1 brings out an incredible value in us as a people. 2 HENRY: Um-hum. 3 DAVID: I mean, you know, we got to respect -- we're all sons and daughters of God. 4 I mean literally, you know. 5 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: Okay. So, so when I began to show 8 them how I got this, then it goes on to say, you know, 9 thus said the Lord to His anointed, ask Me concerning 10 My sons and the work of My hands. Command ye Me. I have made man upon the earth and forged him from the 11 12 dust of the earth. I have given him My Spirit and I will raise him up and direct all his ways. 13 14 See, God begins to explain things and, of 15 course, you know, my advantage is that I never was very 16 good in literature, reading or anything, but if -- once I was shown all these things, and it's like wow. 17 like whew! You know, the Bible calls the quickening. 18 19 The quickening is a process of learning where knowledge 20 is implanted -- right into your spectrum of 21 comprehension. 22 HENRY: Um-hum. 23 It's just like, Bing! DAVID: You're 24 quickened! Like, I know it all. You know. It's kind 25 of like -- have you ever seen the movie, "Lawnmower

Man"?

1 HENRY: Um-hum. 2 DAVID: Okay. See, Satan is a counterfeiter. Course Satan has all the money in the world. So see 3 ever since I started, right? 4 5 HENRY: Um-hum. 6 DAVID: With this communication between, you 7 know, Orion and, and myself. 8 HENRY: Um-hum. 9 All of a sudden, everything that I DAVID: 10 was experiencing -- Satan came out and inspired men in 11 this world to try to counteract and counterfeit it by 12 making movies and stuff. Like "Terminator-2" and all 13 that kind of stuff? 14 HENRY: Yeah. 15 Where you've got these fighting 16 machines and stuff that just blow everything up and 17 destroy everything? Well, that's the same as what Joel 18 through the prophecies talk about with regards to 19 Messiah and all that. You know, the mind and the world 20 is getting so close to the fulfillment of all the 21 events that the ancients have been inspired to see. In 22 their day they couldn't explain it, because they 23 couldn't explain modern -- modernized, you know, technology. 24 25 HENRY: Um-hum.

He goes like, whoa, and he was 8 telling me like, man, this is so awesome. 9 10 HENRY: Um-hum. 11 DAVID: I says yeah, you know, but still. 12 So, like, Joel, it's, it's you're like trying to study without the vision, you're kind of like going, 13 what's these chariots and torches? What, they got like 14 15 torches that, you know, like they're trying to get 16 light from it? No. 'Cause these torches cause the 17 trees to shake terribly. 18 HENRY: Um-hum. 19 DAVID: You see? It causes the ground to 20 thunder, just like Nahum in the prophecies say. 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 But sad to say is that Nahum says that when they confront those who, you know, fortified 23 24 their power mightily, which you know is us. I'm happy 25 to say in the light of God, I'm sad to say in the light that, you know, there's no, I mean, you know, I like

HENRY: 3 Um-hum. 4 So, you know, so like I've had to sit a lot of times and let people tell me and then I'll 5 have to sit there and go, well, that sounds good, but 6 7 have you ever thought about -- and then I start showing them out of the Bible. Like, for instance, the -- one 8 9 of the easiest ones is the sixth seal, which -- here in Joel tells about the sun, moon and stars being 10 11 darkened. Here in Zephaniah, sun, moon and stars being 12 darkened. Here in Amos they kind of go like, oh, yeah 13 -- oh, yeah. 14 And all of a sudden they get excited because 15 like yeah, that's what that is. And they begin to see 16 that from the written word, their own Bible, the 17 picture becomes plainer than what -- and then more 18 enlightening than what they're own opinion of it was. 19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: So they -- in their own mind, they're 21 satisfied to divorce their own opinion and to readily 22 accept the wisdom that's been given by the Book. 23 HENRY: Um-hum. 24 DAVID: So then they don't, they -- they look 25 at me and they go like, you know, yeah, you know, yeah, that's good. I like that, you know.

