12/15/72 Mr. Kelly advised that Dean had talked to Mr. Gray and we are not to interview Dahlberg at this time. Mr. Minneapolis so informed.

12/16/72 A phone call was received from ANG Peterson asking for an informant's name, of information on Dahlberg. This was prepared & held & delivered to him at 5:00 p.m. Also Mr. Kelly to contact some names of our reports have been delivered to Peterson and to the U.S. Attorney.

12/17/72 SAC Kunkel & Mr. Bates met with Mr. Gray who requested that we contact the local fact-finding of Fiering and all law authorities and associates. Such investigation was ordered in Miami. He also instructed that we check out thoroughly & completely, telephone Mr. Kelly. This was also ordered.

12/18/72 Mr. Kelly advised Mr. Bates & instructed that he tell SAC Kunkel that if they have a good prospect as per 12/15/72 they should attempt to make a contact with them at home or away from the office and see if they would be willing to talk with the FBI without an attorney present.

12/19/72 Mr. Gray said agents should go after Odle on the night of 7/15/72 and see if he would talk to the FBI. Mr. Bates immediately relayed this to SAC Kunkel. Kunkel felt that if he let Odle & he refused to talk, it would give him an opportunity to get his story straight before being interviewed before the Grand Jury. Mr. Bates relayed this to Mr. Gray who agreed & instructed we should hold up on this.
