An altercation erupted 22 between Saigon Penn and the uniformed officer because 23 of racial slurs that the uniformed officer made to Saigon Penn. 25

It erupted, finally another 1 officer came eventually, another one-man car, and eventually wound up with Saigon Penn shooting and killing the uniformed officer and shooting and wounding the lady, the unarmed lady who was a ride-along in the 5 ride-along car. What do you think happened to Saigon Penn? STEVE SCHNEIDER: Tell me. JOHN-2: He was acquitted. Why was he acquitted? Self-defense. Saigon Penn was acquired for 10 self-defense. Now, you asked me about a ATF agent. 11 Obviously, I'm not alone here. Somebody just handed me 12 a, a, a -- two notes. 13 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Um-hum. 14 JOHN-2: There was an ATF agent who was 15 convicted of attempted murder to kill his wife. He is 16 presently in prison. There was an FBI agent and a 17 Customs agent down in Florida who were into stealing 18 drugs. They have been charged and indicted. So, to 19 answer your question, we do indict and we do convict 20 Government agents for wrongdoing. Period. 21 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Well, it sounds good. 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there is wrongdoing no matter what. And -- it would appear like to cover their butts for what they did. 2 JOHN-2: Well, don't you think it's about 3 time that somebody comes out and sets the record straight? 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tanks out there digging and doing things. They all got 1 to hear originally Jim make a statement no one would be 2 on the property. Those --3 JOHN-2: Steve --4 STEVE SCHNEIDER: -- kind -- that -- John, 5 that's out of -- that's what I'm dealing with. I says who am I speaking to. He says you'll find out. He says your end is coming. He says you're going to be taken out. He says you're going to lose your life. I mean, the-these are the kind of threats we've had over and over again.

JOHN-2: Okay. We get -- believe it or not, we get those at the office too, you know.

STEVE SCHNEIDER: Well, I believe that, but, I mean, you know, that always makes people jumpy, but we've never taken that -- I've always said, well -- you know, I mean, it does give you the willies a little bit, that you could be driving around or going here or

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there and someone might tempt to do some weird, offthe-wall thing with all the people out -- the, the 2 way things are these days. 3 JOHN-2: Steve, if you --4 STEVE SCHNEIDER: But, I mean --5 6 JOHN-2: -- if you're only held -- you 7 personally are only held as a material witness and Judy is only held as a material witness, you'll be out on 8 bond in, in a day, like the, like the two other --9 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Well, I do believe --10 JOHN-2: -- they, they --11 STEVE SCHNEIDER: That's why I told you I'm 12 not so concerned about my--13 I know. Let me tell you something, this is one of the biggest events in the nation. I mean, the World Trade Center bombing ---STEVE SCHNEIDER: And, and we don't --JOHN-2: -- is over. STEVE SCHNEIDER: Just so you have it right, though, John, we didn't want that. We don't want to --JOHN-2: I know that. STEVE SCHNEIDER: -- be a notoriety or be-become infamous. JOHN-2: Of course not. STEVE SCHNEIDER: I mean, here -- the statements that are made, like Bob Ricks, about how he believes that he wants to be heard around the world --I mean, what -- we had our own plan. We believed that in the <u>Bible</u> it talks about a Hebrew word called

shigionoth. It means turbulent lyrics, by music, the highest form of communication there is, John. the music, he is an awesome guitarist. And, in fact, we've already had invitations all around Hollywood and the, the best places to be able to perform. the truth. We can check -- do you want 22 us to check on that and find out --23 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Yes. Yes. 24 JOHN-2: -- what was --25 STEVE SCHNEIDER: You know, if you need a