1 HENRY: Um-hum. 2 DAVID: How did you learn this, they say? 3 Then I go, uh-oh, you know, well, let me, let me show 4 you something over here. Come up hither, you know. 5 HENRY: That's right. 6 DAVID: Because the Lamb wasn't there. 7 Remember when the question was asked, who's worthy? 8 The Lamb wasn't there yet. 9 HENRY: Um-hum. 10 DAVID: Said no man. 11 HENRY: Um-hum. 12 DAVID: Then all of a sudden, all of a sudden 13 the Lamb appeared. And the reason why it's as, it's as 14 -- been slain is because God knows that already His 15 truth is not going to be accepted by the majority. 16 HENRY: Um-hum. 17 DAVID: You know. But yet the seven horns 18 mean the situation is completely under control, 19 completed power, and the seven eyes is complete vision 20 and every avenue opened, you know, and besides, God 21 says, when He refers to, to, to His Anointed One, you 22 know, which is the first-born of this generation, or 23 the first man that God will redeem, you know, He says 24 over here, and this is for the, this is for the 25 Gentiles. It's from chapter 60 all the way to 64 of Isaiah is the message that's to be given to the

1 Gentiles while they're still under the dominion of 2 Babylon. So it says -- actually, I'm sorry. It's from 40 to 66, instead of quoting it, I'll just read it 3 here. Here we go. Okay. Okay. So, in chapters, in 4 chapters 40 it tells you, it says, Behold, the Lord God 5 6 shall come with a strong hand -- of course that's the 7 Book. 8 HENRY: Um-hum. 9 His arm shall rule for Him, which DAVID: 10 (indiscernible) know as the Messiah. Behold His reward 11 is with Him, which is the Book, His work before him. 12 And His work is, He shall gather His flock like a 13 shepherd. 14 HENRY: Um-hum. 15 He shall gather the lambs with his DAVID: 16 arm and carry them in His bosom, and shall gently lead 17 those who are with youngs, which are the babies. 18 HENRY: Um-hum. 19 DAVID: Okay? So, then, all of a sudden, you 20 know, it's like, well, what is this reward? And, you 21 know, what is -- why has it got to be done this way 22 for? So the prophet goes to tell you something about 23 how deep this -- He goes, who would measure the waters in the hollow of His hand. In other words, how deep is 24 25 this truth? In Heaven, you know, it's a sea of glass, right?

1 HENRY: Um-hum. 2 DAVID: The Word of God is deep. 3 HENRY: Um-hum. 4 DAVID: And who has meted out Heaven with a 5 span and comprehend the dust of the earth. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: It says, who would -- who has 8 directed the Spirit of the Lord, being his counselor 9 had taught him. It says, behold the nations are a drop 10 of a bucket. That's why when the, when the 11 son of man comes with this Book --12 HENRY: Um-hum. 13 DAVID: That's why God's laughing at all of 14 these, these guys maneuvers out here with all these 15 little tin can tanks and all these heavy artilleries 16 and stuff. 17 HENRY: Um-hum. 18 DAVID: Of course, you know, to us, being of 19 the flesh to the rest of the people who are there, 20 they're kind of like, ehh, you know. 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 DAVID: They're kind of scared. It is, it is very scary, you know, in the flesh. 24 HENRY: Sure. 25 DAVID: But the faith reaches up higher and God already told us about it ahead of time anyway and

1 God's telling us that, you know, not to worry about it. That they're the ones that need to worry. 2 3 HENRY: Um-hum. Because they don't know what they're 4 DAVID: 5 doing. 6 HENRY: Right. DAVID: 7 It says here, and are counted as the small dust of the balance. 8 9 HENRY: Um-hum. 10 So it says here that -- it says, have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not been 11 told you from the beginning? Have you not understood 12 from the foundations of the world? It is God that 13 14 sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the 15 inhabitants thereof shall be as grasshoppers, and He 16 stretches forth a curtains of the heavens and spreadeth 17 them abroad, as a tent to dwell in. For He will bring 18 the princes to nothing and He will make the judges of the earth as vanity, which is the same as Psalms 2. 19 20 HENRY: Right. 21 The kings of the earth, the rulers, DAVID: 22 you know, they -- God laughs at them. 23 HENRY: Um-hum. 24 DAVID: Yea, they shall not be planted, which 25 means -- see, they're going to be destroyed because of

their attitude towards, you know, the, the Book.

