When you come out and tell the press what occurred and what the incorrect statements have been, that's the way to get your story out because -- for this reason, they are going to record you on video. They are going to record you on audio and that is going to be played on CNN and every network throughout America.

STEVE: Does it -- John, does it bother you in any degree at all that the FBI and/or the government can control and have such power over the press and other factions of society? Does that bother you?

JOHN: Let, let me tell you something.

Control of the press, if you call it control of the press, only occurs when there's one side giving their, giving their point because they have nothing else to focus their attention on. When you have two sides of an issue, even in the case of Watergate, you had deep throat, you know. And, and it's often been referred to that the press is out of control. You know what I

mean? 2 STEVE: I'm not talking about the press being out of control. I'm talking about how they've not been 3 allowed to cover the story and they're all saying basically the same thing. 6 JOHN: Steve --7 STEVE: There's, there's some others across America that are raising some pretty strong issues 8 about the Constitution, about what -- how far the 9 government's already gone, the concept of Big Brother. 10 I mean seriously. 11 12 JOHN: Let me tell -- let me tell you 13 something. 14 STEVE: Long before this -- I mean just from 15 my own observation, being at different universities, speaking with professors, just watching history, 16 there's been so many holes in the history that a lot of 17 these professors have given and through the years you 18 ask questions. Where's the other dimension? There's 19 20 something missing here. 21 JOHN: Steve, when, when you come out and you 22 address the press --23 STEVE: Well, I wouldn't be addressing anything like that in the first place -- kind of 24 25 nonsense.

And, so, churches and religious bodies are a witness to the world that there is a God and that there are things unseen that are realities and that we who live in the world of reality should take knowledge of the wisdom of the ancients, those who were closer to the beginnings of time and those who witnessed the manifestations of God, you know. The Bible scripture, it's been around a long time. We've all been confronted with it, haven't we?

JOHN: Sure.

DAVID: Okay. And, of course, you know, we, just as many other groups in this country are

professing a knowledge of God and a lot of people are startled to, to hear what foundation I'm basing our knowledge 'cause we do claim that we're separate from everybody else and not to be compared with any, although that's definitely what people are trying to grasp a hold of.

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Now, within our range, like I say, the opening of the seals is the most prolific and the most important event in the history of religion known to the scriptures of the Bible. I mean it's, it's the last event, isn't it? And, of course, it's also in itself, it's a test, it's a test and it's an event, it's a political matter. I've been trying to explain to Mr. Dolan about this because, you know, if there is a God, -- he has a government, too, doesn't he? And as we have a sun and we have a system of planetary bodies that, you know, revolve around the sun. So, there are many suns throughout the universe and galaxies and, and just enumerable.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: And we would be vain to think that we're the only form of life or intelligence in this world. I mean just on -- in this, this solar system.

I mean, no doubt about it, probability and wisdom would teach us that there are intelligence far above us and beyond.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

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2 STEVE: And, of course, you know, if there is 3 this governing power and system called God and if God has communicated to men in this world and if it is 4 through the testament of scripture, then no doubt, 5 again, I emphasize that, you know, the seven seals is 6 definitely a mystery. It's an in-time thing. When 7 8 there's time no longer, this mystery should be finished. And this is our position. I know it seems to your view to be a, an abstract or a strange --10 especially based upon our apparent actions, you know. 11 I understand that you all don't want to deal with us on 12 a religious basis, especially from the fact that men 13 have lost their lives. I mean, you know, we're under 14 investigation for firearms misuse. 15 I mean, you know, these are things that we understand, you know, and I'm 16 very sympathetic in regards to these things. But where 17 we're at right now, separate from where you're at, is 18 that, you know, we have a knowledge and an 19 understanding and within our own ranks, within the 20 members -- you know how mankind is, we all make 21 mistakes, don't we? 22

JOHN: Of course.

DAVID: You know, within our own members we have a problem that is based upon knowledge that's been given from the scripture, knowledge that's been

violated within our own ranks and there are people who
have been enlightened in regards to the will of God in
harmony from the Bible and they found themselves in
transgression to this will. And, like I say, you have
to bear with me to try and understand --

JOHN: I, I'm listening to you.

DAVID: -- from our point of view. So, you know, and, you know, like I say, when they, when they brought all these things in, you know -- of course, we, we knew, we knew that, you know, the FBI -- remember Mr. Friday and all that on T.V., you know. You know, we knew, we knew you all had bugs and stuff, you know, but --

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: -- the thing, the thing of it is this, you know, understand that from amongst us it's not just a matter of people coming out to the, to the judicial system of justice as it is known in the world, it's a matter of a person finding themselves, reconciled unto God because, you know, the Bible teaches clearly throughout all the prophetic writings that God controls the affairs of the nations. You know, there's no nation or empire that's not been allowed to be set up except to be by God.

