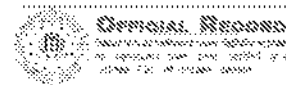

### Details:

On the morning 12/07/2017 the FBI was notified that a school shooting had occurred at the high school in Aztec, NM. WILLIAM ATCHISON date of birth (DOB)03/18/1996, made entry into the High School armed with a firearm. ATCHISON shot and killed CASEY MARQUEZ (Juvenile) and FRANCISCO FERNANDEZ (Juvenile). Law Enforcement responded to the school pronouncing ATCHISON deceased a short time later.

A query of WILLIAM ATCHISON in Sentinel and other FBI databases found that ATCHISON [Redacted]

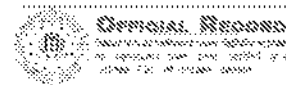

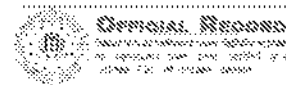

On December 7, 2017, Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) assisted deputies of the San Juan County Sheriff's Office (SJCSO) in clearing and securing the residence at [Redacted]

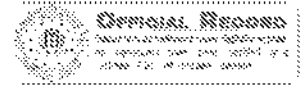

FBI agents and SJCSO deputies attempted to make contact with the residence of the above-mentioned address. After several attempts to make contact with the residents, SJCSO observed an open door on the side of the house. Based on the circumstances that the subject of a mass school shooting lived at the residence, and that no answer to law enforcement presence was observed, SJCSO deputies and FBI agents concurred, that there existed a reasonable belief that the safety and welfare of the residents of [Redacted] was at risk.

Agents and deputies made entry into the residence, and begun a security sweep of the residence. Agents and deputies eventually made contact with [Redacted] and briefly detained her, unrestrained in the kitchen. Agents and deputies then cleared the remaining portion of the residence. FBI and SJCSO then maintained the scene as a search warrant was prepared.

FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of entry 12/20/2017

On 12/7/17 the Albuquerque Evidence Response Team (ERT) was alerted to a shooting that took place at Aztec High School in Aztec, NM at approximately 8am. Shortly after the incident the San Juan Sheriff's office requested FBI assistance to include ERT response.

Ultimately the New Mexico State Police (NMSP) took the lead role in the investigation and scene processing. AQ ERT assisted by searching the exterior areas of the school grounds for any impacts as it appeared approximately four rounds were fired through exterior windows, no impacts were discovered or documented. AQ ERT also assisted NMSP by completing a final sweep search of all areas of the school with possible evidence /impacts, identifying several point of impact for further processing.

AQ ERT remained in Aztec on standby should further searches be necessary until approximately 8am on 12/8/17.