1 That's what, that's what tears me up. It says here, 2 yea, they shall not be sown, yea, their stock shall take root in the earth, for God shall blow upon them --3 remember there's fire? 4 5 HENRY: Um-hum. 6 DAVID: And they shall wither and the 7 whirlwind, which is Jeremiah 30, the whirlwind of the 8 Lord, His fury, shall take them away as stubble. 9 HENRY: Um-hum. 10 DAVID: That's why Daniel says that the, the 11 rock hit the image in the feet. It all blew away. 12 HENRY: Um-hum. 13 DAVID: To whom then will you liken God, or 14 why, or why -- or shall I be equal saith the Holy One. 15 Lift up your eyes on high and behold who had created 16 these things from in the heavens? That bringeth out 17 their host by number, and see how the universe is up 18 there? 19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: For God calls them all by names by 21 the greatness of his might, for that he is strong in 22 power, not one faileth. Be awesome for one of those 23 stars to fall down and hit ours, wouldn't it? 24 HENRY: Um-hum. 25 DAVID: So why sayest thou, O Jacob, and

speakest, O Israel, that our way is hid from the Lord,

that our judgment is passed over from our God? 1 2 HENRY: Um-hum. See, 'cause in this, in this 3 4 situation, the prophecy, we get into a real scary 5 situation like, well, you know, well, are you going to 6 help us, God, or not? And God says, have you not 7 known? Have you not heard that the everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the all the ends of the earth, 8 fainteth not, neither is weary? There is no searching 9 10 (indiscernible) His understanding. 11 For He will give power to the faint and to 12 them that have no might He will increase strength. For 13 in this, the youths will be faint, which we are, and 14 weary. The young men shall utterly fall, which we 15 have, but they that wait upon the Lord shall renew 16 their strength. For they shall mount up with wings of eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall 17 18 walk and not faint. 19 Now, the reason being is in Matthew 24, this 20 is the fulfillment. These are the eagles that gather 21 with the carcass, and the carcass is the Lord who comes 22 with a strong hand, the Lord's body. Okay? 23 HENRY: Um-hum. 24 So what God admonishes in His record

in 42 is He states, this is His announcement to the world, He says, Behold My servant, whom I uphold. Now,

we know that the Father gives the Book to the Lamb, 1 2 right. 3 HENRY: Um-hum. Mine elect, I mean you know, the 4 DAVID: 5 Father elected him, right? HENRY: 6 Um-hum. 7 DAVID: In who My soul delighteth. 8 HENRY: Um-hum. 9 DAVID: Now, what makes him different than 10 anybody else? It says, I have put My Spirit upon him. 11 He shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. Now, 12 what he, what he does is he brings God's 13 judgment to the Gentiles. 14 HENRY: Um-hum. 15 In other words, the Gentiles will be DAVID: 16 judged by him. 17 HENRY: Um-hum. 18 DAVID: But by the truth he's trying to teach 19 them. 20 Um-hum. HENRY: 21 He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor 22 cause His voice to be heard in the street. That's why 23 you never heard me out, you know, on -- in, in -- I'm 24 not an evangelist. I don't go around all over the 25 world going, you know, and the Lord said, you know. You know how those guys do.