search warrant or whatever you might want to do, go ahead and do that and -- because, you know, we -- even 2 3 now, if we can do anything to help alleviate or can get 4 information or whatever else, you know, check it all out, because we left things in the garage. We left 5 things, if you want, like -- say, in the house there is 6 like a cellar, and I can't remember what was left in 7 8 there, but I think there were things left in there and 9 in certain closets and so --10 JOHN-2: Okay. Just, just do me a favor and, and repeat the address for me, if you would. 11 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Okay. 12 13 JOHN-2: I can get this stuff done. STEVE SCHNEIDER: It's 178 --14 JOHN-2: 15 178. 16 STEVE SCHNEIDER: -- East Arrow Highway. 17 JOHN-2: East Arrow Highway. STEVE SCHNEIDER: So, I was talking to David 18 19 yesterday. I forgot to --20 JOHN-2: In Pomona? STEVE SCHNEIDER: Yes. In, in Pomona. 21 JOHN-2: And whose house is that? 22 23 STEVE SCHNEIDER: That was ours. You can -- it doesn't matter what --5 JOHN-2: How's he feeling this morning? 6 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Not good. 7 JOHN-2: Not good? 8 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Definitely not good. 9 JOHN-2: What's --10 STEVE SCHNEIDER: He's draining. And I went 11 into -- I did peek in the door there. I knocked at the 12 door, peeked in the door, and I -- he said a few words 13 to me. But he -- it -- wound is draining -- I did notice that. It doesn't seem like the bleed -- there's 15 bleeding there, but he definitely is not feeling well. 16 JOHN-2: Headache? 17 STEVE SCHNEIDER: He didn't, he didn't say 18 anything about a headache, but he just said overall 19 he's not feeling well at all today. 20 JOHN-2: Um-hum. 21 STEVE SCHNEIDER: So, I says, well, you know, 22 you know where I'm at. If you want, just call for me and I'll be back to you and --24 JOHN-2: Okay. 25 STEVE SCHNEIDER: So, he said he would do

that. He's going to still try to rest, hoping that sleep will go a long way with taking care of the problems. 3 JOHN-2: I hope, I hope he hasn't gotten blood poisoning, you know, because that's literally 5 life-threatening, you know, and --6 STEVE SCHNEIDER: I understand that. 7 know, I, I -- I'm sure -- he is aware of that. 8 JOHN-2: Well, you've got nurses there, so --9 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Right. 10 What's Julianne saying about how JOHN-2: 11 he's doing? Does she check him out? 12 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Yes. They have been. 13 fact, I think they're going to be coming back to him 14 here pretty quickly. 15 JOHN-2: Yeah, has he -- can you tell from 16 the, from the reports of Julianne -- or -- you have one 17 or two nurse? Two nurses? 18 STEVE SCHNEIDER: We have two. 19 JOHN-2: Two. 20 STEVE SCHNEIDER: To tell you the truth, I'm 21 not, I'm not very impressed, though. I'm not. You 22 know, there are some that have had a lot of experiences with --24 Um-hum. JOHN-2: 25 STEVE SCHNEIDER: -- emergency wards.

these two we have do not seem like they have had that kind of experience. 2 JOHN-2: Well, see -- yeah, you're right. 3 And the same is tr--4 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Even like, say, with Judy's 5 I'm not impressed with, you know -- right from 6 finger. the beginning when that happened, the care that was 7 given and, and the manner it was given. 8 JOHN-2: Well, you know, there's all kinds of 9 different doctors. Some treat trauma and, and injuries 10 and others treat, you know, different things. 11 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Well, that's the thing. 12 JOHN-2: And so --13 STEVE SCHNEIDER: I think that they lack in 14 that area probably. 15 JOHN-2: Unless you get somebody who is 16 familiar with trauma, which is, is basically what 17 gunshot is, unless you get a nurse who's been in the ER 18 and the OR a lot and seen a lot of trauma, then they're 19 probably not that, you know, experienced. 20 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Exactly. 21 JOHN-2: I mean, not that they don't have 22 great intentions, but they're not plainly experienced. 23 I know, I know Judy wouldn't want to come out without 24 you, and I know how strongly she feels about that, 25 because she, she told us. But -- in fact I talked to

her last night. You -- I don't know if you were around 2 or not. 3 STEVE SCHNEIDER: I don't think so. JOHN-2: No. Okay. I talked to her and then 4 I asked her about her finger and she said, hey, David 5 6 said that it was three-and-a-half times its size and she said that it's at least double its size and the, 7 the tape looks like somewhere in between. 8 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Right. 9 JOHN-2: But, I'll be honest with you --10 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Right. 11 JOHN-2: -- it doesn't look real good to me, 12 13 you know, and I'm not a doctor. But it just looks bad. It looks like --14 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Oh, it is. It does look 15 good. And then, you know, I'm concerned about 16 gangrene. I'm concerned about any other --17 JOHN-2: Well --18 STEVE SCHNEIDER: -- infection or whatever. 19 JOHN-2: Yeah. I mean, if you get blood 20 poisoning that's plain and simply life-threatening. 21 And the doctors said to me last night on the phone, his 22 exact words were: "The hand does not sustain infection 23 well." And I'm not quite sure what he meant. 24

STEVE SCHNEIDER: I don't -- you know what?

