Basic felt that since he had served the amount of time recommended by the sentencing judge, his obligation had been met. (Basic was sentenced to life for air piracy although the judge made some remarks as to 10 years being a reasonable time served at the time of sentencing.

Basic has filed a motion which sets forth the reasons for his escape. AUSA [redacted] will respond to the motion during the week of 7/6/87. Should the judge rule against BUSIC on the motion, it is expected that he will enter a plea of guilty.

SYNOPSIS: Busic, who was involved in the Croation Freedom movement prior to his incarceration, escaped from Otisville Federal Correction Institution (FCI), New York, between 11:00 pm, 4/16/87, and 1:00 am, 4/17/87. He was serving a life sentence for Air Piracy resulting in death. Busic was apprehended without incident by local authorities, Milford, Pennsylvania, on 4/18/87.

DETAILS: Zvonko Busic left a dummy in his bed and escaped between 11:00 pm, 4/16/87, and 1:00 am, 4/17/87, from the Otisville FCI (Medium Security Facility), New York. Wire cutters were located on the ground where an inner fence was cut and it is speculated that he climbed an outer fence. The FBI offered its assistance to the U.S. Marshals Service and made our investigative files regarding subject available for review. Busic was apprehended without incident on 4/18/87, at 6:30 am by a Milford, Pennsylvania, Police Officer responding to a report of someone sleeping behind a building.

On 9/10/76, TWA Flight 355 enroute to Chicago from New York City, carrying 85 passengers and crew of 7, was hijacked by Busic and 4 others (under threat of blowing the plane up). They flew to France, via Montreal; Newfoundland; and Iceland. The hijackers demanded an eight page letter be published by five major newspapers pressing Croation demands for independence from Yugoslavia. Radioed instructions identified a locker at La Guardia Airport where a bomb was located. A New York City police officer was killed and three others wounded in an attempt to deactivate the bomb. All subjects surrendered to French authorities on 9/11/76, and were returned to New York on 9/12/76 where they were taken into custody. Busic was convicted of Air Piracy resulting in death and was sentenced to life imprisonment on 7/20/77, in the EDNY, Brooklyn, N.Y.

Busic was active in the Croation Freedom Movement and is a suspect in several unsolved bombings that occurred in the mid 1970's.

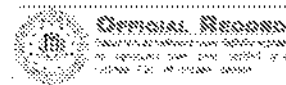