1 HENRY: Um-hum. 2 Now, a bruised reed shall He not DAVID: break, and the smoking flax shall He not quench, which 3 4 is true. I've never hurt anybody. He shall bring forth judgment unto truth. In other words, what's the 5 6 truth? Seven seals. 7 HENRY: Um-hum. 8 He shall not fail nor be cut off 9 until He has set judgment in the earth and the isles 10 shall wait upon His law, which His law is prophecy. 11 HENRY: Um-hum. 12 DAVID: They've got to, they've got to 13 believe that God's going to do what He says. 14 HENRY: Um-hum. 15 Thus said the Lord God, He that DAVID: 16 created the heavens, and stretched them out. He that 17 spread forth the earth, and that which comes out of it. 18 He that giveth breath unto the people that 19 (indiscernible) upon it, and spirit to them that walk 20 therein. I, the Lord, have called thee in 21 righteousness and I will hold thy hand and I will keep 22 thee and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a 23 light to the Gentiles. 24 Okay? So that's, that's why, you know, that 25 -- well, that's, that's why the seven seals are very important.

I -- me and you, we're one, one communication, one bloodline, but some of the 19 20 other bloodlines are clotted. 21 HENRY: Exactly. And that's why we need for 22 you to, even though you can't get down on your knees, I 23 want you to, in your mind, be down on your knees so, so 24 that --25 DAVID: Well, I'm on my back, looking upwards --

1 **HENRY:** (Laughter.) 2 -- and, and waiting. DAVID: 3 I, I really, I really feel that there HENRY: 4 is an awful lot of people that are on, you know, that 5 are under pressure, because of the waiting. And I'm not talking about you and me. I'm talking about the 6 7 young people, you know, within the compound and the 8 young people outside of the compound. 9 DAVID: Yeah. 10 **HENRY:** You know? So, if there's anything 11 that you can do to speed the process up, I tell you, you know, I think it'll be in the best interest and, 12 13 and everybody will be served, you know, greatly because your message needs to get out. It needs to get out and 14 there are lots of people that you're going to -- whose 15 16 lives you're going to touch. You've touched a lot, a 17 lot of people's lives, but there are thousands more 18 that you need to touch. 19 DAVID: Well, it's, it's going to be, going 20 to be definitely worked out. That's for sure. 21 **HENRY:** Good. 22 DAVID: So that's why, like I said, I was 23 just simply bringing up that like last night, you know, these guys that are creeping around out here, thinking 24 25 they're hiding and all that, they're not.

HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: You know, and the darkness doesn't 2 cover them and the, and the fog doesn't. It covers them to a degree. 3 HENRY: Yeah. 4 5 DAVID: But there's a certain point of degree 6 to where, you know, you know, infrared and stuff like 7 that, you know, you can just about today purchase from 8 like Excaliber and places like that. 9 HENRY: Um-hum. 10 DAVID: Just about any of the, you know, 11 Series 1, Series 2, or Series 3, you know, technical 12 scoping and stuff like that. 13 HENRY: Uh-huh. 14 DAVID: And, of course you know there's, 15 there's, there's units that you can sense, you can 16 sense when you're using infrared and stuff like that. 17 **HENRY:** Um-hum. 18 DAVID: But it's not so much that as it's 19 when you're using the, the shadowed light, you know, 20 the, the lights that have the, you know, you, you, you 21 put a filter on them and --22 HENRY: Uh-huh. 23 DAVID: -- then you're able to see. 24 Uh-huh. HENRY: 25 DAVID: So, you know, you know, and like, like -- okay, this tape back here -- it's not there

1 It's, it's been moved and that makes everybody 2 more at rest. You know, it's kind of like someone out there sticking their tongue at you --3 4 HENRY: (Laughter.) 5 -- you know, the thing is it DAVID: 6 shouldn't, it shouldn't, it shouldn't, it shouldn't 7 hurt our feelings --8 HENRY: I know what you're saying. 9 DAVID: But the thing of it is is that, you know, I just don't want, you know --10 11 HENRY: Yeah. 12 DAVID: -- to make a bad thing worse --13 HENRY: Exactly. 14 -- by, by somebody out there finding DAVID: 15 out a hard way that you, you don't violate, you don't 16 violate trust and promises like that by doing those 17 things, 'cause that stuff is made out of, you know, 18 high-strengthened steel --19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: But, you know, there are things that, 21 you know, are available, you know, whether illegal or 22 elegal (phonetic), you know. They are available that can, that can penetrate those little buggies out there. 23 24 HENRY: Um-hum. 25 DAVID: You know? Um-hum. HENRY:

DAVID: And, and the thing of it is is like I say, you know, it's a government -- it's, it's a political thing now. It's a political thing to where, you know, my god is a political ruler and, and I am, I am embannered to my god. Now, I would not be doing this if what I had experienced was not true.

