the same concerns as a, as you as a father of two children myself. So I can 17 appreciate some of your, some of your, your concerns. 18 19 And I --(Indiscernible.) 20 SITA: -- certainly I'm not getting mad at DICK: 21 you, Sita, for expressing those. Because as a mother, 22 that's your responsibility to ensure that your wishes are, are followed and that the kids' wishes are. So 24 please, I can appreciate that. I know you're frustrated.

I (indiscernible). SITA: 1 I know you're tired. Sita, trust me. DICK: 2 We're -- I'm going to take, make sure that those kids 3 are, are handled properly. Please. If there's nothing 4 else that happens here, understand that I will ensure 5 and we will ensure the FBI that those kids are properly 6 cared for. And the only way we can improve on that 7 care is for you to come out and take care of those kids 8 themselves -- yourself. (Unidentified voice in background not discernible.) 1 We're --2 NICOLE: Oh. DICK: -- we're just doing the best we can 3 4 under --I don't think so. NICOLE: 5 DICK: -- this is a difficult situation for 6 all of us. And we're doing the best we can, and what 7 we ask is in return for you to work with us. And we'll 8 get, we'll get things worked out. It may not be as quickly as you would like. And it may not be as 10 quickly as I would like. 11 NICOLE: Quickly. How long does it take to 12 get a dead body out of this place? 13 DICK: Again, we're trying to deal with all 14 these requests of yours. And again it's not getting 15 done as quickly --16 NICOLE: Look. 17 DICK: -- as you want, Nicole. 18 NICOLE: You came in here. When you guys 19 fired on us, you guys fired first. I have bullet holes 20 in my son -- I'm glad he wasn't in his bed. He would 21 have been killed. 22 DICK: Nicole, you need to tell the world 23 that very same thing. 24 NICOLE: Well, then why don't you give us a 25 line out?

DICK: You will have the opportunity to do 1 2 that. NICOLE: When? When, Dick? When? 3 DICK: You know, listen. Let me tell you 4 what again, very briefly what we went over this morning 5 with Steven concerning a local article that was written 6 in the Forth Worth Star Telegraph where a person writes 7 in and says that the, the attack, he calls it an attack 8 on the compound by federal agents was an attempt to 9 suppress religion simply because the members live 10 communally. 11 And he goes on to say the government has 12 become a police state. They want everybody to bow down 13 to them. Goes on to say, he said the raid's violence 14 which left four ATF agents and at least some Dividians 15 dead was the fault of the U.S. Government. 16 Now that's the kind of support you're getting 17 out there. But you need to, to ensure that that is 18 communicated by the people inside that can tell what 19 happened from their viewpoint. 20 NICOLE: Dick, don't try and patronize me. 21 DICK: ATF is --22 NICOLE: You don't want us to have a line. 23 You don't want us to have a line out. That is a, 24 that's a fact. You don't. Because you would have 25

given it to us a long time ago.

Your best line is to walk out of there 1 and talk to whomever you want to talk to. 2 NICOLE: I'm not walking out of -- oh, 3 freedom of speech. What happened to the Constitution 4 of America? It doesn't exist. 5 DICK: What did I just tell you? You have 6 7 the ability to talk to anyone you wish. When you come out of there absolutely. And I told David and Steve 8 there will be so many requests to talk to you folks 9 you'll be able to get your story out in any fashion --10 That's a load of baloney. NICOLE: 11 DICK: It isn't a load of baloney. 12 It's -- that's bullshit, Dick. NICOLE: 13 Listen, Nicole. Let me review a 14 15 couple of things for you, the things that we've done at your request. Not specifically yours. But the folks 16 inside that were done for you, okay? A phone line was 17 opened up. Obviously --18 (Indiscernible.) 19 NICOLE: -- that was for both. That was for DICK: 20 21 both of us. NICOLE: Keep going. 22 DICK: Okay, but it was done. You had the 23 same interest in it as we have. And that was done on 24 the 28th, Sunday. 25

And then David wanted to make a statement,

and in return for that he said I will bring all my people out. He gets an hour on the telephone -- or I'm 2 sorry. An hour in the media after he does a statement 3 of his own choice. He puts it together. Nobody, nobody edited that statement. He put exactly what he 5 wanted on there. And it was played verbatim. 6 Then we get, we get a reference to play the 7 tape on national TV and they will come out. Now that 8 comes from Scott. It's, it's played. Again, you don't 9 come out. Then someone suggested, Rita I believe, said 10 play the tape during prime time, and the women and the 11 children will come out. Of course, it's played during 12 prime time. Nobody comes out. Or you know, the group 13 doesn't come out. 14 David wants 150 feet of phone line. We 15 furnish that to him. 16 NICOLE: You, you don't hook it up? 17 DICK: Well, how can we hook it up? We're 18 not in there. We sent in a telephone for it. 19 NICOLE: Why did you cut off all 20 communication in the first place? 21 That -- and again I told you I'm not 22 going to lie to you. That is commonly done --23 NICOLE: Commonly done. 24 DICK: -- in these, in these situations. 25 NICOLE: Freedom of speech. Commonly done.

DICK: No. 1 NICOLE: Yes. 2 There's actually has nothing to do 3 with freedom of speech. It has to do with as I 4 suggested to some of the guys yesterday when you have 5 this kind of incident, as unfortunate as it is, there 6 are all kinds of people out there that, that want to 7 involve themself to some degree. And some, just people 8 with some off --9 NICOLE: Dick --10 DICK: -- the wall things --11 NICOLE: Dick the truth is --12 DICK: -- to say will call in. 13 NICOLE: -- David and Steve were on, on the 14 They were speaking live to the people on radio. 15 And they were telling what you happened, and you guys didn't like it. So you cut our lines. That's what 17 happened. (Unidentified male voice in background not 18 discernible.) 19 DICK: Absolutely. 20 NICOLE: Absolutely. 21 DICK: We did --22 NICOLE: You didn't like what they were 23 saying. 24 DICK: No, I'm saying we cut the lines. It's 25 not because what, of what you were saying --

