Now but here this Moses is standing before Pharaoh, and

Pharaoh questions by what authority he's come to him.

Moses says I am sent me. What did that look like to

Moses -- I mean to, to Pharaoh? He's being a wiseguy,

right?

JOHN: Sure.

DAVID: You know, Pharaoh in all of his splendor and grandeur, you know, becomes -- hey, here's this, here's this shepherd guy saying I am sent me.

Let my people go. Who's this -- this guy's a madman.

Well, so God began to very cautiously work in degrees to where whose word would stand? Would it be Pharaoh's word? Would it be Moses's word?

Well, Moses says, you know, thus shall happen to you. Thus shall happen to you. The manifestations were shown. The plagues came. And finally, Pharaoh had to get on his knees, you know. That was all done in mercy.

But the king had a hard problem with taking the facts. Just like the same spirit is in man in every generation. In the days of Christ, hey, the manifestations were so clear not in hurting people, not in destroying property and all that, but in mercy and

1 truth. And yet the Sanhedrin and the Pharisees
2 couldn't see the facts. They just could not see.
3 Because it crossed the grains of their own pride.

I mean this guy was taking people after him. They were saying hey, all the nation's falling after him. We got to stop this. It's bad for business. Christ was killed because he was bad for business. No people in the synagogues on the Sabbath. They're all out on the countryside listening to sermons for free. No, no tides coming in.

Hey, the guy goes, the guy goes to Jack in the Box and, and carries 5,000 people with him, and the guys inside, who this guy -- 5,000. We're going to make big money today. He orders one, one Jack in the Box burger, one milkshake and orders 5,000 cups. You know, the guy pays, gets paid for one burger and, and one, one milkshake and 5,000 cups, and the guy goes out and feeds 5,000 and walks off, you know? That's bad for business. You see what I'm saying?

JOHN: Sure.

DAVID: And so that kind of gift the world did not want that kind of knowledge, that kind of technology. A man from beyond the stars came to the world, came to be born of a virgin, came to manifest the powers beyond this world. And the world was making a buck. And it didn't want it as of yet. Man loves --