HENRY: Well --

DAVID: If, if I did not know this god, and if the president of the United States had come to me one day and says, you know, Mr. Howell, I want you to work with the United States of America, you've been a good citizen. I've, I've seen your report cards.

You've been a good citizen and I want you to work on a tactical force with the FBI and I want you to help deal with, with bad guys and everything and I'd like to give you this position and then, then that's -- I would have been so honored and so proud that somebody would have overlooked my apparent bad English and bad history, you know what I mean?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And bad spelling and all that and would have looked basically at my citizenship and my commitment, you know, and to give me such a position. And then, then I would be where you're at right now.

HENRY: Uh-huh.

DAVID: And some, some other goofy would be

1 | where I'm at right now.

HENRY: Um-hum. Well, see, one of the things though is, as a matter of fact, on behalf of the FBI and on behalf of the ATF, I am asking you, you know, to help us with this situation that we have at hand.

DAVID: Right.

know, that you have helped us, because like you said, you've, you've kept the young guys within the compound who feel that they're being taunted, you know, and could have picked off some of these guys, you, you've kept them from doing that. Now, I, I ask you with all sincerity, to please do whatever you need to do so that we can bring this thing to a conclusion as soon as possible. I think that the world needs to hear your message and it will hear your message. And I look forward to that. I will continue to follow what happens to you from now on.

DAVID: Well, that's good. I hope so. But, you know, that wisdom, you know, can, can you, can you imagine being a big macho guy and standing before God in the judgment and there has to be a woman there too?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Isn't that wild?

HENRY: Really.

DAVID: And to think that the way we treated

1 women is the way we're going to be judged in the 2 judgment? 3 HENRY: Um-hum. 4 DAVID: Oooh. 5 HENRY: I know it. 6 DAVID: And you know --7 HENRY: I know --8 DAVID: -- all -- a lot of Hebrews, see, they 9 already know about -- key to being feminine, but, you 10 know, the Greek and the Roman systems, they were very, 11 you know, they were paganistic and they were very 12 masculine-predominant in their religions. 13 HENRY: Uh-huh. 14 DAVID: And they, they just totally went to 15 the manuscript and -- especially the Aramaic New 16 Covenant manuscript, and everywhere the, the Shekhina 17 was brought to pass, which is the spirit that Christ 18 refers to, Chachma Wise Woman --19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: -- they change it to masculine. 21 change it to Paraclete Numa, made it either the spirit 22 of neuter or masculine. That's funny how people can 23 decide, well, I don't like God in the concept of being 24 male and female and being a family. Um-hum. 25 HENRY: DAVID: That's where the Star of David

originally originated from. It, it based itself in two 1 2 triangles linked together --3 HENRY: Um-hum. 4 DAVID: -- an incorporation of what the 5 pyramids were. It showed that at each angle or pivot 6 there was a connection between the father, the mother, 7 both coming together into one, the offspring. 8 symbol of the Star of David was the family in heaven 9 being united with the family on earth. That's why they 10 interlock together, making the six sides of the pointed 11 Star of David. 12 HENRY: Um-hum. 13 DAVID: Of course, you know they -- some 14 people consider that to be a cultic sign, but of 15 course, anything in the world that you look at and have regard to, not knowing the meaning or significance to 16 17 the reality of it, is a cultic sign. Even if it's a 18 cross of Jesus. 19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 DAVID: You know? 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 So anyway, I'm going to go ahead and DAVID: 23 let you go and in the morning Heather will be coming 24 out. 25 HENRY: At first light? Yeah, you know. Give, give us a DAVID:

little chance to, to crank up in the morning. 1 2 **HENRY:** Okay. 3 DAVID: And --4 Are you coming out with Heather? HENRY: 5 DAVID: I, I can't answer that right now. 6 Possibly. Maybe. I don't know. 7 HENRY: Okay. 8 DAVID: I mean I'm being --9 HENRY: I want you to --10 -- honest with you now. DAVID: 11 HENRY: Okay. I want you, I want you to work 12 towards that. I really --13 I've been praying every day which 14 plan. Okay. Let me explain. In the prophecies, 15 Isaiah 28 for instance. Well, let me just go back. 16 From the time of Moses, God refers and says, Moses, 17 Moses. The prophecies all throughout the prophetic 18 rise of the scripture, and this is very unique and a 19 mystery that I've shown to a lot of people, the 20 prophecies stutter. Statements are repeated twice. In 21 all the prophecies. 22 Now, a person might not even know this or 23 not, not -- may not be aware of it for the longest 24 time --25 HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: But of course in the prophecies

1 Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen? 2 HENRY: Um-hum. 3 Isaiah 28 talks about a strong and DAVID: 4 mighty one that God raises up, that's going to be as a overflowing scourge, as tempest and hail, and you know, 5 6 mighty fire overflowing that's going to cast down to 7 the ground the crown of pride. And it says that, that 8 it'll be as an overflowing scourge that the wicked --9 it'll be like their beds will be too short to sleep in. 10 You know, so God says -- about this event, God says, 11 whom shall he teach knowledge and who shall he make to understand doctrine? 'Cause the whole subject revolves 12 13 around all the prophecies about this event. 14 HENRY: Um-hum. 15 It says them that are weaned from the DAVID: 16 milk and drawn from the breast, for precept must be 17 upon line upon line, precept upon precept, precept upon 18 precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, 19 there a little. For with stammering lips -- stammer 20 means stutter, right? 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 DAVID: And all the prophecies do this. They all come to a point of importance and it repeats itself 23 24 twice. 25 HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: In another tongue when he speaks to

1 this people to whom he said, this is the rest where ye 2 shall cause the weary to rest and this is the 3 refreshing, but yet they would not hear. Now, the 4 seventh day of the Lord thy God is the day where we 5 find rest. God's commanded a law that thou shalt work six days, but on the seventh day, it's the day of the 6 7 Lord thy God. And he explains that God made heaven and earth in six days and chose a day to sit back and have 8 a good time. Right? 9 10 HENRY: Um-hum. 11 DAVID: And so what happens is that many 12 people, they, they don't really know which day the 13 Sabbath is. Some people are not even convicted on it, but, but, but nonetheless, one day of the seven God 14 15 commands to have a day that's dedicated to God. Right? 16 HENRY: Right. 17 DAVID: But Christ says the Sabbath is not made -- man is not made for the Sabbath, the Sabbath is 18 19 made for man. Now, on the original Sabbath, Eve was 20 created in the evening of the sixth day, wasn't she? 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 Adam had already been hired in the 23 Garden of Eden and already had a job, hadn't he? 24 Naming the animals. 25 HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: But the scripture says there was no

help meet for Adam. Now, Adam just didn't know what to 1 2 do, did he? So, the Lord God caused Adam to rest. A 3 deep sleep fell upon Adam and while Adam was resting, 4 God began to work to form the Shekhina, or to reveal 5 the mystery of the inner man. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 You see? And now God formed the DAVID: 8 woman and brought them to the man and he says, now this 9 is Isha, for out of man she was taken. For she is bone 1.0 of my bone and flesh of my flesh. In other words, now I'm complete. 11 12 HENRY: Um-hum. 13 DAVID: Now, the Bible commands the Sabbath 14 to be observed from even to even, okay? 15 HENRY: Um-hum. 16 So on that sixth day as the sun began 17 to dawn -- I mean, the sun began to draw into the 18 evening, Lylatov, what took place was is that God 19 commanded the man and the woman to enter into the 20 Sabbath covenant. 21 HENRY: Um-hum. 22 DAVID: So, now, you know what that was, 23 don't you? 24 What now? HENRY: DAVID: The Sabbath covenant. 25

HENRY:

Oh.