I believe that would be true. I wouldn't doubt that at

25

all. 2 JOHN-2: Yeah. So, I was speaking directly to a physician. And, you know, they've got their 3 limitations. The videotape, you get color changes and all that stuff and it's not really as clear as --5 there's no substitute for being treated. That's, 6 that's the bottom line on that. 7 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Yeah. 8 JOHN-2: So, you know, I know you care about 9 her a lot. If there's some way we could get her 10 treated --11 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Of course. 12 JOHN-2: How do you want to do it? You know 13 what I mean? If you -- you know, between you and me, 14 you could send your wife out with the video, and then 15 we could pick her up and take her to the hospital. You 16 know. Do you think you can talk her into it for her 17 own sake? 18 STEVE SCHNEIDER: I really doubt it, 19 seriously. 20 JOHN-2: You know. 21 STEVE SCHNEIDER: I was doing that earlier, 22 since talking to you, and she said she doesn't want to 23 do that. And I says well, okay, I'm not going to -- I 24 says you, you talk to me about it if you want to and 25 I'll leave it with you. So, that's more or less what

I've done now. JOHN-2: Okay. So, she's pretty committed to 2 3 staying? STEVE SCHNEIDER: Yeah. She, she says look, 4 Steve, I've stayed this far. I've heard this from the 5 Bible. My soul's on the line, and she says I want to 6 hear what his God has to say. 7 JOHN-2: Um-hum. 8 STEVE SCHNEIDER: She says I'm, I'm very 9 interested. And I says okay, well, I won't, won't say 10 anything. And --11 JOHN-2: Sure. 12 STEVE SCHNEIDER: -- they're all hoping that, 13 you know, it could happen today even. 14 JOHN-2: Well, it would be great if it could 15 happen today, you know. 16 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Exactly. You know, like, 17 seriously, a week ago Tuesday, when he said we're going 18 out everybody was gla-- I mean, nobody had it -- there, 19 there was no question about it. And, and he said I, I 20 want to have a last prayer. He was praying. Even he, 21 I really don't think, expected that he was going to --22 in fact, I know he wasn't. He was committed to going 23 out. 24 JOHN-2: Sounded like that. 25 STEVE SCHNEIDER: He, he gave me a last

instruction, how, you know -- would you say this and that for me if I don't get to talk. And I says well, sure I will. You know, and this is, this is what happened a week ago. JOHN-2: Yeah. I know. I know. STEVE SCHNEIDER: So -- and, then, he's hears 6 an audible voice saying one word, not any -- not even 7 any instruction really other than just wait. 8 JOHN-2: Yeah. 9 STEVE SCHNEIDER: He's even told me himself. 10 He's, he's wondering how long and -- so, I mean -- so, 11 like with herself, that's why I brought that up, with 12 herself she says she wants to see. You know And, besides, even -- I mean, even if you had 21 the slightest doubt in the world that we would, the 22 world is watching, CNN, ABC, NBC, CBS --23 24 STEVE SCHNEIDER: Well, not really, because, you know, they don't have -- like, again, you guys have 25 kept them so at bay that -- I mean, even with a, a

couple different radio stations trying to make a connection to us -- I mean, look at what Ricks had to say? And his reasons he gave, no one buys that. But, like, even in the book of Ezekiel, there 19 was no Assyrian or 12 tribes in the days of Ezekiel, 20 even though he ac-- he speaks of them as if they exist. 21 22 JOHN-2: Yeah. 23 STEVE SCHNEIDER: So, obviously, he's seeing • 24 something in the future and he's labelling something with the same spirit of the past. You understand? 25 JOHN-2: I understand.

STEVE SCHNEIDER: So, you know, you take the time and look at Nahum as a person, John. John, I like you. I like talking to you.

JOHN-2: And vice versa.

STEVE SCHNEIDER: I like, I like your attempt to even with me and I respect you highly already. I really do.

JOHN-2: Thank you.

STEVE SCHNEIDER: And, I mean, whatever comes of this, I want to see you live forever. I hope one day you and I can be travelling throughout space, I can come visit you, and vice versa, and I, I, I believe that's possible.

JOHN-2: Well, I'm going to tell you one thing in respect to that you were already in there -- talking to -- today. That's the Assyrian. That's the bottom line with me, you know.

STEVE SCHNEIDER: Well, you know, like what Rick said about me, about showing a, an uneven temper---or temperament. Well, sure, I have shown that, but it comes from a frustration upon one hand we being asked to do one thing and on the other hand those showing the contrary of what they're doing on the outside of the building. Those are the things. Or the threats.
