HARTZ stated she has learned from her mother, PEARL, that JACK occasionally goes and visits ELLIS MARSHALL fairly regularly and believes that the last time that JACK visited MARSHALL was in the Spring or early Summer of this year.

HARTZ stated she does not know the connection that MARSHALL has with her brother; however, she assumes their relationship goes back to their "State Department days."

HARTZ went on to state she is in telephonic conversation with her mother at least once a week. She recalls on one occasion that her mother informed her that her son, JACK, had gone to Mexico in the Spring or early Summer of 1972, to go fishing with a few friends from the Washington, D. C.,/Virginia area. HARTZ does not know the exact location in Mexico where this group went; however, she recalls that her mother had mentioned her brother had some friends in Mexico City and that he was previously while he was with the State Department."

DAVID PACKARD, Chairman, Northern California Committee to Re-Elect the President, furnished the following information:

He indicated that in the process of establishing policy concerning functions of the chairman and representatives of the Committee to Re-Elect the President, several questions came up concerning who would be in charge of making arrangements and handling finances for the Northern California area. He stated it was his opinion that all these policies and arrangements should be made by himself inasmuch as he was the chairman. He stated as a result he wrote a letter to the National Headquarters for a policy statement, and on June 22, 1972, GEORGE GORDON LIDDY came to San Mateo and had a conference with himself and THOMAS HIGH concerning these policy decisions. He indicated nothing else was discussed during the course of this meeting.

Mr. PACKARD advised he had never met nor had any dealings with EVERETTE HOWARD HUNT, JR., nor did he have any information concerning the burglary of the Democratic National Headquarters, Washington, D.C.

THOMAS HIGH, Assistant Regional Chairman for the Committee to Re-Elect the President, advised he was at a meeting with GEORGE GORDON LIDDY and DAVID PACKARD on the morning of June 22, 1972. He stated he met Mr. LIDDY at the San Francisco International Airport, where he had arrived from Los Angeles, California, and brought him to the Northern California Headquarters of the Committee to Re-Elect the President. He stated the purpose of this meeting was solely to establish policy and to fix responsibility as to how the financing and other policy making decisions would be handled as they pertained to Northern California. He indicated that while Mr. LIDDY was at his office he made a long-distance phone call to (202) 964-4072. Mr. HIGH was unable to furnish the name of the individual to whom this call was placed.







Attached is a summary of current developments concerning burglary of Democratic National Headquarters.

1. W. Richard Howard, Staff Assistant, White House, interviewed in regard to his memorandum 3/30/72, which reflected Hunt was to be dropped as consultant at the White House in order that 1701 (address of Committee to Reelect the President) could pick him up and use him. Howard explained that the White House desired to hire Hunt as full time consultant; however, Hunt was 20 year retiree with a Government agency and full time employment would interfere with his annuity. Therefore, it was decided that Hunt remain at the White House only as a day-today consultant. The reference to 1701 was merely a suggestion that maybe someone could find a job for Hunt on a full time basis at the Committee to Reelect the President. Howard related final decision in this regard was with Bruce Kehrli. Kehrli will be interviewed as soon as John Dean, counsel to the President, can make arrangements.

2. Assistant U. S. Attorney advised subpoena for Felipe De Diego dated 8/15/72, instead of 8/8/72. Possibility that De Diego will be granted immunity for his testimony; however, Department has not yet rendered a decision in this regard.







3. Analysis of time and attendance cards from White House reviewed and of interest was Liddy's claim to have been employed at White House for 8 hours 9/4/71, as it was on this date Hunt positively identified by airline stewardess in company of man who resembled Liddy.

4. Felipe De Diego scheduled to appear before Federal Grand Jury 8/15/72, where he will be offered opportunity to testify, if he refuses he will be granted immunity, if he further refuses, Assistant United States Attorney will recommend he be held in contempt