NICOLE: Because you didn't like it. 1 they told how the BATF --2 DICK: Um-hum. 3 NICOLE: -- came in here and started firing 4 first. And they did not know that. They accused us of 5 that first. 6 DICK: Nicole, there's been a national 7 inquiry made, a Congressional inquiry made reference to 8 yesterday in the paper. 9 NICOLE: (Indiscernible.) 10 They're opening up an inquiry on that. DICK: 11 And you'll all get a chance to say exactly what you 12 saw, what you did, and what you saw the ATF do. That 13 is -- it's your right. It's your responsibility. And 14 the world will demand it. 15 NICOLE: Dick, it doesn't make one hell of a 16 difference, all right? So that's not -- still until I 17 start seeing some milk or, or some --18 DICK: We've got the milk. 19 NICOLE: -- such element here, I, I really 20 21 have nothing more to say to you. DICK: Nicole, we have the milk. 22 NICOLE: Well, where --23 DICK: And I made that clear to both --24 NICOLE: Are you going to let it go sour? 25 Are you going to let it sit out there and go sour?

And still they wander around, and you've 17 got the audacity to call me up because a human being is 18 looking out a window when you've got guys in our 19 automobiles, moving our motorcycles, doing things that 20 21 you never called me about. You know what I want to say to you? And I'm 22 trying to hold back. Because I still love you and your 23 soul and those people down there. I do want to 24 communicate with you. We all do. But what is this one-sided business, Dick? Let's start being real

serious. 1 DICK: That's our point. 2 No, no, it is not your point. You 3 start looking at what and then -- and you're recording 4 5 everything. You look to hear what you're saying. becomes very redundant when you're repetitively saying 6 the same thing -- (unidentified male voice in 7 background not discernible) --8 9 DICK: Listen --Listen. And you're evading your 10 STEVE: statements. You asked me to look at that press 11 conference. I did. It made me sick also. 12 13 Listen, when you fired on federal DICK: officers, you lost some of your private property 14 rights. 15 STEVE: No, when they fired on human beings 16 that are to be protected by this very government which 17 is for the people, by the people. They should be stuck 18 in jail right now. That investigation should -- just a 19 minute. Here's David. 20 STEVE TO DAVID: He says we lost our rights 21 when we fired on them. 22 23 DAVID: Now, Dick, let me say something. You 24 think the only people in this organization is here at this camp? You ask Robert Gonzales what I told him, 25

what I've told everybody else. I've gone all around

this world ever since 1985. We're not the only people 1 that believe this message. 2 DICK: David, you're not the only one that 3 listens to God either. 4 DAVID: No. Let me tell you something. My 5 God has seven seals. Your God does not. You do not 6 know the seven seals. You therefore are out of rank 7 with the living God. And this nation is going to learn 8 of a living God. As little David of old went before 9 Goliath, I stand before you. You and this nation's 10 going to learn there's a God in heaven. He has a 11 truth, and just because you wish to evade it, just 12 because you do not know the fear of the Lord does not 13 mean you're going to be without responsibility. You 14 15 are going to pay. Now keep your press conferences going. 16 communications going. But remember, I'm telling you 17 there's a lot more of us than you know. A lot more 18 than you realize. 19 DICK: What is that supposed to imply? 20 DAVID: That implies you go ahead and you do 21 with us what you feel. You go ahead and tell the press 22 what you want. 23 We're trying to --DICK: 24 DAVID: Because that's what you're doing. 25 DICK: -- communicate to you in part --

DAVID: And I am trying to communicate with 1 Everything I've said you've got recorded. Now 2 you -- I suggest to you you review in the fear of God 3 very prayerfully what I've shown you all over that 4 scripture, all over that Bible. 5 DICK: Listen, David, we're going to work 6 together to resolve this issue. We are --7 DAVID: Oh, you, you --8 9 DICK: -- going to do that. DAVID: -- we, we referring to you and who 10 else there? 11 No. That we meaning we here and you 12 DICK: in there are going to work together to resolve this 13 issue. And the sooner that we agree on that, the 14 sooner we're going to get it resolved appropriately 15 with --16 DAVID: Do not call us up and tell us that 17 someone is looking out the window. We have the right 18 to look out. This is God's world. His sun is shining 19 outside. We can look out if we want to. 20 I did not tell you to look out the 21 DICK: I said take care in the manner in which you do 22 window. that so nothing --23 DAVID: Right. You fire on us --24 So that nothing happens. 25 DICK: DAVID: -- you fire on us and it starts.

There is no firing going to be done. 1 Okay. So you don't have to warn us 2 about looking out the window then. 3 DICK: I am telling you that the safety rules 4 need to be followed. We talked --5 Okay. So follow them. DAVID: 6 DICK: -- about that. You understand them. 7 We understand them. 8 DAVID: Follow them. 9 DICK: And as long as we both understand 10 them, there will be no problem. 11 DAVID: Follow them then, Dick. Okay? 12 Do we agree? They're -- the safety DICK: 13 14 rules --DAVID: We agree. 15 DICK: -- are going to be followed. Is that 16 17 correct? DAVID: Mine and yours. 18 DICK: Absolutely. There will be no 19 problems. But we'll work together with one another to 20 ensure that does not happen. 21 22 DAVID: Are you worried about dying, Dick? 23 DICK: Am I worried about dying? DAVID: Yes. 24 DICK: Not today or tomorrow, now. 25 DAVID: Okay. That's good. We share the

I've told --STEVE: I am listening. 6 DICK: -- you that before. 7 STEVE: I am listening. 8 DICK: We have people outside as you well 9 know. These people are somewhat exposed at times, all 10 right? They're concerned about their safety on the 11 outside as well as you're concerned about your safety 12 on the inside. When someone goes to a window with a 13 balaclava which you were not familiar with. I will 14 15 explain that --STEVE: We don't have, we don't have such a 16 thing by the way. That is wrong. It's incorrect. 17 18 Take a picture and show it and send it to me. DICK: And -- well, how about black paint on 19 20 the face? STEVE: No black paint on the face. You're 21 looking at a dark-skinned woman that was looking out a 22 window. 23 24 DICK: A dark-skinned woman --STEVE: That's correct. 25 DICK: -- looking out the -- in camouflage?

