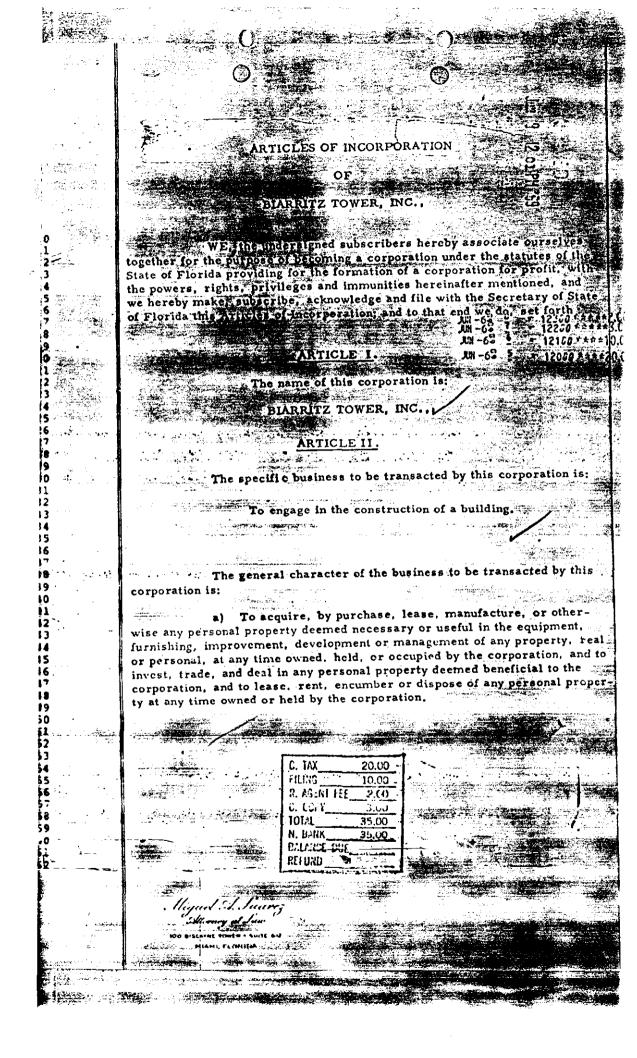

- b) To build, erect, construct, purchase, ar otherwise acquire, own, provide, establish, hold, work, develop, sell, convey, lease, mortgage, exchange, improve and otherwise deal in and dispose of real estate and real property and all other kinds of property of whatsoever nature, whether real, personal or mixed, or any interests or rights therein without limits as to amounts; to buy, sell, assign, convey and cancel liens upon personal property and real estate of every kind and nature whatsoever: to act as broker or agent for the purchase, sale, leasing and management of real estate, and the negotiating of loans thereon; to borrow and lend money and to negotiate loans; to draw, endorse, accept, discount and deliver bills of exchange, promissory notes, bonds, debentures, and other negotiable instruments of whatsoever nature, and secure the same by mortgage on its property or otherwise; to issue on commission, subscribe for, take, acquire, hold, exchange and deal in shares, stocks, bonds, obligations or securities of any government or authority, individual or corporation.
- c) To carry on the business of a holding company and to purchase and acquire any mercantile or commercial business, trada or enterprise permitted by the laws of the State of Florida, and to own, hold, operate, maintain, use, sell, or otherwise dispose of the same. To enter into or engage in any such business, trade or enterprise.