DAVID: Well, that's, that's the whole
purpose of the Sabbath.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: A memorial of the living God. God's

made -- God made man after God's image and to God's likeness, right?

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: Well, in Isaiah 58, Isaiah is commanded to proclaim a message of Israel, saying lift up thy voice like a trumpet, you know, lift up thy trumpet, show my people trans -- show my people their transgression and the house of Jacob their sins.

HENRY: Um-hum.

DAVID: And God says, this is the fast that I have chosen, for you to bow your head as a bulrush and to spread ashes underneath you and to hang your head, you know, and to grow mournfully. God says is, is this not the Sab -- the fast I've chosen for you to, to feed the hungry and to clothe the naked and those that are cast out into your home and to hide not yourself from your own flesh?

Now, the Sabbath day is a day where God blesses mankind with the end of the work of the week and the joys of having husband and wife and they becoming one flesh.

HENRY: Um-hum.

1 DAVID: That's why the word Shabbat is Abba, 2 which means Father, and Shabbat is feminine, which means the father is in the mother. 3 4 HENRY: Um-hum. 5 DAVID: Now, that's pretty nice, isn't it? 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 DAVID: Okay. Now, so what happens is is 8 that Jeremiah talks about lo, the day has come saith 9 the Lord, when Judas shall say, they shall use this 10 speech in the Lion of Judah, behold a woman shall 11 compass a man. Now, you know when a, when a man and a 12 woman are together, united together --13 HENRY: Uh-huh. 14 DAVID: -- the man is complete in the woman, 15 isn't he? 16 HENRY: Um-hum. 17 DAVID: Okay. You see? Now, that's the 18 memorial to the god of creation. 19 HENRY: Um-hum. 20 Now, when the -- Constantine and them DAVID: 21 changed the, the laws of God, they took on a different 22 spirit. 23 Um-hum. HENRY: 24 DAVID: And they proclaimed the first day of 25 the lunar week as the Sabbath, which was Sunday, and that institution went on and took in additional laws

being inspired from a different spirit and they began 1 2 to command men not to marry. And of course what 3 happens is the natural purposes of creation, these men 4 entered up into all kinds of problems, such as 5 homosexuality in the priesthood and things like that. 6 You know, Martin Luther, though, he, he began to 7 research and he, he put things back right by mar -- by 8 marrying Catherine Van Borne (phonetic sp.) in 1525. I 9 -- that's a beautiful story. Have you read it? 10 HENRY: Um-hum. 11 DAVID: Yeah, you know, he, he was going to 12 give her to somebody else and she says, no, Luther, I'm 13 going with you. So -- you know it's funny how people 14 can get wild ideas about things and they can think --HENRY: Hold on a second. Hold on a second. 15 16 DAVID: -- something's true. 17 HENRY: Hold on a second. Hold on --18 DAVID: Sure. 19 HENRY: Listen. They just gave me a message 20 here -- hold on a second. Okay. Some of those tanks 21 are going to be moving around during the night, but 22 they want me to, to tell you that, that it's going to 23 be routine in terms of, of the shifting of the, you 24 know, a shift change and to ensure that the perimeter is okay, nobody's going to come in there or anything. 25 But they want you to know that there's no danger to

anybody in the compound. 1 2 DAVID: Okey doke. 3 HENRY: Okay? 4 DAVID: Let me, let me get the message 5 around. But tell them, just please be careful. 6 **HENRY:** I will. 7 DAVID: Okay? 8 HENRY: I will. 9 DAVID: I, I appreciate that. 10 HENRY: Okay. 11 'Cause if something messes up on this DAVID: 12 side or on your side, then World War III again. 13 HENRY: No, we don't need that. 14 DAVID: You know what I mean? 15 HENRY: We do not need that. 16 DAVID: I know. It's crazy. Let's, let's 17 let, let's, let's, let's look at these passages of 18 scripture I've been sharing with you --19 HENRY: Yes. 20 DAVID: -- and I wish your other agents, they 21 would look at them and, and, you know, take a look at 22 them and, and, you know, it would be so awesome if 23 everyone could just sit down and have --24 **HENRY:** I know. 25 DAVID: -- one honest Bible study in this great nation of America.