No, that had a camouflage jacket on. 1 STEVE: I will relay that to those folks who 2 DICK: 3 made the report. The excitement of you who's in a safe STEVE: place. These people are in Bradleys, and they're 5 reporting such things, someone looks out. 6 7 incredible. Well, what are you reporting to us? 8 DICK: 9 Did you not report to us --STEVE: Everything. We, we were getting 10 11 back --12 -- things that concern you? STEVE: -- remember how this morning how I 13 14 talked to you about bringing some kerosene in for 15 heaters, because there was a chill. It was cold. We had run out. 16 17 I heard you talk about, yeah. 18 STEVE: Yes. And you didn't respond to that. 19 I was waiting for you to call back after that session 20 and we pick up to where we were. 21 DICK: It was not --22 STEVE: And instead of you calling back with 23 something of substance, you're calling back with 24 something that is so foolish. Here are full-grown 25 military men in armor, iron clad vehicles, and they're concerned about someone's face looking out the window

with a bala whatever it is on their face. In the first place it's not even true. 2 3 DICK: Would you have us just stand out there on the road? Is that what you would prefer that we 4 did? 5 6 STEVE: Did I say anything like that? 7 Okay. Then understand what those DICK: 8 Bradleys are for. 9 STEVE: Don't we show -- aren't we showing a 10 lot of trust with yourself, because we're not squawking and screaming like these people are constantly? 11 12 (Unidentified male voice in background not discernible.) Listen, the Bradleys will remain 13 14 there with the people in them for protective. Okay, 15 for protective reasons. However, we are making an effort to determine what those are and to listen to you 3 and to deal with what those things that you're telling us about. 5 In turn, I expect you to get those children 6 together and send them out as we have agreed. We'll talk about it. 5 DICK: DAVID: And you call me back --6 7 DICK: We'll talk --DAVID: -- a little bit later, all right? 8 9 DICK: We'll talk about it. Now listen --DAVID: Because --10 DICK: -- we talk about --11 12 DAVID: -- I'm also human too. 13 I understand. And we talk about the DICK: 14 third seal, and you're going to let some children leave the compound. Is that correct? 15 DAVID: You are going to show me the third 16 seal, and I will let some children leave the compound. 17 18 DICK: David, how am I going to accept from you that what you say that -- (unidentified male voice 20 in background not discernible) -- in other words, I 21 tell you what the third seal is or what we believe the 22 third seal might be. But then you're going to say no, 23 that doesn't -- just like you did before. No --24 DAVID: No, no, no. I never did that. 25 That's not, that's not the definition. That's not my explanation. That's not God's

explanation. And then --It's self-obvious. It's in the DAVID: 2 prophesies. It's obvious. 3 DICK: David, what's obvious to you may not 4 be obvious to others. 5 DAVID: Hey. Psalms 45 is obvious. 6 the first seal. It's obvious. Even you know that. 7 The same king, the same crown, the same bow. 8 Everything in Psalms 45 is the same as the first seal. That's obvious. The second seal, the man on the red 10 horse. Hey, Zechariah's prophesy, the man on the red 11 horse. The same truth. The same seal. 12 DICK: They shall kill one another. He was 13 14 given a great sword. 15 DAVID: Yeah. DICK: Great horse rider power was given to 16 17 him --DAVID: But that revolved, that revolves 18 around --19 DICK: -- to take peace from the earth. 20 DAVID: -- that revolves, that revolves 21 around Zechariah Chapter 1 and 2. 22 DICK: David, when I try to understand what 23 you're saying, you reject that out of hand. All right? 24 DAVID: I'm going to reject your opinions. 25 But when you're showing me right out of the Bible,

reading it word for word, I'm going to accept it. DICK: Hey, I'll be happy to read whatever it 2 is that you feel that will help me understand this from 3 the Bible. I will do that. There, you know, I'm not disagreeing with that. I don't --5 DAVID: Look. 6 DICK: -- want to reject knowledge at all. 7 DAVID: Let's unwind. Your voice is becoming 8 9 monotonous. Let's give it a fair chance. Sit back. Take control of yourself. Sit down. Sit with those 10 other wise men of yours. And let's find that third 11 12 seal. DICK: David, I will agree to sit down and 13 talk if you will agree to sit down and do the same 14 thing with the folks out there. Okay? 15 DAVID: I am. 16 I explained --17 DICK: DAVID: I already told you you could talk to 18 19 the women. I know. I know. DAVID: Or, or, or --DICK: I'll give you my word on that ... 5 DAVID: -- you're going to come in here and 6 7 try to blow us up. DICK: We're not going to do that. 8 DAVID: Look. 9 DICK: So we can start from that premise. 10 DAVID: You're going to try. 11 12 DICK: We're not going to do that. We're not going to try to do that. We can agree on that. And 13 I'll call you back shortly with -- and we'll get 14 15 together again. 16 DAVID: And there's some girls that want to talk to you. 17 18 DICK: I'll be happy --19 DAVID: They, they want to give you a piece of their mind. 20 21 DICK: I'll be happy to talk with them. DAVID: And you can do what you wish to. You 22 can talk with them and, and, you know, convince them 23 that they need to come out. And if they desire to, 24 25 it's fine.