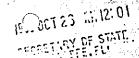

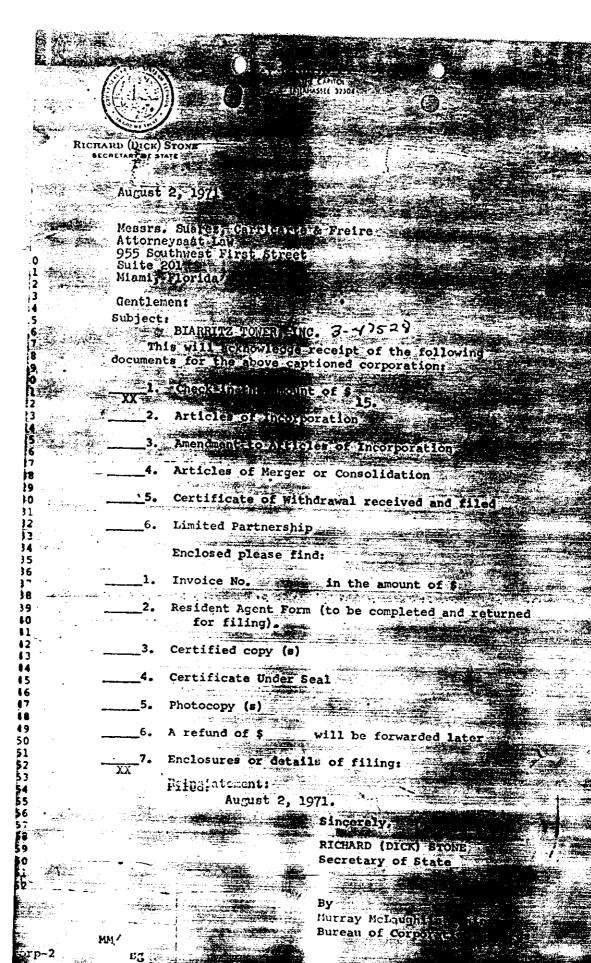

ALFRED C. BALDWIN, HOWARD HUNT, DAVID COLSON, DAVID YOUNG, ALEX BUTTERFIELD, VIRGILIO GONZALES, BERNARD L. BARKER, JAMES W. MC CORD, EUGENIO R. MARTINEZ, ANGELO F. FIORINI, with seven other elimination photographs.

Miss DEVLIN advised that she recognized JAMES MC CORD, as he was in charge of Security at the Committee to Re-Elect the President. She also recognized DAVID COLSON and DAVID YOUNG, who she said she has met and seen at functions outside the premises of the offices of the Committee to Re-Elect the President. She stated that she recognized no other photographs.

She advised she has worked at the Committee to Re-Elect the President as Receptionist since February 22, 1972.

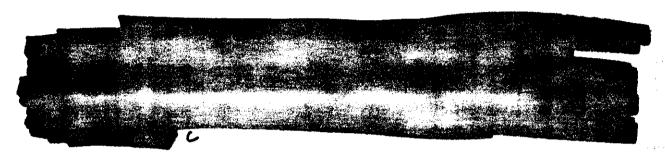

Mr. BERT K. SILVERMAN, was interviewed at his place of employment, 1030 15th Street, Northwest, Suite 168. telephone number 223-2607.



SILVERMAN stated he had visited his "in-laws" in Miami, Florida during the Christmas 1971 holidays. During this trip, he visited BOUMAN at Winter Haven, Florida on a strictly personal basis.

In the early part of January, 1972, SILVERMAN made reservations for BOUMAN at the Hay-Adams Hotel, Washington, D.C. BOUNAN visited Washington, D.C. for an unknown purpose and SILVERMAN met him once in the tap room at the Hay-Adams Hotel for a drink. BOUMAN was in the company of a white male but SILVERMAN stated he was completely unable to furnish any descriptive data concerning this individual and would be unable to identify a photograph.

SILVERMAN stated HOMARD HUNT was unknown to him and viewed a group of (14) photographs including those December 2014 of E. HOWARD HUNT, JENE VALDES, RAOUL GODOYN, GEORGE LEONARD, ANGELO FRANK FIORINI, FRANK CARTER, EDWARD MARTIN and ALFRED C. BALDHIN.

W. PEYTON GEORGE, employed in the Congressional Lisison Office for the Secretary of Agriculture, Washington, D.C., (WDC), was interviewed in a Bureau vehicle in the parking lot at the United States Capitol.

Mr. GEORGE advised that a call was received at his home on April 26, 1972, from JAMES McCORD, who requested that GEORGE contact him regarding employment. GEORGE telephonically contacted McCORD on April 27, 1972, and was advised by McCORD, that he had read GEORGE's resume at the Society for Ex-Agents in New York City and was interested in hiring him for a security position. GEORGE informed him that the monthly meeting for ex-agents in the WDC area was being held at HOGATE's Restaurant on that same date and the meeting would be an ideal place for further discussion. However, McCORD did not show up at the meeting.

