Attached summarizes comments of Assistant U. S. Attorneys Earl J. Silbert and Don E. Campbell made during a 7/14/72, conference with the Special Agent in Charge of the Washington Field Office in connection with the FBI investigation of the 6/17/72, Burglary of Democratic National Committee Headquarters.

Mr. Silbert, who is primarily in charge of the Federal grand jury action, was highly impressed with the completeness and comprehensiveness of this investigation and is overwhelmed by the volume of reports submitted to him. Silbert is completely satisfied with progress of investigation to which Mr. Campbell agreed.

Silbert remarked that he was becoming exasperated with delaying tactics by Washington Metropolitan Police Department in not providing a report concerning the arrests of the five burglary subjects on morning of 6/17/72.

This is to record comments made by Assistant United States Attorneys EARL J. SILBERT and DONALD E. CAMPBELL at a conference held in the SAC's office, Washington Field Office, on 7/14/72 regarding the captioned matter. During the course of the conference, the Assistant United States Attorneys were asked whether the investigation conducted thus far had been responsive to the needs of the United States Attorney's Office and whether, in their opinion, it had been comprehensive and, also, whether they could offer any suggestions to further assist the Grand Jury inquiry. Mr. SILBERT, who is primarily in charge of presenting this case to the Grand Jury, advised that he had never been so impressed with the completeness and the comprehensive nature of the investigation being conducted by the FBI. He stated that he felt he was virtually being overwhelmed by the volume of reports that have been submitted to him thus far. He felt there were at least twenty-five FBI Offices involved in the investigation, and he was corrected on this point and advised that there were actually forty-seven

involved at that time. He said he was completely satisfied with the progress of the investigation conducted by the FBI, and Mr. CAMPBELL agreed with his remarks.

In an aside, Mr. SILBERT stated that he had made several inquiries of the Metropolitan Police Department in an effort to obtain a report concerning the arrest for burglary of the five subjects in this case on the morning of 6/17/72. He stated that he had not received a report from the Police Department and that he was becoming exasperated over the delaying tactics employed by the Police Department which has cited various excuses, such as participants being on annual or sick leave, and the report had, therefore, not been completely assembled.



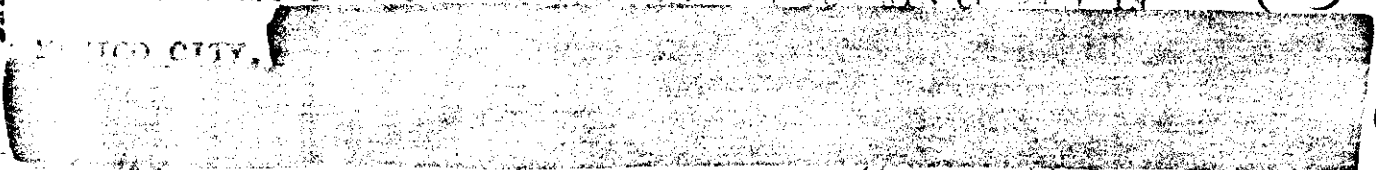