DICK: Well, kick --

1	DAVID: But right now, right now they're
2	really interested in those 6 gallons of milk.
3	DICK: Okay. David, please, do me a, do me a

Here he is. Hang on, Dick. 1 DAVID: I'm here. 2 DICK: David. 3 DAVID: Yeah. 4 5 DICK: Dick. DAVID: Go ahead. 6 I spent some time at your request 7 looking at this third seal. 8 9 DAVID: All right. DICK: And I believe your question to me is 10 what is the third seal and what is -- what does the 11 third seal represent? 12 13 DAVID: Where is it found in the Bible? DICK: And it's my understanding that once --14 15 that you're going to send some children out once we get this, once we discuss this at some length. Is that --16 DAVID: Uh-huh. 17 -- is that -- that is the agreement 18 19 we're talking about, is it not? DAVID: Yeah, where is it found. 20 DICK: And I appreciate your getting up. I 21 know you're tired, but I appreciate your getting up 22 and, and helping me out with this thing. 23 24 DAVID: Okay. Go ahead. 25 DICK: All right. We're -- the third seal

we're talking about a famine condition that could be

1 | brought on the Roman empire as a result of their persecution of the Christians in Asia Minor. We're 2 dealing with a black horse and rider. 3 DAVID: Dick --4 DICK: It has to do with possibility of 5 famine and that people should, should measure out their wheat and that the days' wages --DAVID: Dick. You know, I love you guys so 8 much. But would you like me to share with you what the 9 third seal is? 10 DICK: Certainly. But David --11 12 DAVID: (Indiscernible.) DICK: -- do I have your agreement, do I have 13 your agreement that once we share this information with 14 one another I will, I will give you what I, I've tried 15 16 to determine and tried to find out. And I will listen 17 to your representation. DAVID: Now, wait a minute. Here, turn the 18 light on, sweetheart. Thank you. Where's my Bible at? 19 I'm going to -- got your Bible there, Dick? 20 21 DICK: Yes, I do. DAVID: Okay. Seven 18 19 thunders uttered their voices, right? 20 David, what verse are we reading, DICK: 21 please? Let me follow along with you. 22 DAVID: Oh, okay. In Chapter 10 of Revelation. 23 24 DICK: Chapter 2 of Revelation. 25 DAVID: Ten. Chapter 10. DICK: I'm sorry. I'm sorry. I

misunderstood you. Chapter 10 of Revelation. 1 DAVID: Chapter 10, yeah. I'm trying to wake 2 3 up here. DICK: All right. All right. DAVID: Now we find out during the sixth --5 now remember, the seventh seal is contained in Chapter 6 And in this seal, the seventh seal, the trumpets 7 are being administered, right? 8 DICK: In the seventh seal, yes. 9 Okay. Now during the sixth trumpet, DAVID: 10 what happens is, is that there's a, there's a picture 11 12 of a large company of warriors, okay? DICK: All right. 13 There's 200 million. 14 DAVID: DICK: 200 million warriors. 15 DAVID: Right. So where it says right here 16 that -- okay, it tells us here that verses 13, and the 17 sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four 18 horns of the golden altar which is before God, saying 19 to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, loose the 20 four angels which are prepared which are bound in the 21 great river Euphrates. Now Euphrates was the river 22 that went under Babylon, right? 23 David, yes. But tell me where are you 24 reading from? 25

DAVID: I'm reading from Revelation 9 --

1 DICK: Okay. 2 DAVID: -- 13. Verse 13. Right. The sixth angel. DICK: 3 DAVID: Yes. Sounded his trumpet. 5 DICK: DAVID: Exactly. 6 DICK: All right. 7 DAVID: Okay. So what happens is, is that 8 9 Euphrates was the river that ran underneath Babylon, okay? 10 DICK: All right. 11 12 DAVID: Okay. And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, a day, a 13 month, and a year to slay the third part of men. Okay? 14 15 DICK: All right. 16 DAVID: And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand --17 DICK: Or 200 million. 18 DAVID: Which is 200 million. Okay, now 19 20 right now, these four angels which are loosed are liberated. They're really not bound. But what happens 21 22 is, is that in Chapter 7 of Revelation these four 23 angels were the same angels --DICK: Standing at four corners of the earth. 24 25 DAVID: Of the earth holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow upon the

earth or the sea or tree or anything. And the angels
in the east, their commander says hurt not till we have
sealed the servants of our God on their forehead.

Now in Jeremiah 30 and 31 refers to the whirlwind of the Lord, it goes forth with a fury. When those four winds are let loose, right?

DICK: All right.

DAVID: It creates a whirlwind. A gigantic whirlwind. That's when Isaiah 21 says as whirlwinds in the south go through. Talks about the anger of the Lord. Okay? In Isaiah 27 what happens is, is this is the time referred to in prophecy called the filling of the 144,000. I'll go over here real quick and, and show you real quick here. It's in 27th Chapter of Isaiah. I'm reading this, because that way --

DICK: 27th Chapter of Isaiah?

DAVID: Yeah.

DICK: All right.

DAVID: In the 26th Chapter, the first of the people have God that been under attack. So then that day shall this song be sung in the land of Judah; We have a strong city; salvation will God appoint for walls and bulwarks. The same as Zechariah, Chapter 1 and 2 that I read last night where God will be a wall of fire and about Jerusalem. So it says open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the

| truth may enter in. And only those who keep the seals.

2 | Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is

3 stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. Trust ye

4 | in the Lord for ever: in the Lord God is everlasting

5 strength.

For he bringeth down them that dwell on high. That's you guys. The lofty city he bringeth, layeth it low, layeth it low, even to the ground; he bringeth it even to the dust. That's the fall of Babylon.

The foot shall tread it down, even the feet of the poor, and the steps of the needy. Now the way of the just is uprightness: thou, most upright, which is the Father who sits on the throne dost weigh the paths of the just. That's the seven seals.

Yea, in the way of thy judgments, O Lord, have we waited for thee. Because see we know the seven seals. The reason being is the desire of our souls to thy name. That's why the 144,000 in Chapters 14 has the seal of living God which is the name of the Father on their foreheads.

And to the remembrance of thee. With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early. Because they learn the truth when the Lamb comes as it is right now to show them the truth that is written.

DICK: The Lamb, Lamb will show the truth.