JOHN: 'Uh-huh.

DAVID: I mean, you know, God's letting us

| all live.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: And, so, where we stand right now, and I've been trying to explain this since day one and I know it's been kind of, you know, abstract to you, is that we are resolving something within ourselves in regards to individuals who have been found in this transgression, you know. The, the event of Sunday took place.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: Like I say, we have been preparing for, for not this event, in particular, but forever since 1985.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: I mean, you know, the testament of the prophets, the testament of the revelation, the perfect harmonization of scripture, the mind of those who said that God said, you know. Has to be perfectly harmonized before we can get a complete picture and that's what we have done. Individuals have received this information but they, but they fail to adhere to it and every principle and this puts them in a bad light with God.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: And, so, now what we're resolving now is the fact that, that we, that we understand -- and

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this is where I tell you that I've been waiting for information from my commander which I state is the God who sits on the throne, my father, which -- he's your father, everybody else's father, too. It's just some people don't know him to the degree that maybe others do. And in the reconciliation, we're in the process now to where these individuals who will be coming out, they know why they'll be coming out.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

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DAVID: And they understand and they are to be made to understand that, you know, everything from this point on is in the providence of God and this is where my position comes in to show them from the testaments again, to reconfirm the covenants.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: Reconfirm to them that what's been written aforetime -- well, you know, that's one thing that God always states, like through Isaiah, he claims he's the God who declares the end from the beginning from ancient times, things not yet done. He claims that by his word he made heaven and earth and he claims by his word his projections of future events will come to pass as he declares. He claims he has that power over the sun, moon, stars, the elements of the atomic creation. You know, he says he can bring it to pass as he will. And he gives me his options. There are

prophets that don't need to be fulfilled. No one needs to be destroyed.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

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DAVID: You know, and there are prophecies that should men fail to take heed to this counsel and his will, then they will definitely receive the retribution foretold.

Now, there are people here who are really more concerned and afraid in the fear of God than they are of what they might receive in punishment at your hand.

JOHN: Uh-huh. Uh-huh.

DAVID: You know. Israel was scattered amongst the nations because when Israel wanted to be like the nations, they forfeited their blessings from God. So, God says, all right, you want to be like them, get out there with them.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: You know, like the prodigal son and the new covenant, you know. And you'll be under their laws and under their mandates and you follow -- like with Babylon, God says to Isaiah -- I mean to Jeremiah, those who go into Babylon, seek the peace of Babylon. And, and, you know, and where the cities of peace will have, then you'll have peace.

JOHN: Uh-huh.

DAVID: You're under the law -- and we 1 believe in that. 2 3 JOHN: Uh-huh. 4 DAVID: You know, we believe in the 5 Constitution. We believe in America. We know God has blessed this nation above all nations, you know. It 7 may be true we may have stepped over the borderline of certain regulations but there's a reason for it and 8 that's where it lies in the hands of God. 9 10 JOHN: Uh-huh. DAVID: Something that God will have to get 11 us out of, you know. We step into the fires of, of 12 Babylon. It, it's going to take God to get us out of 13 14 it. 15 JOHN: Uh-huh. DAVID: And we, and we are fully ready and 16 satisfied with that, you know, your decisions in 17 regards to our judicial position. We're satisfied 18 with what the courts will decide in regards to our 19 individual cases because our faith, again, is based in 20 21 a higher court, you know. 22 JOHN: Right. 23 If we go to the Supreme Court here and are found guilty in every degree, then we, we have 24 25 confidence there's one last court.

JOHN: Right.

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DAVID: You understand what I'm saying?

JOHN: Completely.

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DAVID: Okay. So, so, this is something that I know -- you know, we've been trying to emphasize to you all but, again, the shadows of the walls between us is, is the, is the fact and it is a fact that, you know, that the way you perceive me to be and the way I may be is two different things.

DAVID: But our knowledge in regards to the last will and testament, you know, to the Christian church, clearly what must be hereafter is the seals. I mean that's what John the revelator stated. DAVID: -- run like the lightnings, you know, 13 we're gonna -- you know, I -- see, I've been preparing 14 my students for this for many years and that's why 15 we're having a bad trouble. You know, I've been 16 teaching about them that when the time comes of the 17 18 passion or the time of the end which is not just a bang, God wipes everybody out. It's, it's a 19 progressive thing. You know, I've told them that --20 21 JOHN: Uh-huh. DAVID: -- that there's going to be -- you're 22 going to see these things, you're going to see these 23 tanks, you're going to see these things right here in 24 your front yard, you know. God's going to let us know. 25

And I can honestly tell you that nobody tipped us off