GEORGE contacted McCORD at his office at The Committee to Re-Elect the President, 1701 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W. McCORD informed GEORGE that he felt GEORGE was qualified to assume the position as Director of Security for a detail to guard Mrs. MARTHA MITCHELL. Mrs. MITCHELL had expressed desire to have former FBI agents between age 30-40 years on the detail. McCORD offered a salary of \$20,000 per year. GEORGE informed McCORD that he was well satisfied in his present position and had eventual plans of practicing law in WDC. Therefore, the only conditions under which he would consider employment would be if he obtained a salary of approximately \$30,000 per year and a position with the law firm, Mitchell, Mudge, Rose and Alexander, McCORD advised that he would arrange a meeting with FRED LARUE.

On April 29, 1972, McCORD, LARUE, and GEORGE met and discussed details of the proposed position for GEORGE.

LARUE advised that GEORGE's salary request was not out of line, but LARUE would have to speak to JOHN MITCHELL concerning the position with Mr. MITCHELL's law firm.

On May 1, 1972, GEORGE was recontacted by McCORD and was informed that LARUE had contacted Mr. MITCHELL who was leary of the financial arrangements that would arise since GEORGE's salary would probably have to be listed as campaign contributions. McCORD stated he would secure jobs for GEORGE in McCORD's security consulting firm in order to bolster GEORGE's salary to the \$30,000 figure. GEORGE declined the offer stating he was happy in his present position, would not consider the job. He suggested former FBI Agents ROBERT McKENNA and CHUCK ORSI for the job.

On June 16, 1972, GEORGE and his family were sightseeing in WDC, and on the spur of the moment, decided to attend
the 8:30 P.M. concert at the Waterfront Amphitheater. On the
way to the concert at approximately 8:00 to 8:15 P.M., he
stopped at the Howard Johnson's Notor Lodge directly across
from the Watergate Hotel in order to purchase an ice cream
cone for his son. Seated at a stool in the restaurant was
McCORD, who immediately approached GEORGE and engaged him in
a brief conversation. GEORGE could not state McCORD was in
the company of any of the individuals who were arrested in
the Watergate. McCORD was observed leaving the Motor Lodge
but did not cross the street to the Watergate, but presumably
went somewhere else in the Lodge.

PAUL E. ERTZINGER, Chairman of the Washington Chapter of the Ex-FBI Agents Society, was interviewed at his residence, 4422 Ellicott Street, N.W., telephone EM3-9203.

ERTZINGER advised that he was contacted by JAMES W. MC CORD sometime during the first ten days in May, 1972. MC CORD asked ERTZINGER to furnish several names of ex-FBI Agents who might be interested in doing security type work for the Committee for the Re-Election of the President. MC CORD told ERTZINGER that the job would require some traveling. ERTZINGER advised that MC CORD did not actually ask him if he wanted the job and MC CORD seemed to know that ERTZINGER would not be interested in a job that involved traveling. ERTZINGER stated that he was looking for employment, but did not want to travel. MC CORD indicated that the job would probably last until November, 1972. Salary was not discussed, however, ERTZINGER later learned that the salary would be \$105 per day. He also heard later that the job wull be bodyguard for MARTHA MITCHELL. ERTZINGER told MC CORD that he would try to think of several people for the job. The conversation was terminated and ERTZINGER has not heard from MC CORD since then. ERTZINGER stated that he did not know MC CORD and this was his only contact with MC CORD.

Agent who now works for Page Communications in Vienna, Virginia. ERTZINGER knew BARTLETT was interested in employment and he gave BARTLETT MC CORD's name and telephone number. BARTLETT later called ERTZINGER and told him that he had met with MC CCRD personally and recommended a couple of other men for the position offered by MC CCRD.

Vice President of First National Bank, 1701 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D. C., knew MC CORD and had given

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ERTZINGER's name to MC CORD. MC CORD and LOVE both work in the same building and see each other occasionally in this connection.

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