DAVID: Yeah. That's why I'm here. 1 brought my reward to give to every man. I'm here to 2 3 teach these seals. DICK: All right. DAVID: Same as in Psalms 2. The heathen 5 They imagine a vain thing. Kings of the earth, 6 7 rulers take counsel. Gather against the Lord and against me saying let's break his bands asunder and cast his cords from us. You all don't want these seals. He that sits in the heavens, my Father, is 10 laughing at you right now. And the next step is the 11 Pather fixing to, to speak to you, and you're going to 12 13 be in big trouble anyway. So it says here when thy judgments are in the 14 15 earth --DICK: David, David, let me -- where, where 16 are you again now? 17 DAVID: We're here at Chapters 26 of Isaiah. 18 DICK: Okay. 19 DAVID: Verses 9. 20 DICK: Okay. Hold on for just a minute here. 21 22 Let me, let me catch up with you a little bit, 26, 9. DAVID: Well, you remember, remember what we 23 already read, right? 24 25 DICK: Right. Okay. My soul yearns for you in the night.

DAVID: Okay. This is takedown of what it states about in that day, Chapter 26, verse 1. Shall this song be sung land of Judah. Psalms 40 is the song of the Lamb. He brings seven seals. A new song. Psalms 40. Song of the Lamb. Same as Revelation, Chapter 15. Song of Moses, Deuteronomy 32. And the song of the Lamb. Okay.

DICK: All right.

DAVID: And that day shall this song be sung land of Judah. We have a strong city; salvation will God appoint for walls and bulwarks. Mean God's going to save these people, right?

Open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the truth may enter in. What truth is it they've got to keep? We got to find out, don't we?

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee. Trust ye in the Lord, for in the Lord Jehovah is everlasting strength. For he bringeth down them that dwelleth on high, that's Babylon, the lofty city, he layeth it low, he layeth it low, even to the ground; he bringeth it even to the dust. The feet of the poor shall tread it down, even the steps of the needy. Feet of the needy, poor, steps of the needy.

The way of the just which is the path we walk in is uprightness: thou, most upright, which is the

Father who's got the book, dost weigh the path of the just. He directs our steps, don't he?

Yea, in the way of thy judgments, O Lord, have we waited for thee. There are seven seals you understand. The reason why the desire of our soul is to thy name. That's what I was saying. The 144,000 in Chapter 7 of Revelation are sealed by the angel from the east who has the seal of the living God which is a scroll with seven seals. That's why in Chapter 14 the 144,000 stand on Mt. Zion with the seal of the living God in their foreheads which is God's name.

To remembrance of thee. With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek the early for when thy judgments are in the earth, which is the fulfillment of these terrible things such as the seals teach, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.

Now here's what Christ had to suffer so much for and he let you guys have. Let favour be showed to the wicked. That's what I'm trying to do right now to you guys. Yet will he not learn righteousness. In the land of uprightness if you all are allowed to be in this kingdom that all the prophets talk about, okay, will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the Lord.

Now my Father sits in heaven, he sits on the

throne. He gave me a book. There's seven seals. If
you don't know these seals, you're not a part of my
kingdom. You have nothing to do with me.

But anyway, Lord, when thy hand is lifted up, you know what's in God's hand, don't you? The book with seven seals. He upholds his word above heaven. They will not see. You guys aren't looking very good. But you're going to see. And you're going to be ashamed for your envy at the people, those who know these things. Yes, the fire of thine enemies shall devour them. It's going to backfire. What you all are going to do is going to backfire on you.

Lord, thou wilt (indiscernible) peace for us: for thou hast also wrought all our works in us. O Lord our God, other lords beside thee have had dominion over us, such as teachers and preachers and government officials and stuff like that. But by thee only will we make mention of thy name. Because they're going to be dead. They're not going to live. They'll be deceased. They will not rise. Therefore thou hast visited and destroyed them, and made all their memory to perish. That's what's fixing to happen to you guys, you see?

DICK: That's a reference to the fourth seal.

DAVID: Now listen. What we're doing here is we're fixing, we're going into the, into the third

1 | seal. That's the thing we're talking about. This is 2 | not the fourth seal.

DICK: All right.

DAVID: Let me show you.

DICK: Okay.

DAVID: Thou hast increased the nation, O

Lord. Just like Psalms 18 when I read to you guys.

You've got it there on record. After you're punished,

after God makes an example out of you, and after you

find out beyond question who I really am, then I'm

given a kingdom just like Daniel 7 and all the prophets

teach, Isaiah 2, Michael 4.

And then the rest of the nations are asked if they want any of this, if they'd like to have a cup of God's wrath. Of course, at that time they're going to disarm. Hopefully they're going to come and learn of God's ways and allow me to finish teaching them the truth.

So this is where it says thou hast increased the nation. Thou art glorified: thou hadst removed it far unto all the ends of the earth. Lord, in trouble have they visited thee, they poured out a prayer when thy chastening was upon them.

Like a woman with child, that draweth near the time of her delivery, is in pain, and crieth out in her pains; so have we been in thy sight, O Lord. We 1 have been with child, we have been in pain, we have as

2 it were brought forth wind. (Makes "raspberry" noise.)

3 You know what I mean? We have not wrought any

4 deliverance in the earth; neither have the inhabitants

5 of the world fallen.

Well, the way this happens is there's going to be a resurrection. Now let me explain about these angels. Thy dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in the dust: for thy dew is the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be past. For the Lord cometh out of his place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their iniquity. And the earth shall also disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain.

So in that day, the Lord with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, which is your leader. Even leviathan that crooked serpent; he shall slay the dragon in the sea. In that day sing ye unto her, A vineyard of red wine.

I the Lord do keep it; I will water it every morning: lest any hurt it, I will keep it night and

1 day. .2 David, as you're going along, can you DICK: 3 give me some references so I can kind of follow along with you too? 5 DAVID: Okay. I'm trying to, I'm trying to keep up 6 DICK: with you but I'm, I'm having difficulty, you know --7 DAVID: We're in verse 4 now, okay? 8 9 DICK: Verse 4 of --DAVID: I'm taking the eucharist right now. 10 Hold on a second. 11 12 [gap] DAVID: Okay. All right. 27, verse 4. 13 Isaiah 27, verse 4. DICK: 14 15 DAVID: 28, verse 4. I'm sorry. 16 DICK: 28, verse 4. 17 DAVID: Yeah. During the time that the kingdoms of this world are to be overthrown, Isaiah 14 refers the same as Isaiah 28 -- excuse me, 27, I'm sorry. Fury is not in me. You got that verse there? 20 21 DICK: I've got Isaiah 28, 4. DAVID: 27, 4. 22 23 DICK: Okay. We're going to 27, 4, all right? 27, 4. I am not angry. If only there were 24 briefs and thorns confronting me. I would march 25 against them in battle. I would set them all on fire.