1 **HENRY:** Well --2 You know, America does not have to be DAVID: mutilated or destroyed. 3 4 HENRY: Well, you're right, see --It can be exonerated still above all 5 DAVID: other nations. 6 7 HENRY: And that's why I'm telling you, that's why I'm telling you, because one of our 8 weaknesses is the number of people that we have in, in 9 10 prisons. Okay? Here you have a perfect opportunity to 11 make a difference. You know? For people that are 12 forgotten, that nobody cares about. 13 DAVID: Well, no one is forgotten in God. 14 That's for sure. 15 HENRY: Well, I know but I'm saying within, 16 you know, within our system here, within our system 17 here, who -- you know, there's very few clergy that go 18 into the prisons to, to teach the Word. I don't know 19 You know, I mean, it shouldn't be that way, but 20 that's the way that it is. It's a shame. The flock 21 should be growing and, and instead, you know, the --22 it's the other way around. Peop -- more and more 23 people are moving away from the religion. And that's 24 that, you know, I think that's that's one of the 25 problems --

DAVID: That's the abomination of the

1 churches. They have no knowledge to give them. 2 HENRY: Exactly. Exactly. 3 Okay. Well, let me get this out to DAVID: them and --4 5 HENRY: Okav. 6 DAVID: -- and, and, you know, tell the guys to give us a few minutes out there on your side --7 8 **HENRY:** Okay. 9 DAVID: -- and we'll get this underway. MR. KORESH: -- the knowledge of God, the knowledge of trust. I mean, what kind of, what kind of story of this is that a child hears about Abraham who goes off and he's told by God to sacrifice his own son? Now, here is a definite biblical story of child abuse. I mean, what, what, what a test to a child's mind, that my son the Lord shall provide unto thee a sacrifice? The father, where is the lamb? The Lord shall provide.

And all of a sudden, son, the Lord has provided you for 1 2 a sacrifice. Now, what, what a dramatic experience. 3 HENRY: Um-hum. MR. KORESH: You know, what a, what a 4 5 shock to a child, a young man. 6 HENRY: Um-hum. 7 MR. KORESH: You know? 8 HENRY: Um-hum. 9 And then all of a sudden, the MR. KORESH: 10 Bible tells that Isaac complied, you know? 11 HENRY: Um-hum. 12 MR. KORESH: And Isaac, Isaac is going to 13 allow his father to, to kill him for a sacrifice and 14 about the time that the knife started coming down 15 towards his son's chest (indiscernible) the Lord, you 16 know, grabbed the arm of Abraham --17 HENRY: Um-hum. 18 MR. to misquote or mistranslate the passage saying, you

1 know, the Bible does say smite the shepherd, sheep will 2 be scattered and it says, you know, God will sacrifice 3 the little ones. No, that's not what it says. Nowhere 4 in the Hebrew manuscript or text does it say that --5 HENRY: Um-hum MR. KORESH: -- at all. And yet, you know, 6 7 this case of biblical apparent child abuse is praised 8 by Christians as one of the most sober tests of child 9 obedience. 10 HENRY: IIm-hum. 1.1 MR. flood that there were men with men working that which

is unseemly. 1 2 HENRY: Um-hum. 3 MR. KORESH: You know what I mean? 4 HENRY: Right. 5 MR. KORESH: And reaching into themselves 6 with just recompense which is meat. Of course, you 7 know, the -- the subject is they received a disease 8 which they couldn't get rid of, they deserved it. 9 HENRY: Um-hum, um-hum. 10 MR. KORESH: And it was in the days of Noah 11 it is today, the, the epidemic of AIDS --12 HENRY: Um-hum. 13 MR. KORESH: -- you know, this virus 14 which --15 HENRY: Exactly. 16 MR.
