[Redacted] confidentially advised in relet that there is an establishment known as the "Truth Shop" in Harlem, NY, which is the home of the black nationalists. This establishment also represents a haven for a number of "new groups". The "new groups", not further identified, are acting in a very subtle manner and are receiving money from the "Chinese Reds". One member is a Japanese girl who always hangs around the "Truth Shop" and who seems to be one of the ring leaders.

On 11/8/66 [] advised that KOCHIYAMA, resides at 545 W. 126th St., NYC, and at present is working on her yearly newsletter, which is called Christmas Cheer. In her newsletter she writes all the news that has occurred in the various black nationalist groups. She has at present curtailed most of her activities in order to work at this. Previously she has held dinners and parties to raise funds for the different groups.

On 11/15/66, [] advised that KOCHIYAMA, is employed at the Concerto West, 125th St., NYC. In a conversation with source she indicated that she came to NY from California after having spent time in a detention camp during World War II.

On 10/24/66, the files of the Credit Bureau of Greater New York as received by IC [] reveal that MARY KOCHIYAMA, is married to WILLIAM KOCHIYAMA, and that he is employed by the International Christian University in Japan (Publicity Man) at 475 Riverside Drive, NYC.

Indices of the Los Angeles Office and Japanese directories back to 1949 are negative concerning MARY KOCHIYAMA and WILLIAM KOCHIYAMA.

Chinese sources of the Los Angeles Office have no information regarding persons of Japanese extraction.

[redacted] (Bufile 100-230765. New York file 100-105684) is the brother of [redacted] International Christian University, Tokyo, Japan (ICU). It was mentioned in referenced letter WILLIAM KOCHIYAMA is employed in New York City as a Publicity Man for ICU.

On 11/29/66 [redacted] stated he has never heard of MARY or WILLIAM KOCHIYAMA. He said the address 475 Riverside Drive, New York City, is that of the ICU Foundation, Incorporated, a fund gathering organization for the United States based in New York City. He doubts his brother knows any of the employees except possibly the director of the foundation.

[redacted] was interviewed in the Los Angeles County Jail on 5/23/72, by SA [redacted] at which time a photograph of subject was exhibited to him for viewing.

[redacted] advised that the photograph appeared to be identical with the MARY KOCHIYAMA known to him, who was associated with the Bazaar Brothers in New York City.

[redacted] stated that he had heard a number of rumors that KOCHIYAMA had numerous well placed contacts throughout the east coast and allegedly she had sources from whom she could purchase weapons. [redacted] declined to be specific relative to the identities of these persons and stated that he could not estimate the degree of reliability of such rumors, inasmuch as he had heard numerous comments in the past from a number of the members of the Bazaar Brothers from time to time about KOCHIYAMA's black nationalist activities.

As previously pointed out in prior communications, [redacted] faces possible extradition from Los Angeles on local charges, and for this reason, it is felt that he is not being completely truthful or candid with the interviewing agent, apparently hoping to avoid or delay such extradition.