Right. Okay. So you got the New DAVID: 1 American Standard? 2 I do. DICK: 3 DAVID: Verse 5. Or let him take hold of my strength. Right? 5 DICK: Right. Refuge, right. 6 That he may make peace with me; and 7 he shall make what? 8 DICK: And let them make peace with me. 9 In other words, what's God's DAVID: 10 11 strength? The ability to make peace. 12 DICK: DAVID: Nah. It's his word. 13 DICK: Well, through his word but to make 14 peace through his word. 15 DAVID: Seven, seven seals is the negotiation 16 here. If you reject the seven seals, you're rejecting 17 If you reject me, you're rejecting my father. And 18 then judgment cannot be diverted. You will be 19 punished. And your great nation, the United States of 20 America, the great land shadowing with wings that all 21 the prophets talk about. The lamb-like beast of 22 Revelation 13 is going to be made an example of above 23 all nations. It's all going to come to end in 1 hour. 24 This is what Revelation 18 is talking about, the fall 25 of Babylon.

1	Now I know you don't understand these things,
2	and I know you think you're too big for this to happen.
3	DICK: No, I don't. I have Revelation 18
4	here.
5	DAVID: But the, but the day of judgment is
6	here at hand. Now watch. Well, he will cause them
7	that come of Jacob, right, to take root: Israel shall
8	blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with
9	fruit. Israel shall be preserved out of this.
10	Now read verse 7 to me from your translation.
11	DICK: 28, 7?
12	DAVID: Yes.
13	DICK: Okay. 28, 7.
14	DAVID: Right.
15	DICK: And these also stagger from wine and
16	reel from beer, priests and prophets stagger from beer.
17	DAVID: No, no, no. Verse 7 of 27.
18	DICK: Verse 7 of 27.
19	DAVID: Right.
20	DICK: All right. Verse 7. Has the Lord
21	struck her as he struck down those who struck her. Has
22	she been killed as those were killed who killed her.
23	DAVID: Right. In other words, that's going
24	to be something in verse 8 what are you going to do
25	when this question is asked?
	DICK: By warfare and exile you contend with

her. With his fierce blast he drives her out as I on a day the east wind blows. 2 DAVID: Oh, what a sorry translation. Okay. 3 Now --DICK: You don't want the -- I mean this 5 6 translation's not --7 DAVID: No, no, no. No, now wait a second. Let's look here. 8 9 DICK: Okay. DAVID: It says according to the King James, 10 verses 7, hath he smitten him, as he smote those that 11 12 smote him? Or is he slain according to the slaughter 13 of them that are slain by him? In measure, when it shooteth forth, thou wilt debate with it: he stayeth 14 15 his rough wind in the day of the east wind. Now remember that in the seal we've learned 16 that an angel is ascends from the east, correct? With 17 the seal of the living God, right? 18 19 DICK: Right. 20 Telling the four ends -- four angels to hold the four winds that it would not blow upon 21 earth or sea, right? 22 23 DICK: Right. 24 In other words, you know, hold the 25 winds, and let not the winds blow. Hurt not until we've sealed the servants of our God on their

1 | foreheads. That's why Isaiah states here that he

2 | stayeth which means he holds in check his rough wind.

3 When those four winds are loosed, the whirlwind of the

4 Lord that all the prophets talk about, what all the

5 prophecies is let loose, and God's anger as in Jeremiah

6 says the fierce anger of the Lord shall not return

7 until he's performed the intents of his heart. In the

8 latter days you shall consider it.

It says behold, the whirlwind of the Lord goeth forth with fury. A continuing whirlwind. For it shall fall with pain upon the head of the wicked. In the latter days you shall consider it perfectly.

Now that's where the question is hath he smitten him. Now God's allowing me to be smitten. And I've been smitten by you.

DICK: All right.

DAVID: Okay. But am I going to be smitten as God's going to smite those that smote me? No. Or am I going to be slain according to the slaughter of them that's going to be slain by me? No. Now it says here everyone's going to get to see who wins in this confrontation. Everybody in the world is going to get to see who's going to come out of this smelling like a rose and who's going to come out of this looking bad.

Now in measure thou wilt debate with it.

There's seven measures. There's sevens seals. Thou

wilt debate with it. We're supposed to debate with this. And while we're debating, God's holding his rough wind. The angels aren't letting those winds loose yet.

If your eyes could be opened to the invisible powers that are confronting this world right now, you would understand that there are four angels, four commanding angels, that are holding back legions and legions of angels. And you know, angels are beings just like people of the world. It's just they're not as, they're not as, as embodied in, in such limited beings. They're not of dirt in other words.

DICK: From the four corners of the earth.

DAVID: From the four corners of the earth.

Now this is so that the seal of the 144,000 can take place. But it says here by this therefore shall the iniquity of Jacob be purged; and this is all the fruit to take away his sin; when he maketh all the stones of the altar as chalkstones that are beaten in sunder, groves and images which are idols shall not stand up.

Yet the defenced city shall be desolate, and the habitation forsaken, and left as a wilderness: there shall the calf feed, and there shall he lie down, and consume the branches thereof. When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: women come and set them on fire. You'll learn about those

women too. For you are a people of no understanding.
That's what we're dealing with now. Therefore he that
made you will not have mercy on you, and he that formed

you will shew you no favor.

And it will come to pass in that day, that the Lord shall beat off of the channel of the river unto the stream of Egypt, and ye shall be gathered one by one, O children of Israel. And it shall come to pass on that day, that a great trumpet shall be blown, that's the seventh trumpet. And they shall come which were ready to perish in the land of Assyria and the outcast land of Egypt and shall worship the Lord in the holy mount at Jerusalem. Okay, this is where the gathering comes.

DICK: That's seals four through seven.

DAVID: Exactly. Okay? Now, whatever the Prophets have stated, remember, these events of revelation are the previews of the events that are to soon take place against this great nation known as Babylon.

Now, remember, in Daniel 2, Babylon is a cessation, a continuation of the empires that will rule over Israel to the end of time when God will break the yoke of all nations from off his people, that God may set himself up a kingdom.

Now the nations are as such in Daniel 2. The head of gold is Babylon, the arms of silver, which is part of the same mind of man, the same spirit, is the Meso-

Persians, Alexander, excuse me, Fires and Derias (phonetic), and then we'll come into the empire of Grecia, the belly of brass, and then Rome will come in, the legs of iron, and then Rome will apparently fall, but not so, it will evolve itself into ten toes representing many nations, partly strong and partly broken, known as Europe. In other words, Rome will still rule through Europe because Daniel tells us there will rise up a power that will get involved in a religion known as Roman Catholicism, and it will rule the world and it'll have pre-eminence in the world until the time the ancient of days comes and judgments given to the saints of the most high. That's why those ambassadors are sent to Vatican right now all the time, you see? You know, there's the greatest world, political and social libraries of all empires contained in the Vatican. Upon us is a great religious figurehead, it has the smallest nation, a little horn, the smallest nation in all the world but yet one of the most prominent nations of the world. Now, what we're looking at here is we know whatever the seven thunders are, they must be found in the testimony of the prophets. So as we said before, as we open the first seal, the white horse, the bow, the crown, it is brought to view in the 45th Psalm. You know, you agree with me so far, right?

DICK: I'm following you, yes.

DAVID: Okay, now, we've already been shown that the truth of that 45th Psalm tells us who's going to win this battle, who's the mightiest of them all, and the reason it's giving is so that the definite threat may be known that men might fear God, 'cause Christ doesn't really want to hurt anybody. That's up to them. If they want to go ahead and take a punch, the prophet's have given the details of the aftermath of that.

Now, but the point is, is that the girl brought to view in Psalm's 45, Hearken O daughter, and consider, brings us to Revelation 19, where the marriage of the lamb does come, and the wife does make herself ready, and the invitation there is blessed is everyone that is called to the marriage sufferer of the lamb. And that's what we're trying to do, we're trying to invite people to life eternal, to become one with the spirit of God. The spirit of man and the spirit of woman should be unity. Their minds should be as one, their hearts should as one.

On the later days in the doctrine of God, God has something on his mind. God's got seven seals. Christ is one with the father. Christ, likewise, has seven eyes, he knows what the seven seals are and all those are unity with me and knowledge of the seven seals

shall be a part of the marriage of the lamb, that event of Revelation 19, which clearly tells you that after that subject is brought to view in the 19th Chapter, then John sees the heaven depart and the man on the white horse is there and righteously this judge and make war.

Now, no one's going to get hurt until it is fulfilled that the probation of man has not been sufficient in regards to God's allowing him to have the privileges which they again will reject. That's what Isaiah 27 is all about. Let righteousness, -- show the wicked, you -- learn righteousness. They just don't care about God's magistrate, they just don't care about his judiciary, his thrown and his word.

Now, the second seal, the man on the red horse who has the great sword, if they should kill one another is the events referring to Zechariah's testimony where Zechariah Chapter 1, he explains that God's angry at the Jews 'cause they would not listen to the former prophets. Zechariah sees a vision, a man riding on the red horse --

DICK: In committing war and bloodshed.

DAVID: No, that's not what it says.

DICK: Okay.

DAVID: The key note is that the events reveal that in the word of God, God is able to entail

the future, and because the testimony of Christ, which 1 is the spirit of prophecy, we see the warfare comes in 2 the fact that in the vision, Zechariah's shown four 3 horns and he questions the angel of the Lord, which is on this red horse, what be these? And he says, these 5 are they which scattered Judah, Israel, and 6 Jerusalem, that there be nobody and no place, that they 7 can now lift up their head. Now, that was the four 8 horns of Babylon, Medopersia (Phonetic), Greece and 9 Rome. And the prophet says that they will come back 10 one day to Jerusalem as carpenters to build. In other 11 words, the Jews, having been scattered, by war, by 12 confrontation, by political power, which is people 13 killing one another, just as the seal tells us, they 14 will come back one day to build there. 15 Well, we know in Jerusalem today, on Mt. Zion, 16 there's a catholic tabernacle there. We know that all 17 religions of the world from all of these empires today, 18 known as Europe, all have places and churches in 19 Jerusalem. 20 God states clearly though, that when he gets ready 21 to take over Jerusalem, 'cause he's jealous for -- the 22 great jealousy, it'll be manifested by a wall of fire 23 around the bout. When God is ready to set up his 24 kingdom there, there's not going to be a multitude of 25

religions and a multitude of professions, because

that's just confusion. There's one God and there's one book and there's one set of seals and there's one lamb, then if there's not a unity in that, then only that and that truth shall win and prevail.

Now, the third seal, we turn to the Book of Revelation again, as in Chapter 10, the seven thunders, which are uttered, whatever this sixth seal, sixth trumpet is about this 200 million, which is definitely more troops than you got out here, isn't it?

DICK: It certainly is.

DAVID: I think you're outnumbered my friend.
We find out there in the third seal, it says right
here, and there went out, this is Revelation 6 verses 4

DICK: Hold on for a second, David.
Revelation 6, verse 4.

DAVID: This horse, which was red, had power, second seal, now, Chapter, verse, verse 5, when he had opened the third seal, I heard a third beast say, come and see. And behold lo a black horse. He that sat up on him, had a pair of balances in his hand. And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, a measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny. See thou hurt not the oil and the wine. Okay, now --

DICK: Which were very precious in that day.

No. That day is not that day. These DAVID: 1 seals are to be revealed --2 No, I understand. DICK: 3 DAVID: -- in the end of the world. 4 DICK: But I understand. Oil and wine were, 5 are a very precious thing in --6 DAVID: Oil and wine were basic --7 DICK: -- extreme. 8 DAVID: -- every day commodities of Israel. 9 The olive trees flourished, everybody had it, just like 10 today everybody's got margarine and everybody's got 11 12 Crisco. DICK: All right. 13 You know? I mean, everybody's got DAVID: 14 these things, you know, they were never scarce. 15 DICK: All right. 16 DAVID: Now, but remember, that, which must 17 be hereafter, revolves around seals that, when there's 18 time no longer, will be finished. DAVID: Now, remember, the seven seals of the Book of Revelation, the same God of the gentiles is still the God of Israel. In the Romans 11, what we've been shown, is Paul made it very clear that God did not cast away his people which he knew. For the redeemer we find, according to Paul, says that all Israel will be saved as it is written, and he quotes the prophecies of Isaiah, that the redeemer shall again one day return to Zion and shall turn away and -- from Jacob and this is the covenants that I will make with them when I shall take away their sins. Because we're seen and we're judging to see whether you gentiles, whether you who claim to spiritual Israel are going to be any more decent and any more respective to your messiah, but when I'm trying to show you the seals and what the Jews were 2,000 years ago. You've got to learn these seals. Now, Hosea very clearly states that they're going to seek the Lord their God in the latter days. Is that true or is that false?

DICK: That is true.

DAVID: So would there not be a truth here worth knowing pertaining to the latter days?

DICK: There would be.

DAVID: Okay, now, we go over here and we see in Chapter 6, -- 'cause remember, my students, I, I

1 open up these whole books --2. DICK: All right. DAVID: -- to them. You know, they feel that 3 truth is, is worth enough time to spend sufficient time 4 and fully comprehending every measure of statement in 5 these books, comparing them with all the statements to 7 the other prophets, okay? Now, we see in Chapter 6 of Hosea. What does it 8 9 say to us? 10 Israel is unrepentant. DICK: 11 DAVID: Well, go ahead. Chapter 6 of Hosea. Verse 1. 12 DICK: Come, let us return to the Lord. 13 14 has torn us to pieces but he will heal us. injured us but he will bind up our wound. 15 DAVID: By scattering amongst the nation. Go 16 ahead. 17 18 After two days he will revive us. the third day he will restore us and we may live in his 19 20 presence. 21 Let us acknowledge the Lord. Let us press on to acknowledge him as surely as the sun rises, he will 22 appear, he will come to us like the winter rains. 23 Okay. So the angel who is sent from 24 DAVID: the east are sent just like the sun arises, doesn't he? 25 And what's the great light that he has? He has the

words of the seven seals. Go ahead.

DICK: Like the spring rains, the water, the earth, Chapter, or Verse 4, what can I do for you? And from what can I do for you, Judah? Your love is like the morning mist, like the early dew that disappears.

DAVID: It doesn't last long, does it.

DICK: Just a short while. Therefore, I cut you in pieces with my prophets. I killed you with the words of my mouth. My judgments flash like lightning upon you.

DAVID: Okay. For the covenant of the son of man, it's suppose to be lighting from the eastern side to the west, seven seals. What else can merciful God in heaven do for you people? If you cannot believe in the warnings and the forward nations of Gods testament, if you cannot sit here and reason with us, and back down and humble your hearts before God, everything written by the mouth of the prophets will come upon you in perfect order.

I'm afraid for you. You, you're saying, on the one hand, that you, that you respect my religion, and on the other hand, I'm playing a life and death riddle with you, I'm trying to be a merchant with you, I'm trying to deal with you in mercy as best to my ability, and you say that my actions are contrary to your laws. I agree, but remember, your actions, likewise, shall be

uncovered. Your deeds and your activities shall be 1 investigated to the very light of, of reason, and 2 everything that you and your nations ever done. I'm 3 willing to throw these records out, but you have to 4 first acknowledge God. Forget about me, I'm just a 5 middle man. Forget about me. I am nothing more than 6 what God has permitted me to be. But the seven seals 7 are definitely important things. 8 9 Now, verse 6, what did God desire? DICK: Mercy, not sacrifice. 10 DAVID: Yes, and the knowledge of what? 11 DICK: Acknowledgment of God rather than 12 burnt offering. 13 DAVID: And how do we know God but by his 14 seven seals, when there's time no longer, right? 15 DICK: Right. 16 DAVID: Okay. Now, it's very important then, 17 I'm hoping you're being able to see. Very important. 18 Now he says here, over here, that in Chapter 7, 19 verses 15. What does that verse mean there to you? 20 DICK: Verse 15? 21 DAVID: Right. 22 Okay, hold on for a second. DICK: 23 them and strengthen them that they do not plot evil 24 against me. Educated and strengthen so they won't plot 25

DAVID: The evil against God, right? 1 DICK: Exactly. 2. DAVID: So verse 16, what do they do then? 3 They do not turn to the most High. 4 DICK: They are like a faulty bow, their leaders will fall by 5 the sword because of their insolent words. 6 DAVID: Rage of their tongues, go ahead. 7 8 DICK: For this they will be ridiculed in the land of Egypt. 9 DAVID: Okay. 10 They will be ridiculed by God. 11 DICK: 12 DAVID: Okay. Because something to do with their tongues, raging against someone, right? 13 Um-hum. 14 DICK: Okay, so we go over here, in verses DAVID: 15 11 and 12, and what does your scripture say there? 16 DICK: Verses 11 or 12 or are we talking 17 18 about Chapter 11 and 12? DAVID: No, verses 11, 12, Chapter 8. 19 Okay. Though Ephraim built many 20 DICK: altars for sin offerings, these had become altars for 21 sinning. 22 DAVID: Okay. 23 DICK: Wrote for them the many things of my 24 law, but they regarded them as something alien. 25

they didn't, they didn't follow the law --

DAVID: No, wait a minute. I have written to 1 them the great things of my law, --2 DICK: Okay. 3 DAVID: -- but they were counted as a strange 4 5 thing.
